2-MINUTE OFFENSE

OPENING KICKOFF: UT Martin is holding steady in the national polls, as the Skyhawks are again ranked No. 17 by Stats Perform and No. 19 in the AFCA Coaches rating this week. The Big South-OVC Association has had a member nationally-ranked every week of the 2023 season (including preseason), with a season-high ranking of No. 11 (SEMO in preseason AFCA poll).

1st DOWN: UTM and SEMO are atop the Association standings at 2-0 each. It is the Skyhawks' third-straight year opening conference play 2-0, while the Redhawks are 2-0 for the second consecutive season. Meanwhile, Bryant and Charleston Southern each won their first Big South-OVC game last week. For the Bulldogs, it is their first 1-0 conference start since 2021, while the Bucs are 1-0 in league action for the first time since 2018.

2nd DOWN: Martin has an Association-best 5-game overall win streak, and is averaging 37.8 points, 505.4 yards of offense and 279.8 rushing yards, while allowing just 19.2 points and 358.6 yards in that span.

3rd DOWN: Eight of the nine Association-conference games played thus far have been won by the home team, while the overall average margin of victory is 14.33 points. Three contests have been one possession decisions — including two by two points-or-less, and the nine games have had a combined 423 points, for a per game average of 47.00 points scored.

4th DOWN: Gardner-Webb faces Eastern Kentucky Saturday in a re-match of last year's FCS First Round, which was won by the Runnin' Bulldogs, 52-41.

ABOUT THE BIG SOUTH-OVC FOOTBALL ASSOCIATION

This is the first season of the Big South-OVC Football Association. On Feb. 22, 2022, the Big South Conference and Ohio Valley Conference announced the creation of an association of their football member institutions, to begin with the 2023 NCAA Division I football season and have an initial term of at least four years. The unique agreement combines the two conferences' football membership to ensure NCAA championship access and stability for the multisport conferences. In creating the association, presidents from each of the multisport conferences pointed to the similarities of the OVC and the Big South, with their complementary geographies and intercollegiate athletic philosophies, as key to making this association possible. The first year is comprised of 10 members. Western Illinois will join the Association beginning with the 2024 season, while Bryant will depart after this season for CAA Football.

SLANT ROUTES

- * BRYANT: The Bulldogs are looking to start 2-0 in conference games for the first time since 2018 ... Bryant is facing its third first-time opponent of the season on Saturday, and is 1-1 against first-time foes thus far.
- * CHARLESTON SOUTHERN: The Buccaneers are looking to start 2-0 in conference games for the first time since 2016 ... CSU has a .500 overall record for the first time since the opening two weeks of the 2021 season.
- * EASTERN ILLINOIS: The Panthers are facing their second of three first-time opponents on Saturday ... EIU is looking to avoid an O-3 conference start for the first time since the 2021 Spring season.
- * GARDNER-WEBB: The Runnin'
 Bulldogs are playing their final
 non-conference game on Saturday ...
 Gardner-Webb has won its last four
 home games, dating back to last
 season, and is averaging 37.8 points
 during that time at Spangler Stadium.
- * LINDENWOOD: The Lions are idle this week and return to action Oct. 28 at Tennessee State.
- * ROBERT MORRIS: The Colonials are idle this week and return to action Oct. 28 at home against Tennessee Tech.
- * SOUTHEAST MISSOURI: The Redhawks have won seven consecutive conference games, and are averaging 41.4 points during that streak ... SEMO has won five of the last six meetings with Tech.
- * TENNESSEE STATE: The Tigers' 4-2 start is their best open to a season since 2017, and their four wins match last year's overall total ... Saturday marks the first of three-straight first-time opponents for TSU.
- * TENNESSEE TECH: The Golden Eagles last defeated SEMO in 2021, a 28-17 home victory ... Tech has held its last four opponents to just 229.8 yards of offense.
- * UT MARTIN: The Skyhawks won the first and only meeting with CSU back in 1994, a 42-14 home victory ... UTM is looking to start 3-0 in conference action for the third-straight year.

PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - OCT. 16

OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Zevi Eckhaus, Bryant, QB • 6-1, 205, Jr. • Culver City, Calif.

Eckhaus accounted for 369 yards of total offense and four touchdowns as Bryant began Big South-OVC Association play with a 43-24 win over Robert Morris. The junior completed 22-of-36 passes for 283 yards and three touchdowns without an interception and carried the ball six times for 86 yards and another score. His touchdown passes went for 21, 4 and 6 yards and his touchdown run was 11 yards. Eckhaus is 85 yards away from becoming the second player in program history to throw for 7,000 yards, is tied for second in career touchdowns (56) and just became the school's all-time leader in total offense (7,579).

