2-MINUTE OFFENSE

OPENING KICKOFF: For the first time this season, a full slate of conference games is on the docket this week, as all 10 Association members will compete against each other. Another full set of league contests will be played next week, with the Nov. 18 season finale schedule comprised of four match-ups.

1st DOWN: Gardner-Webb's 38-34 victory last week over then-No. 13/14 UT Martin was its first win against a nationally-ranked opponent since the 2021 Spring season, when the Runnin' Bulldogs defeated #24 Elon, 42-20, in the debut of head coach **TRE LAMB**. Lamb is now 2-3 against nationally-ranked foes, including 1-1 against ranked conference members.

2nd DOWN: The 6-2 Tennessee State Tigers have secured their first winning season since 2017, when TSU finished 6-5. The last time the Tigers won seven games was in 2016 (7-4). Meanwhile, TSU carries a 4-game win streak into Saturday's contest at Charleston Southern, and is averaging 37.0 points, while holding the opposition to 14.3 points and 243.0 yards of offense during its streak.

3rd DOWN: The highest-scoring games in the Association were last week, as Gardner-Webb (38) and UT Martin (34) combined for 72 points, followed by Bryant (47) and Charleston Southern (24) at 71 points.

4th DOWN: SEMO's streak of consecutive quarters with a point ended at 23, as the Redhawks were held scoreless in the fourth quarter in their 35–31 win at Nicholls.

ABOUT THE BIG SOUTH-OVC FOOTBALL ASSOCIATION

This is the first season of the Big South-OVC Football Association. On Feb. 22, 2022, the Big South Conference and Ohio Valley Conference announced the creation of an association of their football member institutions, to begin with the 2023 NCAA Division I football season and have an initial term of at least four years. The unique agreement combines the two conferences' football membership to ensure NCAA championship access and stability for the multisport conferences. In creating the association, presidents from each of the multisport conferences pointed to the similarities of the OVC and the Big South, with their complementary geographies and intercollegiate athletic philosophies, as key to making this association possible. The first year is comprised of 10 members. Western Illinois will join the Association beginning with the 2024 season, while Bryant will depart after this season for CAA Football.

SLANT ROUTES

- * BRYANT: The Bulldogs have matched their win total from 2022 (4), and last won five games in 2021 (7) ... QB ZEVI ECKHAUS passed for 450 yards and 3 TDs against Gardner-Webb last season.
- * CHARLESTON SOUTHERN: The Buccaneers are playing their fourth and final first-time opponent of the season on Saturday, which is also CSU's final home game of the year.
- * EASTERN ILLINOIS: The Panthers are seeking their first winning season since 2017, when EIU finished 6–5.
- * GARDNER-WEBB: The Runnin' Bulldogs won the first meeting with Bryant last year, 48-40 ... GWU is the lone Association member undefeated at home (4-0) and winless on the road (0-4).
- * LINDENWOOD: The Lions won the first meeting with Eastern Illinois last year, 37–34 in double-overtime ... Lindenwood is looking to avoid three-straight losses for the first time since 2018.
- * ROBERT MORRIS: The Colonials are playing their fourth of five first-time opponents of the season on Saturday, and are 1-2 thus far.
- * SOUTHEAST MISSOURI: The Redhawks are playing their second of three first-time opponents on Saturday ... SEMO is seeking its secondstraight 4–0 conference start.
- * TENNESSEE STATE: The Tigers have scored 40-plus points in back-to-back games for the first time since the first two games of the 2016 season ... Saturday marks the third of three-straight first-time opponents for TSU. The Tigers are 4-1 against first-time foes this season.
- * TENNESSEE TECH: The Golden Eagles last defeated UTM in 2012 (W, 45–44 at home) ... TTU's 38 points last week was its most in a game since scoring 40 in a win at EIU in 2019.
- * UT MARTIN: The Skyhawks have won the last 10 meetings with Tennessee Tech, and have averaged 36.4 points during that win streak, while holding Tech to an average of 13.2 points.

PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - OCT. 30

OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Zevi Eckhaus, Bryant, QB • 6-1, 205, Jr. • Culver City, Calif.

