2-MINUTE OFFENSE

OPENING KICKOFF: Bryant and Eastern Illinois recorded last-second, comeback victories on field goals last weekend. The Bulldogs rallied from a 13-3 deficit at Princeton to win 16-13 in overtime on **ETHAN GETTMAN**'s 37-yard field goal. EIU came back from a 28-7 deficit to defeat McNeese, 31-28 on **STONE GALLOWAY**'s 56-yard field goal with :20 seconds remaining.

Ist DOWN: Two rushers gained more than 200 yards on the ground this past weekend, as Eastern Illinois' **MJ FLOWERS** rushed for a Big South-OVC record 272 yards against McNeese, while UT Martin's **SAM FRANKLIN** posted his second 200-yard rushing game in three weeks with 221 in the Skyhawks' 37-21 win at North Alabama. Franklin is averaging 202.33 rushing yards in his last three outings.

2nd DOWN: Tennessee State is looking for its second consecutive 2–0 start in conference games this weekend ... UT Martin is looking to open 1–0 in league play for the third-straight season. The match-up is part of the Sgt. York Trophy series contested between the three Tennessee-based OVC schools.

3rd DOWN: UT Martin has an Association-best 3-game win streak, and during that span, the Skyhawks are averaging 47.0 points, 566.33 yards of offense and 327.67 rushing yards, while allowing just 19.7 points and 372.33 offensive yards.

4th DOWN: UT Martin entered the Top 25 rankings following Week 4, and is currently No. 22 in the Stats Perform poll. The Big South-OVC has had a member ranked every week of the 2023 season (including preseason).

ABOUT THE BIG SOUTH-OVC FOOTBALL ASSOCIATION

This is the first season of the Big South-OVC Football Association. On Feb. 22, 2022, the Big South Conference and Ohio Valley Conference announced the creation of an association of their football member institutions, to begin with the 2023 NCAA Division I football season and have an initial term of at least four years. The unique agreement combines the two conferences' football membership to ensure NCAA championship access and stability for the multisport conferences. In creating the association, presidents from each of the multisport conferences pointed to the similarities of the OVC and the Big South, with their complementary geographies and intercollegiate athletic philosophies, as key to making this association possible. The first year is comprised of 10 members. Western Illinois will join the Association beginning with the 2024 season, while Bryant will depart after this season for CAA Football.

SLANT ROUTES

- * BRYANT: The Bulldogs are facing Rhode Island for the third-straight year, and have scored 21 points in each of the last two meetings.
- * CHARLESTON SOUTHERN: The Buccaneers are looking to snap a 5-game skid against former Big South rival Kennesaw State. CSU fell to the Owls last year, 30-20.
- * EASTERN ILLINOIS: The Panthers are looking to start 4-1 for the first time since 2013 (11-1 regular-season record) ... EIU has already surpassed last season's win total (2).
- * GARDNER-WEBB: The Runnin' Bulldogs are idle this week and return to action Oct. 7 at home vs. Robert Morris
- * LINDENWOOD: The Lions are playing their fourth of seven first-time opponents on Saturday, and are 2-1 against first-time foes this season ... Lindenwood is looking to avoid back-to-back losses for the first time since Sept. 24-Oct. 1, 2022.
- * ROBERT MORRIS: The Colonials achieved their first shutout since blanking VMI, 23-0, on Sept. 16, 2017 ... RMU's lone win over Howard came in 2021 (W. 22-16 at home).
- * SOUTHEAST MISSOURI: The Redhawks are idle this week and return to action Oct. 7 at Central Arkansas ... SEMO has lost back-to-back games in the same year for the first time since Oct. 16-23, 2021 ... The Redhawks' last two defeats have been by a combined 4 points.
- * TENNESSEE STATE: The Tigers last defeated UT Martin in the 2021 Spring season (W, 26-24) ... TSU last opened a season 3-1 in 2017 ... Tennessee State is ranked No. 4 in the BOXTOROW HBCU FCS Coaches poll.
- * TENNESSEE TECH: The Golden Eagles held Kennesaw State to 96 rushing yards -- the fewest in the Owls' football history ... Tech held its first opponent to less than 10 points since Nov. 2, 2019 when it won 17-7 at Murray State.
- * UT MARTIN: The Skyhawks have won the last two meetings with TSU ... UT Martin last started 4-1 overall in 2021 (opened 9-1).

PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - SEPT. 25

OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Sam Franklin, UT Martin, RB • 5-10, 200, R-So. • Little Rock, Ark.

