### No. 6 TCU 13, No. 3 Oklahoma State 6

#### Big 12 Championship Notes

- The cumulative attendance of 13,480 for session six is the highest since 2009. The attendance of 7,383 for Game 12 between Oklahoma State and TCU is the highest for a session six contest since 2009.
- TCU improved to a league-best 18-9 all-time in the Big 12 Championship.
- Oklahoma State fell to 27-38 all-time in the tournament.
- The winner of the elimination game between Oklahoma State and TCU will advance to the Big 12 Championship game.
  - Oklahoma State last appeared in the Big 12 Championship game in 2017.
  - TCU last appeared in the title game last season.

#### **No. 6 TCU (32-25, 3-1 Big 12 Championship)**

- Starting pitcher Jared Janczak had his best outing of the season. The redshirt senior threw a season-high six innings on 96 pitches. He also struck out 12 batters, the most in his season - the 12 strikeouts also tie teammate Nick Lodolo for the tournament-high in 2019.
- Josh Watson homered to left in the 4<sup>th</sup> to tally his seventh and eighth RBIs of the tournament, leading all players.
- TCU improved to 8-1 on the season when collecting 15+ hits. The Frogs finished with 18 hits, tying their school-record in the Big 12 Tournament.
- The Horned Frogs struck out 16 Cowboys, setting a new school-record in the Big 12 Championship.

#### **No. 3 Oklahoma State (34-18, 2-1 Big 12 Championship)**

- Colin Simpson hit his tournament-leading third HR in the loss. The homer to centerfield was his 15<sup>th</sup> of the season and 46<sup>th</sup> of his career, which is the 10<sup>th</sup> most in Oklahoma State history.
- Cade Cabiness hit a grand slam in the 7<sup>th</sup> inning to tie the game. It was the second grand slam of the tournament, marking the first time ever in the same Big 12 Championship.
- Oklahoma State surrendered 10+ runs for just the fifth time this season, falling to 1-4.
- The Cowboys are also now 9-12 when being out-hit by their opponents.

**STAT OF THE GAME:** For the first time since 2003, and omitting the years between 2006-2011 when the Big 12 Tournament switched formats, both “if necessary” games will be played.\*

**ATTENDANCE:** 7,383

**WHATS NEXT:** Oklahoma State and TCU will face off tonight with a berth in the Big 12 Championship game on the line. That game will begin 30 minutes after the contest between Texas Tech and West Virginia concludes.

\*The 2013 Big 12 Championship switched to the round-robin format due to inclement weather.

#### **No. 6 TCU 13, No. 3 Oklahoma State 6**

##### Oklahoma State Head Coach Josh Holliday

###### *Opening statement...*

“Obviously, it was a much different game than the ones we’ve played at this point. Give TCU a lot of credit. The young man that started for them has been one of the best pitchers in the Big 12 for a number of years during his career. He’s fought through some injuries and he pitched a really fine game as well. He was more competitive pitch-to-pitch than we were and we weren’t able to match him. Hats off to Jared Janczak. We weren’t sharp, there were too many mistakes made. That’s on me as a coach. I didn’t have the kids as ready to play as I should have. We’ll work on that. I do appreciate the effort very much. I thought the way that Noah Sifrit came into the game in relief was key to us. He gave us a chance to get back in the game. Cade hits a grand slam and next thing you know, it’s 6 to 6. But, we made a mistake or two here and there and then to their credit, they banged the ball around the yard. We have a good team and we can’t let one game or mistake let self-doubt creep in. Conference tournaments are challenging and sometimes a game like that is part of the conference tournament experience. We just have to move past it quickly and get ready to play those guys again tonight.”

###### *On the possibility of playing at home in the postseason...*

“That would be special. That was something that was thrown out there as a nugget to plant a positive seed and try to grow it in the back of the kids’ minds. All along that is something that we wanted. We don’t want to get too far ahead worrying about things like that because the boys believe that the good teams are the ones who make it the furthest and the ones who focus on the now and not get caught up in things like that. That would be a great reward for this particular group of kids if that happens because there is some really special people on this team. What you’re watching Colin Simpson do...he’s the best power hitter that’s played here in quite some time. He’s a very special kid and we’ll have a really hard time replacing him as a person. Obviously, him the player is pretty awesome, but him the person is equal parts a treat to be around. To see something like that for them to be able to do that at Reynolds Stadium would mean a lot because it would be another chapter in their experience at Oklahoma State. That would be a great deal for them.”

###### *On managing the pitching in the game...*

“I thought Coach Walton managed it well. We got behind and had to try to bridge the gap. We tried to use a couple different kids. Noah did the best job of keeping us in it. Mitchell did a nice job. When we got tied in the eighth inning, we went to our closer hoping to put up a zero so we could come back in the bottom of the eighth hoping to come back for the win. It didn’t happen that way. That’s baseball. From there, you have to get Ben out knowing you’re going to need him again. Then, we went to Nate and John, but that’s the game and we have a number of quality pitchers ready to pitch tonight’s game. We had to manage it that way. You have to be smart about who you use when you’re ahead and who you use when you’re behind.”
