2-MINUTE OFFENSE

OPENING KICKOFF: Southeast Missouri has clinched at least a share of the Big South-OVC Championship, the program's third title under head coach **TOM MATUKEWICZ** and the fourth overall conference crown. The Redhawks can clinch the outright championship and automatic bid to the FCS Playoffs with a win Saturday.

Ist DOWN: The Association could finish with a *FOUR-WAY* tie for first-place at 6-2 should Tennessee State defeat SEMO, as well as Tennessee Tech defeat Eastern Illinois and UT Martin defeat Linenwood in the regular-season finales on Saturday. All four teams would be declared cochampions. In this scenario, SEMO and TTU would have finished 2-1 against the tied teams, with TSU and UTM at 1-2 that would reduce the tie to SEMO and TTU. SEMO won head-to-head over Tech and would win the AQ.

2nd DOWN: For the first time in Association history, three teams are ranked in the National Top 25 in the same week, as SEMO, UT Martin and Tennessee State are all rated in the AFCA Coaches Poll. The Redhawks are at No. 11, the Skyhawks are at No. 24 and the Tigers are No. 25.

3rd DOWN: Western Illinois QB **NATHAN LAMB** is the first player in Association history with two 80-plus yard completions in a game when he connected with **CAMEREN SMITH** and **MATTHEW HENRY** for 81-yard touchdowns at SEMO last week.

4th DOWN: Western Illinois RB **CAMEREN SMITH** has scored a touchdown in an Association-record eight consecutive games. His 12 touchdowns this season have come in that span and features four multi-TD efforts.

ABOUT THE BIG SOUTH-OVC FOOTBALL ASSOCIATION

This is the second season of the Big South-OVC Football Association. On Feb. 22, 2022, the Big South Conference and Ohio Valley Conference announced the creation of an association of their football member institutions that began play with the 2023 NCAA Division I football season. The initial agreement of at least four years was enhanced on June 12, 2024 that will provide an opportunity to extend the original partnership through 2030 and beyond. The unique agreement combines the two conferences' football membership to ensure NCAA championship access and stability for the multisport conferences. In creating the association, presidents from each of the multisport conferences pointed to the similarities of the OVC and the Big South, with their complementary geographies and intercollegiate athletic philosophies, as key to making this association possible.

SLANT ROUTES

- * CHARLESTON SOUTHERN: The Buccaneers are concluding the season against an FBS opponent for the first time since 2021 ... CSU is playing an ACC opponent for the third consecutive year.
- * EASTERN ILLINOIS: The Panthers are looking to conclude the season with back-to-back wins for the first time this year ... EIU is seeking its first win over Tennessee Tech since 2021 (W, 28-14).
- * GARDNER-WEBB: The Runnin'
 Bulldogs are concluding the season
 on the road for the first time since
 the 2021 campaign ... GWU has won
 its last three season finales, and is
 playing its fifth and final first-time
 opponent of the year.
- * LINDENWOOD: The Lions are seeking back-to-back victories in Association games for the first time this season, as well as consecutive wins over Top 25 teams ... A win would give Lindenwood its second .500-orbetter campaign in three years at the FCS level.
- * SOUTHEAST MISSOURI: The Redhawks are seeking their first-ever 10-win season ... SEMO is looking to finish with a 7-1 conference record for the first time since 2019, and has won the last five meetings with Tennessee State.
- * TENNESSEE STATE: The Tigers have won eight games for the first time since 2013 when TSU was 10-4 and finished 6-2 in conference action ... Tennessee State is looking to defeat Southeast Missouri for the first time since 2017 (W, 23-20 at home).
- * TENNESSEE TECH: The Golden
 Eagles are seeking their first 5-game
 win streak since winning 5-straight
 across the 2000 (4) and 2001 (1) seasons ... TTU won the last meeting with
 Eastern Illinois (20-17 in 2022).
- * UT MARTIN: The Skyhawks are looking to win their regular-season finale for the first time since 2022 ... UTM first played Lindenwood in '22 and won, 56-26, at home.
- * WESTERN ILLINOIS: The Leathernecks are looking to close out the season with a victory for the first time since the 2021 spring season.

PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - Nov. 18

OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Paxton DeLaurent, Southeast Missouri, QB • 6-5, 229, Sr. • Camdenton, Mo.

DeLaurent accounted for 415 yards of total offense and five total touchdowns as Southeast Missouri topped Western Illinois 54-45 to earn at least a share of the Big South-OVC Championship. The senior completed 25of-40 passes for 375 yards and four touchdowns, while rushing seven times for 40 yards (5.7 yards/carry) and an additional touchdown. DeLaurent had passing touchdowns of 21, 39 and 17 in the first half and added a 48-yarder in the third quarter. His rushing touchdown was 10 yards and came late in the second quarter. This marks the fifth time this season he has been named Offensive Player of the Week. Nationally, DeLaurent ranks first in completions/game (26.64), fourth in points responsible for (182) and fifth in passing touchdowns (27), total offense (305.0 yards/game), passing yards (3,287) and passing yards/game (298.8).

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Daniel Rickert, Tennessee Tech, DL • 5-11, 232, Jr. • Nolensville, Tenn.

Rickert had a monster day in keying a Tennessee Tech defense that limited No. 18/19 UT Martin to just 185 yards of total offense as the Golden Eagles won 10-9 to claim the Sgt. York Trophy and keep alive a possibility of gaining a share of the Big South-OVC Championship. The victory snapped an 11-game losing streak to the Skyhawks for the Golden Eagles. Rickert tallied nine tackles (3 solo), had 3.5 sacks for minus-18 yards, 4.0 total tackles for loss, forced a fumble, had a pass breakup and three quarterback hurries. The 3.5 sacks are tied for the sixth-most by a FCS player in a game this season; his 0.60 sacks/game leads the Big South-OVC this season.

SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

DC Pippin, Southeast Missouri, K • 6-0, 195, Sr. • Springfield, Ill.

Pippin tallied 18 points kicking as No. 12/13 Southeast Missouri knocked off Western Illinois 54-45 to claim at least a share of the Big South-OVC Championship. The senior connected on 4-of-4 field goals, hitting from 43, 20, 40 and 34 yards and was a perfect 6-of-6 on PATs. The four made field goals matched his career high and is tied for the third-most by a FCS player this season. Pippin, who earned this honor for the fourth time this season, also had 11 kickoffs, averaging 55.0 yards per attempt with four touchbacks. He leads all FCS players in field goals per game (2.36) and is fourth in scoring (10.1 points/game).

Ellis earned his fourth Freshman of the Week award of the season after tallying five tackles (3 solo) and 1.5 tackles for loss (for minus-2 yards) in Tennessee State's 23-20 road win over Gardner-Webb. The victory set up an opportunity for the Tigers to potentially win the Big South-OVC Championship next week. Ellis ranks 11th in the Association in tackles per game (5.8).

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI IS IN THE PLAYOFFS WITH A WIN

Southeast Missouri can clinch the outright Big South-OVC Football Association championship and automatic bid to the FCS Playoffs with a win Saturday at Tennessee State to finish the season 7-1 in conference action.

TENNESSEE STATE IS IN THE PLAYOFFS WITH A WIN PLUS HELP

If Tennessee State defeats Southeast Missouri on Saturday, and both Tennessee Tech and UT Martin fall in their respective contests, the Tigers will share the Association crown with SEMO and clinch the automatic bid to the FCS Playoffs, which would mark TSU's first playoff berth since 2013.

BUT WAIT, THERE'S MORE...

