2-MINUTE OFFENSE

OPENING KICKOFF: For the fourth consecutive week, two Big South-OVC Association teams are ranked in the Top 25 polls, as Southeast Missouri checks in at No. 6 in both national rankings, while UT Martin is No. 19 in the Stats Perform poll and No. 22 in the AFCA Coaches poll. It also marks the first time that two Big South-OVC programs were inside the Top 20 in either poll. The Association has had a member nationally-ranked eight-straight weeks this season, and 22 of the last 25 weeks — with multiple Top 25 squads eight times in that span.

1st DOWN: Southeast Missouri was ranked No. 6 overall last week by the Division I Football Championship Committee in its first in-season Top 10 ranking of FCS teams. It was the first time an Association member was among the Committee's Top 10 in-season rankings.

2nd DOWN: Tennessee State's **C.J. EVANS** is the first player in Big South-OVC Association history with two kickoff return touchdowns in a season — and also the first with two kickoff return TDs in back-to-back games. He had a 98-yard return this past week vs. UT Martin, and recorded a 99-yarder in TSU's previous game at Howard.

3rd DOWN: UT Martin ranks third in the nation in rushing defense with its 83.3 average. The Skyhawks have limited their last three opponents to a combined 130 net rushing yards (43.3 average), and have held six foes to 66 net rushing yards or less this season.

4th DOWN: Eastern Illinois QB **PIERCE HOLLEY** is the first Big South-OVC Association player to throw for more than 300 yards in five consecutive games.

ABOUT THE BIG SOUTH-OVC FOOTBALL ASSOCIATION

This is the second season of the Big South-OVC Football Association. On Feb. 22, 2022, the Big South Conference and Ohio Valley Conference announced the creation of an association of their football member institutions that began play with the 2023 NCAA Division I football season. The initial agreement of at least four years was enhanced on June 12, 2024 that will provide an opportunity to extend the original partnership through 2030 and beyond. The unique agreement combines the two conferences' football membership to ensure NCAA championship access and stability for the multisport conferences. In creating the association, presidents from each of the multisport conferences pointed to the similarities of the OVC and the Big South, with their complementary geographies and intercollegiate athletic philosophies, as key to making this association possible.

SLANT ROUTES

- * CHARLESTON SOUTHERN: The Buccaneers are looking to avoid an 0-7 conference record for the first time ... Charleston Southern is facing its third nationally-ranked opponent on Saturday, and is 1-1 in those games.
- * EASTERN ILLINOIS: The Panthers are facing their two first-time opponents of the season over the next two weeks -- Gardner-Webb this week and Charleston Southern next Saturday ... EIU is 4-0 in November Association games.
- * GARDNER-WEBB: The Runnin' Bulldogs are playing their fourth of five first-time opponents on Saturday ... GWU is seeking consecutive victories for the first time this season.
- * LINDENWOOD: The Lions are looking to avoid back-to-back Association losses for the first time this season ... Lindenwood is facing its third overall nationally-ranked opponent this season on Saturday (second FCS).
- * SOUTHEAST MISSOURI: The Redhawks are looking to open 6-0 in conference games for the first time since 2010 (7-0) ... The Redhawks have averaged 47.0 points in their two victories over Lindenwood.
- * TENNESSEE STATE: The Tigers are looking to avoid back-to-back losses for the first time this season ... West-ern Illinois marks TSU's lone first-time opponent of the season.
- * TENNESSEE TECH: The Golden Eagles are seeking their first nonconference win since Oct. 14, 2023 (W, 28-7 at South Carolina State) ... Tech is looking to snap a 2-game skid to Samford, as its last win in the series was in 2019 (W, 59-58 in 20T).
- * UT MARTIN: The Skyhawks have won the two meetings with CSU by scores of 17–0 (2023) and 42–14 (1994) ... UTM is seeking its fourth consecutive 7-win season.
- * WESTERN ILLINOIS: The Leathernecks are facing their fourth of five first-time opponents of the season on Saturday ... Western is averaging 37.67 points in its last three outings, and has eclipsed 30 points in six of nine games this year.

PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - Nov. 4

OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

MJ Flowers, Eastern Illinois, RB • 6-1, 220, R-So. • Cincinnati, Ohio

Flowers tallied 280 all-purpose yards and three touchdowns as Eastern Illinois topped in-state rival Western Illinois 45-38. The sophomore carried the ball 27 times for 194 yards (7.2 ypc) and a 10-yard touchdown in the first quarter. In the fourth quarter, he had a 65-yard run where he broke through multiple defenders to set up EIU's final touchdown of the day. Flowers also caught three passes for 86 yards, including a 64-yard touchdown on the opening drive of the third quarter, and an 18-yarder on the first drive of the fourth quarter. His 280 all-purpose yards ranks fifth in the FCS in 2024; he ranks 21st nationally in all-purpose yards (116.56).

CO-DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Davion Williams, Charleston Southern, SAF • 6-1, 185, R-So. • Frostproof, Fla.

Williams led all players with eight tackles (seven solo) in Saturday's game with Gardner-Webb. The sophomore had four tackles-for-loss (for minus-17 yards) and a sack (for minus-9 yards) while forcing a fumble and adding a quarterback hurry. His biggest play of the day was a strip sack in the third quarter that gave the Bucs the ball back in the red zone and led to a touchdown three plays later. Williams' four TFL's are the most by a Big South-OVC player this season (12th-most nationally) and most by a CSU player in a game since 2021.

Cayman Spaulding, Tennessee Tech, LB • 6-0, 189, So. • Lithonia, Ga.

Spaulding had six tackles (four solo), 2.5 tackles for loss (for minus-8 yards), a sack and returned an interception 29 yards for a touchdown in Tennessee Tech's 52-10 Homecoming victory over Lindenwood. After his team had scored early in the third quarter to increase the lead to 24-0, the sophomore picked off the next pass and streaked to the end zone to increase the lead to 31-0. He was a key part of a defense that limited the Lions to just 249 yards of total offense.

SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

CJ Evans, Tennessee State, RS/RB • 5-8, 180, Sr. • Mobile, Ala.

Evans returned his second kickoff for a touchdown on the season, this time 98 yards against UT Martin on Saturday. With his team trailing 21-0 late in the first quarter, Evans took the kickoff and scored to trim the margin. It is tied for the 10th longest kickoff return in the FCS this season; Evans had a 99-yarder earlier this year against Howard, making him one of five players nationally with two kick returns for touchdowns this season. The senior averaged 46.7 yards on three returns, rushed for seven yards and caught two passes for 16 yards to finish with 163 all-purpose yards. Evans has eight total kickoff returns this season and is averaging 44.38 yards per return.

FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

Tyson Greenwade, Charleston Southern, RB • 5-11, 210, R-Fr. • Dalton, Ga.

Greenwade accounted for 99 all-purpose yards and a touchdown in Charleston Southern's home game with rival Gardner-Webb. He carried the ball 15 times for 68 yards (4.5 ypc) and scored on a 1-yard run in the third quarter to pull his team within three points. The freshman also caught three passes for 31 yards, including a 25-yard reception late in the fourth quarter that led to a CSU touchdown a play later as the Bucs cut the margin to 17-14.

SIX CYLINDER

Big South-OVC leader Southeast Missouri is coming off its second bye week of the season, and will seek to become the first team in Association history to start 6-0 in conference games. The Redhawks are ranked No. 6 nationally in both major polls (Stats Perform and AFCA Coaches), and were rated No. 6 by the FCS Championship Committee last week.

MAKING A DENT IN THE RECORD BOOK

UT Martin quarterback **KINKEAD DENT** has scored a rushing touchown in four-straight games, tying the Association record by a QB. Former Gardner-Webb signal-caller **JAYLEN KING** had a rushing TD in four-straight games last season. Dent and Western Illinois QB **NATHAN LAMB** have each thrown a touchdown pass and rushed for a score in a game a league-high four times this season, which also matches the Association record. Meanwhile, Lamb's six rushing touchdowns this year are the most by a quarterback in Association single-season history.

TACKLE BOX

Charleston Southern recorded a season-high 14 tackles-for-loss this past Saturday against Gardner-Webb, tied for the second-most in a game in Association history. **DAVION WILLIAMS** had 4.0 TFL against the Runnin' Bulldogs, which is also tied for the second-most by an individual in Association annals.

