* **CHARLESTON SOUTHERN:** The Buccaneers are looking to snap a 13-game losing streak in Association games ... CSU is seeking its first road win since Sept. 7, 2024 (won at Furman).

* **EASTERN ILLINOIS:** The Panthers are seeking to win three of their first four Association games for the first time ... EIU last defeated SEMO in 2017 (W, 19-16 at home).

* **GARDNER-WEBB:** The Runnin' Bulldogs are looking to start 3-0 in Association games for the first time, and last opened 3-0 in conference games in 2022 (5-0 in Big South) ... GWU last defeated UTM in 2023 (W, 38-34 at home).

* **LINDENWOOD:** The Lions are looking to start 3-0 in Association games for the first time, and last opened 3-0 in conference games in 2021 (7-0 in GLVC) ... Lindenwood is seeking its sixth consecutive home victory on Saturday.

* **SOUTHEAST MISSOURI:** The Redhawks carry a five-game Association home winning streak into Saturday's contest ... Southeast Missouri has won the last seven meetings with EIU, and has not lost at home in the series since 2014.

* **TENNESSEE STATE:** The Tigers are meeting Howard for the second-straight year and third time overall. TSU won last season's match-up in DC, 27-14, and claimed the first-ever meeting in 2001 (W, 45-0 at home).

* **TENNESSEE TECH:** The Golden Eagles are looking to start 4-0 in Association games for the first time ... Tech won last year's meeting with Lindenwood, 52-10 at home on Nov. 2.

* **UT MARTIN:** The Skyhawks are looking to avoid back-to-back road losses in Association games for the first time ... UTM last defeated Gardner-Webb in 2024 (W, 35-17 at home).

* **WESTERN ILLINOIS:** The Leathernecks are looking to avoid starting 0-4 in Association games for the first time ... The program's 31-20 triumph over Charleston Southern last season was WIU's first-ever OVC-Big South conference game (Oct. 5, 2024).

2-MINUTE OFFENSE

OPENING KICKOFF: Tennessee Tech is ranked No. 8/8 this week, marking the 20th consecutive week that an Association member has appeared in the National Top 25 poll -- extending a league record that began Sept. 16, 2024. Meanwhile, Tennessee Tech reached its highest ranking ever last week in the I-AA/FCS era (since 1978) at No. 7, and is just the second program in Association history to be ranked inside the Top 10 (SEMO in 2024).

1st DOWN: Tennessee Tech is the first team in the Association's brief history to open a season 6-0, and is one of seven FCS programs at least 6-0 at this point of the 2025 season. It is Tech's first 6-0 start since 1977 (started 8-0). The Golden Eagles' current 11-game win streak is the longest active streak in the Football Championship Subdivision, and is the longest overall winning streak in the Association's three years of existence.

2nd DOWN: Tennessee Tech has won seven-straight conference games, the longest conference-game win streak in the Association's three seasons of existence. The previous record was five.

3rd DOWN: Tennessee Tech leads the FCS in scoring offense (51.7 points per game) and rushing defense (51.2 yards allowed), and ranks third in both total offense (509.7 yards per game) and total defense (243.0).

4th DOWN: Gardner-Webb recorded eight sacks and 15 tackles-for-loss in last week's win at Eastern Illinois -- the second-most single-game totals in Association history. GWU holds both of those records as well -- 11 quarterback takedowns vs. EIU in 2024, and 18 stops behind the line-of-scrimmage at Tennessee Tech in 2023. Gardner-Webb ranks 13th nationally in sacks (2.83 per game) and 12th in TFL per game (7.2).

ABOUT THE OVC-Big South Football Association

This is the third season of the OVC-Big South Football Association. On Feb. 22, 2022, the Big South Conference and Ohio Valley Conference announced the creation of an association of their football member institutions that began play with the 2023 NCAA Division I football season. The initial agreement of at least four years was enhanced on June 12, 2024 that will provide an opportunity to extend the original partnership through 2030 and beyond. The unique agreement combines the two conferences' football membership to ensure NCAA championship access and stability for the multisport conferences. In creating the association, presidents from each of the multisport conferences pointed to the similarities of the OVC and the Big South, with their complementary geographies and intercollegiate athletic philosophies, as key to making this association possible.

OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Jase Bauer, UT Martin, QB • 6-2, 215, Sr. • Ankeny, Iowa

Bauer accounted for 260 yards of total offense and three touchdowns as UT Martin topped Western Illinois 32-31. The senior completed 19-of-28 passes for 235 yards and a touchdown and rushed for 24 yards and two additional scores. He connected on a 10-yard passing touchdown in the second quarter before tallying a pair of two-yard rushing scores in the fourth, as UTM overcame an 11-point deficit. On the final drive Bauer completed a 34-yard pass and followed that with a 29-yard strike to set up his team on the two-yard line. He currently ranks sixth nationally in completion percentage (70.1%).

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Cahari Haynes, Gardner-Webb, LB • 6-3, 217, R-So. • Shelby, N.C.

Haynes made eight tackles (five solo), 2.5 tackles for loss (for -12 yards), 1.5 sacks (for -11 yards) and a quarterback hurry as Gardner-Webb won 21-10 at Eastern Illinois. With the victory the Runnin' Bulldogs remained undefeated in the OVC-Big South (2-0) and also against FCS opponents (4-0) this season. He helped anchor a stingy defense that limited the Panthers to just 229 yards of total offense.

SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Cade Hechter, UT Martin, K • 6-2, 245, R-Sr. • Sydney, Australia

Hechter made a pair of field goals and a pair of extra points as UT Martin topped Western Illinois 32-31 on Homecoming. The senior connected from 28-yards out with 7:43 to play in the first half and added a 41-yarder just before the break to pull the Skyhawks within one point at halftime. Hechter ranks ninth nationally in field goal percentage (87.5%).

CO-FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

Johnny Weber, Southeast Missouri, QB • 6-5, 213 R-Fr. • Kenosha, Wis.

Pressed into his first career start after Southeast Missouri lost its top two quarterbacks to injury in its last game, Weber led the Redhawks to a 28-12 home victory over Tennessee State, as the team snapped a three-game losing streak. Weber completed 24-of-39 passes (to eight different receivers) for 283 yards and two touchdowns in the win. He had a nine-yard touchdown pass in the first quarter and added a 10-yarder early in the fourth quarter to put the game out of reach.

Cason Carswell, Western Illinois, QB • 6-3, 190, Fr. • Mason, Mich.

Carswell earned the honor for the second-straight week after passing for 327 yards and a pair of touchdowns as Western Illinois came up just short at UT Martin. In his second career start, the freshman completed 21-of-30 passes without an interception and also had four carries for five yards. At the end of the game, with his team down one point, he drove the Leathernecks 45 yards in seven plays, before the team's potential game-winning field goal was blocked.

ASSOCIATION 30 FOR 30

What if I told you that the winning team in nine of the 12 Association conference games played thus far scored at least 30 points in their respective victories? The winning team has scored 35, 31, 35, 34, 66, 30, 30, 31, 21, 32, 28 and 27 points for an average of 30.83 points. The average margin of victory after 12 games is 17.25, as eight of the 12 contests have been decided by double-digits. In addition, Tennessee Tech's 46-point triumph over Western Illinois in Week 6 was the highest win margin for a conference game in Association history. The previous high was 42 points (Tennessee Tech 52, Lindenwood 10 on Nov. 2, 2024).

TASK FORCE

Charleston Southern's defense has forced 14 fumbles this season, breaking the OVC-Big South single-season record of 13 that was shared by Eastern Illinois (2013) and Lindenwood (2014). The Bucs have forced multiple fumbles in a game five times this year, including three in a contest three times (at Coastal Carolina, vs. South Carolina State and at Gardner-Webb). In addition, **JUSTIN WATERS** owns seven forced fumbles, which is also an Association single-season mark. He ranks first nationally with 1.0 forced fumbles per game.

CARSON WILL SOCK IT TO YOU

Gardner-Webb RB **CARSON GRESOCK** became just the third player in Association history with two 50-yard touchdown runs in the same game when he achieved the feat this past week at Eastern Illinois. He first scored on a 64-yard run, and added a 55-yard scoring rush eight minutes later. Gresock joins Lindenwood's **STEVE HALL** (75, 94 vs. WIU in 2024) and Tennessee State's **KENDRIC RHYMES** (60, 51 vs. N.C. A&T this season) with this distinction. Meanwhile, Gresock has 467 rushing yards on just 52 carries this season for an average yards per carry of 8.98 -- including 312 yards in his last 27 carries (=11.56 ypc) over the last three games.

