2-MINUTE OFFENSE

OPENING KICKOFF: No. 13/19 UT Martin clinched at least a share of the inaugural Big South-OVC Football Association championship, as the Skyhawks concluded league play with a 5-1 record. It is UTM's third-straight conference title. UT Martin can earn the outright championship and automatic bid to the FCS Playoffs with a Gardner-Webb loss to Charleston Southern on Saturday.

1st DOWN: Gardner-Webb can clinch a share of the Big South-OVC championship with a win Saturday over Charleston Southern. Should the Runnin' Bulldogs prevail, GWU would capture the Big South-OVC automatic bid to the FCS Playoffs based on its 38-34 victory over UT Martin back on Oct. 28. A victory would also mark Gardner-Webb's second-straight conference crown.

2nd DOWN: Bryant is averaging 43.0 points in its last three games. Of the Big South-OVC teams with at least three league wins, the Bulldogs are the only squad to win all three by double digits (22.3 average win margin). Only SEMO has a higher average win margin in Association games than Bryant at 23.3 points.

3rd DOWN: Depending on the outcomes this Saturday, eight of the 10 Association members could finish with .500 conference records. In that scenario, RMU would need to defeat EIU, CSU would need to win at GWU, and TSU would need to down TTU.

4th DOWN: Through 26 Association games, the home team has won 16 times (=61.5 winning percentage). UTM finished 3-0 in home league games.

ABOUT THE BIG SOUTH-OVC FOOTBALL ASSOCIATION

This is the first season of the Big South–OVC Football Association. On Feb. 22, 2022, the Big South Conference and Ohio Valley Conference announced the creation of an association of their football member institutions, to begin with the 2023 NCAA Division I football season and have an initial term of at least four years. The unique agreement combines the two conferences' football membership to ensure NCAA championship access and stability for the multisport conferences. In creating the association, presidents from each of the multisport conferences pointed to the similarities of the OVC and the Big South, with their complementary geographies and intercollegiate athletic philosophies, as key to making this association possible. The first year is comprised of 10 members. Western Illinois will join the Association beginning with the 2024 season, while Bryant will depart after this season for CAA Football.

SLANT ROUTES

- * BRYANT: The Bulldogs have alternated wins and losses each week of 2023 ... Bryant is looking for its first winning season since finishing 7-4 in 2021.
- * CHARLESTON SOUTHERN: The Buccaneers are seeking their first road win of the year ... CSU last defeated GWU in 2021 (W, 32-24 in Boiling Springs).
- * EASTERN ILLINOIS: The Panthers have won seven games for the first time since the 2015 season (7–5), and are seeking their first 8-win campaign since 2013 (12–2).
- * GARDNER-WEBB: The Runnin' Bulldogs' have posted back-to-back winning seasons for the first time since 2002-2003 ... GWU is averaging 38.3 points during its current 4-game win streak.
- * LINDENWOOD: The Lions concluded the 2023 season with a home loss to Bryant ... Lindenwood played a league-high seven first-time opponents this year.
- * ROBERT MORRIS: The Colonials' have won back-to-back games for the first time since winning 5-straight in 2019 ... RMU is 2-2 against first-time fees this season
- * SOUTHEAST MISSOURI: The Redhawks are playing their third first-time opponent on Saturday, and are seeking their first win in those contests (0-2).
- * TENNESSEE STATE: The Tigers are 2-0 in home conference games this season ... TSU has won the last two meetings with Tech and four out of the last five ... Tennessee State last won seven games in 2016.
- * TENNESSEE TECH: The Golden
 Eagles are looking to defeat TSU for
 the first time since the 2021 Spring
 season, which was a 24-10 home win
 ... Tech last defeated the Tigers in
 Nashville in 2016 (W. 44-16).
- * UT MARTIN: The Skyhawks have won at least eight games for the second time in three seasons ... UTM has won the last three meetings with Samford, the most recent matchup was in 2021 (W, 33-27).