Franklin rushed for 200-plus yards for the second time this season, making him the only NCAA player at any level to do that in 2023, as UT Martin came from behind to top North Alabama, 37-21 and improve to 3-1 on the year. The sophomore carried the ball a career-high 32 times for 221 yards (6.9 yards per carry) and two touchdowns while adding a nine-yard reception to finish with 230 all-purpose yards. Franklin scored on a 74yard run early in the fourth quarter and later added a 43-yard touchdown to cap the scoring. Franklin, who has the two longest rushes in the Big South-OVC this season (81 and 74 yards) leads all FCS players in rushing yards per game (163.2).

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Chris Hunter Jr., UT Martin, LB • 6-1, 235, R-Jr. • Knoxville, Tenn.

Hunter played a key role in helping UT Martin shutout North Alabama after halftime as the Skyhawks scored 28 unanswered second half points to pick up the 37-21 road victory. Hunter had six tackles (including 0.5 for loss), a pass breakup and his first career interception, which came in the fourth quarter and helped cement the victory.

CO-SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Ethan Gettman, Bryant, K • 6-4, 190, Sr. • Dayton Beach, Fla.

Gettman was perfect on the day as Bryant overcame a 13-3 deficit early in the fourth quarter to win 16-13 in overtime at Princeton. The senior connected from 38 yards with 1:37 to play to force the extra period and his 37-yard field goal in overtime proved to be the game-winner. Gettman also connected from 40 yards in the third quarter. The three made field goals tied a Bryant record and overall he moved into fourth place in school history with 18 career field goals made.

Stone Galloway, Eastern Illinois, K • 5-11, 210, Sr. • Collinsville, Ill.

Having missed the first two games of the season with a leg muscle injury suffered in pre-game warmups before the season-opener, Galloway was the hero in Eastern Illinois' 31-28 come-from-behind win over McNeese. With the game tied late in the fourth quarter, Galloway took his first attempt of the season, connecting from 56 yards out with 20 seconds remaining to lift the Panthers to the win and their first 3-1 start since the 2016 season. The field goal was the second-longest in EIU history and one of only eight of 50-plus yards in school history. The 56-yarder was the longest by a FCS player this season.

FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

MJ Flowers, Eastern Illinois, RB • 6-1, 195, R-Fr. • Cincinnati, Ohio

Flowers ran for 272 yards, the most by any NCAA player this season (FBS, FCS, Division II, Division III) in Eastern Illinois' 31-28 come-from-behind win over McNeese. The freshman carried the ball 37 times to average 7.4 yards per attempt (without any negative runs) and caught six passes for 26 yards to finish the day with 298 all-purpose yards. The 272 yards is the third-most in a game in EIU history (trailing only a 308 and 283 yard performances). Flowers leads all freshman nationally in rushing yards per game (74.0).

FRANK THE TANK

UT Martin RB **SAM FRANKLIN** is the national leader in rushing yards with 653 — 130 yards ahead of his closest competitor, while his 163.2 rushing yards per contest is 32.4 ahead of second-place. He has rushed for more than 200 yards in two of the last three games (259 vs. Missouri State in Week 2 and 221 at North Alabama in Week 4). Franklin has an Association-best six rushing touchdowns, which have gone for a total of 313 yards (=52.2 yard average). Five of Franklin's six rushing scores have gone for 40-plus yards (81, 49, 46, 74 and 43). Meanwhile, Franklin has outrushed eight Big South-OVC squads to this point.

BLOSSOMING FLOWERS

Eastern Illinois RB MJ FLOWERS set Big South-OVC Association single-game records with his 37 rushing carries and 272 rushing yards this past Saturday against McNeese — the highest single-game effort by any NCAA player this season (FBS, FCS, D2, D3). The Association has three of the top five single-game rushing outputs in the FCS this year, with UT Martin's SAM FRANKLIN holding second-place (259) and fifth (221) on the list.

200-YARD PASSING ODYSSEY

Just one Big South-OVC Association QB has thrown for more than 200 yards in all four games to open the season — Southeast Missouri's **PAXTON DeLAURENT**. He leads the league with 1,089 passing yards, which includes a single-game best 358 yards this past Saturday at Eastern Kentucky. DeLaurent opened the season with 213 passing yards at Kansas State, 267 vs. Lindenwood and 251 vs. Southern Illinois prior to surpassing the 300-yard mark for the first time this season.

PASSING GRADES

Lindenwood QB **COLE DUGGER** is tied for the Big South-OVC Association lead with 10 passing touchdowns, which includes four in the season opener and a league-record-tying five in Week 3. His touchown passes have accounted for 18.18 percent of his 55 completions thus far, which have gone for a total of 405 yards (=47.8 percent of his 847 passing yards this season) and an average TD pass of 40.50 yards. Meanwhile, UT Martin's **KINKEAD DENT** is the only Association quarterback with a touchdown pass in all four games to start the campaign (9 total).