HIGH FLYING

The Tennessee Tech Golden Eagles have scored 310 points in their first six games, which included an Association-conference game record 66 points against Western Illinois in Week 6. TTU is the first team in Association history with three 60-point games in a season, while its 310 points **ALREADY RANK** 9th-most in a single-season in Association annals. The Golden Eagles are 38 points away from the Top 5 in the league's three seasons of existence. Earlier this season, TTU was the first team in Association history to score at least 40 points in three consecutive games, as the Golden Eagles started the year with 65, 45 and 72 points. The 72 points against Davidson in Week 3 was an Association-record against a Division I opponent. In addition, TTU amassed three-straight games with 500-plus offensive yards (570-513-576), establishing another Association record for most consecutive games with 500 yards of total offense.

NOAH'S ARK

Tennessee Tech WR **NOAH ROBINSON** is tied for the Association lead with five touchdown receptions, which came in three-straight games during Weeks 3-6. During the league's inaugural season of 2023, Robinson caught six TD passes when he played for Robert Morris, and his six career 100-yard reception games during his time in the Association (5-RMU, 1-TTU) are tied for the most in OVC-Big South annals.

RUSH HOUR

Eastern Illinois and Gardner-Webb are the only Association teams to have three different players with a 100-yard rushing game this year. For EIU, **COLE LACRUE** (193 in Week 1), **CHARLES KELLUM** (133 in Week 1) and **JACARRE FLEMING** (111 in Week 5) have eclipsed the century mark, while **NATE HAMPTON** (132 in Week 1), **QUASEAN HOLMES** (116 in Week 1) and **CARSON GRESOCK** (105 in Week 6, 137 in Week 7) have the rushing trifecta for the Runnin' Bulldogs. GWU is second in the conference with 208.8 rushing yards per game, while EIU sits third at 165.2.

LIFE BEGINS AT FORTY

Western Illinois PK **ANTONIO CHADHA** ranks second all-time in Association history with 11 field goals made from 40-plus yards. He converted a 48-yarder at Tennessee Tech in Week 6 to move into sole possession of second-place on the league's career list, and is three behind record-holder **DC PIPPIN** of Southeast Missouri, who made 14 field goals from 40-yards or longer during his time in the Association from 2023-24. Chadha is 3-of-5 from 40-49 yards this season, with makes from 48 (twice) and 49 yards.

AGENTS OF SHIELD

Tennessee Tech QB **JACE WILSON** connected with WR **LUKE SHIELDS** on the longest pass play in Association history in Week 6 -- a 94-yard score against Western Illinois that is now the longest play from scrimmage in the league's record book. The previous longest pass play was 93 yards.

BIRDS OF PREY

Tennessee Tech has recorded an interception in each game this season with eight total picks, tied for eighth-most in the FCS, and has three INT returns for touchdowns, tied with Eastern Kentucky, Furman and Tarleton State for the most in the nation -- and the second-most in a season in the Association record book. The Golden Eagles have returned multiple interceptions for touchdowns in all three seasons of the Association's existence, and is the first Association member with pick-6's in consecutive games -- having done so in three-straight contests (Weeks 3, 5 and 6).

SPEED DIAL CALLS TO THE HOUSE

Tennessee Tech's **ANDREW SMITH** has tied the OVC-Big South Association single-season record with two interception return touchdowns, which came in back-to-back games. In Week 5, Smith had a 94-yard pick-six at Tennessee State, the longest interception return in Association history and breaking the previous record of 85 yards, achieved by TTU's **JACQUEZ MCGOWAN** in 2023 against North Alabama. In Week 6 against Western Illinois, Smith returned an INT 16 yards for a score, and his 110 interception return yards this season are second-most in a campaign in the league's three-year history.

FOUR OVC-BIG SOUTH PLAYERS NAMED SEMIFINALISTS FOR CAMPBELL TROPHY

Charleston Southern LB **NICK BARTALO**, Eastern Illinois LS **BRETT GALLETTI**, Tennessee Tech WR **TREMEL JONES** and Western Illinois DB **CHRISTIAN PIERCE** were named among the 44 Semifinalists for the 2025 **WILLIAM V. CAMPBELL** Trophy last week, college football's premier scholar-athlete award presented by the National Football Foundation & College Football Hall of Fame. The NFF will announce 12-16 finalists on Oct. 22.