MJ Flowers, Eastern Illinois, RB • 6-1, 195, R-Fr. • Cincinnati, Ohio

Flowers rushed for 201 yards and four touchdowns while also adding a pair of receptions as Eastern Illinois topped Tennessee State for its third-straight win to improve to 7-3 on the season. The redshirt freshman scored on runs of 8 and 2 yards in the first quarter, added a 31-yard score in the third quarter to put the Panthers ahead for good, and cemented the game with a 1-yard score in the fourth quarter. It marked his second 200yard rushing game of the season (just the third EIU player to accomplish the feat), making him the only FCS freshman with multiple 200-yard games this year. Flowers now has 675 rushing yards on the season, third among all Big South-OVC players and third nationally among all freshmen.

Young picked off a pass and returned it to paydirt with 3:20 remaining before halftime in what proved to cap the scoring for the Runnin' Bulldogs. His pass breakups helped Gardner-Webb hold TTU to 0-for-5 on fourth down on the day. Young's interception return was one of two on the afternoon for GWU, which marked a first in the program's Division I history.

WHAT THE ECK!

Bryant QB **ZEVI ECKHAUS** is the first Association quarterback with three-straight 300-yard and 4 TD passing games. He first threw for 338 and 4 TD strikes in Week 9 at Charleston Southern, had 338 yards and 4 in Week 10 in the Bulldogs' overtime loss to Gardner-Webb, and 367 and 4 this past week in Bryant's 38-3 win at Lindenwood. In his last three games, Eckhaus is 87-of-127 passing (=68.5 percent) for 1,043 yards with 12 touchdown passes and just two interceptions.

KING OF THE HILL

Gardner-Webb QB **JAYLEN KING** is the first Big South-OVC Association quarterback this season with two TD passes for at least 50 yards in a conference game, as he connected on scoring strikes of 59 yards and 62 yards in the Runnin' Bulldogs' 35-0 win at Tennessee Tech this past week. In Week 10 at Bryant, King became the first Big South-OVC Association quarterback with 100 rushing yards and 100 passing yards in the same game, as he tallied 108 yards on the ground — the first league QB with a 100-yard rushing game — plus 160 yards through the air. He also became the first Association QB with two rushing and two passing TDs in the same contest.

THE DEFENSIVE NEVER RESTS

The Big South-OVC Association members have combined for 19 defensive touchdowns this season (12 interception returns and six fumble returns). Gardner-Webb and Tennessee Tech have a league-best four defensive TDs -- TTU's toal includes an Association single-game record three in its 38-13 Week 9 win at Robert Morris. In that game, the Golden Eagles returned two fumbles for scores (DANIEL RICKERT - 20 yards and AARON SWAFFORD - 52 yards), plus a pick-six from TIM COUTRAS (39 yards). Charleston Southern and Southeast Missouri have three defensive scores in 2023. All but two Association squads have scored on the defensive side of the ball this season.

CONFERENCE ROOM

Of the 26 Association-conference games played thus far, 16 have been won by the home team, while the overall average margin of victory is 14.85 points. Ten contests have been one possession decisions — including seven by a field goal-or-less, while four match-ups have gone into overtime. The 26 games have combined for 1,278 points, for a per game average of 49.15 points scored.

NATIONAL ACCLAIM

Six of the 10 Association members have received Top 25 consideration this season — with four teams cracking the Top 25 rankings at some point during the campaign. Gardner-Webb was No. 24/25 to open the season, while Southeast Missouri was ranked the first four weeks of the year. UT Martin entered the Top 25 on Sept. 25 and has been ranked every week since (8 weeks), while Eastern Illinois was No. 25 the week of Oct. 2. Receiving votes this year have been Tennessee Tech (preseason), and Tennessee State (Sept. 18, Oct. 16, Oct. 23, Oct. 30, Nov. 6).

WINNING STATE OF MIND

The Big South-OVC Association plays its final regular-season non-conference game this Saturday when UT Martin visits Samford. The Association is 20-14 (=58.8 percent) against non-conference FCS competition, and went 9-2 in its 11 non-conference games this year against "State"-named FCS schools. Eastern Illinois led the way at 3-0 (Indiana State, Illinois State and Northwestern State), followed by Tennessee Tech (Kennesaw State and South Carolina State) and Tennessee State (Kennesaw State and Norfolk State) at 2-0 each. UT Martin (Missouri State) and Charleston Southern (Kennesaw State) went 1-0. Robert Morris (Youngstown State) and Lindenwood (Illinois State) went 0-1.

