# 2-MINUTE OFFENSE

**OPENING KICKOFF:** Tennessee Tech is ranked No. 7/10 this week, marking the 19th consecutive week that an Association member has appeared in the National Top 25 poll — extending a league record that began Sept. 16, 2024. Meanwhile, Tennessee Tech continues to have its highest ranking ever in the I-AA/FCS era (since 1978), and is just the second program in Association history to be ranked in the Top 10 (SEMO in 2024).

**Ist DOWN**: Tennessee Tech is the first team in the Association's brief history to open a season 5–0, and is one of seven FCS programs at least 5–0 at this point of the 2025 season. It is Tech's first 5–0 start since 1977 (started 8–0). The Golden Eagles' current 10–game win streak is the longest active streak in the Football Championship Subdivision, and is the longest overall winning streak in the Association's three years of existence.

**2nd DOWN**: Tennessee Tech has won six-straight conference games, the longest conference-game win streak in the Association's three seasons of existence. The previous record was five.

**3rd DOWN:** Tennessee Tech leads the FCS in scoring offense (56.6 points per game) and rushing defense (48.8 yards allowed), ranks third in total offense (532.2 yards per game) and fourth in total defense (249.8).

4th DOWN: Gardner-Webb won the second annual "North-South BBQ Bowl" over Charleston Southern last Saturday, 30-27, on CHARLES VIOREL'S 48-yard field goal as time expired. GWU held a 10-7 lead entering the fourth quarter before both teams scored 20 points each in the final stanza for the final margin. Viorel tied an Association single-game record with two field goals from 40-plus yards (43, 48).

#### ABOUT THE OVC-BIG SOUTH FOOTBALL ASSOCIATION

This is the third season of the OVC-Big South Football Association. On Feb. 22, 2022, the Big South Conference and Ohio Valley Conference announced the creation of an association of their football member institutions that began play with the 2023 NCAA Division I football season. The initial agreement of at least four years was enhanced on June 12, 2024 that will provide an opportunity to extend the original partnership through 2030 and beyond. The unique agreement combines the two conferences' football membership to ensure NCAA championship access and stability for the multisport conferences. In creating the association, presidents from each of the multisport conferences pointed to the similarities of the OVC and the Big South, with their complementary geographies and intercollegiate athletic philosophies, as key to making this association possible.

### SLANT ROUTES

- \* CHARLESTON SOUTHERN: The Buccaneers are looking to snap a 12-game losing streak in Association games ... CSU last defeated a nationally-ranked program in 2024 (W, 24-20 vs. #15/16 Furman).
- \* EASTERN ILLINOIS: The Panthers are looking to start 3-0 in Association games for the first time, and last opened 3-0 in conference games in 2017 (4-0 in OVC) ... EIU last won three-straight league games in 2023 (final four contests of the season).
- \* GARDNER-WEBB: The Runnin' Bulldogs are looking to start 2-0 in Association games for the first time, and last opened 2-0 in conference games in 2022 (5-0 in Big South) ... GWU won the first-ever meeting with EIU last year on Nov. 9 (31-28 at home).
- \* LINDENWOOD: The Lions are idle this week and return to action next Saturday at home against Tennessee Tech.
- \* SOUTHEAST MISSOURI: The Redhawks are looking to avoid starting 0-2 in Association games for the first time ... SEMO has won the last two meetings with Tennessee State in Cape Girardeau (2021 47-14; 2018 38-21).
- \* TENNESSEE STATE: The Tigers are looking to avoid starting 0-3 in Association games for the first time ... Tennessee State won last year's meeting with SEMO (28-21), which snapped a 5-game losing streak in the series.
- \* TENNESSEE TECH: The Golden Eagles are looking to start 3–0 in Association games for the first time ... Tech won the first-ever meeting with CSU last year on Oct. 26 (28–23).
- \* UT MARTIN: The Skyhawks are looking to avoid back-to-back losses in Association games for the first time ... UTM is 7-1 all-time in Association home games, and has won the last two meetings with WIU (2024, 2022)
- \* WESTERN ILLINOIS: The Leathernecks are looking to avoid starting 0-3 in Association games for the first time ... WIU's lone win in the series with UTM was a 56-0 triumph in 2003 in Macomb.

### PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - OCT. 6

#### **OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

#### Kekoa Visperas, Tennessee tech, QB • 6-0, 193, R-Sr. • Eatonville, Wash.

Visperas accounted for 431 yards of total offense and four touchdowns as Tennessee Tech improved to 5-0 for just the third tie in program history in topping Western Illinois 66-20. The Eastern Washington transfer completed 24-of-38 passes for 358 yards and four scores and rushed for a team-high 73 yards on eight carries (9.1 ypc). Visperas had touchdown passes of 9, 31 and 25 yards in the first half and added a 4-yard score early in the third quarter. His play helped the Golden Eagles tally a season-best 618 yards of total offense as the squad reached 60-plus points for the third time this season.

#### **DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

#### Justin Waters, Charleston Southern, LB • 6-1, 230, Sr. • Reistertown, Md.

Waters tied the OVC-Big South single-game tackles record with 19 stops (nine in the fourth quarter alone) in the North/South BBQ Bowl battle with rival Gardner-Webb. The senior had nine solos stops and also forced a pair of fumbles in a game that came down to the final play. The 19 tackles are tied for the third-most by a Division I player (FBS or FCS) this season (along with his teammate Steve Zayachkowsky who achieved the feat on September 20). Waters has seven forced fumbles on the season, three more than any other Division I player (FBS or FCS). His second forced fumble came in the end zone, ending a potential scoring drive for GWU in the third quarter.

#### SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

#### Charlie Viorel, Gardner-Webb, K • 5-10, 185, Jr. • Wilmington, N.C.

Viorel connected on a career-long 48-yard field goal as time expired to lift Gardner-Webb to a 30-27 victory over rival Charleston Southern in the North/South BBQ Bowl. The junior accounted for 12 points on the day, also nailing field goals from 38 and 43 yards and making all three of his point after attempts.

#### **ASSOCIATION 30 FOR 30**

What if I told you that the winning team of the eight Association conference games played thus far all scored at least 30 points in their respective victories? The winning team has scored 35, 31, 35, 34, 66, 30, 30 and 31 points for an average of 36.5. The average margin of victory after eight games is 20.63, as five of the eight contests have been decided by double-digits. In addition, Tennessee Tech's 46-point triumph over Western Illinois last week was the highest win margin for a conference game in Association history. The previous high was 42 points (Tennessee Tech 52, Lindenwood 10 on Nov. 2, 2024).

#### **HIGH FLYING**

The Tennessee Tech Golden Eagles have scored 283 points in their first five games, which included an Association-conference game record 66 points this past week against Western Illinois. TTU is the first team in Association history with three 60-point games in a season, while its 283 points ALREADY RANK 12th-most in a single-season in Association annals. The Golden Eagles are 17 points away from becoming just the ninth team to reach 300 points in a campaign in the league's three seasons of existence. Earlier this season, TTU was the first team in Association history to score at least 40 points in three consecutive games, as the Golden Eagles started the year with 65, 45 and 72 points. The 72 points against Davidson in Week 3 was an Association-record against a Division I opponent. In addition, TTU amassed three-straight games with 500-plus offensive yards (570–513–576), establishing another Association record for most consecutive games with 500 yards of total offense.

#### **RUSH HOUR**

Eastern Illinois hosts Gardner-Webb this week, and the squads are the only Association teams to have three different players with a 100-yard rushing game this year. For EIU, **COLE LaCRUE** (193 in Week 1), **CHARLES KELLOM** (133 in Week 1) and **JACARRE FLEMING** (111 in Week 5) have eclipsed the century mark, while **NATE HAMPTON** (132 in Week 1), **QUASEAN HOLMES** (116 in Week 1) and **CARSON GRESOCK** (105 in Week 6) have the rushing trifecta for the Runnin' Bulldogs. GWU is second in the conference with 200.4 rushing yards per game, while EIU sits third at 174.00. The Panthers have scored 11 rushing TDs, with the Runnin' Bulldogs at nine. Meanwhile, Eastern Illinois is the only league member to have a player score multiple TDs in every contest thus far.