RUNNING BUC

Charleston Southern RB **Ke'MARION BALDWIN** is tied for the OVC-Big South Association lead with six rushing touchdowns, which includes an 89-yarder at Gardner-Webb in Week 6 -- the second-longest rush from scrimmage in Association history. Five of Baldwin's six scores this season have been double-digit distances, as he has reached the end zone from 39, 26, 10, 1, 89 and 14 yards out for a touchdown-run average of 29.83 yards. Baldwin rushed for 175 yards at GWU, and is second among the league leaders with 488 rushing yards.

TECHIES

Tennessee Tech has scored 43 touchdowns through five contests (7.2 per game), and **QUINTELL QUINN** reached the end zone in each of the first five games. A total of 16 different players have scored a touchdown for the Golden Eagles this year -- tying the Association single-season team record for most players with a touchdown. That mark was first set by Gardner-Webb in 2023 and matched by UT Martin in 2024. Tech's 43 overall TDs this season are already seventh-most in a single-season in league history. The overall touchdown record is 57 by UT Martin last year.

CATCH ALL

UT Martin WR **BRYCE BAILEY** is the first wide receiver and second non-quarterback in OVC-Big South Association history to rush, catch and throw a touchdown in a season during the league's brief existence. He became just the fourth non-QB in Association history to throw a touchdown pass in a game, but the first to do so against an FBS opponent when he connected with RB **JOHN GENTRY** on a 39-yard scoring play at Oklahoma State in Week 1. Bailey, who is 2-of-3 passing for 54 yards and a score this season, rushed for a touchdown in Week 2, and caught two touchdowns passes vs. Southeast Missouri in Week 5. The first non-QB with the rush-catch-throw TD trifecta was Robert Morris tight end **CHAESE JACKSON** in 2023.

QUICK GLANTZ

Lindenwood QB **NATE GLANTZ** was the only Association signal-caller to throw for 200-plus passing yards AND a TD pass in the first four games of the 2025 season. In Week 4, he became the second QB in Association history with a 200-yard passing (249) & 100-yard rushing (104) game against Stony Brook. In Week 6, Glantz recorded the longest rush ever by an Association QB when he scampered 59 yards in the Lions' victory over UT Martin. The previous long by a quarterback was 56 yards (Gardner-Webb's **JAYLEN KING** in 2023).

QUARTERBACK VISPERER

Tennessee Tech QB **KEKOA VISPERAS** amassed an Association season-high 431 yards of total offense (358 passing, 73 rushing) against Western Illinois in Week 6, the fourth-highest single-game total in Association history, and the third-most in a conference game. He leads the league with 264.50 total offensive yards per game, which ranks 18th in the nation.

HOLTZ ON

Gardner-Webb LB **ROBERT HOLTZ** leads the Association with 10.0 tackles-for-loss, tied for fifth-most in the nation, and his 1.43 TFL per game are also fifth in the FCS. Holtz has recorded multi-TFL in three games this season -- including 3.0 in each of the past two contests. He is also the league leader with 6.0 sacks.

SPECIAL AGENT

Lindenwood R-Freshman WR **RICO BOND** shares the Association lead with five receiving TDs and is fourth with 28 receptions, while his 355 receiving yards rank eighth. During a three-game span during Weeks 2-4, Bond caught 20 passes for 274 yards and four touchdowns, and reached the end zone in all three contests.

ACE IN THE HOLMAN

Western Illinois RB **MARKELL HOLMAN** leads the Association with 515 rushing yards, and has been the Leathernecks' leading rusher in all seven games this season. He recorded back-to-back 100-yard games with 139 against Valparaiso in Week 3, and 118 at Eastern Washington in Week 4.

SUPER SIZE COMBO

Southeast Missouri (569) and Southern Illinois (612) combined for 1,181 yards of total offense in Week 4, the second-most combined total offense in a game in the Association record book, and the most combined offensive yards for a non-conference contest.

JUMPING JAX

Southeast Missouri QB **JAX LEATHERWOOD** threw for an OVC-Big South season-high 422 yards in Week 4 against nationally-ranked Southern Illinois, the fifth-highest single-game passing yards in Association history.

HUNGRY LIKE A WOLF

Eastern Illinois freshman QB **CONNOR WOLF** threw for 411 yards against Illinois State in Week 3, the most by a freshman in Association history, and at the time was the sixth-most in a game in the league's brief existence (now seventh). Wolf also threw four touchdown passes against the Redbirds, becoming the just the fourth different QB in Association era with a 400-yard / 4-TD performance. The others were Southeast Missouri's **PAXTON DeLAURENT** (2 in 2024), Western Illinois' **NATHAN LAMB** (1 in 2024) and Eastern Illinois' **PIERCE HOLLEY** (1 in 2024).

