2-MINUTE OFFENSE

OPENING KICKOFF: For the second and final time this season, a full slate of conference games is on the docket this week, as all 10 Association members will again compete against each other. Last week's five matchups featured *FOUR* one possession outcomes — all won by the visiting team — *TWO* overtime results and an overall margin of victory of 5.4 points.

Ist DOWN: No. 16/21 UT Martin can clinch at least a share of the Big South-OVC regular-season championship with a victory on Saturday over Southeast Missouri. UTM and SEMO were Ohio Valley co-champs in 2022, but did not play each other last season, and the Redhawks were awarded the automatic qualifier via the league's tiebreaker process. SEMO won the previous meeting between the squads in 2021, 31-14 at home

2nd DOWN: Gardner-Webb head coach **TRE LAMB** is facing his alma mater this week, as the Runnin' Bulldogs are looking to even their all-time series with Tennessee Tech. The last time the teams went head-to-head was in 2008. Lamb began his collegiate playing career in Cookeville in 2009.

3rd DOWN: Bryant has played in an Association-high three overtime games this season, and is 1-2 in those contests. Meanwhile, the Bulldogs have scored 40-plus points in three of their last four outings.

4th DOWN: For the fourth consecutive week, Tennessee State DL **TERRELL ALLEN** recorded at least 4.0 tacklesfor-loss in a game, as he finished the Charleston Southern contest with 4.0 TFL, and has 18.5 in that span.

ABOUT THE BIG SOUTH-OVC FOOTBALL ASSOCIATION

This is the first season of the Big South-OVC Football Association. On Feb. 22, 2022, the Big South Conference and Ohio Valley Conference announced the creation of an association of their football member institutions, to begin with the 2023 NCAA Division I football season and have an initial term of at least four years. The unique agreement combines the two conferences' football membership to ensure NCAA championship access and stability for the multisport conferences. In creating the association, presidents from each of the multisport conferences pointed to the similarities of the OVC and the Big South, with their complementary geographies and intercollegiate athletic philosophies, as key to making this association possible. The first year is comprised of 10 members. Western Illinois will join the Association beginning with the 2024 season, while Bryant will depart after this season for CAA Football.

SLANT ROUTES

- * BRYANT: The Bulldogs have alternated wins and losses each week of 2023 ... QB ZEVI ECKHAUS has passed for 676 yards and 8 TDs in his last two games.
- * CHARLESTON SOUTHERN: The Buccaneers won the last meeting with Robert Morris in 2022, a 34-21 victory at home, and both wins in the RMU series have been home triumphs ... CSU last won five games in a season in 2019 (6).
- * EASTERN ILLINOIS: The Panthers have notched their first winning season since 2017 ... EIU is looking to snap a 3-game skid to TSU, as its last victory over the Tigers was in 2019 (W, 49-38).
- * GARDNER-WEBB: The Runnin' Bulldogs' lone victory in the TTU series was in 2006, a 30-26 home win ... A win Saturday would give GWU backto-back winning seasons for the first time since 2002-2003.
- * LINDENWOOD: The Lions conclude their 2023 season at home on Saturday ... Lindenwood is looking to avoid its first 4-game losing streak since 2017
- * ROBERT MORRIS: The Colonials' lone victory in the CSU series was a 34-21 home win in 2021 ... RMU is seeking back-to-back wins for the first time since winning 5-straight in 2019
- * SOUTHEAST MISSOURI: The Redhawks have won four out of the last five meetings with UT Martin ... SEMO did not have a rushing TD last week for the first time since the season opener.
- * TENNESSEE STATE: The Tigers have won the last three meetings with EIU by an average score of 28.7 to 12.3 ... TSU last won seven games in 2016.
- * TENNESSEE TECH: The Golden Eagles' 41 points last week against UTM matched the squad's total through the first three Association games of the year ... TTU has scored 10 touchdowns in its last two outings; Tech had nine TDs after seven games.
- * UT MARTIN: The Skyhawks' last win over SEMO in Martin was Oct. 23, 2021 (W, 38-30) ... UTM is looking to finish undefeated at home this season.

PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - Nov. 6

OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Kinkead Dent, UT Martin, QB • 6-4, 210, Gr. • Yazoo City, Miss.

