2-MINUTE OFFENSE

OPENING KICKOFF: The second season of the Big South-OVC Football Association kicked off with the league's first Week O appearance this past Saturday, as South-east Missouri downed former Big South football member North Alabama, 37-15, in the FCS Kickoff in Montgomery, Ala. Year 2 of the Association is comprised of nine members, with Western Illinois making its Association debut this season. The 2024 conference schedule features every team playing each other for an 8-game league slate.

Ist DOWN: All nine Big South-OVC squads will play in Week 1. Three contests are Thursday night openers, while six of the nine total match-ups on the schedule are against FBS opponents. Week 2 features the first Association game of the season when SEMO hosts UT Martin.

2nd DOWN: The Big South-OVC 2024 Preseason Players of the Year are Eastern Illinois QB PIERCE HOLLEY (Offense) and Southeast Missouri LB BRYCE NORMAN (Defense) Holley is among the WALTER PAYTON Award Preseason Watch List candidates, while Norman is a preseason All-American and BUCK BUCHANAN Award Preseason Watch List member.

3rd DOWN: The Association welcomes three new head coaches in 2024 — **CRIS REISERT** (Gardner-Webb), **BOBBY WILDER** (Tennessee Tech) and **JOE DAVIS** (Western Illinois). Davis was EIU's Offensive Coordinator in 2022-23.

4th DOWN: Eight of the nine Association members will play 13 total games against FBS opponents this fall, with five squads playing two -- EIU, GWU, TTU, UTM and WIU.

ABOUT THE BIG SOUTH-OVC FOOTBALL ASSOCIATION

This is the second season of the Big South-OVC Football Association. On Feb. 22, 2022, the Big South Conference and Ohio Valley Conference announced the creation of an association of their football member institutions that began play with the 2023 NCAA Division I football season. The initial agreement of at least four years was enhanced on June 12, 2024 that will provide an opportunity to extend the original partnership through 2030 and beyond. The unique agreement combines the two conferences' football membership to ensure NCAA championship access and stability for the multisport conferences. In creating the association, presidents from each of the multisport conferences pointed to the similarities of the OVC and the Big South, with their complementary geographies and intercollegiate athletic philosophies, as key to making this association possible.

SLANT ROUTES

- * CHARLESTON SOUTHERN: The Buccaneers are opening the season at home for the third-straight year, and are looking to start 1-0 for the second consecutive season ... CSU's Week 1 match-up vs. The Citadel has been dubbed the "Lowcountry Boil Bowl" as the crosstown rivalry continues.
- * EASTERN ILLINOIS: The Panthers are looking to start 1-0 for the second consecutive season ... EIU carries a four-game win streak into Week 1's contest at Illinois.
- * GARDNER-WEBB: The Runnin' Bulldogs are opening the season at home for the first time since 2022, which was also the last time GWU opened 1-0 ... Gardner-Webb is seeking its first victory over Wofford since 2014.
- * LINDENWOOD: The Lions are playing their first-ever FBS opponent in Week 1 ... Kansas will mark the first of four first-time foes for Lindenwood this season.
- * SOUTHEAST MISSOURI: The Redhawks are 1-0 for the first time since 2019 ... Southeast Missouri is opening the season with two games away from home.
- * TENNESSEE STATE: The Tigers are looking to start 1-O for the first time since 2019 -- which was also against Mississippi Valley State ... TSU is ranked No. 8 in the preseason HBCU Coaches poll, and received votes in the HBCU media poll.
- * TENNESSEE TECH: The Golden
 Eagles are opening the season on the
 road for the fourth-straight year, and
 second time at an FBS opponent in
 three seasons ... TTU will face backto-back FBS members in the first two
 weeks of the 2024 campaign.
- * UT MARTIN: The Skyhawks are opening the season at a nationally-ranked FBS member for the second-straight year ... Kansas State will be UTM's lone first-time foe of 2024.
- * WESTERN ILLINOIS: The Leathernecks are opening the campaign at an FBS foe for the second-straight year ... WIU will face consecutive FBS members in the first two weeks of the season, while playing its first three contests of 2024 on the road.

1. TRANSITIONING SCHOOLS

a. To be eligible for the conference's automatic bid to the FCS Football Championship, a school must be a full Division I member.

b. Transitioning schools will be utilized in the tiebreaker process.

c. If a transitioning school is involved in a two-way tie, the tied team that is eligible for postseason competition shall be the league's recipient of the automatic bid.

d. If a transitioning school wins the multi-team tiebreaker, the procedure would start over with the remaining teams.

2. TWO-WAY TIE

a. If the two teams played each other during the conference season, the winner of the head-to-head contest shall be the league's recipient of the automatic bid.

b. If the tied teams did not play each other during the conference season, each team's head-to-head record against all common opponents in the league will be used to determine the automatic bid.

c. If a tie still exists, then each team's record against the next highest common opponent in the league standings will be used to determine the automatic bid. When arriving at a group of tied teams that each team has played, composite records between the tied teams shall be utilized to determine if one of the tied teams has won more games against the group of tied teams.

d. If the teams are still tied, a point system will be utilized based on a complete schedule and wins using Massey rankings entering the final day of the regular season, as indicated below.

e. Should the points system finish in a tie, the tied team with the best Massey rating on the final day of the regular season (i.e., Saturday morning) will receive the automatic bid.

3. MULTIPLE TIES

a. If at any point, a tie is broken using the multiple-tie tiebreaker procedures and only two teams remain, the remaining teams will revert to the two-way tiebreaker (head-to-head).

b. If the tied teams all played each other during the conference season, the team with the best cumulative record involving games with the tied teams shall be declared champion. For example if a team is 2–0 against two other tied teams, that team will be declared champion.

c. If the tied teams all played one another and have identical records against the other tied teams then each team's record against all common opponents in the league will be used to determine the automatic bid. If teams are still tied, then each team's record against the next highest common opponent in the league standings will be used to determine the automatic bid.

d. If the tied teams did not play each other, then each team's record against all common opponents in the league will be used to determine the automatic bid. If the teams are still tied, and they did not play each other, then each team's record against the next highest common opponent in the league standings will be used to determine the automatic bid.

e. If the teams are still tied, a point system will be utilized based on a complete schedule and wins using Massey rankings entering the final day of the regular season, as indicated below.

f. Should the points system finish in a tie, the tied team with the best Massey rating on the final day of the regular season (i.e., Saturday morning) will receive the automatic bid.