#### LIFE BEGINS AT FORTY

Western Illinois PK **ANTONIO CHADHA** ranks second all-time in Association history with 11 field goals made from 40-plus yards. He converted a 48-yarder this past week at Tennessee Tech to move into sole possession on the league's career list, and is three behind record-holder **DC PIP-PIN** of Southeast Missouri, who made 14 field goals from 40-yards or longer during his time in the Association from 2023-24. Chadha is 3-of-4 from 40-49 yards this season, with makes from 48 (twice) and 49 yards.

# **BIRDS OF PREY**

Tennessee Tech has recorded an interception in each game this season with seven total picks, tied for fourth-most in the FCS, and has three INT returns for touchdowns, tied with Furman and Tarleton State for the most in the nation — and the second-most in a season in the Association record book. The Golden Eagles have returned multiple interceptions for touchdowns in all three seasons of the Association's existence, and is the first Association member with pick-6's in consecutive games — having done so now in three-straight contests (Weeks 3, 5 and 6).

#### SPEED DIAL CALLS TO THE HOUSE

Tennessee Tech's **ANDREW SMITH** has tied the OVC-Big South Association single-season record with two interception return touchdowns, which have come in back-to-back games. In Week 5, Smith had a 94-yard pick-six at Tennessee State, the longest interception return in Association history, and the longest non-special teams play in league annals. The return bested the previous record of 85 yards, achieved by TTU's **JACQUEZ McGOWAN** in 2023 against North Alabama. This past week against Western Illinois, Smith returned an INT 16 yards for a score, and his 110 interception return yards this season are second-most in a campaign in the league's three-year history.

#### FOUR OVC-BIG SOUTH PLAYERS NAMED SEMIFINALISTS FOR CAMPBELL TROPHY

Charleston Southern LB NICK BARTALO, Eastern Illinois LS BRETT GALLETTI, Tennessee Tech WR TREMEL JONES and Western Illinois DB CHRISTIAN PIERCE were named among the 44 Semifinalists for the 2025 WILLIAM V. CAMPBELL Trophy last week, college football's premier scholarathlete award presented by the National Football Foundation & College Football Hall of Fame. The NFF will announce 12-16 finalists on Oct. 22.

# RUNNING BUC

Charleston Southern RB **Ke'MARION BALDWIN** leads the OVC-Big South Association with six rushing touchdowns, which includes an 89-yarder this past week at Gardner-Webb — the second-longest rush from scrimmage in Association history. Five of Baldwin's six scores this season have been double-digit distances, as he has reached the end zone from 39, 26, 10, 1, 89 and 14 yards out for a touchdown-run average of 29.83 yards. Baldwin rushed for 175 yards last week at GWU, and is now second among the league leaders with 447 rushing yards.

#### **TECHIES**

Tennessee Tech has scored 39 touchdowns through five contests (7.8 per game), and **QUINTELL QUINN** has reached the end zone in all five games thus far. A total of 16 different players have scored a touchdown for the Golden Eagles this year — tying the Association single—season team record for most players with a touchdown. That mark was first set by Gardner—Webb in 2023 and matched by UT Martin in 2024. Tech's 39 overall TDs this season are already eighth—most in a single—season in league history. The overall touchdown record is 57 by UT Martin last year.

#### **CATCH ALL**

UT Martin WR BRYCE BAILEY is the first wide receiver and second non-quarterback in OVC-Big South Association history to rush, catch and throw a touchdown in a season in the league's brief existance. He became just the fourth non-QB in Association history to throw a touchdown pass in a game, but the first to do so against an FBS opponent when he connected with RB JOHN GENTRY on a 39-yard scoring play at Oklahoma State in Week 1. Bailey, who is 2-of-3 passing for 54 yards and a score this season, rushed for a touchdown in Week 2, and caught two touchdowns passes vs. Southeast Missouri in Week 5. The first non-QB with the rush-catch-throw TD trifecta was Robert Morris tight end CHAESE JACKSON in 2023.

#### **OUICK GLANTZ**

Lindenwood QB **NATE GLANTZ** was the only Association signal-caller to throw for 200-plus passing yards *AND* a TD pass in the first four games of the 2025 season. In Week 4, he became the second QB in Association history with a 200-yard passing (249) & 100-yard rushing (104) game against Stony Brook. Glantz leads the OVC-Big South with 1,344 passing yards, and is tied for second with five rushing scores this year.

