Big 12 Championship Notes

- West Virginia will appear in its first Big 12 Championship game since 2016. In the 2016 game the Mountaineers lost to TCU 11-10 in extra innings.
- West Virginia improved to 13-11 all-time in the Big 12 Championship, making them one of three teams to have a record above .500 in the Big 12 tournament.
- Texas Tech falls to 22-38 all-time in the tournament with 17 appearances.
 - The Red Raiders are projected by multiple outlets to host a Regional next weekend.

No. 1 Texas Tech (39-17, 3-2 Big 12 Championship)

- Cameron Warren collected Texas Tech's only hit of the game, bringing his season total to 75, second-best on the team.
- Hunter Dobbins had his best start of his career, throwing 80 pitches over 6.0 IP, allowing two earned runs and just five hits.

No. 5 West Virginia (37-19, 3-1 Big 12 Championship)

- Brandon White continued his stellar performance, collecting three hits in as many at-bats, and scored a run.
- Darius Hill drove in West Virginia's only RBI of the night in the win, bringing his season total to 41. He tied Marques Inman for the team-high.
- Starting pitcher Ryan Bergert won his second game of the season and allowed just one hit and no runs.
- Zach Ottinger relieved Bergert and threw four innings of perfect baseball to finish off the Red Raiders and send the Mountaineers to the title game.

STAT OF THE GAME: 2016. West Virginia will appear in the Big 12 title for the first time since 2016.

ATTENDANCE: 3,713

WHATS NEXT: The Mountaineers will square off against the winner of the Oklahoma State and TCU game that will be played on Sunday at 9 a.m. CT. The championship game will be played following the OSU/TCU semifinal.

West Virginia Head Coach Randy Mazey

Opening statement...

“I know I am overstating the obvious when I say this but these two guys... to do what they did tonight is what older kids are supposed to do. These are freshman facing one of the best offensive teams in the country, if not the best offensive team in the country. No walks, just attacking hitters all night long. Bergert’s first start of the year and to do what he did, and for Ottinger to come in and give us four innings after that and go 3-0 against Gabe Holt and to get him out. Words can’t express how proud I am of these guys. These guys have been doing this all year long and I keep telling them in a tournament situation like this you will never know when you’ll be needed. They were needed in one of the biggest games in the history of our program and they stepped up.”

On the impact of Brandon White throughout the tournament...

“I have been telling people for three years that he is the best center fielder that I have ever coached and now everyone is starting to see it. He just changes the game. It’s hard to do that but Josh Jung does it for Texas Tech and he has done it for them all season and Brandon White does it for us. The difference when Brandon does it, every time he makes a catch he saves runs. The catches he makes are game changers and take runs off the board. If he doesn’t catch that ball today that’s probably a two-run double and the whole game is different. Amazing, amazing, amazing to watch that guy play.”

Opening statement...

“Congratulations to Coach Maizy and his team. They played great tonight. The guys that threw really threw the ball really well. I think that we had one shot really to string something together and you just have to give them credit. They pitched well and played good defense. Good luck to them and the rest of the teams left in the tournament. ”

On what learning about your pitching depth in a conference tournament...
