# 2-MINUTE OFFENSE

**OPENING KICKOFF:** Tennessee Tech is ranked No. 11/13 this week, marking the 17th consecutive week that an Association member has appeared in the National Top 25 poll — extending a league record that began Sept. 16, 2024. The previous best for the Association was 14-straight weeks in the 2023 campaign (preseason poll to final poll). Tennessee Tech has its highest ranking since Sept. 27, 1994 (No. 11).

**Ist DOWN**: Tennessee Tech is the first team in the Association's brief history to open a season 3–0, and is one of nine FCS programs at least 3–0 at this point of the 2025 season. It is Tech's first 3–0 start since 1977 (started 8–0). The Golden Eagles' current 8–game win streak is tied for the longest active streak in the Football Championship Subdivision, and is the longest overall winning streak in the Association's three years of existence.

**2nd DOWN**: Tennessee Tech leads the FCS in scoring offense (60.7 points per game), and ranks third in both total offense (553.0 yards per game) and total defense (194.7 yards allowed per game).

**3rd DOWN**: Lindenwood QB **NATE GLANTZ** rushed for a career-high 104 yards in the Lions' Week 4 win over Stony Brook, which was the second 100-yard rushing game in his Lindenwood career — becoming the first Association quarterback with multiple 100-yard rushing games in the league's young history.

4th DOWN: Charleston Southern LB STEVE ZAY-ACHKOWSKY tied the Association single-game record with his 19 total tackles at William & Mary in Week 4. He tallied seven solo stops and 12 assisted tackles to become the third player in the Association's three-year history with 19 tackles in a contest.

#### ABOUT THE OVC-BIG SOUTH FOOTBALL ASSOCIATION

This is the third season of the OVC-Big South Football Association. On Feb. 22, 2022, the Big South Conference and Ohio Valley Conference announced the creation of an association of their football member institutions that began play with the 2023 NCAA Division I football season. The initial agreement of at least four years was enhanced on June 12, 2024 that will provide an opportunity to extend the original partnership through 2030 and beyond. The unique agreement combines the two conferences' football membership to ensure NCAA championship access and stability for the multisport conferences. In creating the association, presidents from each of the multisport conferences pointed to the similiarities of the OVC and the Big South, with their complementary geographies and intercollegiate athletic philosophies, as key to making this association possible.

#### SLANT ROUTES

- \* CHARLESTON SOUTHERN: The Buccaneers are looking to avoid starting 0-5 for the first time since 2022 (0-5) ... The Bucs last faced South Carolina State in 1999, and the previous three meetings (1997, 1998, 1999) were one-possession setbacks.
- \* EASTERN ILLINOIS: The Panthers are looking to start 1-0 in Association games for the first time, and last opened 1-0 in conference games in 2022 (OVC) ... EIU won last year's match-up against WIU, 45-38 at home.
- \* GARDNER-WEBB: The Runnin' Bulldogs are idle this week, and return to action next Saturday in their Association opener against Charleston Southern in the annual "North-South BBQ Bowl" game.
- \* LINDENWOOD: The Lions are looking to win three consecutive games for the first time since winning fourstraight in 2022 ... Miami (Ohio) will mark Lindenwood's third and final first-time opponent of the season, and second FBS foe this year.
- \* SOUTHEAST MISSOURI: The Redhawks are looking to start 1-0 in Association games for the third consecutive season ... SEMO won last year's meeting with UT Martin in double-overtime, 45-42, which was the conference opener for both teams.
- \* TENNESSEE STATE: The Tigers are looking to start 1-O in Association games for the first time since 2023 ... Tennessee State last defeated TTU in 2022 (W, 30-14 in Cookeville).
- \* TENNESSEE TECH: The Golden Eagles are looking to start 1–0 in Association games for the second consecutive year ... Tech has won the last two meetings with TSU, including last year's conference opener (24–14).
- \* UT MARTIN: The Skyhawks are looking to avoid starting O-5 for the first time since 2007 (O-6) ... UTM is seeking its first 1-O Association start since 2023.
- \* WESTERN ILLINOIS: The Leathernecks are looking to start 1-0 in Association games for the secondstraight year ... WIU last defeated EIU in 2016 (W, 38-21 in Charleston).

#### PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - SEPT. 22

#### **OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

#### Nate Glantz, Lindenwood, QB • 6-2, 201, R-Sr. • Elkhorn, Neb.

Glantz accounted for 353 yards of total offense and three touchdowns as Lindenwood topped Stony Brook 30-27 and pick up its second-straight victory. The redshirt senior completed 20-of-29 passes for 249 yards and two scores and rushed 13 times for a career-high 104 yards (8.0 ypc) and another touchdown. On the Lions second play of the game, he connected with Rico Bond for a 30-yard touchdown and after rushing for a sevenyarder midway through the second quarter, he connected with Bond on a 34-yarder just before halftime. Nationally, Glantz ranks ninth in total offense (287.0 yards/game), 10th in passing yards (1,030) and rushing touchdowns (5), 12th in points responsible for (60), 17th in completions (19.5/game) and 18th in total touchdowns (5).

#### **DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

#### Steve Zayachkowsky, Charleston Soutern, LB • 5-10, 215, Jr. • Indian Trail, N.C.

Zayachkowsky tallied 19 tackles (7 solo) at William & Mary on Saturday. The 19 stops tied the OVC-Big South Football Association record for tackles in game and marked the most by a Buccaneer since the 2006 season. The 19 tackles are the second-most by a Division I (FBS or FCS) player in 2025.

Chadha was perfect on his kick attempts in a high scoring game at Eastern Washington. The sophomore connected on a 39-yard in the first quarter and was 4-of-4 on point after attempts. Chadha also had six kickoffs, four of which went for touchbacks.

#### FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

#### Rico Bond, Lindenwood, WR • 6-1, 177, R-Fr. • St. Louis, Mo.

Bond had a season-best eight catches for 119 yards and two touchdowns as Lindenwood won its home opener in topping Stony Brook 30-27. The redshirt freshman caught a 30-yard touchdown pass from Nate Glantz just 1:49 into the game and added his second score on a 34-yard catch just before halftime to put the Lions ahead 27-3. Bond has now scored in three-straight games and is averaging 73.0 yards per game, which is second in the Association and 39th nationally (fourth nationally among freshmen).

#### **GOLDEN ERA**

Tennessee Tech is the first team in Association history to score at least 40 points in three consecutive games, as the Golden Eagles have started the season with 65, 45 and 72 points. The 72 points against Davidson in Week 3 was an Association-record against a Division I opponent. In addition, Tech has amassed three-straight games with 500-plus offensive yards (570-513-576), establishing another Association record for most consecutive games with 500 yards of total offense. Meanwhile, Tennessee Tech's two 60-point games is an Association single-season record.

#### **QUICK GLANTZ**

Lindenwood QB **NATE GLANTZ** is the first Association signal-caller this season to throw for 200-plus passing yards *AND* a TD pass in four-straight games to start the year. He became the second QB in Association history with a 200-yard passing (249) & 100-yard rushing (104) game this past week against Stony Brook. Glantz has rushed for a touchdown in his last three games, and leads the OVC-Big South with five rushing scores this year.

#### **JUMPING JAX**

Southeast Missouri QB **JAX LEATHERWOOD** threw for an OVC-Big South season-high 422 yards this past week against nationally-ranked Southern Illinois, the fifth-highest single-game passing yards in Association history. He is the league leader with 92 completions and 1,064 passing yards, and has thrown a TD pass in all four appearances.

#### **SPECIAL AGENT**

In his last three games (Weeks 2-4), Lindenwood WR **RICO BOND** has caught 20 passes for 274 yards and four touchdowns, and has reached the end zone in all three contests. He leads the Association in receiving yards (301) and receiving TDs (4), while his 23 receptions rank second.

#### **SUPER SIZE COMBO**

Southeast Missouri (569) and Southern Illinois (612) combined for 1,181 yards of total offense this past week, the second-most combined total offense in a game in the Association record book, and the most combined offensive yards for a non-conference contest.

