

Phillips 66 Big 12 Men's Basketball Championship

Big 12 Championship Notes

- TCU improved to 3-2 in the first round of the Phillips 66 Big I2 Championship and 3-4 overall. The Horned Frogs are now I-O as the No. 8 seed and I-O versus Oklahoma in the championship.
- OU's first-round record in the Big I2 Championship moved to 4-3 in the first round and 22-18 overall. The Sooners are now I-2 as the No. 9 seed. This was their first appearance in the first round since losing to No. 9 Texas A&M in 2012.
- TCU shot 65.5 percent (19 of 29) in the first half, its highest tally in Big 12 Championship history, and its best percentage for a half this season.
- The I9-point margin of victory was TCU's largest in a Big I2 Championship game and its largest margin of victory all-time over the Sooners.
- The Horned Frogs move on to face Kansas in Thursday's semifinals. The Jayhawks swept the regular season match-ups, winning 86-80 in Fort Worth and 87-68 in Lawrence.

Individual & Team Notes

- TCU ended the first half on a 15-2 run, holding the Sooners without a field goal for the last four minutes of the half. OU's only points in that span came on free throws from Christian James at the 00:54 mark.
- The Horned Frogs snapped a seven-game losing streak. Their last victory came against Texas Tech, 62-61, in Fort Worth on February 2.
- Junior forward for TCU, Vladimir Brodziansky tallied his sixth 20-point game this season (20 points). He also notched three blocks to move him into sole possession of second place in TCU history for blocks in a single season (75).
- TCU junior guard Kenrich Williams recorded his 14th double-double of the season, finishing with 19 points and 11 rebounds.
- For the first time since TCU joined the Big I2, the Horned Frogs defeated OU twice in one season.
- OU junior forward Khadeem Lattin reached double figures for the 10th time this season after scoring a team-high 18 points.