Dent passed for 318 yards and five touchdowns as UT Martin stormed back to top Tennessee Tech, 44-41 in overtime and move back into first-place in the Big South-OVC standings. Three of his five touchdown passes came in the final 8:16 of regulation and overtime, including the game-winning nine-yard strike on third down on what proved to be the final play of overtime (a play that was No. 1 on SportsCenter's Top 10 Plays). Dent ranks eighth nationally in passing touchdowns (21), 11th in points responsible for per game (15.3) and 35th in total offense (239.1 yards/game).

CO-DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Dominic Pagano, Charleston Southern, S • 6-1, 190, R-Jr. • Parkland, Fla.

Pagano came up big for the Charleston Southern defense in its 35-21 victory over Tennessee State. In the second quarter he returned a fumble 69 yards for a touchdowns to put the Buccaneers ahead 21-7. Later in the quarter, he picked off a Draylen Ellis pass and returned it 17 yards. He finished the game with five solo tackles and 86 defensive return yards.

Bryce Norman, Southeast Missouri, LB • 6-0, 200, Jr. • Jackson, Mo.

Norman tallied 12 tackles, 3.5 tackles for loss, 3.0 sacks and forced and recovered a fumble that he returned 46 yards for a touchdown in Southeast Missouri's game with Robert Morris. The 12 tackles (including seven solo stops) were a game-high and marked his fifth double-digit tackle effort of the season. Norman's touchdown came in the second quarter and put the Redhawks ahead, 17-14; it marked the first defensive touchdown of the season for SEMO. Norman ranks 27th nationally in tackles per game (9.1).

SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Hayden Olsen, Tennessee Tech, PK • 5-9, 161, Jr. • Buford, Ga.

Olsen was perfect on his kicking attempts against nationally-ranked UT Martin, making 2-of-2 field goals and 5-of-5 PATs to tally 11 points. The junior connected from 54 and 47 yards with the 54-yarder being a careerlong and tied for the second-longest in school history. It is the fourth-longest field goal in the FCS this season. Olson extended his school record streak of consecutive made PATs to 85. This season he ranks 26th nationally in field goal percentage (77.8%).

FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

Jaylen King, Gardner-Webb, QB • 6-4, 200, Fr. • Folkston, Ga.

King earned the award for the second-straight week and improved to 3-1 as a starter in leading Gardner-Webb's comeback as they topped Bryant, 45-44 in overtime. The freshman accounted for 268 yards of total offense and four touchdowns. He completed 18-of-36 passes for 160 yards and two touchdowns and rushed 24 times for 108 yards (4.5 ypc) and two additional scores. After the Runnin' Bulldogs fell behind 38-24 with 10:28 to play, he led back-to-back drives to tie the game with 18 seconds left in regulation. On the game-tying drive (which went nine plays in 1:58), he converted a 4th and long with an 11-yard run.

ALLEN PACKS THE SACK LUNCH

In his last *FOUR* games, Tennessee State DL **TERRELL ALLEN** has recorded 18.5 TFL and 11.5 sacks, to boost his season totals to national-bests of 24.5 stops behind the line of scrimmage and 14.5 quarterback takedowns. In Week 9, Allen established Association-game records with 6.5 tacklesfor-loss and 4.5 quarterback sacks in TSU's 43-20 victory over Lindenwood.

KING OF THE HILL

Gardner-Webb QB **JAYLEN KING** became the first Big South-OVC Association quarterback with 100 rushing yards and 100 passing yards in the same game this past week at Bryant, as he tallied 108 yards on the ground — the first league QB with a 100-yard rushing game — plus 160 yards through the air. He also became the first Association QB with two rushing and two passing TDs in the same contest. King has rushed and passed for TDs in a game four consecutive weeks.

FIVE HOLE

In UT Martin's 44–41 overtime victory over Tennessee Tech this past week, UTM's **KINKEAD DENT** and TTU's **JORDYN POTTS** each threw five touchdown passes to match the Association single-game record. It was Dent's second 5-TD pass game of the year, as he first reached the number back in Week 3 vs. Houston Christian. Potts' effort marked the first multi-TD pass game for a Golden Eagle QB this season.

THE DEFENSIVE NEVER RESTS

The Big South-OVC Association members have combined for 16 defensive touchdowns this season (nine interception returns and six fumble returns). Tennessee Tech has a league-best four defensive TDs — which includes an Association single-game record three in its 38-13 Week 9 win at Robert Morris. The Golden Eagles returned two fumbles for scores (DANIEL RICKERT – 20 yards and AARON SWAFFORD – 52 yards), plus a pick-six from TIM COUTRAS (39 yards) in that contest. Charleston Southern has three defensive scores in 2023 (one INT, two FUM), while Gardner-Webb and Southeast Missouri each have a pick-six and fumble recovery TD this season. All but two Association squads have scored on the defensive side of the ball this season.