GONE IN SIXTY SECONDS

Robert Morris scored on three pass plays of at least 60 yards in its 46–0 win this past Saturday over Virginia–Lynchburg. QB **ANTHONY CHICCITT** first connected with **NOAH ROBINSON** on a 60-yarder to open the scoring, followed by a 66-yard scoring play to **LANDEN LUCAS**. At 9:51 in the third quarter, **ANDRE COOPER** scored on a 69-yard pass from **ZIN'TAYVIOUS SMITH**.

STATE OF MIND

The Big South-OVC Association will play 11 non-conference games this season against "State"-named FCS schools, including three against Kennesaw State. The league is 4-2 thus far — Eastern Illinois is 2-0 (Indiana State and Illinois State), while UT Martin (Missouri State) and Tennessee Tech (Kennesaw State) at 1-0. Robert Morris (Youngstown State) and Lindenwood (Illinois State) are 0-1. The remaining five meetings: Charleston Southern (Kennesaw State), Eastern Illinois (Northwestern State), Tennessee State (Kennesaw State, Norfolk State), Tennessee Tech (South Carolina State).

HOUSE CALLS

During the first three weeks of the 2023 season, Big South-OVC Association members returned five interceptions for touchdowns, with four among the 12-longest in the FCS to this point:

HESS TRUCK

Southeast Missouri RB **GENO HESS** moved into fifth-place in Ohio Valley Conference history with 4,364 rushing yards, and is 92 rushing yards away from jumping into fourth-place. Hess is the active FCS rushing leader (by 598 yards). He scored his first two touchdowns of the season in Week 2, and has 56 rushing scores in his career -- just two away from tying the OVC record.

GAITHERING STEAM

Gardner-Webb RB **NARII GAITHER** is ninth all-time in Big South Conference history with 2,837 career rushing yards, and needs 23 rushing yards to move into eighth-place. He is 163 rushing yards shy of becoming just the seventh with 3,000 in his career. Meanwhile, Gaither is second among Big South running backs for career receptions with 88, and needs three to move into first-place. His 719 career receiving yards are fourth among Big South RBs all-time.

AROUND THE ASSOCIATION...

BRYANT

RB RYAN CLARK had career-highs of 21 carries and 78 rushing yards in Bryant's overtime win at Princeton. He entered the contest with 10 rushing yards on seven attempts ... TE KONOR LATHROP caught the first TD of his career, which went for 11 yards and brought the Bulldogs to within three points (13-10) with 6:37 remaining ... PK ETHAN GETTMAN tied his school single-game record with three field goals in the win, converting from 40, 38 and 37 yards ... Nine of Bryant's last 15 games have been decided by one possession ... MICHAEL OTTY has collected a sack in each of the last three games.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern is the only Big South-OVC Association squad with an interception return, kickoff return and fumble return this season following **JOSHUA HILL**'s 32-yard fumble recovery for a score this past Saturday at Western Carolina ... RB **TJ RUFF** scored twice at WCU, scoring on TD runs of 1 and 47 yards. It was the first multi-rushing TD effort by a CSU back since **JD MOORE** last season against Robert Morris on Nov 5

EASTERN ILLINOIS

K **STONE GALLOWAY**'s game-winning 56-yard field goal — on his first attempt of the year — is the longest in the FCS this season ... The Panthers lead all FCS teams with seven interceptions this season, and is tied for the FCS lead with Charleston Southern with their 2 defensive touchdowns ... EIU rushed for a season-high 311 yards in its comeback win over McNeese last Saturday — its first game this year with 100-plus rushing yards.

GARDNER-WEBB

DL TY FRENCH recorded 1.5 tackles-for-loss at East Carolina to push his career total to 45.5 (fifth-most in Big South Conference history), and holds the Association lead with 8.0 TFL after four weeks. He has tallied at least 0.5 TFL in all four games this season, including 3.0 twice ... RB NARII GAITHER is now the third player in program history to rush for 2,800 rushing yards (2,837). Gaither is also the program record-holder for receptions by a running back with 88 ... The Runnin' Bulldogs suffered their first shutout under head coach TRE LAMB, and first since falling 16-0 to Charleston Southern in 2018.

LINDENWOOD

Over the past two games, WR **JEFF CALDWELL** has 10 catches for 323 yards and five touchdowns. He caught a 73-yard touchdown pass this past Saturday at Illinois State, and is the only Big South-OVC Association player with two 70-yard pass receptions this season (72-yarder for a score in Week 3 at Western Illinois). Caldwell is tops in the conference with six touchdown grabs, which have been for an average of 41.0 yards (246 yards total) ... QB **COLE DUGGER** has completed a league-best four passes of 60+ yards — three of which that have gone 72-plus yards.

