

Coastal Carolina 7, (5) Texas Tech 5 – Attendance 25,367 (MCWS Total: 211,999; Avg. 21,200) – Time of Game: 3:48

Coastal Carolina advances to play TCU on Friday at 7 p.m. (CT) (5) Texas Tech has been eliminated from the College World Series with a 1-2 record

Coastal Carolina (51-17):

- Coastal Carolina picked up its 17th win in the last 19 games
- Coastal Carolina now owns 51 wins, second-most in the nation ... Florida's 52 wins lead the nation ...
- Coastal Carolina is the second team in Super Regional era (since 1999) to make CWS & lead NCAA in homers in same year, joining Florida in 2012, but the Chanticleers have not yet homered in three games in Omaha ...
- Coastal Carolina entered today 0-for-10 against left-handed pitching at the CWS. They were 5-for-13 today
 against southpaws ...
- Coastal Carolina's seven runs tonight were the most by any team so far at the 2016 CWS ...
- Coastal Carolina's 12 stolen bases in the NCAA Tournament, including four tonight, are the most in the country this postseason ...
- Coastal Carolina improves to 31-3 this year when scoring seven or more runs ...
- Coastal Carolina improves to 7-1 on neutral fields this season ...
- Coastal Carolina improved to 3-0 on Thursday's this season ...
- CCU is the first team to debut at the CWS and earn multiple wins since Vanderbilt won twice in 2011 ...
- Coastal Carolina avoided consecutive postseason losses for the first time since the 2013 Blacksburg Regional ...
- Five of CCU's nine hits tonight came from players who have already earned their degrees (two each by Parrett and Remillard, one by Owings).
- Four Chanticleers (Connor Owings, Zach Remillard, Michael Paez and G.K. Young) extended their CCU singleseason record for games played by appearing in their 68th contest of the spring ...
- David Parrett had his first RBI of the postseason with an RBI single in the second inning. It was his first RBI since May 21st vs. Campbell ... Parrett had two hits the entire month of May and the first two rounds of the postseason ... He entered the day hitting .130, but had two hits, three RBIs, two stolen bases tonight ...
- David Parrett stole both second and third base in the fifth inning, the first time he's swiped multiple bags in a
 game since March 6 vs. Ball State ... Parrett's three RBI match a season-high, also done March 12 vs. Illinois ...
- Mike Morrison stranded a pair of runners in the third inning, and has now stranded 30-of-39 runners this season
 ... Morrison's ERA moved to 1.38 with tonight's effort, tied for second-best in history in the program's Division I
 era ... Had season-highs with 4.1 innings, 83 pitches and four walks ...
- Bobby Holmes has inherited 23 runners this year, including a pair tonight. Only two have scored ...
- Zach Remillard and G.K. Young both have 95 hits this season, tied for fourth in CCU single-season history ...
- G.K. Young has reached base in 15 straight games and extended his hit streak to 10, which is a season-best ...
- Bobby Holmes earned his fourth save of the season, and eighth of his career ...
- Anthony Marks steal in the 1st inning was Coastal's first of the CWS in three tries. CCU entered Omaha with 107 steals on the year ...
- Zach Remillard had his 29th game with multiple hits. Tyler Chadwick had his 12th such game, and David Parrett his second ...



Texas Tech (47-20):