#### **TECHIES**

Tennessee Tech has scored 25 touchdowns through three contests (8.33 per game), and **QUINTELL QUINN** and **Q'DARYIUS JENNINGS** have reached the end zone in all three games thus far. A total of 14 different players have scored a touchdown for the Golden Eagles this year. Last season, Tech had 15 different players with a TD, while the Association single-season team record for most players with a touchdown is 16 (set by Gardner-Webb in 2023 and matched by UT Martin in 2024).

#### **HUNGRY LIKE A WOLF**

Eastern Illinois freshman QB **CONNOR WOLF** threw for 411 yards against Illinois State in Week 3, the most by a freshman in Association history, and at the time was the sixth-most in a game in the league's brief existence (now seventh). Wolf also threw four touchdown passes against the Redbirds, becoming the just the fourth different QB in Association era with a 400-yard / 4-TD performance. The others were Southeast Missouri's **PAXTON DELAURENT** (2 in 2024), Western Illinois' **NATHAN LAMB** (1 in 2024) and Eastern Illinois' **PIERCE HOLLEY** (1 in 2024).

#### **FULL NELSON**

Eastern Illinois WR **CJ NELSON** caught seven passes for 194 yards ( =27.71 yards per completion) and two touchdowns against Illinois State in Week 3, the seventh-most receiving yards in a single-game in Association history. He has 210 receiving yards in his two appearances this season.

# **BULLDOG BITES**

Gardner-Webb's 52-45 season-opening win at then-No. 18/19 Western Carolina was the Association's first over a ranked non-conference foe in the regular-season since Sept. 21, 2024, when Southeast Missouri knocked off No. 7/7 Southern Illinois, 38-21. The Association now has five wins over nationally-ranked out-of-conference members in its three-year history, three of which occurred in 2024. Gardner-Webb's 627 yards of offense against the Catamounts were the fourthmost in a single-game in the Association record book.

#### **CATCH ALL**

UT Martin WR **BRYCE BAILEY** became just the fourth non-QB in Association history to throw a touchdown pass in a game, but the first to do so against an FBS opponent when he connected with RB **JOHN GENTRY** on a 39-yard scoring play at Oklahoma State in Week 1. Bailey has thrown a pass in three of four games this season, and is 2-of-3 for 54 yards and a score. He added a rushing touchdown in Week 2, but is seeking his first TD reception of the season.

#### RECEPTIONS

Southeast Missouri receiving tandem KALVIN GILBERT (125) and CAM PEDRO (105) tallied 100yard receiving efforts this past week against Southern Illinois. It was the fifth time that SEMO had multiple 100-yard receiving individuals in the same game, the most in Association history. Following the Redhawks for most games with two players with 100 yards receiving are Eastern Illinois (3), Western Illinois (3) and Bryant (1).

#### **RHYME TIME**

Tennessee State RB KENDRIC RHYMES is tied for the Association lead with 328 rushing yards, good for a tie for 17th in the country. His 109.33 rushing yards per game rank No. 10 in FCS. Meanwhile, in the Tigers' Week 1 win over North Carolina A&T, Rhymes became just the second Association player with two 50-plus rushing TDs in a game when he scored on runs of 60 and 51 yards.

#### ACE IN THE HOLMAN

Western Illinois RB MARKELL HOLMAN is the first Association rusher with back-to-back 100-yard games this season following his 118-yard effort this past week at Eastern Washington. In Week 3, he gained 139 against Valparaiso, and is tied for the league lead with 328 rushing yards. Holman has been the Leathernecks' leading rusher in all four games this season.

#### **BACK-PACKING**

Eastern Illinois QB COLE LaCRUE rushed for 193 yards in Week 1, an Association-record for a quarterback. He threw for 129 yards to become just the third QB in Association history with 100 rushing + passing yards in a game. Two days later, Gardner-Webb's NATE HAMPTON became the first with 200 passing + 100 rushing yards in a contest, as he threw for 263 yards and rushed for 132 in GWU's win at Western Carolina. Hampton was also the first QB in Association history with four rushing TDs in a game.