While a potential four-way tie for first-place was broken out on the front page of this week's report, additional scenarios exist below:

- * Should TSU, SEMO and UTM finish league play at 6-2, the teams went 1-1 against each other so the tiebreaker moves down to record vs. next highest team in the standing -- which would be Tennessee Tech at 5-3. SEMO was the lone squad to defeat TTU and would capture the AQ.
- * Should TSU, SEMO and TTU finish league play at 6-2, the teams went 1-1 against each other so the tiebreaker moves down to the next highest team in the standings -- which would be both Lindenwood and UT Martin at 5-3, so the composite record against the tied teams is used. Tech was the only squad to defeat both Lindenwood and UTM and would receive the AQ.

ANOTHER WEEK, ANOTHER RECORD FOR COMBINED PASSING YARDS

For the fourth time this season, the Big South-OVC single-game record for combined passing yards has been established, as Western Illinois (500) and Southeast Missouri (375) combined for 875 yards through the air this past week. The previous record of 795 stood for one week (Eastern Illinois - 458 and Gardner-Webb - 337 in Week 11). Prior to the that, the record was 747 by Western Illinois (564) and Lindenwood (183) in Week 9, which supplanted the record of 730 by Southeast Missouri (364) and Eastern Illinois (366) set in Week 6.

NOTE FROM CRAIG HALEY

According to Stats Perform's **CRAIG HALEY**, Southeast Missouri K **DC PIPPIN**'s 34 field goal attempts this season are one shy of the FCS single-season record of 35, which was set by William & Mary's **BRIAN PATE** in 2009. Meanwhile, Pippin's Association-record 26 field goals are three shy of the FCS season record of 29 held by North Dakota State's **ADAM KELLER** (2014) and James Madison's **ETHAN RATKE** (2021).

KICKIN' PIPPIN

As noted above, Southeast Missouri K **DC PIPPIN** has made a Big South-OVC Association single-season record 26 field goals, which leads all of FCS. He has six 10-point kicking games this season following his Association single-game record 18 points this past Saturday in the win over Western Illinois. He has five games with at least three field goals made, and three games with four. Pippin's 111 points scored kicking to date has shattered the old Association single-season mark of 73 (UT Martin's **AIDAN LAROS** in 2023), and ranks fourth in the FCS this season.

MAKING THEIR POINT

Southeast Missouri (54) and Western Illinois (45) set the Big South-OVC Association record for most combined points with 99 this past week. The old record was 98, set last year by Charleston Southern (21) against Western Carolina (77). The old record for a conference game was 89 combined points, which was set last season by Gardner-Webb (45) and Bryant (44).

TENNESSEE RIVER

Tennessee State's four 40-point games this season are its most times scoring 40+ points in a campaign since five times in 2001. The 2024 Tigers have scored 40 points each month of the season -- with the first three times being the same exact point total -- 41 vs. Mississippi Valley State on Aug. 31; 41 vs. Arkansas-Pine Bluff on Sept. 14, and 41 vs. Eastern Illinois on Oct. 12. TSU scored a season-high 45 points in Week 11 at Western Illinois.

THE LEAGUE OF EXTRAORDINARY GENTLEMEN

Through 32 Association-conference games played, the home team has won 19 times (=59.38 winning percentage), while the overall average margin of victory is 13.34 points. Fourteen contests — or 43.75 percent — have been one possession decisions. The 32 games have had a combined point total of 1,749, for a per game average of 54.66 points. Last season, the 30 Big South-OVC Association-conference games were decided by 16.10 points, and averaged 48.83 combined points (1,465 point scored).

NATIONAL BAROMETER

The Association completed the regular-season 12-10 (=54.5 percent) against non-conference FCS opponents, which includes two wins among six contests against nationally-ranked foes. Charleston Southern earned the league's first victory of the season against a Top 25 squad when the Buccaneers defeated then-No. 15/16 Furman, 24-20, in Week 2. Two weeks later, SEMO downed then-No. 7/7 Southern Illinois for the Association's first-ever triumph over a Top 10 progam. In 2023, the Association was 20-15 against out-of-conference foes in the regular-season.