- Texas Tech made its second trip to the College World Series in the last three years ... Both times they opened up against TCU and lost (3-2 in 2014, 5-3 in 2016) ...
- TTU was one of seven programs nationally to advance to Omaha twice over the past three seasons ... They join the likes of Florida, TCU, Miami (Fla.), Vanderbilt, Virginia and Louisville ...
- No. 5 TTU was one of three national seeds to make it to the CWS (others: No. 1 Florida, No. 3 Miami) ... It's the Red Raiders first national seed since the NCAA went to the current format (Super Regionals) in 1999 ... TTU (1-2) was the last remaining National Seed (both Florida and Miami finished 0-2) ...
- All four of TTU's CWS losses have been by two or less runs (2014: TCU, 3-2 and Ole Miss, 2-1; 2016: TCU 5-3 and Coastal Carolina, 7-5) ... Texas Tech drops to 4-1 in elimination games this postseason ...
- Head Coach Tim Tadlock, the Big 12 Coach of the Year and finalist for the Skip Bertman National Coach of the Year Award, is the first skipper in Big 12 to lead a program to Omaha twice in his first four seasons ... He owns a 584-222 record during 13 years as a head coach (9 at Grayson, 4 at Tech) ... Sports a 149-95 all-time record at TTU, an 11-7 record in NCAA Tournament and 1-4 in CWS ...
- TTU is 26-25 all-time in the NCAA Tournament (11 appearances), which includes a 6-4 mark this year ... They
 are 1-4 all-time in CWS appearances ... Made postseason play from 1995-2002 (eight-straight years) and then in
 2004, 2014 and 2016 ...
- TTU's five runs are its most in a CWS game (previous was three on twice against TCU in 2014 and 2016) ... Its nine hits vs. Coastal Carolina are the most in a game ...
- The Red Raiders turned a pair of double plays (eighth and ninth innings), which pushed their seasonal total to a
 Division I-best 83 ...
- TTU threw three different freshmen starting pitchers in their three games the first time this has happened in the last 30 years of the CWS (Steven Gingery, Davis Martin and Erickson Lanning) ...
- Texas Tech came into tonight's game with 22 doubles in the NCAA Tournament (most by any team) ... They hit a pair against Coastal pushing its tournament lead to 24 ...
- TTU has committed 12 errors in the NCAA Tournament, which is the most by any team in the field ... There have been a total of 19 errors in this year's CWS seven by the Red Raiders ... They have had three or more errors in a game eight times (twice in the 2016 CWS vs. TCU/G3, vs. Coastal Carolina/G9) ... The seven defensive miscues are the most by a CWS team since Mississippi State had seven in five games back in 2013 (last in three games was by Florida State in 2010) ...
- All nine TTU starters reached base in the game with Tanner Gardner leading the way reaching four times (three
 walks and one hit) ...
- Erikson Lanning (3-4) worked just 2.1 innings (shortest outing by a starter in this CWS) where he allowed four runs (one earned) on four hits with a pair of walks and three strikeouts ... It was the sixth time this season he has given up four or more runs in a game and first since April 5, 2016 vs. Florida State ... Second shortest outing of the season for Lanning (shortest: 1.2 IP vs. Abilene Christian on May 10) ... Entering the CWS, Lanning had not allowed a run in two previous NCAA Tournament outings including a 7.0 inning start against East Carolina on June 12 ... He allowed his first run of the postseason in the second inning (snapped a string of 10.2 scoreless frames dating back to June 3 vs. Fairfield in a relief appearance ...
- Robert Dugger allowed three runs (one earned) in two innings of work and tied his career-high with five strikeouts (last vs. East Carolina on June 11) ...
- Eric Gutierrez extended his hit streak to five games with a single up the middle in the second inning ... Tallied his 22nd multi-hit game with a single to right in the seventh inning ... He has reached base in 12 of last 15 games, which followed his 0-for-16 slump ... Has reached base in 8 of 13 plate appearances in this year's CWS (went 0-for-8 in 2014 CWS) ...
- Stephen Smith's bases clearing double in the bottom of the second gave TTU a 3-1 lead ... It was his 11th multi-RBI game of the season ... Hunter Hargrove drove in his eighth run of the NCAA Tournament (second of CWS) with a sac fly in the seventh frame ...
- Michael Davis recorded his 22 multi-hit game of the season with an RBI single through the right side in the seventh inning ... He became the seventh different TTU player to record multiple hits in a CWS game ...



2016 College World Series Notes

Runs Notes:

- Miami allowed four of the CWS' five runs in the first inning this year (3 vs. Arizona, 1 vs. USCB) ...
- TCU (twice), Arizona (once), Coastal Carolina (once), Texas Tech (once) and UC Santa Barbara (once) are the
 only teams to score at least five runs in a game this CWS ...
- There were seven unearned runs in the first nine games of the CWS ... TTU had six in Game 10 vs. Coastal Carolina ...
- Through 10 games there have been 54 runs scored tied for the fewest in CWS history (other was 2014) ...
- Of the last 50 teams to score five or more runs at the CWS, 47 of them have won (Virginia lost 10-5 to Florida/2015, Virginia lost 9-8 to Vanderbilt/ 2014, TTU lost 7-5 to Coastal Carolina/2016) since 2010 at Rosenblatt ... Since the CWS moved to TD Ameritrade Park, teams that score at least 5 runs are 42-3 (.933) ...
- In this year's CWS, 38 of the 54 runs scored (70.4%) have been driven in via a hit ...
- In other words, 16 of the 54 runs (29.6%) have scored as a result of something other than a hit ...
- Actual scoring breakdown: hits (38), error (5), sac fly (4), groundout/fielder's choice (3), sac bunt (2), walk (2) ...
- Inning breakdown of runs scored: first (5), second (5), third (9), fourth (6), fifth (10), sixth (6), seventh (2), eighth (3) and ninth (8) ...

Hit Notes:

- Coastal Carolina's first five hits of the game (vs. Florida/Game 4) went for extra bases (3 doubles, 2 triples)
 marking the first time at the CWS in TDAPO that a team's first five base knocks were for extra bases ...
- Hits breakdown: singles (107), doubles (26), triples (3) and home runs (7) ...
- Pinch hitters in the CWS this year are 5-for-10 (.500) with two RBI ... UC Santa Barbara has three of the five hits with Ryan Cumberland (UCSB) leading the way ...

