# 2-MINUTE OFFENSE

**OPENING KICKOFF:** UT Martin is climbing in the national polls, as the Skyhawks are ranked No. 14 by Stats Perform and No. 13 in the AFCA Coaches rating this week. The Big South-OVC Association has had a member nationally-ranked every week of the 2023 season (including preseason), with a season-high ranking of No. 11 (SEMO in preseason AFCA poll).

**1st DOWN:** UTM and SEMO are atop the Association standings at 3–0 each. It is the Skyhawks' third-straight year opening conference play 3–0, while the Redhawks are 3–0 for the second consecutive season. UT Martin has won 8–straight conference games, while Southeast Missouri has a 9–game win streak in league contests, dating back to the 2021 season finale. The teams will go head-to-head on Nov. II in Martin.

**2nd DOWN**: Martin has an Association-best 6-game overall win streak, and is averaging 34.3 points, 472.8 yards of offense and 265.5 rushing yards, while allowing just 16.0 points and 339.2 yards in that span.

**3rd DOWN:** Several Association records were set last week: Most rushing TD (4 – TSU's **JORDAN GANT**); Most rushing TD by a QB (3 – EIU's **PIERCE HOLLEY**); Longest TD rush (88 – GWU's **JAYDEN BROWN**); Most receiving yards (203 – SEMO's **RYAN FLOURNOY**); Longest TD pass reception (89 – Flournoy), Most sacks (4 – TSU's **TERRELL ALLEN**); and Longest punt (70 – UTM's **AIDAN LAROS**).

4th DOWN: Gardner-Webb hosts UT Martin Saturday, and GWU carries a five-game home win streak into the contest — including an average 37.2 points during the streak.

#### ABOUT THE BIG SOUTH-OVC FOOTBALL ASSOCIATION

This is the first season of the Big South-OVC Football Association. On Feb. 22, 2022, the Big South Conference and Ohio Valley Conference announced the creation of an association of their football member institutions, to begin with the 2023 NCAA Division I football season and have an initial term of at least four years. The unique agreement combines the two conferences' football membership to ensure NCAA championship access and stability for the multisport conferences. In creating the association, presidents from each of the multisport conferences pointed to the similarities of the OVC and the Big South, with their complementary geographies and intercollegiate athletic philosophies, as key to making this association possible. The first year is comprised of 10 members. Western Illinois will join the Association beginning with the 2024 season, while Bryant will depart after this season for CAA Football.

#### SLANT ROUTES

- \* BRYANT: Four of the Bulldogs' last six conference games have been decided by one possession -- which started with last year's 1-point loss to CSU on Oct. 15.
- \* CHARLESTON SOUTHERN: The Buccaneers won the first meeting with Bryant last year, 24–23, and sealed the win with a blocked field goal attempt as time expired.
- \* EASTERN ILLINOIS: The Panthers are idle this week and return to action Nov. 4 at Lindenwood.
- \* GARDNER-WEBB: The Runnin' Bulldogs last defeated UT Martin in 2002 (W, 24-0 in Boiling Springs), and also defeated the Skyhawks in 2001 (W, 45-20) ... As a player at Tennessee Tech (2009-12), Head Coach TRE LAMB was 3-1 vs. UTM, and was 28of-61 with 5 TD passes.
- \* LINDENWOOD: The Lions are playing the sixth of seven first-time opponents on Saturday, and are 2-3 thus far
- \* ROBERT MORRIS: The Colonials are playing their third first-time opponent of the season on Satuday, and are 1-1 thus far.
- \* SOUTHEAST MISSOURI: The Redhawks won the last meeting with Nicholls, 42-16, last year on Sept. 17 ... SEMO has scored in 21-straight quarters, and 23 of its last 25.
- \* TENNESSEE STATE: The Tigers' 5-2 start is their best open to a season since 2016 (also 5-2), and their five wins are tied for the most in a season under third-year Head Coach EDDIE GEORGE ... Saturday marks the second of three-straight first-time opponents for TSU. The Tigers are 3-1 against first-time foes this season.
- \* TENNESSEE TECH: The Golden
  Eagles are playing their third and
  final first-time opponent of the season on Saturday, and are 1-1 in those
  contests ... TTU is seeking back-toback road wins for the first time since
  last season (Oct. 29-Nov. 12).
- \* UT MARTIN: The Skyhawks have won the last two meetings with Gardner-Webb (35-9 in 2006 and 31-28 in 2005) ... UTM is looking to start 4-0 in conference action for the third-straight year.

#### PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - Oct. 23

#### **CO-OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

#### Pierce Holley, Eastern Illinois, QB • 6-2, 215, Gr. • Arvada, Colo.

Holley rushed for three touchdowns and the game-winning two-point conversion in overtime as Eastern Illinois topped Bryant, 25-24. The grad student completed 21-of-29 passes for 244 yards and carried the ball 17 times for 19 net yards. He scored on a two-yarder in the first quarter and added a one-yarder just before halftime to give the Panthers the lead at the break. In overtime, he scored from two yards out before his two-point conversion gave the Panthers the lead. Holley ranks fifth nationally in passing yards (2,149), sixth in completions/game (23.5) and 11th in passing yards/game (268.6).

#### Ryan Flournoy, Southeast Missouri, WR • 6-2, 205, Sr. • Hazelcrest, Ill.

Flournoy caught six passes for 203 yards and a touchdown as Southeast Missouri improved to 3-0 in Big South-OVC play with a 28-3 win at Tennessee Tech. The 203 yards are the most in the Association this year and the sixth-most by a FCS player in 2023. He scored on a career-long 89-yard reception in the first quarter -- the third-longest touchdown reception in school history. It marked the second 200-plus yard receiving game of Flournoy's career.

#### **DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

#### Terrell Allen, Tennessee State, DL • 6-0, 275, Sr. • Little Rock, Ark.

Allen was dominant with this second-straight multi-sack game in a 54-0 shutout of Lincoln. The senior had seven tackles (5 solo), 4.0 sacks, forced and recovered a fumble as TSU improved to 5-2 on the year. Allen helped the TSU defense hold Lincoln to just 52 yards on the ground on 45 attempts. Allen's 1.29 sacks per game currently ranks first nationally while his 2.0 tackles for loss per game is second in the FCS.

#### **SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

#### Aidan Laros, UT Martin, K/P • 6-2, 210, R-Soph. • Cape Town, South Africa

Laros accounted for five points in the kicking game and averaged 49.0 yards on five punts as No. 17/19 UT Martin shutout Charleston Southern, 17-0 to improve to 3-0 in Big South-OVC play. The sophomore converted on a 26-yard field goal right before halftime in what proved to be the only points UTM would need. As the punter, he controlled field position, with three of his five punts going for longer than 50 yards, including a season-best 70-yarder. That marked the sixth-longest punt in school history. Laros is averaging 48.0 yards per punt, which ranks first nationally.

#### **FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK**

#### Jordan Gant, Tennessee State, RB • 5-10, 205, R-Fr. • Lakeland, Fla.

Gant rushed for four touchdowns as Tennessee State shutout Lincoln (Calif.), 54-0 to improve to 5-2 on the season. The redshirt freshman carried the ball 12 times for 93 yards (7.8 ypc). He scored on runs of 31 and 3 yards in the first quarter, added a 3-yard score in the second stanza, and capped his scoring with a six-yard touchdown in the third quarter.

#### **CONFERENCE ROOM**

Of the 12 Association-conference games played thus far 10 have been won by the home team, while the overall average margin of victory is 14.33 points. Four contests have been one possession decisions — including three by two points-or-less, while two match-ups have gone into overtime. The 12 games have combined for 520 points, for a per game average of 43.33 points scored.

#### FRANK THE TANK

UT Martin RB **SAM FRANKLIN** is first in the nation with 940 rushing yards and 134.3 rushing yards per game. He rushed for more than 200 yards twice in a three-game span (259 vs. Missouri State in Week 2 and 221 at North Alabama in Week 4), and has a league-best five 100-yard rushing games on the season. Franklin also has an Association-best eight rushing touchdowns, which have gone for a total of 321 yards ( =40.13 yard average). Five of Franklin's eight rushing scores have gone for 40-plus yards (81, 49, 46, 74 and 43). Meanwhile, Franklin has out-rushed five Big South-OVC squads to this point of the season.