CONFERENCE ROOM

Of the 21 Association-conference games played thus far, 13 have been won by the home team, while the overall average margin of victory is 13.05 points. Nine contests have been one possession decisions — including six by a field goal-or-less, while four match-ups have gone into overtime. The 21 games have combined for 1,074 points, for a per game average of 51.14 points scored.

NATIONAL ACCLAIM

Six of the 10 Association members have received Top 25 consideration this season — with four teams cracking the Top 25 rankings at some point during the campaign. Gardner-Webb was No. 24/25 to open the season, while Southeast Missouri was ranked the first four weeks of the year. UT Martin entered the Top 25 on Sept. 25 and has been ranked every week since (7 weeks), while Eastern Illinois was No. 25 the week of Oct. 2. Receiving votes this year have been Tennessee Tech (preseason), and Tennessee State (Sept. 18, Oct. 16, Oct. 23, Oct. 30, Nov. 6).

WINNING STATE OF MIND

The Big South-OVC Association is 20-14 (=58.8 percent) against non-conference FCS competition with one non-league game remaining (Samford in Week 12). The Association went 9-2 in its 11 non-conference games this season against "State"-named FCS schools. Eastern Illinois led the way at 3-0 (Indiana State, Illinois State and Northwestern State), followed by Tennessee Tech (Kennesaw State and South Carolina State) and Tennessee State (Kennesaw State and Norfolk State) at 2-0 each. UT Martin (Missouri State) and Charleston Southern (Kennesaw State) went 1-0. Robert Morris (Youngstown State) and Lindenwood (Illinois State) went 0-1.

WHAT CAN BROWN DO FOR YOU?

Gardner-Webb RB **JAYDEN BROWN** leads all Big South-OVC running backs with five touchdown receptions, which have come on just 14 total catches. He has the top three single-game receiving yard outputs by an Association rusher this season -- 77 vs. Robert Morris in Week 7, 71 vs. UT Martin in Week 9, and 67 in the season opener at Appalachian State. Brown is first in the conference with 137.44 all-purpose yards per game, and posted a career-high 220 this past week at Bryant -- his second game with 200+ in three weeks (205 in Week 8 against Eastern Kentucky).

WHAT THE ECK!

Bryant QB **ZEVI ECKHAUS** is the first Association quarterback with back-to-back 4 TD passing games. He first threw 4 TD strikes in Week 9 at Charleston Southern, and had 4 this past week in the Bulldogs' overtime loss to Gardner-Webb.

FRANK THE TANK

UT Martin RB SAM FRANKLIN is fourth in the nation with 1,095 rushing yards and 121.7 rushing yards per game. He rushed for more than 200 yards twice in a three-game span (259 vs. Missouri State in Week 2 and 221 at North Alabama in Week 4), and is tied for the league lead with five 100-yard rushing games on the season, as well as 10 rushing touchdowns. Those 10 have gone for a total of 331 yards (=33.10 yard average). Five of Franklin's 10 rushing scores have gone for 40-plus yards (81, 49, 46, 74 and 43). Meanwhile, Franklin has still out-rushed three Big South-OVC squads to this point of the season.

LAROS' LEG

UT Martin PK/P AIDAN LAROS is having a season for the ages. He has 63 points as a placekicker (36 PAT, 9 FG), but is the national leader in punting average at 47.7 yards. In Week 9 at Gardner-Webb, he averaged an Association single-game record 56.8 yards per punt, with a long of 70 -- his second 70-yard punt of the year. Laros, who has three games this season with a 50-plus yard punting average, is just behind the all-time FCS single-season punting average record of 48.2 (min. 60 punts), which is held by Northern Arizona's MARK GOULD (62 for 2,987 in 2002).

GAITHERING STEAM

Gardner-Webb RB NARII GAITHER become the seventh player in Big South Conference history with 3,000 career rushing yards when he surpassed the milestone this past week at Bryant. He is now at 3,078, which ranks seventh in Big South annals. Meanwhile, Gaither is the all-time leader for career receptions by a Big South running back with 99. His 816 career receiving yards out of the backfield are second among Big South RBs all-time -- just four away from breaking the record of 819 (Kennesaw State's SHAQUIL TERRY, 2017-21).