WHAT CAN BROWN DO FOR YOU?

Gardner-Webb RB **JAYDEN BROWN** leads all Big South-OVC running backs with five touchdown receptions, which have come on just 14 total catches. He owns three of the top five single-game receiving yard outputs by an Association rusher this season — 77 vs. Robert Morris in Week 7 (second-most), 71 vs. UT Martin in Week 9 (fourth-most), and 67 in the season opener at Appalachian State (fifth-most). Brown is second in the conference with 127.50 all-purpose yards per game, and posted a career-high 220 in Week 10 at Bryant — his second game with 200+ in three weeks (205 in Week 8 against Eastern Kentucky).

ALLEN PACKED THE SACK LUNCH

In a four-game stretch from Weeks 7-10, Tennessee State DL **TERRELL ALLEN** recorded 18.5 TFL and 11.5 sacks, to boost his season totals to national-bests of 24.5 stops behind the line of scrimmage and 14.5 quarterback takedowns. In Week 9, Allen established Association-game records with 6.5 tackles-for-loss and 4.5 quarterback sacks in TSU's 43-20 victory over Lindenwood.

FRANK THE TANK

UT Martin RB SAM FRANKLIN is second in the nation with 1,218 rushing yards and third with 121.8 rushing yards per game. He rushed for more than 200 yards twice in a three-game span (259 vs. Missouri State in Week 2 and 221 at North Alabama in Week 4), owns the league lead with six 100-yard rushing games on the season, and is tied for the top mark with 10 rushing touchdowns. Those 10 have gone for a total of 331 yards (=33.10 yard average). Five of Franklin's 10 rushing scores have gone for 40-plus yards (81, 49, 46, 74 and 43). Meanwhile, Franklin has still out-rushed five Big South-OVC squads to this point of the season.

FIRST CENTURY

UT Martin became the first Big South-OVC member with two 100-yard rushers in the same game this past week against Southeast Missouri, as NARKEL LEFLORE rushed for a career-high 147 yards and SAM FRANKLIN added 123 rushing yards. The duo combined to average 7.5 yards per rush, while Leflore averaged 9.8 yards per carry for the Skyhawks. Leflore had touchdown rushes of 75 -- the third-longest in the Association this year, and 20 yards in the victory.

HOUSE CALLS

Gardner-Webb's JA'KAI YOUNG is the only Big South-OVC player this season with two Pick-6's. Overall, the Association members have returned 12 interceptions for touchdowns this year, and four of the 12 are among the longest returns in the FCS to this point:

LAROS' LEG

UT Martin PK/P AIDAN LAROS is having a season for the ages. He has 68 points as a placekicker (41 PAT, 9 FG), but is the national leader in punting average at 47.1 yards. In Week 9 at Gardner-Webb, he averaged an Association single-game record 56.8 yards per punt, with a long of 70 -- his second 70-yard punt of the year. Laros, who has three games this season with a 50-plus yard punting average, is just behind the all-time FCS single-season punting average record of 48.2 (min. 60 punts), which is held by Northern Arizona's MARK GOULD (62 for 2,987 in 2002).

GAITHERING STEAM

Gardner-Webb RB NARII GAITHER set an Association single-game high for receiving yards by a running back with 82 this past week at Tennessee Tech. He is the Big South's all-time leader for career receptions by a running back with 101, and is now the league's record-holder for career receiving yards by a rusher with 898. Meanwhile, Gaither is seventh in Big South annals with 3,110 career rushing yards, and 114 away from moving into sixth-place.

Southeast Missouri RB GENO HESS is the active FCS rushing leader at 4,939 yards -- 979 ahead of the next player and 61 rushing yards away from 5,000 in his career. His 61 career rushing touchdowns are the most of any active FCS player, as well as the Ohio Valley Conference record. Hess has five 100-yard rushing games this season, second in the conference and includes a season-high 150 in Week 10 against Robert Morris. Hess has been the Redhawks' top rusher in eight of 10 contests.