### **QUARTERBACK VISPERER**

Tennessee Tech QB **KEKOA VISPERAS** amassed an Association season-high 431 yards of total offense (358 passing, 73 rushing) this past week against Western Illinois, the fourth-highest singlegame total in Association history, and the third-most in a conference game. He leads the league with 274.80 total offensive yards per game, which ranks 15th in the nation.

#### **KEYS TO THE CITY**

UT Martin DL **KEYSHAWN JOHNSON** leads the Association with 8.0 tackles-for-loss — tied for 10th in the nation, and his 1.33 TFL per game are tied for 20th in the FCS. Johnson has an Association-best three games this season with at least 2.0 tackles-for-loss (2.0 at Oklahoma State, 2.0 at Missouri State and 2.5 vs. Southeast Missouri). He is also the league-leader with 4.5 sacks.

#### SPECIAL AGENT

Lindenwood R-Freshman WR **RICO BOND** shares the Association lead with five receiving TDs and is tied for second with 28 receptions, while his 355 receiving yards rank second. During a three-game span during Weeks 2-4, Bond caught 20 passes for 274 yards and four touchdowns, and reached the end zone in all three contests.

### **ACE IN THE HOLMAN**

Western Illinois RB **MARKELL HOLMAN** leads the Association with 456 rushing yards, and has been the Leathernecks' leading rusher in all six games this season. He recorded back-to-back 100-yard games with 139 against Valparaiso in Week 3, and 118 at Eastern Washington in Week 4.

#### SUPER SIZE COMBO

Southeast Missouri (569) and Southern Illinois (612) combined for 1,181 yards of total offense in Week 4, the second-most combined total offense in a game in the Association record book, and the most combined offensive yards for a non-conference contest.

# JUMPING JAX

Southeast Missouri QB **JAX LEATHERWOOD** threw for an OVC-Big South season-high 422 yards in Week 4 against nationally-ranked Southern Illinois, the fifth-highest single-game passing yards in Association history.

#### **HUNGRY LIKE A WOLF**

Eastern Illinois freshman QB **CONNOR WOLF** threw for 411 yards against Illinois State in Week 3, the most by a freshman in Association history, and at the time was the sixth-most in a game in the league's brief existence (now seventh). Wolf also threw four touchdown passes against the Redbirds, becoming the just the fourth different QB in Association era with a 400-yard / 4-TD performance. The others were Southeast Missouri's **PAXTON DELAURENT** (2 in 2024), Western Illinois' **NATHAN LAMB** (1 in 2024) and Eastern Illinois' **PIERCE HOLLEY** (1 in 2024).

#### RECEPTIONS

Southeast Missouri receiving tandem KALVIN GILBERT (125) and CAM PEDRO (105) tallied 100-yard receiving efforts against Southern Illinois in Week 4. It was the fifth time that SEMO had multiple 100-yard receiving individuals in the same game, the most in Association history. Following the Redhawks for most games with two players with 100 yards receiving are Eastern Illinois (3), Western Illinois (3) and Bryant (1).

#### **BULLDOG BITES**

Gardner-Webb's 52-45 season-opening win at then-No. 18/19 Western Carolina was the Association's first over a ranked non-conference foe in the regular-season since Sept. 21, 2024, when Southeast Missouri knocked off No. 7/7 Southern Illinois, 38-21. The Association now has five wins over nationally-ranked out-of-conference members in its three-year history, three of which occurred in 2024. Gardner-Webb's 627 yards of offense against the Catamounts were the fourthmost in a single-game in the Association record book.

#### **BACK-PACKING**

Eastern Illinois QB **COLE LaCRUE** rushed for 193 yards in Week 1, an Association-record for a quarterback. He threw for 129 yards to become just the third QB in Association history with 100 rushing + passing yards in a game. Two days later, Gardner-Webb's **NATE HAMPTON** became the first with 200 passing + 100 rushing yards in a contest, as he threw for 263 yards and rushed for 132 in GWU's win at Western Carolina. Hampton was also the first QB in Association history with four rushing TDs in a game.

