Big 12 Championship Notes

- Since the Big 12 Championship's inception in 1997, there have now only been four instances where all of the higher seeds have won their opening day games 1997, 1998, 2016 and now 2019.
- · No. 3 seeds are 31-41 all-time in the Big 12 Championship.
- · No. 6 seeds are 41-34 all-time in the Big 12 Championship
- TCU is 15-9 in the Big 12 Championship and made its first appearance in 2013. The Horned Frogs won the Championship in 2014 and 2016.
- Oklahoma State is now 24-37 all-time in the Big 12 Championship and won the Championship in 2004 and 2017.

No. 3 Oklahoma State (33-17, 1-0 Big 12 Championship)

- Trevor Boone launched his league-leading 19th HR of the season in the 6th inning. Boone's 19th homer is the most from a Cowboy since Corey Brown in 2007 (22).
- Sophomore pitcher, Parker Scott, threw 92 pitches and gave up just four hits and one run in a winning effort.
- Colin Simpson sent his 13th HR of the season over the left field wall in the 2nd inning. The HR moved him into a tie with Texas Tech's Cameron Warren for the second-most in the league.
- · Andrew Navigato collected two hits, increasing his season total to a team-high 56 on the season.

No. 6 TCU (29-25, 0-1 Big 12 Championship)

- Preseason All-American Nick Lodolo threw 104 pitches over 7.0 IP and gave up five hits and five earned runs, but struck out 12 Cowboys, one shy of his career record.
- Wolfe's HR marked his 5th of the season, meaning that TCU joined Kansas State and Oklahoma State as the only three schools in the Big 12 that have six players with 5+ HRs this season.
- Josh Watson continued his strong campaign for the Horned Frogs as his two base hits in tonight's contest brought the outfielder to 68 hits on the year tying his career record set in 2016.
- Big 12 Newcomer of the Year, Jake Geunther, hit his ninth HR of the season in the 9th inning. His nine homers are tied with Johnny Rizer for most on the team.

STAT OF THE GAME: Oklahoma State has now hit multiple HRs in a game 21 times this season, more than any other team in the Big 12 - and the Cowboys improved to 16-5 when they do so.

ATTENDANCE: 4,242