RACK OF LAMB

In his last four outings, Western Illinois QB **NATHAN LAMB** has 1,588 passing yards and 11 touchdown passes. He threw for a Big South-OVC Association single-game record 564 yards at Lindenwood in Week 9, where he went 42-of-55 passing (=76.4 percent) to establish the league record for completions in a game, and finished the day with 604 total yards of offense for another conference record. He is the first player in Association history to pass for 500 yards and gain 600 total offensive yards in a contest. Lamb's previous highs this season were 269 passing yards (at Illinois State in Week 3), 24 completions (vs. ISU) and 350 yards of offense (vs. Tennessee Tech in Week 8).

BIG TIME RUSH

Tennessee Tech rushed for 400 yards in its Week 10 victory over Lindenwood — the most team net rushing yards in an Association—conference game, and the second—highest total in the league record book. The all-time mark is 405 rushing yards by UT Martin last season vs. Missouri State. The Golden Eagles averaged 10.53 yards per carry against the Lions, which surpassed the previous Association record of 10.24 — set by Lindenwood in Week 9.

STUDY HALL

In Lindenwood's 49–38 win over Western Illinois in Week 9, RB **STEVE HALL** rushed for 259 yards and four touchdowns on just 13 carries for a Big South-OVC single-game record 19.92 yards per carry. He tied the league's single-game rushing touchdown record, and reeled off the longest rush from scrimmage in the conference record book with a 93-yard scoring run that sealed the victory over the Leathernecks. Hall also had a 75-yard dash for a touchdown, becoming the first player in conference annals with two TD runs of 75-yards or longer in a game.

INSIDE THE NUMBERS FROM THE LINDENWOOD-WESTERN ILLINOIS GAME

Lindenwood's 49–38 victory over Western Illinois in Week 9 featured several Association record-breaking performances. The Lions rushed for 389 yards on 38 carries for a then-Big South-OVC Association record 10.24 yards per carry. At the time, it was the second-highest single-game rushing total in Association history, and the most in a conference game. Western's 564 passing yards was also a single-game record, as was its 713 yards of offense. The teams combined for a record 1,285 yards of offense (Western – 713, Lindenwood – 572), as well as a then-record 747 combined passing yards (Western – 564, Lindenwood – 183). The 87 combined points at the time tied for the second-most in a conference game in Association annals.

HANGING WITH MR. COOPER

Eastern Illinois WR **COOPER WILLMAN**'s Big South-OVC Association single-game record of 291 receiving yards at Gardner-Webb in Week 11 broke the old conference record of 226 that was set by Western Illinois WR **MATTHEW HENRY** at Lindenwood in Week 9. Willman caught 11 passes and averaged 26.45 yards per catch against the Runnin' Bulldogs. He is fourth in the Association this season with 57 receptions, as well as third with 869 receiving yards and eight TD grabs. Meanwhile, Willman's 291 all-purpose yards was the second-highest single-game total in Association history, and surpassed the 280 recorded by teammate **MJ FLOWERS** in Week 10 against Western Illinois. Flowers holds the all-time record of 298 that he set last season vs. McNeese.

HENRY THE XV

Western Illinois WR MATTHEW HENRY is the Association leader with 969 receiving yards and 88.09 receiving yards per game. In Week 9 at Lindenwood, set Big South-OVC Association single-game records with his 15 receptions and 226 receiving yards (since broken). His catch total bettered Southeast Missouri WR CAM PEDRO's total of 12 the same day vs. Gardner-Webb, while the 226 receiving yards surpassed the old Association record of 204, set by Charleston Southern's NOAH JENNINGS last season vs. Robert Morris. Henry's teammate ELI ARAGON finished the Lindenwood game with 132 yards receiving, marking the first time in Association history that a member had a 200-yard and 100-yard receiver in the same contest. Eastern Illinois accomplished the 200-yard, 100-yard receiving tandem in Week 11 at Gardner-Webb.