Home Run Notes:

- Through 10 games of the CWS, there have been seven home runs with TCU's Luken Baker smacking two (Games 3 and 8) ... Other home runs: Cam Warner (TCU/G3), Zack Collins (Miami/G5), Eric Gutierrez (TTU/G7), Peter Alonso (Florida/G7) and Jared Oliva (Arizona/G9) ...
- Luken Baker's (TCU) three-run homer in the top of the ninth is just the second homer in the 9th inning (or later) in the CWS at TDAPO (other was Jeren Kendall from Vanderbilt in 2015 walk-off) ...
- The total number of home runs at TDAPO is 47 (85 CWS game in park history) ... CWS home run chart at TDAPO including Wednesday: LF/21, LCF/5, CF/3, RCF/2 and RF/16) ... In all games played at TDAPO, there have been 119 home runs ...
- Luken Baker homered in consecutive at-bats (last vs. TTU/G3 and first vs. Coastal/G8) ... It's the first time someone has belted homers in consecutive plate appearances since Texas' Russell Moldenhauer on June 22, 2009 (vs. Arizona State) ...

Pitching Notes

- Game 1 between Oklahoma State and UC Santa Barbara was the first CWS game with both starting pitchers throwing a complete game since June 19, 2013 ... Oregon State's Matt Boyd & Indiana's Aaron Siegers did it ...
- Andrew Beckwith (Coastal Carolina/Game 4) is the third pitcher in this year's CWS to toss a complete game (others: Thomas Hatch/Oklahoma State and Shane Bieber/UC Santa Barbara – both in Game 1) ... There was only one complete thrown in the 2014 CWS and 2015 CWS ...
- Arizona is the first staff since 2010 to have two pitchers with at least 10 strikeouts in a game (Nathan Bannister/11 and Bobby Dalbec/12) ... The last team was UCLA in 2010 (Trevor Bauer twice, Gerrit Cole) ...

Taking The Lead Notes:

- Teams leading after eight innings have won 90 of the last 92 CWS games (Vanderbilt overcame a 3-1 deficit to defeat Cal State Fullerton 4-3 in Game 4 of 2015; TCU scored three runs in top of ninth to beat Texas Tech in Game 3 of 2016) ...
- Teams leading after eight innings at TD Ameritrade Park Omaha are 226-8 all-time at TDAPO in 234 games ...



Shutout Notes:

- With Thomas Hatch's (Oklahoma State) complete game shutout in Game 1 vs. UC Santa Barbara, it was the 82nd CG SHO in CWS History and first since Matt Boyd (Oregon State) on 2013 vs. Indiana on 6/19/13 which is a 1-0 contest ...
- Only four teams have opened the CWS with back-to-back shutouts; 2 went on to win the title (1992 Pepperdine and 1955 Wake Forest did, 1970 Florida St didn't) Oklahoma State has two in 2016 CWS ... Last team to throw consecutive shutouts was Texas in 2014 (against UC Irvine/1-0 and Vanderbilt/4-0) the Longhorns finished tied for third in the CWS that year ...
- Oklahoma State is the first school in CWS history to throw consecutive 1-0 shutouts (vs. UC Santa Barbara/Game 1, vs. Arizona/Game 6) ... They are the fourth team to open a CWS with back-to-back shutouts – 2 of previous 3 went on to win the national championship ...
- With OSU's 1-0 win over UC Santa Barbara, it is the fourth-straight year with a 1-0 game in the CWS ... There were no 1-0 games in Omaha from 1986-2012 (27 years) ... Last 1-0 game to open a CWS was in 1985 (Arkansas 1, South Carolina 0) ... There have been three 1-0 games to open a CWS (Wake Forest 1, Colgate 0/1955; Minnesota 1, Oklahoma 0/1973; Arkansas 1, South Carolina 0/1985) ... This is the 22nd 1-0 decision in CWS history ...
- UC Santa Barbara became the sixth team to be shutout twice in the same CWS (1-0/Oklahoma State, 3-0/Arizona) the last was Rice in 2006 ...

National Seeds Notes

- National Seeds are 1-6 in the 2016 CWS (No. 1 Florida/0-2/eliminated; No. 3 Miami/0-2/eliminated; No. 5 Texas Tech/1-2) ... It's the 17th-straight year that a No. 1 national seed will not win the title only team to do it was Miami in 1999 ... Only two of the last 12 national champions have been national seeds (LSU/2009 and South Carolina/2011) ... For the 11th time in 13 years, the national champion will not be a top 8 national seed ...
- Fewest wins by National Seeds in the CWS (one in 2016) ... Previous was three in 2010 (3-7) ...
- Despite winning seven of their eight regionals, the National Seeds are just 31-21 this season ... Since the NCAA Tournament expanded in 1999, there have only been five seasons where the top-8 seed won fewer than 35 games (2014/27-19 record, 2016/31-21, 2007/31-18, 2013/34-20, 2010/34-20) ...
- For the first time since the bracket expanded in 1999 that no national seed has been among the last four teams remaining in the CWS (Arizona, Coastal Carolina, Oklahoma State an TCU are the four teams left in 2016) ...