#### AROUND THE ASSOCIATION...

#### **CHARLESTON SOUTHERN**

Charleston Southern rushed for a season-high 163 yards last week at William & Mary ... In his last two games, Bucs RB **HAKEEM WATTERS** has rushed for 180 yards on just 16 carries ( =11.25 per carry) with two touchdowns. Those rushing scores have been for distances of 52 (Week 3 vs. Lindenwood) and 63 (Week 4 vs. Western Illinois) ... CSU is seeking its first non-conference victory since Sept. 7, 2024, when the Bucs defeated nationally-ranked Furman, 24–20.

#### **EASTERN ILLINOIS**

All four of Eastern Illinois's touchdowns against Illinois State in Week 3 were receiving touchdowns. EIU entered the contest with five TDs, which were all rushing ... QB **CONNOR WOLF** passed for a school freshman record 411 yards against ISU, as he was 28-of-44 passing with 4 TDs. **CJ NELSON** caught seven balls for 194 yards and two touchdowns, while **COOPER WILLMAN** had five catches for 86 yards and a score. Wolf also connected on a 9-yard pass play to **DealRIOUS SMITH**.

#### **GARDNER-WEBB**

GWU enjoyed a 14-3 first quarter lead at Ohio before the Bobcats came back for the 52-35 victory. The 35 points was Gardner-Webb's most against an FBS opponent since defeating Akron, 38-37, in 2010 ... RB QUASEAN HOLMES scored three times at Ohio (two rushing, one receiving), which included a 68-yard pass play from NATE HAMPTON. Hampton was 19-of-28 passing for a season-high 289 yards, and connected with WR CHRIS LOFTON on a 42-yard scoring strike ... Gardner-Webb's 122 points are the program's most through the first four games since 2021, when the Runnin' Bulldogs scored 143 in their first four contests.

#### LINDENWOOD

Lindenwood jumped out to a 27–3 lead and held off Stony Brook for a 30–27 victory last weelk. The Seawolves entered the season ranked No. 24/25 in the Preseason National Top 25 polls. The Lions recorded season highs of 216 rushing yards and 465 total offensive yards in the SBU game. WR RICO BOND had season-bests of eight catches, 119 yards and two scores in the victory. JACOB WALLER had nine stops, while TAJAY PASSMORE recorded two sacks plus a forced fumble. QB NATE GLANTZ was 20–of–29 passing — his third-straight game with exactly 20 completions, and has thrown for more than 200 yards in each contest to start the season.

#### SOUTHEAST MISSOURI

The Redhawks posted season-highs of four touchdowns, 31 points and 569 yards of offense in its setback to nationally-ranked Southern Illinois last week. RB **BRANDON EPTON JR**. led the squad with 94 rushing yards on 18 carries, and also caught a 34-yard receiving touchdown, which was SEMO's longest pass play of the game. QB **JAX LEATHERWOOD** was 33-of-47 passing for 422 yards, and connected with **CAM PEDRO** on a 22-yard score ... Southeast Missouri is looking to avoid its first 1-3 start since 2023 (1-4).

#### TENNESSEE STATE

RB **KENDRIC RHYMES** posted his Association-leading second multi-touchdown game of the season in Week 3 with a rushing score (5 yards) and receiving TD (22 yards) in the Tigers' setback to Alabama A&M. Rhymes rushed for 111 yards, and was the team's leading receiver with seven catches for 64 yards to finish with 175 all-purpose yards. The seven catches tied for the fourth-most by a running back in a singlegame in Association annals ... RB **ZACK SIMMONS-BROWN** gained 75 yards on nine carries against AAMU ... Rhymes is one of two Association players to lead his team in rushing every game thus far ... Entering Week 5, the Tigers are rated No. 10 in the HBCU Coaches Poll, and receiving votes in the HBCU Media Poll.