THE DEFENSE NEVER RESTS

UT Martin has established a Big South-OVC Association single-season record with four interception return touchdowns this season, as well as records for most interceptions (16) and INT return yards (317). Skyhawks LB **TEVIN SHIPP** owns two of those four pick-6's, which ties the Association record as well. Meanwhile, Big South-OVC Association members have combined for 15 defensive touchdowns after 12 weeks of the season (11 interception returns and 4 fumble returns). Last year, the 10-team Association membership combined for 19 defensive TDs (12 INT, 6 FUM).

PASSIN' PAXTON

Southeast Missouri QB **PAXTON DeLAURENT** is among the national leaders with 27 touchdown passes (T-5th), 26.64 completions per game (1st), 3,287 passing yards (5th), and 298.8 passing yards per game (5th). He is the Big South-OVC Association single-season record holder for passing yards and completions (293), and is two TD strikes away from eclipising the conference mark of 28. DeLaurent, who became the first Big South-OVC Association quarterback to throw for 400 yards in a game when he netted a then-Association single-game record 418 passing yards in Week 8 against Tennessee Tech, is just the second quarterback in Association history to throw 10 TD passes in a 2-game span, as he had six in Week 2 and four in Week 4. In Week 2 against UT Martin, he set Association single-game records for plays (69) and pass attempts (63), and tied the single-game mark for touchdown passes (6). DeLaurent holds the Big South-OVC season mark for most 300-yard passing games with seven.

OUARTER POUNDERS

Southeast Missouri has scored in 40 of 44 quarters in regulation this year, as well as both overtime periods. Three of the four times SEMO has failed to score in a quarter has been in the opening 15 minutes (vs. Tennessee Tech in Week 7, vs. Gardner-Webb in Week 9 and at Lindenwood in Week 11). The Redhawks opened the season with a scoring streak of 24-straight quarters. SEMO's quarter-by-quarter scoring breakdown this season stands at 77 points (first), 97 (second), 75 (third) and 90 (fourth).

RETURN TO SENDER

UT Martin's **OSHAE BAKER** is the current Big South-OVC Association single-season record-holder for punt return yards, as his current total of 220 is ahead of SEMO's **KHALANI RIDDICK**'s 204. Both players surpassed the original season record of 196 set by Gardner-Webb's **MALEEK HUG-GINS** last year. Riddick's 19 punt returns trail Higgins' season-record of 22, while Baker's 13.75 punt return average is pacing ahead of the Association-record of 11.54 yards per return (SEMO's **DALYN McDONALD**).

BLOOMING

Eastern Illinois RB MJ FLOWERS has 44 receptions out of the backfield this season, a Big South-OVC Association single-season record for a running back. He ranks 10th in the league, and surpassed his own conference record of 35 catches that he set last season. In Week 6, Flowers tied the then-Big South-OVC single-game record with his 11 receptions against SEMO. That total is the most-ever by an Association running back. Meanwhile, Western Illinois RB CAMEREN SMITH broke Flowers' single-game record for receiving yards by a running back (86) with 96 this past week at SEMO, and his 81-yard touchdown reception established the longest reception by an Association running back.

WHAT CAN BROWN DO FOR YOU?

Charleston Southern P **GILBERT BROWN** posted an Association single-game record 61.0 punting average, based on 3-4 punts, at Tennessee State in Week 5. He booted kicks of 72, 68, 51 and 53, against the Tigers. Brown, who has 21 punts of 50-yards or longer and recorded a 74-yard punt against Gardner-Webb in Week 10, ranks sixth in the nation with his league-leading 45.85 season punting average, which is just behind the single-season league record of 47.27 yards, set last year by UT Martin's **AIDAN LAROS**.

MAKING A DENT IN THE RECORD BOOK

UT Martin quarterback **KINKEAD DENT** scored a rushing touchown in five-straight games, resetting the Association record by a QB. Former Gardner-Webb signal-caller **JAYLEN KING** had a rushing TD in four-straight games last season. Dent has thrown a touchdown pass and rushed for a score in a game a league-high five times this season, which is also an Association single-season record. Meanwhile, Western Illinois QB **NATHAN LAMB**'s seven rushing touchdowns this year are the most by a quarterback in Association single-season history.