PASSING GRADES

Eastern Illinois OB PIERCE HOLLEY became the first Big South-OVC quarterback with back-toback 300-yard passing games, as he threw for 346 in Week 7 at Southeast Missouri -- one week after setting an Association single-game record of 359 passing yards in Week 6 vs. UT Martin. Holley holds the league lead with 2,515 passing yards, and has thrown for at least 244 yards in eight of his 10 appearances this year. Meanwhile, UT Martin QB KINKEAD DENT is the only Big South-OVC Association quarterback with a touchdown pass in every game this season, and leads the conference with 24 TD scoring strikes.

BLOSSOMING FLOWERS

Eastern Illinois RB MJ FLOWERS is on the JERRY RICE Watch List for the FCS National Freshman of the Year Award. He matched the Association single-game record with four rushing touchdowns this past Saturday at Tennessee State, and his team-high 675 rushing yards ranks third in the conference. Flowers is the Panthers' fifth-leading receiver with 31 catches out of the backfield. He has two 200-yard rushing games this season -- 201 vs. Tennessee State last week and a Big South-OVC Association single-game record 272 in Week 4 against McNeese, which was the season's highest single-game effort by any NCAA player (FBS, FCS, D2, D3) until Oct. 14.

KICK STARTERS

Tennessee State PK JAMES LOWERY (50 and 51) and Tennessee Tech's HAYDEN OLSEN (50 and 54) are the only Big South-OVC Association kickers to make two field goals from at least 50 yards this season. Meanwhile, Lowery and Southeast Missouri PK DC PIPPIN have a league-high six made field goals from beyond 40 yards. Lowery's six conversions have averaged 46.0 yards, while Pippin owns an average distance of 43.33 yards on his six made kicks. Charleston Southern PK SAM BABBUSH has made five field goals from 40-yards or longer (43.4 yards on his kicks from that range), and has converted a 40-yarder in five of CSU's 10 games this season.

200-YARD PASSING ODYSSEY

Southeast Missouri QB PAXTON DeLAURENT saw his league-best streak of six consecutive games with 200 passing yards end in Week 8 when he left the Tennessee Tech victory in the second quarter with an injury. He nearly topped the mark, as he was 7-of-10 for 189 yards before his departure. He did connect on a TD pass to mark his sixth-straight game with a TD pass. His six 200-yard passing games are third-most in the conference, behind Bryant QB ZEVI ECKHAUS (7) and Eastern Illinois OB PIERCE HOLLEY (8).

FIVE HOLE

In UT Martin's 44-41 overtime victory over Tennessee Tech in Week 10, UTM's KINKEAD DENT and TTU's JORDYN POTTS each threw five touchdown passes to match the Association single-game record. It was Dent's second 5-TD pass game of the year, as he first reached the number back in Week 3 vs. Houston Christian. Potts' effort marked the first multi-TD pass game for a Golden Eagle QB this season.

90s ON NINE

One week after the longest pass play in Big South-OVC history was recorded in Week 8 by Southeast Missouri (89 yards), Tennessee State bettered the mark by one yard in Week 9, as DRAYLEN ELLIS connected with DA'SHON DAVIS for a 90-yard score in TSU's win over Lindenwood. Davis finished the day with five receptions for 200 yards -- the second 200-yard receiving game in the Association this season.

RETURN TO SENDER

For the first time in the Association's existence, a non-blocked punt was returned for a touchdown in Week 9, as Southeast Missouri's DALYN McDONALD returned a punt 65 yards for a score in the Redhawks' 35-31 win at Nicholls. It is the longest punt return in the league this season, and McDonald owns the second-longest punt return this year as well -- 37 yards at Eastern Kentucky in Week 4. McDonald ranks 13th in FCS with his 11.5 punt return average.

TIGHT ROPE

One week after setting a Big South-OVC Association single-game record for most receiving yards by a tight end with 76, Robert Morris TE CHAESE JACKSON became the Association's first tight end with 10 receptions in a game when he caught 10 passes in Week 6 at Gardner-Webb. In a four-game stretch from Weeks 3-6, Jackson had 22 receptions for 194 yards and three scores (full season totals stand at 33 catches, 291 yards and five TDs). Meanwhile, UT Martin TE MAX DOWL-ING became the first TE with two touchdown receptions in a game in Week 6 with a 9-yard TD grab and eventual game-winning 7-yard TD catch in the Skyhawks' overtime win at EIU.