#### **TENNESSEE TECH**

Tech tied the program single-game record with its 72 points against Davidson in Week 3, which was the most points in the program's modern history (since 1920). QB **KEKOA VISPERAS** threw for 246 yards and three touchdowns (23-of-32 passing) and rushed for two scores for the squad's eighth-straight win, dating back to last season. The Golden Eagles gained 308 net rushing yards against the Wildcats — their third-straight game with 200-plus, and rank third nationally with 269.0 rushing yards per game ... Through three games in 2025, Tech has rushed for 13 touchdowns and thrown for nine, has outscored the opposition 182 to 31, and has limited foes to 54.3 net rushing yards per game (163 total) ... Dating back to last season, TTU has held its last seven opponents to less than 300 yards of offense *AND* below 100 net rushing yards.

# UT MARTIN

UT Martin avoided a shutout at Missouri State with 10 points in the fourth quarter. K CADE HECHTER first made a 32-yard field goal with 6:55 remaining, and RB TOMMY ANSLEY scored on a 1-yard rush with 1:52 left to extend the Skyhawks' touchdown streak to 17 consecutive games.

#### **WESTERN ILLINOIS**

QB **CHRIS IRVIN** threw for 167 yards and two touchdowns at Eastern Washington this past week. He connected eight times with **TRISTIN DUNCAN** for 110 yards, and threw two TD passes to **CHRISTIAN ANAYA** (14, 3), who finished with eight catches. RB **MARKELL HOLMAN** rushed for 118 yards on 28 carries and scored his second rushing touchdown of the year. He is one of two Association players to lead his team in rushing in every game this year.

# **OVC-BIG SOUTH FOOTBALL TIEBREAKER PROCEDURE**

#### 1. TRANSITIONING SCHOOLS

a. To be eligible for the conference's automatic bid to the FCS Football Championship, a school must be a full Division I member.

**b.** Transitioning schools will be utilized in the tiebreaker process.

c. If a transitioning school is involved in a two-way tie, the tied team that is eligible for postseason competition shall be the league's recipient of the automatic bid.

d. If a transitioning school wins the multi-team tiebreaker, the procedure would start over with the remaining teams.

#### 2. TWO-WAY TIE

a. If the two teams played each other during the conference season, the winner of the head-to-head contest shall be the league's recipient of the automatic bid.

**b.** If the tied teams did not play each other during the conference season, each team's head-to-head record against all common opponents in the league will be used to determine the automatic hid

c. If a tie still exists, then each team's record against the next highest common opponent in the league standings will be used to determine the automatic bid. When arriving at a group of tied teams that each team has played, composite records between the tied teams shall be utilized to determine if one of the tied teams has won more games against the group of tied teams.

d. If the teams are still tied, a point system will be utilized based on a complete schedule and wins using the NCAA four-metric average ranking for FCS\* following all games on the final Saturday of the regular season (and the Massey ranking entering the final day of the regular season for FBS opponents) as indicated below:

e. Should the points system finish in a tie, the team with the best ranking in the NCAA four-metric average for FCS\* following all games on the final Saturday of the regular season will receive the automatic bid.

#### 3. MULTIPLE TIES

 a. If at any point, a tie is broken using the multiple-tie tiebreaker procedures and only two teams remain, the remaining teams will revert to the two-way tiebreaker (head-to-head).

b. If the tied teams all played each other during the conference season, the team with the best cumulative record involving games with the tied teams shall be declared champion. For example, if a team is 2-0 against two other tied teams, that team will be declared champion.

c. If the tied teams all played one another and have identical records against the other tied teams, then each team's record against all common opponents in the league will be used to determine the automatic bid. If teams are still tied, then each team's record against the next highest common opponent in the league standings will be used to determine the automatic bid.

d. If the tied teams did not play each other, then each team's record against all common opponents in the league will be used to determine the automatic bid. If the teams are still tied, and they did not play each other, then each team's record against the next highest common opponent in the league standings will be used to determine the automatic bid.

e. If the teams are still tied, a point system will be utilized based on a complete schedule and wins using the NCAA four-metric average ranking for FCS\* following all games on the final Saturday of the regular season (and the Massey ranking entering the final day of the regular season for FBS opponents) as indicated below:

f. Should the points system finish in a tie, the team with the best ranking in the NCAA four-metric average for FCS\* following all games on the final Saturday of the regular season will receive the automatic bid.