SEE OF RED

SEMO recorded the Association's first-ever win featuring a ranked Big South-OVC team against a ranked non-conference opponent, as the then-No. 21/21 Redhawks won at then-No. 7/7 Southern Illinois, 38-21, in Week 4. It was just the second-ever head-to-head match-up of a ranked Big South-OVC squad against a ranked out-of-conference foe, as the first was between the same two squads last season.

UT MARTIN SKIES PAST KENNESAW STATE FOR ASSOCIATION'S FIRST FBS VICTORY

UT Martin pulled off the Association's first-ever FBS victory in Week 5, as the Skyhawks downed Kennesaw State, 24-13, for the program's second all-time win over an FBS foe. The league was close to scoring another three FBS triumphs earlier this season, as Tennessee Tech (7 points) and Gardner-Webb (7 and 1 point) suffered one possession losses to Bowl Subdivision opponents back in September.

UT MARTIN SETS ASSOCIATION RECORD FOR FEWEST NET RUSHING YARDS ALLOWED

In its Week 2 match-up with Southeast Missouri, UT Martin limited the Redhawks to minus-11 net rushing yards, a Big South-OVC Association single-game record. It was the first time a league member did not allow positive rushing yards in a contest, and surpassed the previous record of five (5) net rushing yards allowed, which was also set by UTM against SEMO last season on Nov. 11.

WEBB SPINNERS

Gardner-Webb is the first Big South-OVC member to have two 100-yard rushers in a game twice in the same season. In Week 8, QUASEAN HOLMES (156) and EDWARD SAYDEE (119) each eclipsed the century mark on the ground in GWU's win over Lindenwood -- the eighth-highest combined rushing yards by two teammates in league annals (275). In Week 4 at Presbyterian, CARSON GRESOCK (134 yards) and Holmes (132) each surpassed 100 rush yards in the contest. The duo also combined for five rushing touchdowns in the victory over the Blue Hose, as Gresock had three scores followed by Holmes' two.

TACKLE BOX

Gardner-Webb's 11 quarterback sacks against Eastern Illinois in Week 11 was a Big South-OVC Association single-game record, and the Runnin' Bulldogs finished the afternoon with 14 tacklesfor-loss -- tied for the second-most in a game in Association history. ANTONIO O'BERRY had 4.0 TFL -- all sacks and his entire tackle total for the game, which is tied for the second-most by an individual in Associaton annals. In Week 10, Charleston Southern recorded a season-high 14 tackles-for-loss against Gardner-Webb. In addition, DAVION WILLIAMS had 4.0 TFL against the Runnin' Bulldogs.

RUSH WEEK

Charleston Southern RB AUTAVIUS ISON rushed for a school-record 229 yards in Week 6 against Western Illinois -- now the fourth-highest single-game rushing total in Big South-OVC Association history, and at the time was just the fifth 200-yard rushing effort in the brief history of the Association. Meanwhile, TYSON GREENWADE added 102 yards on the ground against the Leathernecks -- marking the first time a Big South-OVC squad had a 200-yard and 100-yard rusher in the same game, and the duo's 331 combined yards established an Association single-game record.

HOUSE CALLS

Lindenwood WR JEFF CALDWELL is the Big South-OVC Association single-season record-holder for touchdown receptions with 10, breaking his own record of 8 set in 2023. In Week 5, he had a Big South-OVC single-game record-tying four touchdown receptions at Eastern Illinois. Caldwell is averaging a league-best 20.73 yards on his 45 catches, which is pacing ahead of the Association season record of 18.72 yards per catch.

AT FIRST GLANTZ

Lindenwood QB NATE GLANTZ became just the second quarterback in Big South-OVC Association history to throw for 100 yards and rush for 100 yards in the same game when he achieved the feat in the Lions' 29-14 victory over Charleston Southern in Week 7. He passed for 152 yards and gained a team-high 103 yards on the ground to account for 255 of Lindenwood's 392 offensive yards vs. the Bucs.