Eckhaus completed 29-of-37 passes for a season-high 338 yards and four touchdowns as Bryant went to Charleston Southern and won 47-24. The junior threw touchdowns to three different receivers, connecting on passes of 14, 1, 13 and 1 yards. The final two came early in the fourth quarter to help the Bulldogs put the game out of reach. It marked the fifth time in his career he has thrown four touchdown passes in a game. Eckhaus needs just 36 yards to set the Bryant career passing yards record. Entering this week, he ranks 22nd nationally in completions (19.75/game), 24th in passing touchdowns (14) and 27th in passing yards (1,808).

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Terrell Allen, Tennessee State, DL • 6-0, 275, Sr. • Little Rock, Ark.

Allen earned the award for the third-straight week after playing havoc on defense in the team's 43-20 win over Lindenwood. With the victory, the Tigers improved to 6-2 and locked up its first winning season since 2017. Allen had a game-high 10 tackles (7 solo), 6.5 tackles for loss, 4.5 sacks and forced two fumbles. It marked his third-straight multi-sack game and marked the most sacks by a FCS player in a game this season. His 6.5 tackles for loss set a TSU single-game record and were also the most by a player nationally this year. Allen ranks first nationally in sacks (1.69/game), tackles for loss (2.6/game) and forced fumbles (0.62/game).

CO-SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Dalyn McDonald, Southeast Missouri, RS • 5-11, 185, Sr. • Gautier, Miss.

McDonald was effective on kick and punt returns in a 35-31 win at Nicholls, including returning a punt 65 yards for a touchdown that broke a 21-21 tie in the third quarter as the Redhawks would not trail again. Overall, McDonald averaged 25.0 yards on three punt returns and 23.5 yards on two kickoff returns (with a long kick return of 31 yards). McDonald ranks ninth nationally in punt returns (15.2 yards/return) and 16th in combined kick return yards (452).

James Lowery, Tennessee State, K • 5-10, 210, R-Jr. • Fort Lauderdale, Fla.

Lowery scored 13 points as Tennessee State topped Lindenwood, 43-20. The junior made a season-high three field goals, connecting from 37, 35 and 29 yards while also going 4-for-5 on PATs. Lowery also handled kickoff duties, registering four touchbacks on nine attempts. He ranks 13th nationally in field goals made per game (1.38) and 14th in field goal percentage (84.6%).

FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

Jaylen King, Gardner-Webb, QB • 6-4, 200, Fr. • Folkston, Ga.

King led Gardner-Webb to a 38-34 victory over No. 13/14 UT Martin as the Runnin' Bulldogs improved to 2-1 in Big South-OVC play. The signal caller led a 16-play, 90-yard drive that culminated with King rushing for a 10-yard touchdown with 13 seconds remaining for the go-ahead score. King finished the day with 254 yards of total offense and three total touchdowns. He completed 16-of-33 passes for 216 yards and two touchdowns (a 71-yarder in the first quarter and a 1-yarder in the second quarter), and carried the ball 17 times for 38 yards and the game-winning TD. Gardner-Webb is 2-1 with King as its starting quarterback.

ALLEN PACKS THE SACK LUNCH

Tennessee State DL **TERRELL ALLEN** established Association-game records with 6.5 tackles-forloss and 4.5 quarterback sacks in this past week's 43-20 victory over Lindenwood. In his last *three* games, Allen has recorded 14.5 TFL and 10.5 sacks, to boost his season totals to nationalbests of 20.5 stops behind the line of scrimmage and 13.5 quarterback takedowns.

BIG TECH

Tennessee Tech posted an Association single-game record of three defensive touchdowns this past Saturday in its 38-13 win at Robert Morris. The Golden Eagles returned two fumbles for scores (DANIEL RICKERT - 20 yards and AARON SWAFFORD - 52 yards), plus a pick-six from TIM COUTRAS (39 yards). Tech has a league-best four defensive touchdowns this season.

