Texas Captures 2015 Big 12 Rowing Championship

OAK RIDGE, Tenn. -- Texas won all five races to claim the 2015 Big 12 Rowing Championship as well as the Conference's automatic bid to the NCAA Championship.

The league title is the fifth for the No. 11-ranked Longhorns and second since rowing became a fully-supported Big 12 sport in 2011-12. It was also Texas' 100th all-time Big 12 postseason championship across all sports.

Texas' 48 points in the three races of IV8, 2V8 and IV4 topped the other seven teams also competing for the automatic qualifier. Oklahoma finished second, followed by Tennessee in third and K-State in fourth. Alabama and Kansas tied for fifth place. West Virginia placed seventh and Old Dominion eighth. Alabama, Old Dominion and Tennessee participate as Big 12 rowing affiliate members.

Kansas, K-State, Oklahoma, Texas and West Virginia battled in all five races for the Big 12 Championship. The Longhorns compiled 137 points to finish ahead of second-place Oklahoma, third-place K-State, fourth-place Kansas and fifth-place West Virginia.

Oklahoma captured three runner-up finishes in the IV8, IV4 and 3V8. Tennessee placed second in the 2V8 while Kansas won the silver in the 2V4. KU (IV4, 3V8) and K-State (IV8, 2V8) each had two third-place finishes while Tennessee (2V4) picked up one.