HESS TRUCK

Southeast Missouri RB GENO HESS is the active FCS rushing leader at 4,941 yards -- 1,017 ahead of the next player and 59 rushing yards away from 5,000 in his career. His 61 career rushing touchdowns are the most of any active FCS player, as well as the Ohio Valley Conference record. Hess has five 100-yard rushing games this season, tied for the league-lead and includes a seasonhigh 150 this past week against Robert Morris. Hess has been the Redhawks' top rusher in the last eight contests.

PASSING GRADES

Eastern Illinois QB PIERCE HOLLEY became the first Big South-OVC quarterback with back-toback 300-yard passing games, as he threw for 346 in Week 7 at Southeast Missouri -- one week after setting an Association single-game record of 359 passing yards in Week 6 vs. UT Martin. Holley holds the league lead with 2,394 passing yards, and has thrown for at least 244 yards in eight of his nine appearances this year. Meanwhile, UT Martin QB KINKEAD DENT is the only Big South-OVC Association quarterback with a touchdown pass in every game this season, and leads the conference with 21 TD scoring strikes.

HOUSE CALLS

The Association members have returned nine interceptions for touchdowns this season. Four of the nine are among the longest returns in the FCS to this point:

200-YARD PASSING ODYSSEY

Southeast Missouri QB PAXTON DeLAURENT saw his league-best streak of six consecutive games with 200 passing yards end in Week 8 when he left the Tennessee Tech victory in the second quarter with an injury. He nearly topped the mark, as he was 7-of-10 for 189 yards before his departure. He did connect on a TD pass to mark his sixth-straight game with a TD pass. His six 200-yard passing games are just behind Eastern Illinois QB PIERCE HOLLEY, who has eight such efforts on the year.

KICK STARTERS

Tennessee State PK JAMES LOWERY (50 and 51) and Tennessee Tech's HAYDEN OLSEN (50 and 54) are the only Big South-OVC Association kickers to make two field goals from at least 50 yards this season. Meanwhile, Southeast Missouri PK DC PIPPIN has a league-high six made field goals from beyond 40 yards, and owns an average distance of 43.33 yards on those kicks. Lowery and Charleston Southern PK SAM BABBUSH have made five field goals from 40-yards or longer. Lowery's five have been for an average of 46.6 yards, while Babbush has averaged 43.4 yards on his kicks from that range. Babbush has made a 40-yarder in five of CSU's nine games this season.

90s ON NINE

One week after the longest pass play in Big South-OVC history was recorded in Week 8 by Southeast Missouri (89 yards), Tennessee State bettered the mark by one yard in Week 9, as **DRAYLEN ELLIS** connected with **DA'SHON DAVIS** for a 90-yard score in TSU's win over Lindenwood. Davis finished the day with five receptions for 200 yards — the second 200-yard receiving game in the Association this season.

RETURN TO SENDER

For the first time in the Association's existence, a non-blocked punt was returned for a touch-down, as Southeast Missouri's **DALYN McDONALD** returned a punt 65 yards for a score in the Redhawks' 35–31 Week 9 win at Nicholls. It is the longest punt return in the league this season, and McDonald owns the second-longest punt return this year as well — 37 yards at Eastern Kentucky in Week 4. McDonald ranks 11th in FCS with his 12.7 punt return average.

TIGHT ROPE

One week after setting a Big South-OVC Association single-game record for most receiving yards by a tight end with 76, Robert Morris TE **CHAESE JACKSON** became the Association's first tight end with 10 receptions in a game when he caught 10 passes in Week 6 at Gardner-Webb. In a four-game stretch from Weeks 3-6, Jackson had 22 receptions for 194 yards and three scores (full season totals stand at 32 catches, 275 yards and five TDs). Meanwhile, UT Martin TE **MAX DOWL-ING** became the first TE with two touchdown receptions in a game in Week 6 with a 9-yard TD grab and eventual game-winning 7-yard TD catch in the Skyhawks' overtime win at EIU.

SEEING REDD

In Week 6 against Tennessee Tech, Lindenwood's **SPENCER REDD** recorded the Lions' seventh multi-touchdown game of the season with a 99-yard return of the opening kickoff, followed by a 52-yard receiving touchdown — the team's second player with a receiving TD and special teams score in the same game. In Week 1, **JEFF CALDWELL** first returned a blocked punt for a touchdown, then added a 6-yard reception in the end zone.