90s ON NINE

One week after the longest pass play in Big South-OVC history was recorded in Week 8 by Southeast Missouri (89 yards), Tennessee State bettered the mark by one yard this past Saturday, as **DRAYLEN ELLIS** connected with **DA'SHON DAVIS** for a 90-yard score in TSU's win over Lindenwood. Davis finished the day with five receptions for 200 yards — the second 200-yard receiving game in the Association this season.

CONFERENCE ROOM

Of the 16 Association-conference games played thus far, 12 have been won by the home team, while the overall average margin of victory is 15.44 points. Five contests have been one possession decisions — including three by two points-or-less, while two match-ups have gone into overtime. The 16 games have combined for 777 points, for a per game average of 48.56 points scored.

RETURN TO SENDER

For the first time in the Association's existence, a non-blocked punt was returned for a touch-down, as Southeast Missouri's **DALYN McDONALD** returned a punt 65 yards for a score in the Redhawks' 35–31 win at Nicholls. It is the longest punt return in the league this season, and McDonald owns the second-longest punt return this year as well -- 37 yards at Eastern Kentucky in Week 4. McDonald ranks ninth in FCS with his 15.2 punt return average.

NATIONAL ACCLAIM

Six of the 10 Association members have received Top 25 consideration this season — with four teams cracking the Top 25 rankings at some point during the campaign. Gardner-Webb was No. 24/25 to open the season, while Southeast Missouri was ranked the first four weeks of the year. UT Martin entered the Top 25 on Sept. 25 and has been ranked every week since (6 weeks), while Eastern Illinois was No. 25 the week of Oct. 2. Receiving votes this year have been Tennessee Tech (preseason), and Tennessee State (Sept. 18, Oct. 16, Oct. 23 and Oct. 30).

WINNING STATE OF MIND

The Big South-OVC Association is 20-14 against non-conference FCS competition with one non-league game remaining (Samford in Week 12). The Association went 9-2 in its 11 non-conference games this season against "State"-named FCS schools. Eastern Illinois led the way at 3-0 (Indiana State, Illinois State and Northwestern State), followed by Tennessee Tech (Kennesaw State and South Carolina State) and Tennessee State (Kennesaw State and Norfolk State) at 2-0 each. UT Martin (Missouri State) and Charleston Southern (Kennesaw State) went 1-0. Robert Morris (Youngstown State) and Lindenwood (Illinois State) went 0-1.

WHAT CAN BROWN DO FOR YOU?

Gardner-Webb RB **JAYDEN BROWN** leads all Big South-OVC running backs with five touchdown receptions, which have come on just 14 total catches. He has the top three single-game receiving yard outputs by an Association rusher this season -- 77 vs. Robert Morris in Week 7, 71 vs. UT Martin last week, and 67 in the season opener at Appalachian State. Brown is second in the conference with 127.13 all-purpose yards per game, and posted a career-high 205 in Week 8 against Eastern Kentucky.

FRANK THE TANK

UT Martin RB **SAM FRANKLIN** is fourth in the nation with 1,017 rushing yards and third with 127.1 rushing yards per game. He rushed for more than 200 yards twice in a three-game span (259 vs. Missouri State in Week 2 and 221 at North Alabama in Week 4), and has a league-best five 100-yard rushing games on the season. Franklin is tied for the Association lead with nine rushing touchdowns, which have gone for a total of 328 yards (=36.44 yard average). Five of Franklin's eight rushing scores have gone for 40-plus yards (81, 49, 46, 74 and 43). Meanwhile, Franklin has still out-rushed four Big South-OVC squads to this point of the season.

LAROS' LEG

UT Martin PK/P AIDAN LAROS is having a season for the ages. He has 55 points as a placekicker (31 PAT, 8 FG), but is the national leader in punting average at 48.9 yards. This past week at Gardner-Webb, he averaged an Association single-game record 56.8 yards per punt, with a long of 70 -- his second 70-yard punt of the year. Laros, who has three games this season with a 50-plus yard punting average, is pacing ahead of the all-time FCS single-season punting average record of 48.2 (min. 60 punts), which is held by Northern Arizona's MARK GOULD (62 for 2,987 in 2002).