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Terrell Allen, Tennessee State, DL • 6-0, 275, Sr. • Little Rock, Ark.

Allen tallied seven tackles (6 solo), four tackles-for-loss, two sacks and a pass breakup as Tennessee State topped Norfolk State 24-17 for Homecoming. It marked his first multi-sack game of the season. Allen's play helped TSU limited Norfolk State to 150 total rushing yards.

Patrick Turner, Lindenwood, P • 6-2, 222, R-Fr. • Melbourne, Australia

Turner punted six times for an average of 46.7 yards in Lindenwood's game at Charleston Southern. The redshirt freshman had half of his punts downed inside CSU's 20-yard line and did not have any touchbacks. Turner had a long punt of 62 yards. He ranks second in the Conference in punting (42.17 yards/punt).

FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

Zolten Osborne, Charleston Southern, QB • 6-1, 201, Fr. • North Charleston, S.C.

Osborne completed 15-of-24 passes for 174 yards and two touchdowns as Charleston Southern knocked off Lindenwood 24-10 to open Conference play 1-0. It marked the first two touchdowns of the season for the freshman signal caller. He kicked off the game with a 12-yard score early in the first quarter and added a 6-yard pass with 15 seconds before halftime.

STATE OF MIND

The Big South-OVC Association went 9-2 in its 11 non-conference games this season against "State"-named FCS schools. Eastern Illinois led the way at 3-0 (Indiana State, Illinois State and Northwestern State), followed by Tennessee Tech (Kennesaw State and South Carolina State) and Tennessee State (Kennesaw State and Norfolk State) at 2-0 each. UT Martin (Missouri State) and Charleston Southern (Kennesaw State) went 1-0. Robert Morris (Youngstown State) and Lindenwood (Illinois State) went 0-1. Overall, the Big South-OVC is 18-14 against non-conference FCS competition, and will finish above .500 as just two out-of-conference FCS games remain.

WHAT CAN BROWN DO FOR YOU?

Gardner-Webb RB **JAYDEN BROWN** leads all Big South-OVC running backs with four touchdown receptions, which have come on just 11 total catches. He has the top single-game receiving yard outputs by an Association rusher this season -- 77 vs. Robert Morris in Week 7, and 67 in the season opener at Appalachian State. Brown is second in the conference with 113.33 all-purpose yards per game.

WHAT THE ECK!

Bryant QB **ZEVI ECKHAUS** amassed an Association single-game record of 369 yards of offense this past Saturday against Robert Morris. His effort included 86 rushing yards, and he now holds the top two single-game rushing outputs by a Big South-OVC quarterback this season, as he opened the season with 89 rushing yards at UNLV.

KICK STARTERS

Tennessee State PK JAMES LOWERY has made a Big South-OVC best five field goals from 40-yards or longer — and is the only player thus far with two from at least 50 yards (50 and 51). Lowery's five have been for an average of 46.6 yards. Southeast Missouri PK DC PIPPIN and Charleston Southern PK SAM BABBUSH are second to Lowery with four field goals from 40-plus yards. Pippin's average distance from that range is 43.5 yards, while Babbush's conversion average on his four is 44.3 yards. In addition, Babbush has made a 40-yarder in four of CSU's six games this season. Lowery is the only kicker to make two 40-yard plus field goals in a game twice this year.

TIGHT ROPE

One week after setting a Big South-OVC Association single-game record for most receiving yards by a tight end with 76, Robert Morris TE **CHAESE JACKSON** became the Association's first tight end with 10 receptions in a game when he caught 10 passes in Week 6 at Gardner-Webb. In a four-game stretch from Weeks 3-6, Jackson had 22 receptions for 194 yards and three scores (full season totals stand at 28 catches, 261 yards and four TDs). Meanwhile, UT Martin TE **MAX DOWL-ING** became the first TE with two touchdown receptions in a game in Week 6 with a 9-yard TD grab and eventual game-winning 7-yard TD catch in the Seahawks' overtime win at EIU.

PASSING GRADES

Eastern Illinois QB **PIERCE HOLLEY** is the first Big South-OVC quarterback with back-to-back 300-yard passing games, as he threw for 346 this past week at Southeast Missouri — one week after setting an Association single-game record of 359 passing yards in Week 6 vs. UT Martin. Holley holds the league lead with 1,887 passing yards and 13 touchdown strikes, and has thrown for at least 244 yards in six of his seven appearances this year. Meanwhile, UT Martin QB **KINKEAD DENT** is the only Big South-OVC Association quarterback with a touchdown pass in all six games to start the campaign, and is second in the league with 12 TD scoring strikes.