BOOGIF FEVER

Tennessee State's BOOGIE TROTTER has amassed a Big South-OVC Association single-season record 151 interception return yards on his three picks this season. The old return yardage mark was 85 (Tennessee Tech's JACQUEZ McGOWAN in 2023). Trotter is tied for third in the league with his three INTs, which includes a 69-yard pick-six in Week 4 against Tennessee Tech -- the fifthlongest interception return in Association history.

AROUND THE ASSOCIATION...

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Buccaneers suffered through the first O-8 conference season in program history ... CSU also suffered five single-possession defeats — four of which were Association games, and fell in those games by a combined 16 points (3.2 average) ... In the Bucs' overtime loss at Eastern Illinois last week, **REID MONTGOMERY** converted field goals of 37 and 39 yards, while **JAMIL BISHOP**'s 15-yard touchdown run tied the contest at 13-13 with 4:52 remaining.

EASTERN ILLINOIS

QB PIERCE HOLLEY had his Association-record streak of 300-yard passing games end at six consecutive after being limited to 168 yards last week against Charleston Southern. Holley enters the final week of the season second in the Association with 2,996 passing yards (7th nationally) ... JULIAN PATINO's 18-yard field goal in overtime gave the Panthers the 16-13 win over Charleston Southern. MJ FLOWERS and ALEX HERRERA scored touchdowns on consecutive possessions to put EIU ahead, 13-6 just before halftime.

GARDNER-WEBB

The Runnin' Bulldogs rallied from a 13–0 deficit against Tennessee State to within one point of the Tigers, at 13–12. **MILES RICHARDSON** scored GWU's first points with a 98-yard PAT return, the third defensive extra point this season in the Association ... TE **CAMDEN OVERTON** caught seven passes, tied for the third-most in a game by a tight end in league history ... **RAQUON HARTLEY** had 16 tackles (10 solo) plus 2.0 tackles-for-loss.

LINDENWOOD

Lindenwood recorded its first-ever victory over a ranked FCS opponent with its 24-12 victory over then-No. 6/6 Southeast Missouri in Week 11. The Lions held the Redhawks to their fewest points (12), fewest plays (53) and fewest yards (234) of the season. Lindenwood held possesion of the ball for 40-minutes, 34-seconds, and totaled 56 rushing attempts. WR **JEFF CALDWELL** caught six passes for 99 yards and a score.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI

The Redhawks rallied from two early deficits to pull away from Western Illinois and record its ninth win of the season. SEMO has four 9-win seasons in **TOM MATUKEWICZ**'s 11 years as head coach ... **BRANDON EPTON JR**. rushed for a team-high 126 yards and a touchdown, and also caught three passes for 26 yards and a score ... QB **PAXTON DELAURENT** was 25-of-40 for 375 yards and four touchdowns, his fourth game this season with at least 4 TD passes ... SEMO's defense turned over Western Illinois four times (three INT, one fumble recovery).

TENNESSEE STATE

The Tigers are 14-8 since the start of the 2023 season, and remains at No. 3 in both the HBCU Coaches Poll and Media Poll ... In TSU's 23-20 victory at Gardner-Webb, **JADEN McGILL** rushed for 100 yards on 15 carries (=6.7 average) for the first 100-yard rushing game by a Tiger this season. QB **DRAYLEN ELLIS** threw for 220 yards and two touchdowns, his third-straight multi-TD pass game and sixth of the season. His 20 TD passes this season rank second in the Association ... **C.J. EVANS** has scored a touchdown in six consecutive games -- 2 rushing, 2 receiving and 2 kickoff returns.

TENNESSEE TECH

Tennessee Tech won its fourth consecutive game with its 10-9 win at UT Martin this past Saturday. During the current 4-game win streak, the TTU defense has permitted just 59 points (14.75 average), 953 offensive yards (238.3 average) and 252 yards rushing (63.0 average) in that span ... The Golden Eagles did not permit an offensive touchdown to UTM. RB **JALEN MITCHELL** was responsible for Tech's lone touchdown in the win over Martin (15-yard run), while **DANIEL RICKERT** had nine tackles, 4.0 TFL, 3.5 sacks, a forced fumble, one pass break-up and three QB hurries. Tech finished with 11 stops behind the line of scrimmage.

