BIG 12 CHAMPIONS FOR LIFE

Oklahoma State running back Justice Hill is a quiet leader on the team, but he continues to set an example for his teammates with his work ethic and mindset. His accolades on the field are impressive - Hill was one of IO national semifinalists for the 2017 Doak Walker Award - but he also is passionate about education and was named First-Team Academic All-Big I2 for the second consecutive year. Hill is studying finance.

CONFERENCE NEWS & NOTES

- Baylor earned its second Big I2 Soccer Regular-Season Title and first regular season title since 1998 after defeating Oklahoma I-O.
- The No. 2-seed West Virginia Mountaineers were crowned 2018 Big 12 Soccer Champions after battling their way through No. 7-seed Oklahoma (3-0), No. 3-seed Texas (I-0) and No. I-seed Baylor (3-0).
- For the third time in the past five seasons, six Big I2 programs earned a place in the 20I8 NCAA Soccer Championship with all teams hosting. The Big I2 has earned at least five or more bids in each of the last three seasons and four out of the last five.
- Fifty percent of Big I2 teams (Baylor, Kansas, TCU, Texas Tech and West Virginia) advanced to the second round of the NCAA Soccer Championship for the first time since 2008.
- Baylor advanced to the Quarterfinal round of the NCAA Soccer Championship, securing the program's first-ever back-to-back trip to the NCAA Quarterfinals. This marks the IIth overall time, and fifth since 20II, a Big I2 team has earned a spot in the Quarterfinals.
- TCU's 2-I victory over BYU, in the first round, was the program's firstever NCAA Tournament victory.
- The Big I2 ranked as the No. I (four times) or No. 2 (four times) conference in RPI this season.
- Sixty percent of soccer programs earned recognition in the United Soccer Coaches final rankings: Baylor at No. 9, West Virginia at No. 14, Texas at No. 20 and Texas Tech at No. 24. TCU and Kansas also received votes.
- Texas has now appeared in each of the last 24 United Soccer Coaches poll releases dating back to Sept. 12, 2017.
- Five Big I2 teams are ranked within the top 25 in the final NCAA RPI rankings: No. 5 Baylor, No. 9 West Virginia, No. 17 Texas, No. 19 TCU and No. 20 Kansas. Texas Tech and Oklahoma State are ranked at No. 26 and No. 51.