TENNESSEE RIVER

Tennessee State's three 40-point games this season are second-most in the Association and its most times scoring 40+ points in a campaign since three times in 2016. The 2024 Tigers have scored 40 points each month of the season thus far, and each time being the same exact point total -- 41 vs. Mississippi Valley State on Aug. 31; 41 vs. Arkansas-Pine Bluff on Sept. 14, and 41 vs. Eastern Illinois on Oct. 12.

QUARTER POUNDERS

No. 6/6 Southeast Missouri has scored in 34 of 36 quarters in regulation this year, as well as both overtime periods. The two times SEMO failed to score in a quarter has been in the opening 15 minutes (vs. Tennessee Tech in Week 7 and vs. Gardner-Webb in Week 9). The Redhawks opened the season with a scoring streak of 24-straight quarters. SEMO's quarter-by-quarter scoring breakdown this season stands at 67 points (first), 70 (second), 56 (third) and 80 (fourth). SEMO has reached 30+ points in six of nine contests this season.

THE LEAGUE OF EXTRAORDINARY GENTLEMEN

Through 24 Association-conference games played, the home team has won 15 times (=62.50 winning percentage), while the overall average margin of victory is 14.38 points. Ten contests have been one possession decisions. The 24 games have had a combined point total of 1,345, for a per game average of 56.04 points. Last season, the 30 Big South-OVC Association-conference games were decided by 16.10 points, and averaged 48.83 combined points (1,465 point scored).

THE DEFENSE NEVER RESTS

Big South-OVC Association members have combined for 14 defensive touchdowns after 10 weeks of the season (10 interception returns and 4 fumble returns) -- with UT Martin (3 INT) and Tennessee Tech (2 INT, 1 FUM) leading the way with three each. Last year, the 10-team Association membership combined for 19 defensive TDs (12 INT, 6 FUM). Martin and Tech are tied for the league-lead with 12 interceptions this season, while the Skyhawks have amassed an Association single-season record 272 return yards. In addition, UTM's three INT touchdowns match the league record set by Gardner-Webb last season.

WALL FLOWER

Eastern Illinois RB **MJ FLOWERS** produced a season-high 280 all-purpose yards this past week in the Panthers' 45-38 victory over Western Illinois -- the second-highest single-game output in Association history. Flowers rushed for 194 yards in addition to 86 yards receiving, and now owns the top two single-game all-purpose yard totals in Association annals. He holds the record of 298 that he set last season vs. McNeese.

RACK OF LAMB

In his last two outings, Western Illinois QB **NATHAN LAMB** has 873 passing yards and 8 touchdown passes. He threw for a Big South-OVC Association single-game record 564 yards at Lindenwood in Week 9. He was 42-of-55 passing (=76.4 percent) to establish the league record for completions in a game, and finished the day with 604 total yards of offense for another conference record. He is the first player in Association history to pass for 500 yards and gain 600 total offensive yards in a contest. Lamb's previous highs this season were 269 passing yards (at Illinois State in Week 3), 24 completions (vs. ISU) and 350 yards of offense (vs. Tennessee Tech in Week 8).

PASSIN' PAXTON

Southeast Missouri QB **PAXTON DeLAURENT** is third nationally with 23 touchdown passes, first with 28.00 completions per game, fifth with 2,738 passing yards, and sixth with 304.2 passing yards per game. He is 169 yards away from breaking the Big South-OVC Association single-season record of 2,907, is already the Association season record holder with 252 completions, and six TD strikes away from eclipising the conference mark of 28. DeLaurent, who became the first Big South-OVC Association quarterback to throw for 400 yards in a game when he netted a then-Association single-game record 418 passing yards in Week 8 against Tennessee Tech, is just the second quarterback in Association history to throw 10 TD passes in a 2-game span, as he had six in Week 2 and four in Week 4. In Week 2 against UT Martin, he set Association single-game records for plays (69) and pass attempts (63), and tied the single-game mark for touchdown passes (6). DeLaurent is the only Association quarterback to throw a TD pass in every game this season, while his six 300-yard passing games in 2024 are a Big South-OVC season mark.