UT MARTIN

UT Martin managed just 185 yards of offense in its 10–9 loss at Tennessee Tech, the Skyhawks' lowest offensive output against an FCS opponent since the 2021 playoffs vs. eventual National Runner-Up Montana State ... CAM ROBERTSON's 40-yard blocked punt return for a touchdown followed by a safety brought UTM back from a 10–0 deficit. QB KINKEAD DENT was the squad's top rusher vs. TTU, the first time this season RB PATRICK SMITH did not lead the team in rushing yards. JAYLON SHARPE had 14 tackles and a quarterback sack.

WESTERN ILLINOIS

QB NATHAN LAMB is second in the conference in total offense with 300.82 per game, while his 331 rushing yards are the most among Big South-OVC quarterbacks. He needs 61 rushing yards in the season finale to break the Association single-season quarterback rushing record of 391 set last season by Gardner-Webb's JAYLEN KING ... In the Leathernecks' nine-point loss at SEMO last week, MATTHEW HENRY caught seven passes for 183 yards, while ELI ARAGON caught seven balls for 116. Lamb was 24-of-39 passing for 449 yards and three touchdowns, his second game with more than 400 passing yards in four weeks. K ANTONIO CHADHA made field goals from 46 and 50 yards, and is tied for the Association lead with eight field goals from 40 yards-or-longer.

1. TRANSITIONING SCHOOLS

a. To be eligible for the conference's automatic bid to the FCS Football Championship, a school must be a full Division I member.

b. Transitioning schools will be utilized in the tiebreaker process.

c. If a transitioning school is involved in a two-way tie, the tied team that is eligible for postseason competition shall be the league's recipient of the automatic bid.

d. If a transitioning school wins the multi-team tiebreaker, the procedure would start over with the remaining teams.

2. TWO-WAY TIE

a. If the two teams played each other during the conference season, the winner of the head-to-head contest shall be the league's recipient of the automatic bid.

b. If the tied teams did not play each other during the conference season, each team's head-to-head record against all common opponents in the league will be used to determine the automatic bid.

c. If a tie still exists, then each team's record against the next highest common opponent in the league standings will be used to determine the automatic bid. When arriving at a group of tied teams that each team has played, composite records between the tied teams shall be utilized to determine if one of the tied teams has won more games against the group of tied teams.

d. If the teams are still tied, a point system will be utilized based on a complete schedule and wins using Massey rankings entering the final day of the regular season, as indicated below.

e. Should the points system finish in a tie, the tied team with the best Massey rating on the final day of the regular season (i.e., Saturday morning) will receive the automatic bid.

3. MULTIPLE TIES

a. If at any point, a tie is broken using the multiple-tie tiebreaker procedures and only two teams remain, the remaining teams will revert to the two-way tiebreaker (head-to-head).

b. If the tied teams all played each other during the conference season, the team with the best cumulative record involving games with the tied teams shall be declared champion. For example, if a team is 2-0 against two other tied teams, that team will be declared champion.

c. If the tied teams all played one another and have identical records against the other tied teams, then each team's record against all common opponents in the league will be used to determine the automatic bid. If teams are still tied, then each team's record against the next highest common opponent in the league standings will be used to determine the automatic bid.

d. If the tied teams did not play each other, then each team's record against all common opponents in the league will be used to determine the automatic bid. If the teams are still tied, and they did not play each other, then each team's record against the next highest common opponent in the league standings will be used to determine the automatic bid.

 If the teams are still tied, a point system will be utilized based on a complete schedule and wins using Massey rankings entering the final day of the regular season, as indicated below.

f. Should the points system finish in a tie, the tied team with the best Massey rating on the final day of the regular season (i.e., Saturday morning) will receive the automatic bid.