BLOSSOMING FLOWERS

Eastern Illinois RB MJ FLOWERS is on the JERRY RICE Watch List for the FCS National Freshman of the Year Award. Flowers leads EIU in rushing with 474 yards, and is the Panthers' fifth-leading receiver with 29 catches out of the backfield. He ranks sixth among all Big South-OVC rushers for rushing yards. In Week 4, Flowers set Big South-OVC Association single-game records with his 37 rushing carries and 272 rushing yards against McNeese — the season's highest single-game effort by any NCAA player (FBS, FCS, D2, D3) until Oct. 14.

Eastern Illinois OL CHAD STRICKLAND, Gardner-Webb LB WILLIAM McRAINEY and Tennessee Tech WR BRADLEY CLARK are Semifinalists for the 2023 WILLIAM V. CAMPBELL Trophy, college football's premier scholar-athlete award presented by the National Football Foundation & College Football Hall of Fame. The trio were among 38 players from the FCS.

AROUND THE ASSOCIATION...

BRYANT

QB ZEVI ECKHAUS became the all-time leading passer in program history this past week, and owns a record total 7,776 yards ... RB FABRICE MUKENDI has a rushing TD in three straight games and 14 in his career ... Against Gardner-Webb last week, WR MATT PROCHASKA had a career-high 149 yards and nine catches ... DL MICHAEL OTTY has posted a career-high 40 tackles, 9.5 TFLs, and 6.0 sacks this season ... Bryant's defense has forced a TO in every game this year.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Buccaneers scored a season-high 35 points in defeating Tennessee State last week, 35–21 — their first 30–point game of the season. CSU has scored 24 points in three of its last four outings ... The Bucs allowed a season-low 269 yards of offense in the TSU win, and used an 18-yard TD catch from **WILL KAKAVITSAS** and 25-yard TD run from **TJ RUFF** in the final 3:22 to break a 21–21 tie. The Buc defense forced five fumbles, recovered three and returned them 116 yards, including one for a score ... Ruff has led CSU in rushing each of the past eight games, gaining 519 yards in that span with six touchdowns.

EASTERN ILLINOIS

The Panthers' four Big South-OVC Association games have been decided by a combined 15 points (3.75 average) ... EIU held its third opponent this season to 10 points or less in the Panthers' 16-10 victory over Lindenwood last week. Eastern Illinois limited the Lions to just 16 net rushing yards and 265 total offensive yards, while recording a season-high 11 tackles-for-loss ... Six of Eastern Illinois' nine games have been one possession outcomes (4-2 record) ... QB **PIERCE HOLLEY** is 90-of-151 passing for 1,194 yards and seven TDs through four Association games this year.

GARDNER-WEBB

The Runnin' Bulldogs rallied from a 14-point deficit with 10:38 remaining to force overtime at Bryant to cap another Association comeback win. Gardner-Webb ran a Big South-OVC single-game high 101 offensive plays (61 rush, 40 pass) in the Bryant victory ... GWU's current 3-game win streak has been by a combined 8 points ... The Runnin' Bulldogs play their final regular-season road game this Saturday, and host Charleston Southern in the Nov. 18 season finale. Gardner-Webb has won six-straight home games, dating back to last season, and are averaging 37.33 points during that streak.

LINDENWOOD

WR SPENCER REDD totaled 155 all-purpose yards this past week against Eastern Illinois (88 receiving, 67 kickoff returns) ... WR JALEN SMITH had receptions of 42 and 41 yards against EIU ... QB TYLER KUBAT was 16-of-26 passing for 186 yards against the Panthers, while COOPER JUSTICE connected with CHASE LANCKRIET from 10 yards out to account for the Lions' lone touchdown. Lindenwood finished with five TFL against Eastern Illinois, including two from DONNIE WINGATE.

ROBERT MORRIS

The Colonials earned their first road win since Oct. 19, 2019 at Wagner (W, 21-13) with their 21-20 win at Southeast Missouri last week ... RMU outgained SEMO in yardage, 372-294, and is 3-0 this season when doing so ... Robert Morris has held its last two foes to less than 300 yards of offense ... QB **ANTHONY CHICCITT** was 20-of-33 passing for 232 yards and two scores in the SEMO win, while WR **NOAH ROBINSON** hauled in 11 of those completions for 167 yards and a TD.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI

The Redhawks suffered their first conference loss in nearly two years last week (Nov. 13, 2021) with its setback to Robert Morris. In the game, RB **GENO HESS** rushed for 150 yards on 20 carries (7.5 average), but saw his rush TD streak end at four-straight contests. LB **BRYCE NORMAN** recorded 12 tackles, 3.5 TFL, 3.0 sacks, forced and returned a fumble 46 yards for a score.