200-YARD PASSING ODYSSEY

Just one Big South-OVC Association QB has thrown for more than 200 yards in every game to open the season — Southeast Missouri's **PAXTON DeLAURENT**. His 268.0 passing yards per game and 1,608 passing yards rank second in the conference. DeLaurent opened the season with 213 passing yards at Kansas State, followed by 267 vs. Lindenwood in Week 2, 251 vs. Southern Illinois in Week 3, 358 at Eastern Kentucky in Week 4, 262 at Central Arkansas in Week 6, and 257 this past week vs. Eastern Illinois. DeLaurent has a league-best three games with a touchdown pass and rushing touchdown in the same contest.

FRANK THE TANK

UT Martin RB **SAM FRANKLIN** is third in the nation with 839 rushing yards — just 39 yards shy of the top spot. He is second nationally in rushing yards per game at 139.8. He rushed for more than 200 yards twice in a three–game span (259 vs. Missouri State in Week 2 and 221 at North Alabama in Week 4), and has a league–best four 100–yard rushing games on the season. Franklin also has an Association–best seven rushing touchdowns, which have gone for a total of 317 yards (=45.3 yard average). Five of Franklin's seven rushing scores have gone for 40–plus yards (81, 49, 46, 74 and 43). Meanwhile, Franklin has out–rushed seven Big South–OVC squads to this point.

AROUND THE ASSOCIATION...

BRYANT

QB ZEVI ECKHAUS now has 6,915 career yards through the air, and his 3 TDs vs. Robert Morris this past week was the 16th time he has thrown multiple TDs in a game ... RB SIMI BAKARE scored his first TDs as a member of the Black and Gold and the first multi-TD game of his career ... Bryant forced four turnovers for the first time since the Bulldogs' last game against RMU in 2022 ... The Bulldogs' 43 points was their most against an FCS opponent since scoring 43 against Campbell last season on Nov. 5 ... WR ANTHONY FREDERICK is now seventh all-time in program history with 3,133 all-purpose yards.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern has allowed just 45 points in its four home games this season (11.3 per game average) ... The Bucs are looking to win three consecutive games for the first time since closing out the 2019 season with four-straight victories. The Bucs are also seeking to move above a .500 overall record for the first time since being 4-3 in 2017 ... CSU has held its last two opponents to 286.5 yards of offense (both wins) ... RB TJ RUFF has led CSU in rushing each of the past five games, gaining 343 yards in that span with four touchdowns ... QB ZOLTEN OSBORNE is 30-of-55 passing for 361 yards and two touchdowns in his last two appearances.

EASTERN ILLINOIS

The Panthers are the first Big South-OVC member to have two players with 100 receiving yards in the same game, as DeAIRIOUS SMITH (118) and JUSTIN THOMAS (103) achieved the feat this past week at Southeast Missouri ... EIU has dropped its two conference games by a combined 8 points ... MJ FLOWERS leads all Big South-OVC running backs with 27 receptions, which ranks seventh overall in the conference.

LB WILLIAM McRAINEY now ranks 10th in program history with 283 career tackles ... QB JAYLEN KING collected 218 yards of offense this past Saturday at Austin Peay. His 56-yard touchdown run in the first quarter tied the game at 7-7. He later connected with JAYDEN BROWN on a 17-yard pass play for a score to finish the day with 153 yards on 19-of-35 passing ... GWU is the lone Big South-OVC squad undefeated at home (2-0) and winless on the road (0-4) this season.

LINDENWOOD

WR JEFF CALDWELL picked up his Big South-OVC leading seventh TD reception this past Saturday at Charleston Southern, as his 28-yarder accounted for the Lions' lone touchdown of the day ... QB CARTER DAVIS was 15-of-31 passing for 170 yards and a score, and added 51 rushing yards to rank second on the team ... SPENCER REDD finished the CSU game with 126 all-purpose yards (66 kickoff return, 60 receiving) ... DL KOBE McCLENDON holds the Association lead with 6.5 quarterback sacks, and is third with 9.5 TFL.