#### **BLOSSOMING FLOWERS**

Eastern Illinois RB MJ FLOWERS was named to the initial JERRY RICE Watch List last week for the FCS National Freshman of the Year Award. Flowers leads EIU in rushing with 437 yards, and is the Panthers' third-leading receiver with 28 catches out of the backfield. He ranks fourth among all Big South-OVC rushers for rushing yards, and his 28 receptions are seventh-most in the league. In Week 4, Flowers set Big South-OVC Association single-game records with his 37 rushing carries and 272 rushing yards against McNeese — the season's highest single-game effort by any NCAA player (FBS, FCS, D2, D3) until Oct. 14.

#### **NATIONAL ACCLAIM**

Six of the 10 Association members have received Top 25 consideration this season — with four teams cracking the Top 25 rankings at some point during the campaign. Gardner-Webb was No. 24/25 to open the season, while Southeast Missouri was ranked the first four weeks of the year. UT Martin entered the Top 25 on Sept. 25 and has been ranked since, while Eastern Illinois was No. 25 the week of Oct. 2. Receiving votes this year have been Tennessee Tech (preseason), and Tennessee State (Sept. 18, Oct. 16 and Oct. 24).

#### STATE OF MIND

The Big South-OVC Association went 9-2 in its 11 non-conference games this season against "State"-named FCS schools. Eastern Illinois led the way at 3-0 (Indiana State, Illinois State and Northwestern State), followed by Tennessee Tech (Kennesaw State and South Carolina State) and Tennessee State (Kennesaw State and Norfolk State) at 2-0 each. UT Martin (Missouri State) and Charleston Southern (Kennesaw State) went 1-0. Robert Morris (Youngstown State) and Lindenwood (Illinois State) went 0-1. Overall, the Big South-OVC is 19-14 against non-conference FCS competition, and will finish above .500 as just one out-of-conference FCS game remaining.

#### WHAT CAN BROWN DO FOR YOU?

Gardner-Webb RB **JAYDEN BROWN** leads all Big South-OVC running backs with four touchdown receptions, which have come on just 13 total catches. He has the top single-game receiving yard outputs by an Association rusher this season -- 77 vs. Robert Morris in Week 7, and 67 in the season opener at Appalachian State. Brown is second in the conference with 126.43 all-purpose yards per game, following his career-high 205 this past Saturday against Eastern Kentucky.

#### KICK STARTERS

Tennessee State PK **JAMES LOWERY** has made a Big South-OVC best five field goals from 40-yards or longer — and is the only player thus far with two from at least 50 yards (50 and 51). Lowery's five have been for an average of 46.6 yards. Southeast Missouri PK **DC PIPPIN** and Charleston Southern PK **SAM BABBUSH** are second to Lowery with four field goals from 40-plus yards. Pippin's average distance from that range is 43.5 yards, while Babbush's conversion average on his four is 44.3 yards. In addition, Babbush has made a 40-yarder in four of CSU's seven games this season. Lowery is the only kicker to make two 40-yard plus field goals in a game twice this year.

#### **TIGHT ROPE**

One week after setting a Big South-OVC Association single-game record for most receiving yards by a tight end with 76, Robert Morris TE **CHAESE JACKSON** became the Association's first tight end with 10 receptions in a game when he caught 10 passes in Week 6 at Gardner-Webb. In a four-game stretch from Weeks 3-6, Jackson had 22 receptions for 194 yards and three scores (full season totals stand at 28 catches, 261 yards and four TDs). Meanwhile, UT Martin TE **MAX DOWL-ING** became the first TE with two touchdown receptions in a game in Week 6 with a 9-yard TD grab and eventual game-winning 7-yard TD catch in the Skyhawks' overtime win at EIU.

#### **PASSING GRADES**

Eastern Illinois QB PIERCE HOLLEY became the first Big South-OVC quarterback with back-toback 300-yard passing games, as he threw for 346 in Week 7 at Southeast Missouri -- one week after setting an Association single-game record of 359 passing yards in Week 6 vs. UT Martin. Holley holds the league lead with 2,149 passing yards and 13 touchdown passes (tied), and has thrown for at least 244 yards in seven of his eight appearances this year. Meanwhile, UT Martin QB KINKEAD DENT is the only Big South-OVC Association quarterback with a touchdown pass in all seven games to start the campaign, and is tied with Holley for the league-lead with 13 TD scoring strikes.