RECEPTIONS

Southeast Missouri receiving tandem **KALVIN GILBERT** (125) and **CAM PEDRO** (105) tallied 100-yard receiving efforts against Southern Illinois in Week 4. It was the fifth time that SEMO had multiple 100-yard receiving individuals in the same game, the most in Association history. Following the Redhawks for most games with two players with 100 yards receiving are Eastern Illinois (3), Western Illinois (3) and Bryant (1).

BULLDOG BITES

Gardner-Webb's 52-45 season-opening win at then-No. 18/19 Western Carolina was the Association's first over a ranked non-conference foe in the regular-season since Sept. 21, 2024, when Southeast Missouri knocked off No. 7/7 Southern Illinois, 38-21. The Association now has five wins over nationally-ranked out-of-conference members in its three-year history, three of which occurred in 2024. Gardner-Webb's 627 yards of offense against the Catamounts were the fourth-most in a single-game in the Association record book.

BACK-PACKING

Eastern Illinois QB **COLE LaCRUE** rushed for 193 yards in Week 1, an Association-record for a quarterback. He threw for 129 yards to become just the third QB in Association history with 100 rushing + passing yards in a game. Two days later, Gardner-Webb's **NATE HAMPTON** became the first with 200 passing + 100 rushing yards in a contest, as he threw for 263 yards and rushed for 132 in GWU's win at Western Carolina. Hampton was also the first QB in Association history with four rushing TDs in a game.

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UT Martin QB **JASE BAUER** became the third Association quarterback this season with 200 passing and 100 rushing yards in a contest after throwing for 225 yards and gaining 107 on the ground in the Skyhawks' victory over Southeast Missouri in Week 5. He joined Gardner-Webb's **NATE HAMPTON** (263 P, 132 R vs. Western Carolina in Week 1) and Lindenwood's **NATE GLANTZ** (249 P, 104 R vs. Stony Brook in Week 4) in the 200-100 club. This season is the first time any Association quarterback has recorded a 200-passing & 100-rushing game.

The Buccaneer defense held Tennessee Tech to its fewest points and second-fewest offensive yards of the season last week ... RB **KeMARION BALDWIN** has rushed for 338 yards in his last three games ... CSU ranks 16th in the nation in kickoff return defense (16.23 average return yards allowed).

EASTERN ILLINOIS

QB **COLE LaCRUE** leads the Panthers with six rushing touchdowns, which is tied for the overall OVC-Big South lead ... EIU did not have a player score multiple TDs in a game for the first time last week, as Eastern Illinois was held to a season-low 10 points in its loss to Gardner-Webb ... The Panthers rank 10th nationally in 4th Down Conversion Defense with a 33.3 percentage allowed.

GARDNER-WEBB

The Runnin' Bulldogs have won four-straight FCS games for the first time since winning five-straight contests to close out the 2023 regular-season ... Gardner-Webb has won four of its last five home games ... GWU's 4-2 start is its best since 2013 (also opened 4-2) ... QB **NATE HAMPTON** has thrown a TD pass in every contest this season, and is averaging a league-best 15.00 yards per completion (83 for 1,245 yards).

LINDENWOOD

The Lions are 3-3 for the first time since 2023, are 2-0 in conference games for the first time since 2021, and have won five-straight home games ... Lindenwood has its first three-game FCS win streak since winning three-straight during the 2022 campaign (defeated Central Arkansas, Eastern Illinois and Murray State from Oct. 8-22) ... Lindenwood is averaging 31.67 points in its three wins, compared to 8.7 points in its three losses (13 total points in two FBS defeats).

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI

The Redhawk defense allowed its fewest points (12) and yardage (282) in last week's win over Tennessee State ... RB **BRANDON EPTON JR.** posted the squad's first multi-touchdown effort of the season in the TSU victory with rushing scores of 36 and 2 yards ... SEMO ranks fifth in FCS in net punting with its 42.59 average.

TENNESSEE STATE

RB **ZACK SIMMONS-BROWN** led the Tigers in rushing in last week's setback at SEMO, the first time this season RB **KENDRIC RHYMES** was not TSU's leading rusher in a game. Simmons-Brown scored Tennessee State's lone touchdown on a 50-yard run early in the fourth quarter ... **KAIKI BAKER** is 11th in the nation with 5.67 solo tackles per game.