THREE BIG SOUTH-OVC PLAYERS NAMED SEMIFINALISTS FOR CAMPBELL TROPHY

Eastern Illinois OL CHAD STRICKLAND, Gardner-Webb LB WILLIAM McRAINEY and Tennessee Tech WR BRADLEY CLARK are Semifinalists for the 2023 WILLIAM V. CAMPBELL Trophy, college football's premier scholar-athlete award presented by the National Football Foundation & College Football Hall of Fame. The trio were among 38 players from the FCS.

AROUND THE ASSOCIATION...

BRYANT

WR ANTHONY FREDERICK had season highs of eight receptions, 131 receiving yards and 3 TDs in last week's win at Lindenwood ... QB ZEVI ECKHAUS now has 68 career touchdown passes, two shy of the program record ... In the past three games, the Bulldogs are averaging 440.4 yards of offense, which includes a season-high 487 in last week's win at Lindenwood ... Bryant's five games with 400-plus offensive yards are second-most in the Association behind UT Martin (6) ... Eckhaus has now thrown for 1,501 yards (300 per game), 16 TDs and just two INTs in league play this season.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Buccaneers tallied a season-high 393 offensive yards in last week's setback to Robert Morris ... CSU is seeking its first .500 conference record since the 2021 Spring season ... WR **NOAH JENNINGS** caught eight passes for 204 yards and a touchdown at Robert Morris last week, the first CSU receiver with a 200-yard receiving game since **CORVAUGHN ARCHIE** had 204 vs. Coastal Carolina on Nov. 12, 2011. Jennings entered the RMU contest with 13 catches for 148 yards.

EASTERN ILLINOIS

The Panthers' enjoyed their second-largest margin of victory (13 points) this past week in their 30-17 victory over Tennessee State ... EIU's 197 rushing yards was it second-most in a game this season, while the Panther defense held TSU to 260 yards of offense ... Eastern Illinois posted double-digit TFL for the second-straight week with 10 stops behind the line of scrimmage in the TSU win. EIU had 11 tackles-for-loss in Week 10 at Lindenwood ... Six of Eastern Illinois' 10 games have been one possession outcomes (4-2 record).

GARDNER-WEBB

The Runnin' Bulldogs held Tennessee Tech to just 23 net rushing yards, the second-straight week GWU permitted less than 75 yards on the ground. Gardner-Webb limited Bryant to 68 net rushing yards in Week 10 ... Gardner-Webb's 35-0 win at Tech was its first shutout since knocking off Robert Morris, 48-0, last season on Oct. 8 ... The Runnin' Bulldogs have recorded their four defensive touchdowns (3-INT, 1-FR) this season in their last four games ... Gardner-Webb has won six-straight home games, dating back to last season, and is averaging 37.33 points during that streak.

LINDENWOOD

Lindenwood's second season reclassifying to FCS ends with a 3-7 mark, the program's first sub-500 overall record since 2018 (4-7) ... In the Lions' season finale vs. Bryant, LOGAN SEIBERT provided the squad's lone points with a 35-yard field goal ... WR SPENCER REDD had team-highs of six receptions for 87 yards, while QB JUSTICE COPPER was 18-of-38 passing for 191 yards ... ETHAN STUHLSATZ and TYRONE GRIFFIN led the defense with 10 tackles each.

ROBERT MORRIS

The Colonials rushed for 173 yards in their 14-12 win over Charleston Southern last week, the team's second-most in a game this season and most vs. a Division I opponent. RB **DJ MOYER** rushed for a season-high 82 yards — the highest individual game total for RMU this season. Moyer has been the Colonials' top rusher the past four games and has 232 in that span ... QB **ZACH TANNER** accounted for both scores in the CSU win on rushes of 1 and 25 yards. He finished the day with 64 rushing yards on just six carries (10.7 average) and was 4-of-7 passing for 41 yards.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI

The Redhawks have suffered back-to-back conference losses for the first time since the 2021 Spring season ... SEMO was limited to 22:06 time of possession in the UTM loss, which resulted in season-lows of 45 offensive plays and 162 offensive yards ... WR RYAN FLOURNOY caught nine passes for 112 yards at UTM, and scored on a 75-yard pass play from **GREG MENNE**. Flournoy leads the Association with 792 receiving yards.

