* **CHARLESTON SOUTHERN:** The Buccaneers are looking to snap an 11-game losing streak in Association games ... CSU last defeated Gardner-Webb in 2021 (W, 32-24 in 2OT).

* **EASTERN ILLINOIS:** The Panthers are looking to start 2-0 in Association games for the first time, and last opened 2-0 in conference games in 2017 (4-0 in OVC) ... EIU last defeated Tennessee State in 2023 (W, 30-17 at home).

* **GARDNER-WEBB:** The Runnin' Bulldogs are looking to start 1-0 in Association games for the first time, and last opened 1-0 in conference games in 2022 (Big South) ... GWU has won the last three meetings with Charleston Southern.

* **LINDENWOOD:** The Lions are looking to start 2-0 in Association games for the first time, as well as win back-to-back league games for the first time in their Division I era ... Lindenwood is seeking its fifth consecutive home victory on Saturday.

* **SOUTHEAST MISSOURI:** The Redhawks are idle this week and return to action next Saturday at home against Tennessee State.

* **TENNESSEE STATE:** The Tigers are looking to avoid starting 0-2 in Association games for the first time ... Tennessee State won last year's meeting with EIU (W, 41-17), and has won four of the last five match-ups.

* **TENNESSEE TECH:** The Golden Eagles are looking to start 2-0 in Association games for the second consecutive year ... Tech's lone victory over WIU was in 2019 (W, 38-24 in Macomb).

* **UT MARTIN:** The Skyhawks are looking to start 2-0 in Association games for the first time since 2023 (3-0) ... Both of UTM's wins over Lindenwood were home victories (56-26 in 2022; 33-26 in OT in 2024).

* **WESTERN ILLINOIS:** The Leathernecks are looking to avoid starting 0-1 in Association games for the first time ... WIU won last year's meeting with TTU, 37-21 at home on Oct. 19, which was also Tech's last conference loss.

2-MINUTE OFFENSE

OPENING KICKOFF: Tennessee Tech is ranked No. 9/11 this week, marking the 18th consecutive week that an Association member has appeared in the National Top 25 poll — extending a league record that began Sept. 16, 2024. Meanwhile, Tennessee Tech has its highest ranking ever in the I-AA/FCS era (since 1978).

1st DOWN: Tennessee Tech is the first team in the Association's brief history to open a season 4-0, and is one of seven FCS programs at least 4-0 at this point of the 2025 season. It is Tech's first 4-0 start since 1977 (started 8-0). The Golden Eagles' current 9-game win streak is tied for the longest active streak in the Football Championship Subdivision, and is the longest overall winning streak in the Association's three years of existence. Meanwhile, Tech has won five-straight conference games, matching the Association record accomplished three times previously.

2nd DOWN: Tennessee Tech leads the FCS in scoring offense (54.3 points per game) and rushing defense (55.8 yards allowed), and ranks fourth in both total offense (510.8 yards per game) and total defense (218.5).

3rd DOWN: UT Martin QB **JASE BAUER** rushed for a career-high 107 yards in the Skyhawks' Week 5 win over Southeast Missouri, which is the fourth-most single-game rushing total by an Association quarterback in the league's existence.

4th DOWN: Through four Association conference games played, the road teams are 3-1. Two of the four contests were single-digit winning margins, while the other two were decided by at least 27 points. The winning team eclipsed 30 points in each contest and averaged 33.8 points, while the losing team managed 17.3 points in the match-ups.

ABOUT THE OVC-Big South Football Association

This is the third season of the OVC-Big South Football Association. On Feb. 22, 2022, the Big South Conference and Ohio Valley Conference announced the creation of an association of their football member institutions that began play with the 2023 NCAA Division I football season. The initial agreement of at least four years was enhanced on June 12, 2024 that will provide an opportunity to extend the original partnership through 2030 and beyond. The unique agreement combines the two conferences' football membership to ensure NCAA championship access and stability for the multisport conferences. In creating the association, presidents from each of the multisport conferences pointed to the similarities of the OVC and the Big South, with their complementary geographies and intercollegiate athletic philosophies, as key to making this association possible.

OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Jase Bauer, UT Martin, QB • 6-2, 215, Sr. • Ankeny, Iowa

Bauer accounted for 332 yards of total offense and four touchdowns as UT Martin topped Southeast Missouri 34-10 for its first victory of the season. The senior completed 15-of-22 passes for 225 yards and two touchdowns and carried the ball 15 times for 107 yards (7.1 ypc) and two additional touchdowns. It marked the first UTM quarterback to rush for 100 yards since the 2005 season (Brady Wahlberg). He threw a 75-yard touchdown on the first play from scrimmage and added a seven-yard rushing score just over two minutes later. He threw a 21-yard score in the second quarter and capped his scoring with a two-yard run in the fourth quarter. Bauer ranks 13th nationally in completion percentage (69.3%).

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Keyshawn Johnson, UT Martin, LB • 6-3, 230, Jr. • Belle Glade, Fla.

Johnson had seven tackles (three solo), 2.5 tackles for loss (for -9 yards), 2.0 total sacks and three quarterback hurries as UT Martin topped Southeast Missouri to win its League opener. He helped key a Skyhawk defense that limited SEMO to just 239 yards of total offense (including 30 rushing yards).

SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Antonio Chadha, Western Illinois, K • 5-9, 200, Jr. • Bryn Mawr, Pa.

Chadha was perfect on five kicks in Western Illinois' game with Eastern Illinois on Saturday. The junior connected from 35, 49 and 22 yards on field goals and was 2-of-2 in PATs. He also had five kickoffs, two of which went for touchbacks. Chadha has missed only one field goal (a 48-yarder at Northwestern) this season and ranks 17th nationally in field goal percentage (85.7%).

FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

Jacarre Fleming, Eastern Illinois, RB • 5-8, 195, R-Fr. • Hahira, Ga.

Fleming accounted for 177 all-purpose yards as Eastern Illinois topped Western Illinois 31-23 for its first win in Macomb since 1990. The redshirt freshman carried the ball nine times for 111 yards (12.3 yards/carry) and two touchdowns, caught a pass for five yards and had three kickoff returns for 61 yards (20.3 yards per return). His first score came on a 55-yard run just before halftime to put the Panthers ahead 21-6 at the break. Earlier in the fourth quarter he scored from 30 yards out, helping EIU clinch the victory against its longtime rival.

GRAB A PLATE

Saturday's Charleston Southern at Gardner-Webb match-up is the second rendition of the "North-South BBQ Bowl" in which the winner receives the official "BBQ Bowl" trophy that features a hefty hog adorned with a placard engraved with the winning score. The Runnin' Bulldogs won last year's contest, 17-14, and were treated to a BBQ feast from the Charleston Southern administration as part of the rivalry lore.

HIGH FLYING

The Tennessee Tech Golden Eagles have scored 217 points in their first four games, setting an Association record for most points after four games in the league's young history. The previous high was 148 points set by UT Martin after four games of the 2023 season. Meanwhile, Tech is the first team in Association history to score at least 40 points in three consecutive games, as the Golden Eagles started the season with 65, 45 and 72 points. The 72 points against Davidson in Week 3 was an Association-record against a Division I opponent. In addition, TTU amassed three-straight games with 500-plus offensive yards (570-513-576), establishing another Association record for most consecutive games with 500 yards of total offense. Lastly, Tennessee Tech's two 60-point games this year is an Association single-season record.

UT Martin QB **JASE BAUER** became the third Association quarterback this season with 200 passing and 100 rushing yards in a contest this past week after throwing for 225 yards and gaining 107 on the ground in the Skyhawks' victory over Southeast Missouri. He joins Gardner-Webb's **NATE HAMPTON** (263 P, 132 R vs. Western Carolina in Week 1) and Lindenwood's **NATE GLANTZ** (249 P, 104 R vs. Stony Brook in Week 4). This season is the first time any Association quarterback has recorded a 200-passing & 100-rushing game.

BIRDS OF PREY

Tennessee Tech has recorded an interception in each game this season with six total picks, tied for third-most in the FCS. This past week, **ANDREW SMITH** had a 94-yard pick-six at Tennessee State, the longest interception return in Association history, and the second-straight game the Golden Eagles returned an INT for a score. Smith's return bested the previous record of 85 yards, achieved by TTU's **JACQUEZ MCGOWAN** in 2023 against North Alabama. Tennessee Tech has now returned multiple interceptions for touchdowns in all three seasons of the Association's existence, and is the first Association member with pick-6's in consecutive games.

