

CWS Game 14 Notes: TCU vs. Coastal Carolina Saturday, June 25, 2016

TCU (49-18):

- TCU is playing in its fourth CWS (others: 2010, 2014, 2015) ... The Frogs are 8-8 all-time in CWS action (5-6/TDAPO and 3-2/Rosenblatt) ...
- The Frogs have appeared in 14 NCAA Tournaments posting a 45-34 all-time record ...
- TCU finally broke through and won a Game 2 ... Previously was 0-3 with losses to UCLA/2010, Virginia/2014 and Vanderbilt/2015 ...
- The Frogs have recorded two wins against Florida State, LSU and Texas Tech, while picking up one win vs.
 UCLA and Coastal Carolina ... Their losses came twice to UCLA, Vanderbilt and Coastal Carolina along with one
 each to Virginia and Ole Miss ...
- The Frogs finish with a 7-3 record in NCAA Tournament games this year and despite outscoring its opponents 49-29 ...
- Since May 1st, TCU is 16-6 which ranks second only to Coastal Carolina, who is 21-4 (best in Division I) ...
- TCU is 9-3 at neutral sites this season ...
- Jim Schlossnagle owns a 565-254 record at TCU ... He has guided TCU to 12 NCAA Tournament's sporting a 35-26 overall record and 8-8 in CWS ...
- TCU has hit four of the nine HRs in this year's CWS ...
- Six of TCU's seven home runs in this postseason have come from Luken Baker (3) and Cam Warner (3) ... Dane Steinhagen also has a home run ...
- Jared Janczak (7-4) worked 3.0 innings allowing three runs (all earned) on five hits with a pair of walks and three strikeouts ... He walked the leadoff hitter for the second straight game ... This was his shortest outing since April 30 against Texas Tech (3.0 IP) ...
- Elliot Barzilli drove in TCU's first run of the contest in the fourth inning with a two-out single right field ... It was TCU's first two-out RBI of the CWS ...
- Josh Watson extended his hit streak to six games and on-base streak to a season-long 13 games with a single
 up the middle in the seventh inning ...
- Evan Skoug tallied his 21st multi-hit game of the year with his single to right field in the sixth frame ...
- Ryan Burnett made his eight appearance in NCAA Tournament (third in CWS) tossing 1.1 scoreless innings of
 relief with one strikeout ... In NCAA Tournament action he has not allowed a run in 11.1 innings with 11
 strikeouts (5.0 IP in CWS without a run allowed) ...
- Dan Steinhagen collected three hits (two doubles) pushing his multi-hit total to 21 on the year ...
- Ryan Merrill's sac fly to right field scored Watson and pulled TCU within four, 7-3, in the seventh inning ... He
 drove in Steinhagen with an RBI single in the ninth pushing his on-base streak to 11 games (ties season-high) ...
- Michael Landestoy drove in his second RBI of the CWS with his RBI ground out in the seventh making it a 7-4 ball game ...
- Luken Baker recorded his sixth hit of the CWS with a double down the left field line in the eighth inning ... It was his third extra base hit (2 HRs, 1 double) ...
- Durbin Felton tossed three scoreless innings of relief with five strikeouts ... In five NCAA postseason appearances, he has 14 strikeouts in 11.0 IP (2 CWS games: 7 Ks in 4.0 IP) ...