BIG TIME RUSH

Tennessee Tech rushed for 400 yards in this past week's victory over Lindenwood — the most team net rushing yards in an Association-conference game, and the second-highest total in the league record book. The all-time mark is 405 rushing yards by UT Martin last season vs. Missouri State. The Golden Eagles averaged 10.53 yards per carry against the Lions, which surpassed the previous Association record of 10.24 — set by Lindenwood in Week 9.

STUDY HALL

In Lindenwood's 49–38 win over Western Illinois in Week 9, RB **STEVE HALL** rushed for 259 yards and four touchdowns on just 13 carries for a Big South-OVC single-game record 19.92 yards per carry. He tied the league's single-game rushing touchdown record, and reeled off the longest rush from scrimmage in the conference record book with a 93-yard scoring run that sealed the victory over the Leathernecks. Hall also had a 75-yard dash for a touchdown, becoming the first player in conference annals with two TD runs of 75-yards or longer in a game.

INSIDE THE NUMBERS FROM THE LINDENWOOD-WESTERN ILLINOIS GAME

Lindenwood's 49–38 victory over Western Illinois in Week 9 featured several Association record-breaking performances. The Lions rushed for 389 yards on 38 carries for a then-Big South-OVC Association record 10.24 yards per carry. At the time, it was the second-highest single-game rushing total in Association history, and the most in a conference game. Western's 564 passing yards was also a single-game record, as was its 713 yards of offense. The teams combined for a record 1,285 yards of offense (Western – 713, Lindenwood – 572), as well as a record 747 combined passing yards (Western – 564, Lindenwood – 183). The 87 combined points tied for the second-most in a conference game in Association annals.

HENRY THE XV

Western Illinois WR MATTHEW HENRY set Big South-OVC Association single-game records in Week 9 at Lindenwood with his 15 receptions and 226 receiving yards. His catch total bettered Southeast Missouri WR CAM PEDRO's total of 12 the same day vs. Gardner-Webb, while the 226 receiving yards surpassed the old Association record of 204, set by Charleston Southern's NOAH JENNINGS last season vs. Robert Morris. Henry's teammate ELI ARAGON finished the Lindenwood game with 132 yards receiving, marking the first time in Association history that a member had a 200-yard and 100-yard receiver in the same contest.

BOOGIE FEVER

Tennessee State's **BOOGIE TROTTER** has amassed a Big South-OVC Association single-season record 151 interception return yards on his three picks this season. The old return yardage mark was 85 (Tennessee Tech's **JACQUEZ McGOWAN** in 2023). Trotter is tied for second in the league with his three INTs, which includes a 69-yard pick-six in Week 4 against Tennessee Tech — the fifth-longest interception return in Association history.

LOGAN'S KICK

Lindenwood K **LOGAN SEIBERT** broke his own Big South-OVC Association single-game record for kick scoring with 17 points in the Lions' 29-14 win over Charleston Southern in Week 7. He converted an Association single-game record five field goals along with two PATs to surpass his previous mark of 16 points vs. St. Thomas in Week 4.

KICKIN' PIPPIN

Southeast Missouri K **DC PIPPIN** has made a Big South-OVC Association single-season record 20 field goals, which leads all of FCS. He has five 10-point kicking games this season, as well as four games with at least three field goals made. Pippin's 87 points scored kicking to date has shattered the old Associaton single-season mark of 73 (UT Martin's **AIDAN LAROS** in 2023).

TIGERS DEN

Tennessee State is tied for the lead in all of FCS with 73 tackles-for-loss and 8.1 TFL per game. Based on that average, the Tigers are on pace to finish the regular-season with 97.3 TFL, which would match the Big South-OVC Association single-season record of 97, set by Gardner-Webb in 2023. TSU has recorded at least 10 stops behind the line of scrimmage three times this season, including a season-high 13 in the opener against Mississippi Valley State.

RETURN TO SENDER

Southeast Missouri PR KHALANI RIDDICK is the Big South-OVC Association single-season record-holder for punt return yards, as his current total of 204 surpassed the previous mark of 196 (Gardner-Webb's MALEEK HUGGINS last year). Riddick's 19 punt returns trail Higgins' season-record of 22. Meanwhile, UT Martin's OSHAE BAKER is fifth in the nation with his 15.42 punt return average, which is pacing ahead of the Association-record of 11.54 yards per return (SEMO's DALYN McDONALD).

