2-MINUTE OFFENSE

OPENING KICKOFF: The third season of the OVC-Big South Football Association kicks off Thursday, Aug. 28 ... Year 3 of the Association is again comprised of nine members, and the 2025 conference schedule features every team playing each other for an 8-game league slate for the second-straight year ... The first OVC-Big South game is in Week 3 (Lindenwood at Charleston Southern).

1st DOWN: All nine OVC-Big South squads will play in Week 1. Three contests are Thursday night openers, followed by the first Friday season-opener in the Association's three years of existence. Four of the nine total match-ups on the schedule are against FBS opponents.

2nd DOWN: The Association welcomes one new head coach in 2025 -- **REGGIE BARLOW** of Tennessee State. Barlow was named to the post on March 23, and is 83-58 as a collegiate head coach following stops at Alabama State (2007-14) and Virginia State (2016-21).

3rd DOWN: The OVC-Big South 2025 Preseason Players of the Year are Lindenwood RB **STEVE HALL** and UT Martin DB **JaMICHAEL McGOY JR**. Hall is among the **WALTER PAYTON** Award Preseason Watch List candidates, while McGoy is a preseason All-American and **BUCK BUCHAN-AN** Award Preseason Watch List member.

4th DOWN: Preseason OVC-Big South favorite Tennessee Tech enters the season nationally-ranked for the first time since the 2021 Spring season. The Golden Eagles are No. 21 in the Stats Perform poll, and tied for No. 22 in the AFCA Coaches Poll. SEMO, UT Martin and Tennessee State also received votes in the Stats Perform ranking. Those three programs along with Lindenwood received plaudits in the Coaches' preseason ratings.

OVERTIME: Eight of the nine Associations members will play 14 total games against FBS opponents this fall — a league record. The previous high was 13 a season ago.

ABOUT THE OVC-BIG SOUTH FOOTBALL ASSOCIATION

This is the third season of the OVC-Big South Football Association. On Feb. 22, 2022, the Big South Conference and Ohio Valley Conference announced the creation of an association of their football member institutions that began play with the 2023 NCAA Division I football season. The initial agreement of at least four years was enhanced on June 12, 2024 that will provide an opportunity to extend the original partnership through 2030 and beyond. The unique agreement combines the two conferences' football membership to ensure NCAA championship access and stability for the multisport conferences. In creating the association, presidents from each of the multisport conferences pointed to the similarities of the OVC and the Big South, with their complementary geographies and intercollegiate athletic philosophies, as key to making this association possible.

SLANT ROUTES

- * CHARLESTON SOUTHERN: The Buccaneers are opening the season against an FBS opponent for the first time since 2018, which was also against an SEC foe (at Florida) ... CSU's lone meeting with Vanderbilt was in 2014, a 21-20 loss to the Commodores.
- * EASTERN ILLINOIS: The Panthers are opening the season at home for the first time since the 2021 Spring season ... EIU is seeking its first 1-0 start since 2023.
- * GARDNER-WEBB: The Runnin' Bulldogs are opening the season against a nationally-ranked FCS opponent for the first time since the 2021 Spring season (#24 Elon) ... GWU last opened 1-0 in 2022.
- * LINDENWOOD: The Lions are opening the season on the road for the second consecutive year ... Lindenwood, seeking its first 1-0 start since 2023, defeated St. Thomas last year, 64-0
- * SOUTHEAST MISSOURI: The Redhawks are opening the season against an FBS foe for the second time in three years (2023 at Kansas State) ... SEMO last defeated Arkansas State in 1946.
- * TENNESSEE STATE: The Tigers are looking to start 1-O for the second consecutive year ... TSU won the last meeting with North Carolina A&T in 2010, a 37-7 neutral site victory in Indianapolis on Oct. 2.
- * TENNESSEE TECH: The Golden Eagles are opening the season at home for the first time since the 2021 Spring season, which was also the last time TTU started 1-0.
- * UT MARTIN: The Skyhawks are opening the season at an FBS member for the third consecutive year ... UTM is playing three FBS foes in 2025, and owns the Association's lone FBS victory (won at Kennesaw State in 2024).
- * WESTERN ILLINOIS: The Leathernecks are opening the campaign at an FBS foe for the third-straight year ... WIU will face consecutive FBS members in the first two weeks of the season, both of which will be Friday night affairs at Big Ten programs (at Illinois and at Northwestern).

OVC-BIG SOUTH FOOTBALL TIEBREAKER PROCEDURE

1. TRANSITIONING SCHOOLS

a. To be eligible for the conference's automatic bid to the FCS Football Championship, a school must be a full Division I member.

b. Transitioning schools will be utilized in the tiebreaker process.

c. If a transitioning school is involved in a two-way tie, the tied team that is eligible for postseason competition shall be the league's recipient of the automatic bid.

d. If a transitioning school wins the multi-team tiebreaker, the procedure would start over with the remaining teams.

2. TWO-WAY TIE

a. If the two teams played each other during the conference season, the winner of the head-to-head contest shall be the league's recipient of the automatic bid.

b. If the tied teams did not play each other during the conference season, each team's head-to-head record against all common opponents in the league will be used to determine the automatic hid

c. If a tie still exists, then each team's record against the next highest common opponent in the league standings will be used to determine the automatic bid. When arriving at a group of tied teams that each team has played, composite records between the tied teams shall be utilized to determine if one of the tied teams has won more games against the group of tied teams.

d. If the teams are still tied, a point system will be utilized based on a complete schedule and wins using the NCAA four-metric average ranking for FCS* following all games on the final Saturday of the regular season (and the Massey ranking entering the final day of the regular season for FBS opponents) as indicated below:

e. Should the points system finish in a tie, the team with the best ranking in the NCAA four-metric average for FCS* following all games on the final Saturday of the regular season will receive the automatic bid.

3. MULTIPLE TIES

 a. If at any point, a tie is broken using the multiple-tie tiebreaker procedures and only two teams remain, the remaining teams will revert to the two-way tiebreaker (head-to-head).

b. If the tied teams all played each other during the conference season, the team with the best cumulative record involving games with the tied teams shall be declared champion. For example, if a team is 2-0 against two other tied teams, that team will be declared champion.

c. If the tied teams all played one another and have identical records against the other tied teams then each team's record against all common opponents in the league will be used to determine the automatic bid. If teams are still tied, then each team's record against the next highest common opponent in the league standings will be used to determine the automatic bid.

d. If the tied teams did not play each other, then each team's record against all common opponents in the league will be used to determine the automatic bid. If the teams are still tied, and they did not play each other, then each team's record against the next highest common opponent in the league standings will be used to determine the automatic bid.

e. If the teams are still tied, a point system will be utilized based on a complete schedule and wins using the NCAA four-metric average ranking for FCS* following all games on the final Saturday of the regular season (and the Massey ranking entering the final day of the regular season for FBS opponents) as indicated below:

f. Should the points system finish in a tie, the team with the best ranking in the NCAA four-metric average for FCS* following all games on the final Saturday of the regular season will receive the automatic bid.