TENNESSEE STATE

RB JORDAN GANT has seven rushing touchdowns in the last three games, and still shares the league lead with 10 ... The Tigers were held to their second-fewest yards of the season at Charleston Southern (269), but scored three rushing touchdowns for the third-straight game ... DAYRON JOHNSON caught 11 passes for 91 yards at CSU ... DL TERRELL ALLEN had seven tackles (all solo), four of which were for loss, plus a sack.

TENNESSEE TECH

The Golden Eagles have scored at least 38 points in back-to-back games for the first time since scoring 38 and 40 from Sept. 21-28, 2019 ... QB **JORDYN POTTS** was 24-of-38 passing for 209 yards and 5 TDs in the overtime loss to UT Martin. In his last four outings, Potts is 63-of-113 passing for 677 yards and six touchdowns ... Tech has scored a season-high five touchdowns in each of the past two games ... PK **HAYDEN OLSEN** converted field goals of 54 and 47 yards this past week.

UT MARTIN

UT Martin earned the Sgt. York Trophy for the sixth consecutive season and 11th time overall since the series was originated in 2007. The award is contested between the three OVC football schools in the state of Tennessee ... After the Skyhawks did not win an overtime game since Oct. 4, 2003, UT Martin has now won two overtime contests on the road in 2023 (28–27 at Eastern Illinois on Oct. 7; 44–41 at Tennessee Tech on Nov. 4) ... UT Martin's win last week was the 11th straight in its all-time series against Tennessee Tech.

TIEBREAKER PROCEDURE

1. TRANSITIONING SCHOOLS

a. To be eligible for the conference's automatic bid to the FCS Football Championship, a school must be a full Division I member.

b. Transitioning schools will be utilized in the tiebreaker process.

c. If a transitioning school is involved in a two-way tie, the tied team that is eligible for postseason competition shall be the league's recipient of the automatic bid.

 $\mbox{\bf d}.$ If a transitioning school wins the multi-team tiebreaker, the procedure would start over with the remaining teams.

2. TWO-WAY TIE

 a. If the two teams played each other during the conference season, the winner of the head-tohead contest shall be the league's recipient of the automatic bid.

b. If the tied teams did not play each other during the conference season, each team's head-to-head record against all common opponents in the league will be used to determine the automatic bid.

c. If a tie still exists, then each team's record against the next highest common opponent in the league standings will be used to determine the automatic bid. When arriving at a group of tied teams that each team has played, composite records between the tied teams shall be utilized to determine if one of the tied teams has won more games against the group of tied teams.

d. If the teams are still tied, a point system will be utilized based on a complete schedule and wins using Sagarin rankings entering the final day of the regular season, as indicated on the next page.

e. Should the points system finish in a tie, the tied team with the best Sagarin rating on the final day of the regular season (i.e., Saturday morning) will receive the automatic bid.

B. MULTIPLE TIES

 a. If at any point, a tie is broken using the multiple-tie tiebreaker procedures and only two teams remain, the remaining teams will revert to the two-way tiebreaker (head-to-head).

b. If the tied teams all played each other during the conference season, the team with the
best cumulative record involving games with the tied teams shall be declared champion. For
example, if a team is 2-0 against two other tied teams, that team will be declared champion.
 c. If the tied teams all played one another and have identical records against the other tied

teams, then each team's record against all common opponents in the league will be used to determine the automatic bid. If teams are still tied, then each team's record against the next highest common opponent in the league standings will be used to determine the automatic bid. If the tied teams did not play each other, then each team's record against all common opponents in the league will be used to determine the automatic bid. If the teams are still tied, and they did not play each other, then each team's record against the next highest common opponent in the league standings will be used to determine the automatic bid.

e. If the teams are still tied, a point system will be utilized based on a complete schedule and wins using Sagarin rankings entering the final day of the regular season, as indicated below. f. Should the points system finish in a tie, the tied team with the best Sagarin rating on the final day of the regular season (i.e., Saturday morning) will receive the automatic bid.