BLOOMING

Eastern Illinois RB MJ FLOWERS has 41 receptions out of the backfield this season, a Big South-OVC Association single-season record for a running back. He ranks eighth in the league, and surpassed his own conference record of 35 catches that he set last season. In Week 6, Flowers tied the then-Big South-OVC single-game record with his 11 receptions against SEMO. That total is the most-ever by an Association running back. Meanwhile, Flowers' 86 receiving yards against Western Illinois this past week broke the league's running back single-game mark of 84 that was first established by Gardner-Webb's EDWARD SAYDEE in Week 9.

WHAT CAN BROWN DO FOR YOU?

Charleston Southern P **GILBERT BROWN** posted an Association single-game record 61.0 punting average, based on 3-4 punts, at Tennessee State in Week 5. He booted kicks of 72, 68, 51 and 53, against the Tigers. Brown, who recorded a 74-yard punt against Gardner-Webb this past week, ranks third in the nation with his league-leading 46.94 season punting average, which is just behind the single-season league record of 47.27 yards, set last year by UT Martin's **AIDAN LAROS**.

RUSH WEEK

Charleston Southern RB **AUTAVIUS ISON** rushed for a school-record 229 yards in Week 6 against Western Illinois — now the fourth-highest single-game rushing total in Big South-OVC Association history, and at the time was just the fifth 200-yard rushing effort in the brief history of the Association. Ison's performance surpassed the old CSU record of 226, which was set by **ANDRE COPELAND** on Oct. 15, 2005 vs. West Virginia Wesleyan. Meanwhile, **TYSON GREENWADE** added 102 yards on the ground against the Leathernecks — marking the first time a Big South-OVC squad had a 200-yard and 100-yard rusher in the same game, and the duo's 331 combined yards established an Association single-game record.

SEE OF RED

SEMO recorded the Association's first-ever win featuring a ranked Big South-OVC team against a ranked non-conference opponent, as the then-No. 21/21 Redhawks won at then-No. 7/7 Southern Illinois, 38-21, in Week 4. It was just the second-ever head-to-head match-up of a ranked Big South-OVC squad against a ranked out-of-conference foe, as the first was between the same two squads last season.

UT MARTIN SKIES PAST KENNESAW STATE FOR ASSOCIATION'S FIRST FBS VICTORY

UT Martin pulled off the Association's first-ever FBS victory in Week 5, as the Skyhawks downed Kennesaw State, 24-13, for the program's second all-time win over an FBS foe. The league was close to scoring another three FBS triumphs earlier this season, as Tennessee Tech (7 points) and Gardner-Webb (7 and 1 point) suffered one possession losses to Bowl Subdivision opponents back in September.

UT MARTIN SETS ASSOCIATION RECORD FOR FEWEST NET RUSHING YARDS ALLOWED

In its Week 2 match-up with Southeast Missouri, UT Martin limited the Redhawks to minus-11 net rushing yards, a Big South-OVC Association single-game record. It was the first time a league member did not allow positive rushing yards in a contest, and surpassed the previous record of five (5) net rushing yards allowed, which was also set by UTM against SEMO last season on Nov. 11.

NATIONAL BAROMETER

The Association is 11-10 against non-conference FCS opponents, which includes two wins among six contests against nationally-ranked foes. Charleston Southern earned the league's first victory of the season against a Top 25 squad when the Buccaneers defeated then-No. 15/16 Furman, 24-20, in Week 2. Two weeks later, SEMO downed then-No. 7/7 Southern Illinois for the Association's first-ever triumph over a Top 10 progam.

WEBB SPINNERS

Gardner-Webb is the first Big South-OVC member to have two 100-yard rushers in a game twice in the same season. In Week 8, **QUASEAN HOLMES** (156) and **EDWARD SAYDEE** (119) each eclipsed the century mark on the ground in GWU's win over Lindenwood — the eighth-highest combined rushing yards by two teammates in league annals (275). In Week 4 at Presbyterian, **CARSON GRESOCK** (134 yards) and Holmes (132) each surpassed 100 rush yards in the contest. The duo also combined for five rushing touchdowns in the victory over the Blue Hose, as Gresock had three scores followed by Holmes' two.