#### 200-YARD PASSING ODYSSEY

Southeast Missouri QB PAXTON DeLAURENT saw his streak of six consecutive games with 200 passing yards end when he left the Tennessee Tech victory in the second quarter with an injury. He nearly topped the mark, as he was 7-of-10 for 189 yards before his departure. He did connect on a TD pass to mark his sixth-straight game with a TD pass. His six 200-yard passing games are just behind Eastern Illinois QB PIERCE HOLLEY, who has seven such efforts on the year. De-Laurent has a league-best three games with a touchdown pass and rushing touchdown in the same contest.

#### WHAT THE ECK!

Bryant QB ZEVI ECKHAUS amassed an Association single-game record of 369 yards of offense in Week 7 against Robert Morris. His effort included 86 rushing yards, and he now holds the top two single-game rushing outputs by a Big South-OVC quarterback this season, as he opened the season with 89 rushing yards at UNLV.

#### **SEEING REDD**

In Week 6 against Tennessee Tech, Lindenwood's SPENCER REDD recorded the Lions' seventh multi-touchdown game of the season with a 99-yard return of the opening kickoff, followed by a 52-yard receiving touchdown -- the team's second player with a receiving TD and special teams score in the same game. In Week 1, JEFF CALDWELL first returned a blocked punt for a touchdown, then added a 6-yard reception in the end zone.

#### **GAITHERING STEAM**

Gardner-Webb RB NARII GAITHER is eighth all-time in Big South Conference history with 2,930 career rushing yards, and needs 70 rushing yards to become just the seventh Big South player with 3,000 in his career. Meanwhile, Gaither is the all-time leader for career receptions by a Big South running back with 93. His 782 career receiving yards are second among Big South RBs alltime -- just 38 away from breaking the record of 819 (Kennesaw State's SHAQUIL TERRY, 2017-21).

#### **HESS TRUCK**

Southeast Missouri RB GENO HESS is the active FCS rushing leader at 4,663 yards, 739 ahead of the next player. His 60 career rushing touchdowns are the most of any active FCS player, as well as the Ohio Valley Conference record. Hess has three 100-yard rushing games this season, including a season-high 129 in the win over Eastern Illinois in Week 7, and he has been the Redhawks' top rusher in the last six contests.

#### **HOUSE CALLS**

Eastern Illinois ranks fifth nationally with its league-leading 10 interceptions, and the Panthers' +11 turnover margin is also tops in the Big South-OVC Association. EIU has two of the Association's six interceptions returned for touchdowns this season. Of those six, four are among the 18-longest in the FCS to this point:

#### AROUND THE ASSOCIATION...

#### **BRYANT**

In his last two games, QB **ZEVI ECKHAUS** has rushed for 148 yards on 15 carries ( =9.87 yarder per rush), and is the Bulldogs' season rushing leader with 319 ... RB **FABRICE MUKENDI** tallied two rushing touchdowns at Eastern Illinois this past week, becoming the 12th different Bulldog to score a TD this season. Bryant and UT Martin are tied for the Association lead for most players with at least one touchdown this year ... **ETHAN GETTMAN** made a season-long 45-yard field goal in the loss at EIU.

#### **CHARLESTON SOUTHERN**

Charleston Southern has allowed just 45 points in its four home games this season (11.3 per game average) ... The Bucs held UT Martin to its lowest point total against an FCS program since Dec. 4, 2021, when UTM scored just 7 points in a Second Round Playoff loss at Montana ... CSU has held its last three opponents to 294.33 yards of offense ... RB TJ RUFF has led CSU in rushing each of the past six games, gaining 387 yards in that span with four touchdowns ... The Buccaneers are seeking their first three-game home win streak since winning four-straight at Buccaneer Field across the 2019 and 2021 Spring seasons.

#### **EASTERN ILLINOIS**

The Panthers' three Big South-OVC Association games have been decided by a combined 9 points ... EIU allowed its second-fewest offensive yards of the season this past Saturday, as the Panthers held Bryant to 317. EIU's top defensive mark of the year came in the season opener at Indiana State (217) ... Five of Eastern Illinois' eight games have been one possession outcomes (3-2 record) ... QB **PIERCE HOLLEY** became the first Association QB with three rushing TDs in a game this season this past week. Through three conference games, Holley is 72-of-117 passing ( =61.5 percent) for 949 yards and six TDs.