TENNESSEE STATE

The Tigers have rushed for at least 100 yards in nine-straight games, the second-longest streak in the Association this season (10 - UT Martin) ... **DAYRON JOHNSON** scored his first touchdown this season last week on a 9-yard pass play at Eastern Illinois, while **KARATE BRENSON** tied the game at 14-14 with a 7-yard receiving score.

TENNESSEE TECH

The Golden Eagles suffered their second shutout of the season last week ... Tech held Gardner-Webb to 61 rushing yards, and has limited six of its last seven opponents to less than 100 rushing yards ... QB **JORDYN POTTS** was 24-of-44 passing for 206 yards in the GWU contest, his second-straight 200-yard passing game.

UT MARTIN

UT Martin limited SEMO to five net rushing yards this past week, the fewest allowed since holding Eastern Illinois to minus-5 on Oct. 22, 2011 ... The Skyhawks rushed for 341 yards in the win over Southeast Missouri, their second-most in a game this season ... UTM has scored 40 points in back-to-back games for the first time since a 3-game streak in 2022 (Sept. 24-Oct. 8) ... UT Martin's Big South-OVC championship is the fourth conference title under head coach **JASON SIMPSON** (2006, 2021, 2022 and 2023).

TIEBREAKER PROCEDURE

1. TRANSITIONING SCHOOLS

 To be eligible for the conference's automatic bid to the FCS Football Championship, a school must be a full Division I member.

b. Transitioning schools will be utilized in the tiebreaker process.

 c. If a transitioning school is involved in a two-way tie, the tied team that is eligible for postseason competition shall be the league's recipient of the automatic bid.

 $\mbox{\bf d}.$ If a transitioning school wins the multi-team tiebreaker, the procedure would start over with the remaining teams.

2. TWO-WAY TIE

 a. If the two teams played each other during the conference season, the winner of the head-tohead contest shall be the league's recipient of the automatic bid.

b. If the tied teams did not play each other during the conference season, each team's head-to-head record against all common opponents in the league will be used to determine the automatic bid.

c. If a tie still exists, then each team's record against the next highest common opponent in the league standings will be used to determine the automatic bid. When arriving at a group of tied teams that each team has played, composite records between the tied teams shall be utilized to determine if one of the tied teams has won more games against the group of tied teams.

d. If the teams are still tied, a point system will be utilized based on a complete schedule and wins using Sagarin rankings entering the final day of the regular season, as indicated on the next page.

e. Should the points system finish in a tie, the tied team with the best Sagarin rating on the final day of the regular season (i.e., Saturday morning) will receive the automatic bid.

B. MULTIPLE TIES

 a. If at any point, a tie is broken using the multiple-tie tiebreaker procedures and only two teams remain, the remaining teams will revert to the two-way tiebreaker (head-to-head).

b. If the tied teams all played each other during the conference season, the team with the
best cumulative record involving games with the tied teams shall be declared champion. For
example, if a team is 2-0 against two other tied teams, that team will be declared champion.
 c. If the tied teams all played one another and have identical records against the other tied

teams, then each team's record against all common opponents in the league will be used to determine the automatic bid. If teams are still tied, then each team's record against the next highest common opponent in the league standings will be used to determine the automatic bid. d. If the tied teams did not play each other, then each team's record against all common opponents in the league will be used to determine the automatic bid. If the teams are still tied, and they did not play each other, then each team's record against the next highest common opponent in the league standings will be used to determine the automatic bid.

e. If the teams are still tied, a point system will be utilized based on a complete schedule and wins using Sagarin rankings entering the final day of the regular season, as indicated below. f. Should the points system finish in a tie, the tied team with the best Sagarin rating on the final day of the regular season (i.e., Saturday morning) will receive the automatic bid.