KICK STARTERS

Tennessee State PK JAMES LOWERY, Southeast Missouri PK DC PIPPIN and Charleston Southern PK SAM BABBUSH have made a Big South-OVC best five field goals from 40-yards or longer -while Lowery is the only player thus far with two from at least 50 yards (50 and 51). Lowery's five have been for an average of 46.6 yards. Pippin and Babbush are both averaging 43.4 yards on their kicks from that distance. Babbush has made a 40-yarder in five of CSU's eight games this season. Lowery is the only kicker to make two 40-yard plus field goals in a game twice this year.

GAITHERING STEAM

Gardner-Webb RB NARII GAITHER is seventh all-time in Big South Conference history with 2,989 career rushing yards, and needs 11 rushing yards to become just the seventh Big South player with 3,000 in his career. Meanwhile, Gaither is the all-time leader for career receptions by a Big South running back with 96. His 792 career receiving yards are second among Big South RBs alltime -- just 28 away from breaking the record of 819 (Kennesaw State's SHAQUIL TERRY, 2017-21).

Southeast Missouri RB GENO HESS is the active FCS rushing leader at 4,791 yards, 867 ahead of the next player. His 61 career rushing touchdowns are the most of any active FCS player, as well as the Ohio Valley Conference record. Hess has four 100-yard rushing games this season, including a season-high 129 in the win over Eastern Illinois in Week 7, and he has been the Redhawks' top rusher in the last seven contests.

PASSING GRADES

Eastern Illinois QB PIERCE HOLLEY became the first Big South-OVC quarterback with back-toback 300-yard passing games, as he threw for 346 in Week 7 at Southeast Missouri -- one week after setting an Association single-game record of 359 passing yards in Week 6 vs. UT Martin. Holley holds the league lead with 2,149 passing yards, and has thrown for at least 244 yards in seven of his eight appearances this year. Meanwhile, UT Martin QB KINKEAD DENT is the only Big South-OVC Association quarterback with a touchdown pass in all eight games to start the campaign, and leads the conference with 16 TD scoring strikes.

200-YARD PASSING ODYSSEY

Southeast Missouri QB PAXTON DeLAURENT saw his streak of six consecutive games with 200 passing yards end in Week 8 when he left the Tennessee Tech victory in the second quarter with an injury. He nearly topped the mark, as he was 7-of-10 for 189 yards before his departure. He did connect on a TD pass to mark his sixth-straight game with a TD pass. His six 200-yard passing games are just behind Eastern Illinois QB PIERCE HOLLEY, who has seven such efforts on the year.

WHAT THE ECK!

Bryant QB ZEVI ECKHAUS amassed an Association single-game record of 369 yards of offense in Week 7 against Robert Morris. His effort included 86 rushing yards, and he holds the top two single-game rushing outputs by a Big South-OVC quarterback this season, as he opened the season with 89 rushing yards at UNLV.

HOUSE CALLS

BRYANT

QB **ZEVI ECKHAUS** now has 7,428 passing yards and 61 passing TDs in his career. He had season-highs of 29 completions, 338 passing yards and 4 TD passes in Bryant's 47-24 win at Charleston Southern this past week ... DB **LAKE ELLIS** has an interception in three-straight games ... RB **FABRICE MUKENDI** tallied two rushing touchdowns for the second consecutive week ... The Bulldogs have averaged 45.0 points in their two Association wins this year.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

WR WILL KAKAVITSAS hauled in five passes for 169 yards and three touchdowns in the Bucs' setback to Bryant last week. He scored on receptions of 76, 23 and 35 yards (134 total combined), and became the first CSU receiver with 3 TD in a game since GARRIS SCHWARTING had four in the 2021 season opener ... RB TJ RUFF has led CSU in rushing each of the past seven games, gaining 441 yards in that span with four touchdowns ... In his last four games, QB ZOLTEN OSBORNE has thrown for 695 yards on 50 completions (13.9 yard average).

EASTERN ILLINOIS

The Panthers' three Big South-OVC Association games have been decided by a combined 9 points ... Through three conference games, Holley is 72-of-117 passing (=61.5 percent) for 949 yards and six TDs.