Miscellaneous Notes

- First official review in CWS history (started in 2012) came in top of the third inning of Game 4 in the 2016 CWS between Coastal Carolina and Florida ... The call was four minutes and six seconds (4:06) and was overturned on the field in favor of Coastal Carolina ... Original call was a foul ball down the right field line overturned for an RBI double ...
- Florida is the fourth program with 10 CWS appearances who have not won a championship (Florida State/21, Clemson/12, Florida/10, North Carolina/10, Northern Colorado/10) ...
- For the first time since 2012, the CWS had more than one team in the field make its first CWS appearance with Coastal Carolina and UC Santa Barbara ... In 2012, it was Kent State (1-2) and Stony Brook (0-2) ...
- Oklahoma State is one of three Big 12 teams in this year's CWS (Texas Tech and TCU) ... Last time a
 conference had multiple bids with each team reaching Omaha was the Big 8 in 1993 (Kansas and Oklahoma
 State) ... Last time a conference has three or more bids with each team making the CWS was the SEC in 1990
 (Georgia, LSU and Mississippi State) ...
- Josh Holliday (Oklahoma State), Jay Johnson (Arizona) and Gary Gillmore (Coastal Carolina) picked their first career wins in the CWS ... The last head coach to win his CWS debut was Elliot Avent (NC State) on June 16, 2013 ...
- June 13, 1955 was the last time that Oklahoma State and Arizona both won CWS games on the same day ...
- Saturday marked the first time two head coaches (Josh Holliday and Jay Johnson) won their CWS debut on the same day since June 19, 2010, when Jim Schlossnagle (TCU) and John Savage (UCLA) both won, also on the Opening Day of the CWS ...
- The Big 12 is 20-4 (.833) in the NCAA Tournament after Tuesday's results ... No conference to earn at least 3 bids has ever posted a winning percentage better than .760 ... They Big 12 is 5-1 in 2016 CWS ... Those 20 victories have come against teams from 13 different leagues ... The Big 12 is the only conference with a different regular-season and postseason champion both in Omaha (Texas Tech and TCU) ...



- With TCU's 6-1 victory over Coastal Carolina, they improve to 2-0 in the 2016 CWS ... The Frogs join Big 12 foe
 Oklahoma State (2-0) in the winner's bracket marking the third time that two schools from the same conference
 started 2-0 in the CWS (others: Arkansas and Texas/1979 Southwest Conference; Florida and South
 Carolina/2011 Southeastern Conference) ...
- Jim Schlossnagle (TCU) and Tim Tadlock (Texas Tech) are the only coaches in Big 12 history to guide their squads to the CWS twice in their first four years coaching in the conference ...
- For the first time since 2005, the Atlantic Coast Conference failed to advance a team past its first two games ...
- Teams to score first are now 7-2 in the 2016 CWS ... Visiting teams are 6-3 so far this year ...
- Game 5 had a 62-minute rain delay ... Last weather delay in CWS was Vanderbilt vs. Cal State Fullerton (June 14 & 15, 2015) ... Delay lasted 1:19 with Cal State leading 3-0 in the bottom of the sixth inning – later suspended until next day) ...
- The start time of Game 6 was delayed two hours and 21 minutes due to weather ... Last time we had a starting delay for inclement weather was June 21, 2012 (South Carolina vs. Kent State) ... Rain forced the game to be moved from June 20 to June 21 ...
- The last time the SEC and ACC both went winless at the CWS was in 1984 neither conference had a team in the College World Series that year ...
- Teams that have committed three or more errors in a CWS game have lost the last 16 games (TTU did it twice in this CWS) ... The last such victor was Texas on June 23, 2009 ... Since the move to TD Ameritrade Park, teams to commit three errors in the CWS are 0-14 ...
- The last team to win two or more games in its first CWS appearance was Vanderbilt in 2011 (Vanderbilt was 2-2 that season) ... Coastal Carolina is 2-1 and will seek its third win against TCU on Friday, June 24 at 7 p.m. ...
- Texas Tech (9) and Coastal Carolina (7) combined for 16 walks in Game 10 ... It was the most by two teams in a single game since June 14, 2002 when Nebraska (9) and Clemson (12) combined for 21 ... The nine walks drawn by TTU are the most since Vanderbilt had nine vs. Louisville (June 14, 2014) ...