ROBERT MORRIS

RMU ranks second nationally in team passing efficiency at 183.83, while QB **ANTHONY CHICCITT** is second in the individual category at 179.7, while ranking third with 10 passing TDs ... Chiccitt was 11-of-16 passing for 251 yards and four TDs in last week's 46-0 win over Virginia-Lynchburg ... The Colonials allowed just 57 total yards (6 net rushing, 51 passing) in the victory ... WR **NOAH ROBINSON** has collected 100 receiving yards in his last three games (377 in that span), as well as a streak of three consecutive games with a receiving TD (4).

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI

SEMO is one of 10 teams nationally to not throw an interception this year (164 passing attempts). The next closest team without an interception is San Diego (128 pass attempts) ... The Redhawks have scored in nine-straight quarters, and 11 of their last 12.

TENNESSEE STATE

Tennessee State rallied from four different deficits to defeat Gardner-Webb in Week 3. K **JAMES LOWERY** made field goals from 49 and 50 yards -- with the 50-yarder accounting for the game-winner in TSU's 27-25 victory ... **MONROE BEARD III** tallied 12 total tackles (nine solo), along with a TFL.

TENNESSEE TECH

The Golden Eagles recorded season highs in total offense (361 yards) and rushing yards (224) in its 17-7 win over Kennesaw State last week ... TTU snapped KSU's 73-game streak of scoring 10 or more points, and held the Owls to under 100 rushing yards (96) for the first time ... RB MARCUS KNIGHT rushed 18 times for 112 yards and a score in the victory, and has been Tech's leading rusher the past two games.

UT MARTIN

UTM scored 27 unanswered points at North Alabama to come back from a 21-10 deficit for the victory ... RB **SAM FRANKLIN** is the *ONLY* NCAA player (any level) with two 200-plus rushing games this season. He also has the two longest rushes in the Association this year (81 and 74) ... P/K **AIDAN LAROS** is second nationally in punting averge at 47.4 ... The Skyhawks have scored in nine consecutive quarters and in 12 of their last 13.

TIEBREAKER PROCEDURE

1. TRANSITIONING SCHOOLS

 To be eligible for the conference's automatic bid to the FCS Football Championship, a school must be a full Division I member.

b. Transitioning schools will be utilized in the tiebreaker process.

c. If a transitioning school is involved in a two-way tie, the tied team that is eligible for postseason competition shall be the league's recipient of the automatic bid.

 ${f d}$. If a transitioning school wins the multi-team tiebreaker, the procedure would start over with the remaining teams.

2. TWO-WAY TIE

a. If the two teams played each other during the conference season, the winner of the head-to-head contest shall be the league's recipient of the automatic bid.

b. If the tied teams did not play each other during the conference season, each team's head-to-head record against all common opponents in the league will be used to determine the automatic bid.

c. If a tie still exists, then each team's record against the next highest common opponent in the league standings will be used to determine the automatic bid. When arriving at a group of tied teams that each team has played, composite records between the tied teams shall be utilized to determine if one of the tied teams has won more games against the group of tied teams.

d. If the teams are still tied, a point system will be utilized based on a complete schedule and wins using Sagarin rankings entering the final day of the regular season, as indicated on the next page.

 e. Should the points system finish in a tie, the tied team with the best Sagarin rating on the final day of the regular season (i.e., Saturday morning) will receive the automatic bid.

B. MULTIPLE TIES

 a. If at any point, a tie is broken using the multiple-tie tiebreaker procedures and only two teams remain, the remaining teams will revert to the two-way tiebreaker (head-to-head).

b. If the tied teams all played each other during the conference season, the team with the
best cumulative record involving games with the tied teams shall be declared champion. For
example, if a team is 2-O against two other tied teams, that team will be declared champion.
 c. If the tied teams all played one another and have identical records against the other tied

teams, then each team's record against all common opponents in the league will be used to determine the automatic bid. If teams are still tied, then each team's record against the next highest common opponent in the league standings will be used to determine the automatic bid. If the tied teams did not play each other, then each team's record against all common opponents in the league will be used to determine the automatic bid. If the teams are still tied, and they did not play each other, then each team's record against the next highest common opponent in the league standings will be used to determine the automatic bid.

e. If the teams are still tied, a point system will be utilized based on a complete schedule and wins using Sagarin rankings entering the final day of the regular season, as indicated below. f. Should the points system finish in a tie, the tied team with the best Sagarin rating on the final day of the regular season (i.e., Saturday morning) will receive the automatic bid.