HOUSE CALLS

Lindenwood WR JEFF CALDWELL is the Big South-OVC Association single-season record-holder for touchdown receptions with 9, breaking his own record of 8 set in 2023. In Week 5, he had a Big South-OVC single-game record-tying four touchdown receptions at Eastern Illinois. Caldwell is the Big South-OVC leader with 834 receiving yards, and is averaging a league-best 21.38 yards on his 39 catches. He is pacing ahead of the Association season records of 859 receiving yards and 18.72 yards per catch. Meanwhile, Caldwell is responsible for five of the Association's longest pass plays in history:

AT FIRST GLANTZ

Lindenwood QB **NATE GLANTZ** became just the second quarterback in Big South-OVC Association history to throw for 100 yards and rush for 100 yards in the same game when he achieved the feat in the Lions' 29-14 victory over Charleston Southern in Week 7. He passed for 152 yards and gained a team-high 103 yards on the ground to account for 255 of Lindenwood's 392 offensive yards vs. the Bucs.

BANG FOR YOUR BUC

Charleston Southern's defense recorded two defensive touchdowns at Lindenwood in Week 7, marking just the fourth time in Big South-OVC history a member tallied multiple defensive TDs in a game. **TRAYSON FOWLER** returned an interception 34 yards for a score, and **Ja'KOBE NORTH** picked up a fumble and returned it 47 yards for a score three plays and :14 seconds later. CSU is just the second Association squad with an interception and fumble return TD in the same contest.

AROUND THE ASSOCIATION...

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Buccaneers suffered their fourth 1-possession defeat of the season with its 17-14 loss to Gardner-Webb this past Saturday. The Bucs rallied from a 17-7 deficit when **KALEB JACKSON** scored from 3-yards out with :26 seconds remaining. After CSU recovered the ensuing onside kick, the Buccaneers got within field goal range for a chance to tie, but the 30-yard try was wide right.

EASTERN ILLINOIS

QB **PIERCE HOLLEY** has thrown for 300 yards in five consecutive games, the longest 300-yard passing streak in Association history. Holley has thrown for 326-366-338-348-338 in that span (=1,716) for an average of 343.2, with 12 TD passes. He is second in the Association this season with 2,370 passing yards and 263.3 passing yards per game ... TE **ALEX GINNEVER** became the first tight end in Association history with a 100-yard receiving game, as he caught six passes for 100 yards and two scores in the Panthers' win over Western Illinois last week.

GARDNER-WEBB

RB **EDWARD SAYDEE** has been GWU's top rusher in seven of nine games this season following his teamhigh 86 rushing yards at Charleston Southern last week. He scored on a 44-yard run on the second play of the second half to help the Runnin' Bulldogs clinch the North-South BBQ Bowl trophy ... Gardner-Webb plays its next two games at home, its lone back-to-back contests at Spangler Stadium this season.

LINDENWOOD

Lindenwood was held to its fewest points against an FCS opponent this season (10) in last week's loss at Tennessee Tech. The Lions were also held to their fewest rushing yards of the season (68), and second-lowest offensive output (249) in the setback ... NATE GLANTZ connected with DARRIN FUGITT on a 23-yard pass play for his third-straight game with a TD pass, and sixth game with a TD pass in his last seven contests.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI

SEMO's No. 6 national ranking is the program's highest ever (previous best was No. 7 in 2010) ... QB **PAXTON DELAURENT** had recorded four-straight 300-yard passing games, as he has thrown for 364-418-335-312 in that span (=1,429 / 357.25 average). His six 300-yard passing games this season have come in his last seven outings ... The Redhawks allowed just 274 yards of offense in their Week 9 win over Gardner-Webb -- the fifth game holding 2024 opponents below 300 offensive yards. SEMO leads the Big South-OVC in total defense at 305.11 and scoring defense at 18.67, and its 109.56 rushing defense is 13th nationally.

TENNESSEE STATE

Tennessee State rallied from a 21-O deficit to UT Martin to get within seven points at 21-14 following the first quarter. The Tigers got back within seven points at 28-21 when **JALAL DEAN** caught a 2-yard touchdown pass from **DRAYLEN ELLIS** with 1:09 remaining in the third quarter. Dean and **KARATE BRENSON** each caught 11 passes from Ellis. Dean had 118 receiving yards while Brenson tallied 86. Ellis finished the day 33-of-53 passing for 312 yards and two TDs ... **C.J. EVANS** has returned two of his eight kickoffs for touchdowns, and is averaging 44.38 yards on his kickoff returns this season (8 for 355).