TENNESSEE TECH

Tennessee Tech is 6-0 for the third time in program history (1952, 1977, 2025), and its best start since 1977 (8-0) ... TTU's 11-straight wins is the longest winning streak in program history ... The Golden Eagles are 3-0 in conference play for the first time since 2011 ... Through six games in 2025, Tech has rushed for 22 touchdowns and thrown for 16, has outscored the opposition 310 to 73, and has limited foes to 51.2 net rushing yards per game (307 total) ... Dating back to last season, TTU has held its last 10 opponents to less than 100 net rushing yards -- an Association consecutive record.

UT MARTIN

UTM is 15-1 against conference foes at home since 2020 ... In their 32-31 win over Western Illinois last week, the Skyhawks rallied from a double-digit deficit for the first time since Sept. 14, 2024 against North Alabama. Martin trailed WIU, 31-20 with 1:10 left in the third quarter before **JASE BAUER** scored two, 2-yard TD runs in the fourth quarter to lead the comeback win. RB **JOHN GENTRY** became the first Skyhawk running back to surpass 100 rushing yards in a game this season with 104 against the Leathernecks ... The Skyhawks blocked their national-leading fifth kick of the season last Saturday, which was a 48-yard field goal attempt for the potential game-winner.

WESTERN ILLINOIS

QB **CASON CARSWELL** has thrown for more than 300 yards in his last two appearances, and is 71-of-100 (=71.00 percent) passing for 788 yards and six touchdowns in his last three games ... The Leathernecks are tops in the Association and rank 16th in all of FCS in 4th Down Conversion percentage at 66.7.

OVC-Big South Football Tiebreaker Procedure

1. TRANSITIONING SCHOOLS

- To be eligible for the conference's automatic bid to the FCS Football Championship, a school must be a full Division I member.
- Transitioning schools will be utilized in the tiebreaker process.
- If a transitioning school is involved in a two-way tie, the tied team that is eligible for postseason competition shall be the league's recipient of the automatic bid.
- If a transitioning school wins the multi-team tiebreaker, the procedure would start over with the remaining teams.

2. TWO-WAY TIE

- If the two teams played each other during the conference season, the winner of the head-to-head contest shall be the league's recipient of the automatic bid.
- If the tied teams did not play each other during the conference season, each team's head-to-head record against all common opponents in the league will be used to determine the automatic bid.
- If a tie still exists, then each team's record against the next highest common opponent in the league standings will be used to determine the automatic bid. When arriving at a group of tied teams that each team has played, composite records between the tied teams shall be utilized to determine if one of the tied teams has won more games against the group of tied teams.
- If the teams are still tied, a point system will be utilized based on a complete schedule and wins using the NCAA four-metric average ranking for FCS* following all games on the final Saturday of the regular season (and the Massey ranking entering the final day of the regular season for FBS opponents) as indicated below:
- Should the points system finish in a tie, the team with the best ranking in the NCAA four-metric average for FCS* following all games on the final Saturday of the regular season will receive the automatic bid.

3. MULTIPLE TIES

- If at any point, a tie is broken using the multiple-tie tiebreaker procedures and only two teams remain, the remaining teams will revert to the two-way tiebreaker (head-to-head).
- If the tied teams all played each other during the conference season, the team with the best cumulative record involving games with the tied teams shall be declared champion. For example, if a team is 2-0 against two other tied teams, that team will be declared champion.
- If the tied teams all played one another and have identical records against the other tied teams, then each team's record against all common opponents in the league will be used to determine the automatic bid. If teams are still tied, then each team's record against the next highest common opponent in the league standings will be used to determine the automatic bid.
- If the tied teams did not play each other, then each team's record against all common opponents in the league will be used to determine the automatic bid. If the teams are still tied, and they did not play each other, then each team's record against the next highest common opponent in the league standings will be used to determine the automatic bid.
- If the teams are still tied, a point system will be utilized based on a complete schedule and wins using the NCAA four-metric average ranking for FCS* following all games on the final Saturday of the regular season (and the Massey ranking entering the final day of the regular season for FBS opponents) as indicated below:
- Should the points system finish in a tie, the team with the best ranking in the NCAA four-metric average for FCS* following all games on the final Saturday of the regular season will receive the automatic bid.
