CONFERENCE NEWS & NOTES

- The Big 12 had a nation-leading 60% of its teams selected for the the NCAA Tournament, and tied for the third-most bids overall. The six bids to Big 12 schools mark the Conference's most since 2017.
- The Big 12 is the first conference to go at least 6-0 in the First Round since 2019. For the second consecutive year, the Big 12 was the only multi-bid league to send all of its teams to the Round of 32.
- Iowa State and Texas each reached the NCAA Sweet 16, marking the 13th time in the past 14 tournaments multiple Big 12 teams reached the round.
- Texas reached the NCAA Elite Eight, marking the eighth time in the past nine tournaments a Big 12 team has reached the Elite Eight.
- Four Big 12 teams finished the season in the AP Top 25 poll. No. 6 Texas, No. 7 Baylor, No. 10 Iowa State and No. 22 Oklahoma were ranked. Kansas received votes.
- Baylor won its 12th consecutive Big 12 regular season championship. The Bears are the first team since 2000 to start Big 12 play 0-2 and win the title. BU made its 18th straight NCAA Tournament appearance in 2022.
- Texas won the Phillips 66 Big 12 Women's Basketball Championship, defeating Baylor 67-58 for the Longhorns' first title since 2003. The Longhorns made their second consecutive Elite Eight appearance.
- Iowa State reached the NCAA Regionals for the first time since 2010, and set a school-record with 28 wins.
- Kansas earned its first NCAA Tournament bid since 2013 and advanced to the Second Round.
- Kansas State participated in March Madness for the fourth time in six tournaments, advancing to the Second Round.
- Oklahoma had a 13-game improvement in 2022, earning its first NCAA bid since 2018 and advancing to the Second Round for the first time since 2017.
- Oklahoma State hired then-Kansas City head coach Jacie Hoyt to the same position. She was 81-65 at Kansas City, earning 2020 WAC Coach of the Year.
- TCU's Lauren Heard completed her career by playing in 153 games, which marks a Big 12 record for games played.
- Texas Tech picked up three wins over AP Top 25 teams in 2021-22, all during Big 12 Conference play.
- West Virginia hired Dawn Plitzuweit as head coach after amassing a 158-36 record at South Dakota. She led the Coyotes to the 2022 NCAA Sweet 16.

CONFERENCE NEWS & NOTES

- The Big 12 was the nation's only conference with two positional award winners, as NaLyssa Smith (BU) repeated as Katrina McClain Power Forward of the Year and Ashley Joens (ISU) won the Cheryl Miller Shooting Guard of the Year Award for the second consecutive season.
- The Big 12 has been honored four times in the past two seasons with a national positional award winner, the most of any conference.
- Three Big 12 players, all from Baylor, were selected in the 2022 WNBA Draft. NaLyssa Smith heard her name called second overall, Queen Egbo was picked 10th and Jordan Lewis was taken 24th overall. The Big 12 has had at least three selections in each of the past 19 years.
- Baylor's NaLyssa Smith was the unanimous Big 12 Player of the Year, earning the award for the second consecutive year. KU's Brandon Schneider was Coach of the Year and ISU's Lexi Donarski was Defensive Player of the Year. For a complete list, go to page 3.
- Five Big 12 players were honored as All-Americans by the Associated Press: NaLyssa Smith (Baylor, 1st Team), Ayoka Lee (K-State, 2nd Team), Ashley Joens (Iowa State, 2nd Team), Rori Harmon (Texas, Honorable Mention) and Taylor Robertson (Oklahoma, Honorable Mention).
- Rori Harmon (UT) was named Most Outstanding Player of the Phillips 66 Big 12 Championship, and was joined on the All-Tournament Team by NaLyssa Smith (BU), Ashley Joens (ISU), Madi Williams (OU) and Lauren Ebo (UT).
- K-State's Ayoka Lee set an NCAA single-game record with 61 points against Oklahoma on Jan. 23.
- OU's Taylor Robertson will enter the 2022-23 season as the Division I active career leader in 3-pointers made per game (3.8), 3-point field goal percentage (44.1) and free throw percentage (91.9).
- Five Big 12 teams ranked inside the nation's top-30 in average attendance, led by Iowa State, who ranked second in the NCAA at 9,567 fans per game.
- The Big 12 boasted the nation's leader in both field goals made (NaLyssa Smith, Baylor, 304) and 3-point field goals made (Taylor Robertson, Oklahoma, 124).
- Three of the nation's top-20 scorers during 2021-22 played in the Big 12. NaLyssa Smith (BU) ranked 9th at 22.1, Ayoka Lee (K-State) ranked 10th at 22.0 and Ashley Joens (ISU) ranked 18th at 20.3 points per game.
- Five Big 12 teams are ranked in ESPN.com's Way-Too-Early Top 25 for 2021-22: No. 4 Texas, No. 7 Iowa State, No. 10 Oklahoma, No. 21 Kansas and No. 25 Baylor were picked as top teams for next season.