ROBERT MORRIS

The Colonials have limited their opposition to an average of 54.0 offensive plays the past four games ... RB DJ MOYER finished as RMU's leading rusher for the second time in three games, as he rushed 14 times for 60 yards this past week at Bryant. He also caught four passes for 29 yards and a score ... WR TREN-ELL RIDGLEY had 203 all-purpose yards at Bryant on 14 total touches: team-high seven receptions for 54 yards, six kickoff returns for 146 yards, and one rush for three yards.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI

Southeast Missouri has scored in 17-straight quarters, and 19 of their last 21 ... RB GENO HESS scored two rushing touchdowns against Eastern Illinois to increase his career total to 59, breaking the previous Ohio Valley Conference record of 58, set by EKU's ELROY HARRIS in 1988. The 59 rushing TDs are the most of any active FCS players ... Hess posted his third 100-yard rushing game -- and second-straight -- with a season-high 129 in the win over EIU. He is the active FCS rushing leader at 4,615 yards, 691 ahead of the next player.

TENNESSEE STATE

The Tigers rushed for a season-high 212 yards in their win over Norfolk State last week, and were led by RB JORDAN GANT for the second consecutive week. Gant rushed for 84 yards on 21 carries, followed by RB JALEN ROUSE (68 yards) and QB DRAYLEN ELLIS (57 yards) ... DL TERRELL ALLEN finished with 4.0 TFL vs. NSU, the third Big South-OVC player this season with 4.0 tackles-for-loss in a game ... LB MONROE BEARD III extended his Big South-OVC tackle lead to 73 following his 10 stops vs. Norfolk State -- his fifth-straight game with double-digit tackles. His 12.2 tackles per game rank sixth in the nation.

TENNESSEE TECH

The Golden Eagles scored 28 unanswered points to defeat South Carolina State, 28-7 ... RB MARCUS KNIGHT matched the Big South-OVC single-game high with three rushing touchdowns, while RB JUSTIN PEGUES rushed for a season-high 110 yards and a TD on 21 carries. Pegues has gained 270 yards on his last 51 carries (5.29 average per rush).

UT MARTIN

DE DAYLAN DOTSON remains the league leader with 10.5 tackles-for loss, while P AIDAN LAROS remains the national leader with his 47.8 punting average ... The Skyhawks have out-scored their opponents this season in the second quarter (55-31), third quarter (44-21) and fourth quarter (52-41).

TIEBREAKER PROCEDURE

1. TRANSITIONING SCHOOLS

HOME GAME IN BOLD CAPS

 To be eligible for the conference's automatic bid to the FCS Football Championship, a school must be a full Division I member.

b. Transitioning schools will be utilized in the tiebreaker process.

c. If a transitioning school is involved in a two-way tie, the tied team that is eligible for postseason competition shall be the league's recipient of the automatic bid.

 ${f d}.$ If a transitioning school wins the multi-team tiebreaker, the procedure would start over with the remaining teams.

2. TWO-WAY TIE

 a. If the two teams played each other during the conference season, the winner of the head-tohead contest shall be the league's recipient of the automatic bid.

b. If the tied teams did not play each other during the conference season, each team's head-to-head record against all common opponents in the league will be used to determine the automatic bid.

c. If a tie still exists, then each team's record against the next highest common opponent in the league standings will be used to determine the automatic bid. When arriving at a group of tied teams that each team has played, composite records between the tied teams shall be utilized to determine if one of the tied teams has won more games against the group of tied teams.

d. If the teams are still tied, a point system will be utilized based on a complete schedule and wins using Sagarin rankings entering the final day of the regular season, as indicated on the next page.

e. Should the points system finish in a tie, the tied team with the best Sagarin rating on the final day of the regular season (i.e., Saturday morning) will receive the automatic bid.

B. MULTIPLE TIES

 a. If at any point, a tie is broken using the multiple-tie tiebreaker procedures and only two teams remain, the remaining teams will revert to the two-way tiebreaker (head-to-head).

b. If the tied teams all played each other during the conference season, the team with the
best cumulative record involving games with the tied teams shall be declared champion. For
example, if a team is 2-0 against two other tied teams, that team will be declared champion.
 c. If the tied teams all played one another and have identical records against the other tied

teams, then each team's record against all common opponents in the league will be used to determine the automatic bid. If teams are still tied, then each team's record against the next highest common opponent in the league standings will be used to determine the automatic bid. If the tied teams did not play each other, then each team's record against all common opponents in the league will be used to determine the automatic bid. If the teams are still tied, and they did not play each other, then each team's record against the next highest common opponent in the league standings will be used to determine the automatic bid.

e. If the teams are still tied, a point system will be utilized based on a complete schedule and wins using Sagarin rankings entering the final day of the regular season, as indicated below. f. Should the points system finish in a tie, the tied team with the best Sagarin rating on the final day of the regular season (i.e., Saturday morning) will receive the automatic bid.