GARDNER-WEBB

LB TY ANDERSON returned a fumble 36 yards for a touchdown vs. UTM, his second career defensive TD ... LB WILLIAM McRAINEY surpassed 300 career tackles last week, while DL TY FRENCH eclipsed 100 career solo tackles. French posted his third 3.0 TFL game this past week vs. UT Martin, and has 49.5 in his career, along with 28.5 career sacks ... QB JAYLEN KING has thrown and rushed for a TD in three consecutive games ... The Runnin' Bulldogs have won six-straight home games, dating back to last season, and are averaging 37.33 points during that streak. GWU's next home tilt is the Nov. 18 season-finale vs. Charleson Southern.

LINDENWOOD

WR JEFF CALDWELL picked up his Big South-OVC leading eighth TD reception this past week with a 65-yard scoring play at Tennessee State. It was his third TD catch of the year of at least 65 yards ... QB TYLER KUBAT was Lindenwood's top passer vs. TSU with 114 yards and two scores on 7-of-13 ... The Lions' 5.68 average yards per play rank second in the Association, while their 158.25 rushing yards per game are third.

ROBERT MORRIS

The Colonials are looking to snap their four-game losing streak, as well as earn their first road win since Oct. 19, 2019 at Wagner (W, 21-13) ... Against Tennessee Tech this past week, LB **JAMAR SHEGOG** tallied 3.0 tackles-for-loss, and shared the team tackle lead with **JOE CASALE** with nine each ... QB **ANTHONY CHICCITT** was 20-of-28 passing — his fourth game this year with 20 completions — for 133 yards and two TDs.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI

The Redhawks have won nine consecutive conference games, and are averaging 38.6 points during that streak ... SEMO has held two of its three league opponents to 7 points or less ... TIEBREAKER PROCEDURE

1. TRANSITIONING SCHOOLS

 To be eligible for the conference's automatic bid to the FCS Football Championship, a school must be a full Division I member.

b. Transitioning schools will be utilized in the tiebreaker process.

c. If a transitioning school is involved in a two-way tie, the tied team that is eligible for postseason competition shall be the league's recipient of the automatic bid.

d. If a transitioning school wins the multi-team tiebreaker, the procedure would start over with the remaining teams.

2. TWO-WAY TIE

a. If the two teams played each other during the conference season, the winner of the head-to-head contest shall be the league's recipient of the automatic bid.

b. If the tied teams did not play each other during the conference season, each team's head-to-head record against all common opponents in the league will be used to determine the automatic bid.

c. If a tie still exists, then each team's record against the next highest common opponent in the league standings will be used to determine the automatic bid. When arriving at a group of tied teams that each team has played, composite records between the tied teams shall be utilized to determine if one of the tied teams has won more games against the group of tied teams.

d. If the teams are still tied, a point system will be utilized based on a complete schedule and wins using Sagarin rankings entering the final day of the regular season, as indicated on the next page.

e. Should the points system finish in a tie, the tied team with the best Sagarin rating on the final day of the regular season (i.e., Saturday morning) will receive the automatic bid.

B. MULTIPLE TIES

 a. If at any point, a tie is broken using the multiple-tie tiebreaker procedures and only two teams remain, the remaining teams will revert to the two-way tiebreaker (head-to-head).

b. If the tied teams all played each other during the conference season, the team with the
best cumulative record involving games with the tied teams shall be declared champion. For
example, if a team is 2-O against two other tied teams, that team will be declared champion.
 c. If the tied teams all played one another and have identical records against the other tied

teams, then each team's record against all common opponents in the league will be used to determine the automatic bid. If teams are still tied, then each team's record against the next highest common opponent in the league standings will be used to determine the automatic bid. d. If the tied teams did not play each other, then each team's record against all common opponents in the league will be used to determine the automatic bid. If the teams are still tied, and they did not play each other, then each team's record against the next highest common opponent in the league standings will be used to determine the automatic bid.

e. If the teams are still tied, a point system will be utilized based on a complete schedule and wins using Sagarin rankings entering the final day of the regular season, as indicated below.
f. Should the points system finish in a tie, the tied team with the best Sagarin rating on the final day of the regular season (i.e., Saturday morning) will receive the automatic bid.