#### **GARDNER-WEBB**

LB WILLIAM McRAINEY needs two tackles for 300 in his career ... DL TY FRENCH surpassed 200 career tackles in the EKU win. He needs four solo stops for 100 in his career, as well as 3.5 TFL for 50 ... Gardner-Webb forced UAC Preseason Player of the Year Parker McKinney into three interceptions for the first time in his career. JA'KAI YOUNG returned one of those INTs 40 yards for a score, the squad's first pick-six since TY ANDERSON had a 45-yarder for a score at Marshall on Oct. 1, 2022 ... The Runnin' Bulldogs rushed for a season-high 265 yards this past Saturday in the win over Eastern Kentucky ... RB JAYDEN BROWN gained a career-high 142 yards on the ground on 15 carries vs. EKU — including an Association-record 88-yard TD rush.

#### LINDENWOOD

WR JEFF CALDWELL picked up his Big South-OVC leading seventh TD reception in Week 7 at Charleston Southern, as his 28-yarder accounted for the Lions' lone touchdown of the day ... QB CARTER DAVIS was 15-of-31 passing for 170 yards and a score, and added 51 rushing yards to rank second on the team ... SPENCER REDD finished the CSU game with 126 all-purpose yards (66 kickoff return, 60 receiving) ... DL KOBE McCLENDON is second in the Association with 6.5 quarterback sacks, and tied for third with 9.5 TFL.

#### ROBERT MORRIS

The Colonials have limited their opposition to an average of 54.0 offensive plays the past four games ... In Week 7, RB **DJ MOYER** finished as RMU's leading rusher for the second time in three games, as he rushed 14 times for 60 yards at Bryant. He also caught four passes for 29 yards and a score ... WR **TRENELL RIDGLEY** had 203 all-purpose yards at Bryant on 14 total touches: team-high seven receptions for 54 yards, six kickoff returns for 146 yards, and one rush for three yards.

#### **SOUTHEAST MISSOURI**

#### TIEBREAKER PROCEDURE

#### 1. TRANSITIONING SCHOOLS

 To be eligible for the conference's automatic bid to the FCS Football Championship, a school must be a full Division I member.

**b.** Transitioning schools will be utilized in the tiebreaker process.

 c. If a transitioning school is involved in a two-way tie, the tied team that is eligible for postseason competition shall be the league's recipient of the automatic bid.

 $\mbox{\bf d}.$  If a transitioning school wins the multi-team tiebreaker, the procedure would start over with the remaining teams.

#### 2. TWO-WAY TIE

a. If the two teams played each other during the conference season, the winner of the head-to-head contest shall be the league's recipient of the automatic bid.

b. If the tied teams did not play each other during the conference season, each team's head-to-head record against all common opponents in the league will be used to determine the automatic bid.

c. If a tie still exists, then each team's record against the next highest common opponent in the league standings will be used to determine the automatic bid. When arriving at a group of tied teams that each team has played, composite records between the tied teams shall be utilized to determine if one of the tied teams has won more games against the group of tied teams.

d. If the teams are still tied, a point system will be utilized based on a complete schedule and wins using Sagarin rankings entering the final day of the regular season, as indicated on the next page.

e. Should the points system finish in a tie, the tied team with the best Sagarin rating on the final day of the regular season (i.e., Saturday morning) will receive the automatic bid.

#### B. MULTIPLE TIES

a. If at any point, a tie is broken using the multiple-tie tiebreaker procedures and only two teams remain, the remaining teams will revert to the two-way tiebreaker (head-to-head).

b. If the tied teams all played each other during the conference season, the team with the
best cumulative record involving games with the tied teams shall be declared champion. For
example, if a team is 2-0 against two other tied teams, that team will be declared champion.
 c. If the tied teams all played one another and have identical records against the other tied

teams, then each team's record against all common opponents in the league will be used to determine the automatic bid. If teams are still tied, then each team's record against the next highest common opponent in the league standings will be used to determine the automatic bid. d. If the tied teams did not play each other, then each team's record against all common opponents in the league will be used to determine the automatic bid. If the teams are still tied, and they did not play each other, then each team's record against the next highest common opponent in the league standings will be used to determine the automatic bid.

e. If the teams are still tied, a point system will be utilized based on a complete schedule and wins using Sagarin rankings entering the final day of the regular season, as indicated below.
f. Should the points system finish in a tie, the tied team with the best Sagarin rating on the final day of the regular season (i.e., Saturday morning) will receive the automatic bid.