#### 24

UT Martin QB **JASE BAUER** became the third Association quarterback this season with 200 passing and 100 rushing yards in a contest this past week after throwing for 225 yards and gaining 107 on the ground in the Skyhawks' victory over Southeast Missouri. He joined Gardner-Webb's **NATE HAMPTON** (263 P, 132 R vs. Western Carolina in Week 1) and Lindenwood's **NATE GLANTZ** (249 P, 104 R vs. Stony Brook in Week 4) in the 200-100 club. This season is the first time any Association quarterback has recorded a 200-passing & 100-rushing game.

#### AROUND THE ASSOCIATION...

#### **CHARLESTON SOUTHERN**

The Bucs rushed for a season-high 218 yards in last week's 30-27 North-South BBQ Bowl loss at Gardner-Webb, and fell to the Runnin' Bulldogs by a field goal for the second-straight year. KeMARION BALDWIN rushed 19 times for 175 yards (9.2 average) and three touchdowns, while MEKHI CAMPFIELD had six catches for 103 yards. JUSTIN WATERS tied the OVC-Big South Association single-game record with 19 tackles (9 solo, 10 assisted) and forced two fumbles. Waters is the second player this season and fourth overall in Association history with 19 tackles in a game. Teammate STEVE ZAYACHKOWSKY also had 19 in Week 4 at William & Mary ... Waters' seven forced fumbles are an Association single-season record.

#### **EASTERN ILLINOIS**

The Panthers have scored 30-plus points in three-straight games, averaging 30.67 in that span (30-31-31) ... In last week's 31-7 win over Tennessee State, EIU limited the Tigers to just 42 offensive plays -- the fewest plays allowed in an Association conference game, and second-fewest in a single-game overall ... COLE La-CRUE scored two rushing touchdowns, while COOPER WILLMAN (26 yards) and JOE McNAB (1 yard) caught TD passes from CONNOR WOLF, who was 13-of-20 passing for 134 yards.

#### **GARDNER-WEBB**

The Runnin' Bulldogs have won three-straight FCS games for the first time since winning five-straight contests to close out the 2023 regular-season ... Gardner-Webb has won four of its last five home games ... GWU's 3-2 start is its best since 2013 (opened 4-1) ... In the North-South BBQ Bowl win over Charleston Southern last week, three players combined for all of Gardner-Webb's 243 net rushing yards: CARSON GRESOCK (105), QUASEAN HOLMES (78) and NATE HAMPTON (60). Hampton passed for 247 yards and finished with his third game this season with 300 offensive yards (307). ROBERT HOLTZ recorded seven tackles vs. CSU, three of which were TFL.

#### LINDENWOOD

The Lions are 3-3 for the first time since 2023, are 2-0 in conference games for the first time since 2021, and have won five-straight home games ... Lindenwood has its first three-game FCS win streak since winning three-straight during the 2022 campaign (defeated Central Arkansas, Eastern Illinois and Murray State from Oct. 8-22) ... Lindenwood is averaging 31.67 points in its three wins, compared to 8.7 points in its three losses (13 total points in two FBS defeats) ... QB NATE GLANTZ nearly recorded his second 200-passing yard, 100-rushing yard game in last week's win over UT Martin, as he passed for 227 and rushed for a team-high 91 for his third game this season with 300 yards of offense (318). JALEN SMITH caught three balls for 146 yards for an average yards per catch of 48.7 -- the highest for any player with more than 100 receiving yards on less than 5 receptions.

#### SOUTHEAST MISSOURI

The Redhawks' 10 points in their Association-opening loss to UT Martin was their fewest in a conference game since scoring 10 at Murray State in 2021 (L, 28-10 on Nov. 13) ... RB BRANDON EPTON JR's 4-yard touchdown run extended Southeast Missouri's TD streak to 28 games ... SEMO is looking to avoid starting 1-5 for the first time since 2013 (started 1-7), as well as avoid dropping back-to-back Association games for the first time since 2023 (lost final three league games).

