- The Sooners made their eighth WCWS appearance in the last nine years.

 No other program in the country has made as many trips to the WCWS as


 OU since the 20II season.
- The Cowgirls secured the program's first WCWS berth since 20II. It is also the eighth time overall that OSU has advanced to OKC, a mark which ties Texas A&M for the I2th-most WCWS appearances in NCAA history.
- OU finished as the national runner-up for the second time in program history. Three Sooners were named to the WCWS All-Tournament Team: Sydney Romero, Nicole Mendes and Jocelyn Alo.
- Oklahoma closes the season leading the nation in batting average (.344), onbase percentage (.435), slugging percentage (.639), shutouts (28), earned run average (1.40), home runs per game (1.83) and shutouts (28).
- lowa State was the runner-up in the National Invitational Softball Championship. The 2019 campaign ends as the program's winningest season since 1982 and marks the Cyclones' first time since 1988 to a dvance to a national postseason tournament.
- Four programs were recognized in the final n ational p olls (USA T oday/ NFCA and ESPN/USA Softball: No. 2/2 Oklahoma, No. 6/6 Oklahoma State, No. II/IO Texas and No. I9/I9 Texas Tech.
- The Big I2 finished the season ranked as the No. 2 conference in RPI, which breaks the eight week streak of being ranked No. 3.
- The Conference concluded the 2019 season with a .7II non-conference record.
- Oklahoma became the first team in Conference history to sweep every All-Big 12 individual award. A list of the All-Big 12 Teams can be found on page 6.
- Oklahoma earned its eighth consecutive Big I2 regular-season title and second consecutive undefeated conference season, making OU the only Big I2 program to go undefeated in back-to-back years.
- Due to rain and poor field conditions, the second and final day of the Phillips 66 Big I2 Softball Championship was canceled. Only five out of the six games on Friday's pool play day were completed before rain halted the sixth game.