TENNESSEE TECH

Tennessee Tech posted its second 52-point game of the season on Saturday in defeating Lindenwood, 52-10. The Golden Eagles gained a season-high 519 yards of offense and averaged 8.95 yards per play in the victory. Tech scored five rushing touchdowns and were led on the ground by **JALEN MITCHELL'**s season-high 128 yards. Mitchell has rushed for 308 yards in his last three games (102.7 average) ... TTU ranks second in the Big South-OVC in rushing defense at 94.78 yards allowed, which is fifth in the nation.

UT MARTIN

The Skyhawks jumped out to a 21-0 first quarter lead at Tennessee State and held off the Tigers for the 28-21 victory — UTM's fifth-straight win. QB KINKEAD DENT threw three TD passes for the second-straight game and has nine scoring strikes in his last four appearances … DEVONTE TANKSLEY, ZOE ROBERTS and SCOTTIE ALEXANDER each caught his first touchdown pass of the season in the TSU game … RB PATRICK SMITH has been UTM's leading rusher in all nine games, and leads the Association with 909 rushing yards. That total is more than three league members' season output this year. His Association-record for consecutive games with a touchdown was snapped at 7 against the Tigers.

WESTERN ILLINOIS

The Leathernecks are averaging 37.7 points and 518.0 yards of offense in their last three games, and have surpassed 30 points in six of their last seven contests ... RB **CAMEREN SMITH** takes over the Association's active streak for consecutive games with a touchdown at 6, as he has nine TDs in that span (six rushing, three receiving) ... QB **NATHAN LAMB** is second in the conference in total offense with 280.67 per game, while his 263 rushing yards are the most among Big South-OVC quarterbacks.

1. TRANSITIONING SCHOOLS

a. To be eligible for the conference's automatic bid to the FCS Football Championship, a school must be a full Division I member.

b. Transitioning schools will be utilized in the tiebreaker process.

c. If a transitioning school is involved in a two-way tie, the tied team that is eligible for postseason competition shall be the league's recipient of the automatic bid.

d. If a transitioning school wins the multi-team tiebreaker, the procedure would start over with the remaining teams.

2. TWO-WAY TIE

a. If the two teams played each other during the conference season, the winner of the head-to-head contest shall be the league's recipient of the automatic bid.

b. If the tied teams did not play each other during the conference season, each team's head-to-head record against all common opponents in the league will be used to determine the automatic hid

c. If a tie still exists, then each team's record against the next highest common opponent in the league standings will be used to determine the automatic bid. When arriving at a group of tied teams that each team has played, composite records between the tied teams shall be utilized to determine if one of the tied teams has won more games against the group of tied teams.

d. If the teams are still tied, a point system will be utilized based on a complete schedule and wins using Massey rankings entering the final day of the regular season, as indicated below.

e. Should the points system finish in a tie, the tied team with the best Massey rating on the final day of the regular season (i.e., Saturday morning) will receive the automatic bid.

3. MULTIPLE TIES

a. If at any point, a tie is broken using the multiple-tie tiebreaker procedures and only two teams remain, the remaining teams will revert to the two-way tiebreaker (head-to-head).

b. If the tied teams all played each other during the conference season, the team with the best cumulative record involving games with the tied teams shall be declared champion. For example, if a team is 2-0 against two other tied teams, that team will be declared champion.

c. If the tied teams all played one another and have identical records against the other tied teams, then each team's record against all common opponents in the league will be used to determine the automatic bid. If teams are still tied, then each team's record against the next highest common opponent in the league standings will be used to determine the automatic bid.

d. If the tied teams did not play each other, then each team's record against all common opponents in the league will be used to determine the automatic bid. If the teams are still tied, and they did not play each other, then each team's record against the next highest common opponent in the league standings will be used to determine the automatic bid.

 If the teams are still tied, a point system will be utilized based on a complete schedule and wins using Massey rankings entering the final day of the regular season, as indicated below.

f. Should the points system finish in a tie, the tied team with the best Massey rating on the final day of the regular season (i.e., Saturday morning) will receive the automatic bid.