#### TENNESSEE STATE

RB KENDRIC RHYMES was the Tigers' leading rusher for the fifth-straight game in last week's loss at Eastern Illinois. He finished the day wih a team-high 72 all-purpose yards. QB BYRON McNAIR was 16-of-20 passing for 205 yards and a 28-yard scoring strike to SNAP REED to account for TSU's lone points of the game.

#### **TENNESSEE TECH**

Tennessee Tech is 5-0 for the third time in program history, and its best start since 1977 (8-0) ... TTU's 10-straight wins is the longest winning streak in program history ... The Golden Eagles recorded 618 yards of offense against Western Illinois (166 rushing, 452 passing), the second-most ever in an Association conference game ... Through five games in 2025, Tech has rushed for 19 touchdowns and thrown for 15, has outscored the opposition 283 to 59, and has limited foes to 48.8 net rushing yards per game (244 total) ... Dating back to last season, TTU has held its last nine opponents to less than 100 net rushing yards -- an Association consecutive record.

#### **UT MARTIN**

The Skyhawks were held to their second-fewest points in an Association game last week (14). The Leathernecks finished with 375 yards of offense last week at Tennessee Tech, snapping TTU's streak of eight-straight games holding opponents to under 300 offensive yards. WIU's 20 points were also the most against Tech this season. QB CASON CARSWELL was 34-of-48 passing for 343 yards and two TD connections. WR CHRISTIAN ANAYA caught 13 balls for 132 yards, while DEMARI DAVIS had five catches for 99 yards.

# OVC-BIG SOUTH FOOTBALL TIEBREAKER PROCEDURE

#### 1. TRANSITIONING SCHOOLS

a. To be eligible for the conference's automatic bid to the FCS Football Championship, a school must be a full Division I member.

**b.** Transitioning schools will be utilized in the tiebreaker process.

c. If a transitioning school is involved in a two-way tie, the tied team that is eligible for postseason competition shall be the league's recipient of the automatic bid.

d. If a transitioning school wins the multi-team tiebreaker, the procedure would start over with the remaining teams.

#### 2. TWO-WAY TIE

a. If the two teams played each other during the conference season, the winner of the head-to-head contest shall be the league's recipient of the automatic bid.

b. If the tied teams did not play each other during the conference season, each team's head-to-head record against all common opponents in the league will be used to determine the automatic bid.

c. If a tie still exists, then each team's record against the next highest common opponent in the league standings will be used to determine the automatic bid. When arriving at a group of tied teams that each team has played, composite records between the tied teams shall be utilized to determine if one of the tied teams has won more games against the group of tied teams.

d. If the teams are still tied, a point system will be utilized based on a complete schedule and wins using the NCAA four-metric average ranking for FCS\* following all games on the final Saturday of the regular season (and the Massey ranking entering the final day of the regular season for FBS opponents) as indicated below:

e. Should the points system finish in a tie, the team with the best ranking in the NCAA four-metric average for FCS\* following all games on the final Saturday of the regular season will receive the automatic bid.

#### 3. MULTIPLE TIES

a. If at any point, a tie is broken using the multiple-tie tiebreaker procedures and only two teams remain, the remaining teams will revert to the two-way tiebreaker (head-to-head).

b. If the tied teams all played each other during the conference season, the team with the best cumulative record involving games with the tied teams shall be declared champion. For example, if a team is 2-0 against two other tied teams, that team will be declared champion.

c. If the tied teams all played one another and have identical records against the other tied teams, then each team's record against all common opponents in the league will be used to determine the automatic bid. If teams are still tied, then each team's record against the next highest common opponent in the league standings will be used to determine the automatic bid.

d. If the tied teams did not play each other, then each team's record against all common opponents in the league will be used to determine the automatic bid. If the teams are still tied, and they did not play each other, then each team's record against the next highest common opponent in the league standings will be used to determine the automatic bid.

e. If the teams are still tied, a point system will be utilized based on a complete schedule and wins using the NCAA four-metric average ranking for FCS\* following all games on the final Saturday of the regular season (and the Massey ranking entering the final day of the regular season for FBS opponents) as indicated below:

f. Should the points system finish in a tie, the team with the best ranking in the NCAA four-metric average for FCS\* following all games on the final Saturday of the regular season will receive the automatic bid.