CATCH ALL

UT Martin WR **BRYCE BAILEY** is the first wide receiver and second non-quarterback in OVC-Big South Association history to rush, catch and throw a touchdown in a season in the league's brief existence. He became just the fourth non-QB in Association history to throw a touchdown pass in a game, but the first to do so against an FBS opponent when he connected with RB **JOHN GENTRY** on a 39-yard scoring play at Oklahoma State in Week 1. Bailey, who has thrown a pass in three of five games this season and is 2-of-3 for 54 yards and a score, rushed for a touchdown in Week 2, and caught two touchdowns passes this past week vs. Southeast Missouri. The first non-QB with the rush-catch-throw TD trifecta was Robert Morris tight end **CHAESE JACKSON** in 2023.

FOUR OVC-BIG SOUTH PLAYERS NAMED SEMIFINALISTS FOR CAMPBELL TROPHY

Charleston Southern LB **NICK BARTALO**, Eastern Illinois LS **BRETT GALLETTI**, Tennessee Tech WR **TREMEL JONES** and Western Illinois DB **CHRISTIAN PIERCE** were named among the 44 Semifinalists for the 2025 **WILLIAM V. CAMPBELL** Trophy last week, college football's premier scholar-athlete award presented by the National Football Foundation & College Football Hall of Fame. The NFF will announce 12-16 finalists on Oct. 22.

KEYS TO THE CITY

UT Martin DL **KEYSHAWN JOHNSON** leads the Association with 8.0 tackles-for-loss -- tied for fourth in the nation, and his 1.60 TFL per game ranks 10th in the FCS. Johnson has an Association-best three games this season with at least 2.0 tackles-for-loss (2.0 at Oklahoma State, 2.0 at Missouri State and 2.5 vs. Southeast Missouri). He is also the league-leader with 4.5 sacks.

SPECIAL AGENT

Lindenwood R-Freshman WR **RICO BOND** leads the Association with four receiving TDs and is tied for the lead with 25 receptions, while his 327 receiving yards rank third. During a three-game span during Weeks 2-4, Bond caught 20 passes for 274 yards and four touchdowns, and reached the end zone in all three contests.

TECHIES

Tennessee Tech has scored 30 touchdowns through four contests (7.5 per game), and **QUINTELL QUINN** and **Q'DARYIUS JENNINGS** have reached the end zone in all four games thus far. A total of 15 different players have scored a touchdown for the Golden Eagles this year. Last season, Tech also had 15 different players with a TD, while the Association single-season team record for most players with a touchdown is 16 (set by Gardner-Webb in 2023 and matched by UT Martin in 2024).

RUSH HOUR

Eastern Illinois is the only Association team with three different players with a 100-yard rushing game this year, as well as the only league member to have a player score multiple TDs in every contest thus far. Meanwhile, the Panthers' touchdowns in three games this year were all rushing scores, with the remaining game (Week 3) being all receiving touchdowns.

ACE IN THE HOLMAN

Western Illinois RB **MARKELL HOLMAN** leads the Association with 419 rushing yards, and has been the Leathernecks' leading rusher in all five games this season. He recorded back-to-back 100-yard games with 139 against Valparaiso in Week 3, and 118 at Eastern Washington in Week 4.

QUICK GLANTZ

Lindenwood QB **NATE GLANTZ** was the only Association signal-caller to throw for 200-plus passing yards *AND* a TD pass in the first four games of the season. In Week 4, he became the second QB in Association history with a 200-yard passing (249) & 100-yard rushing (104) game against Stony Brook. Glantz leads the OVC-Big South with five rushing scores this year, as well as with 1,117 passing yards.

SUPER SIZE COMBO

Southeast Missouri (569) and Southern Illinois (612) combined for 1,181 yards of total offense in Week 4, the second-most combined total offense in a game in the Association record book, and the most combined offensive yards for a non-conference contest.

JUMPING JAX

Southeast Missouri QB **JAX LEATHERWOOD** threw for an OVC-Big South season-high 422 yards in Week 4 against nationally-ranked Southern Illinois, the fifth-highest single-game passing yards in Association history. He is the league leader with 99 completions, and is second with 1,113 passing yards and seven TD passes.

HUNGRY LIKE A WOLF

Eastern Illinois freshman QB **CONNOR WOLF** threw for 411 yards against Illinois State in Week 3, the most by a freshman in Association history, and at the time was the sixth-most in a game in the league's brief existence (now seventh). Wolf also threw four touchdown passes against the Redbirds, becoming the just the fourth different QB in Association era with a 400-yard / 4-TD performance. The others were Southeast Missouri's **PAXTON DeLAURENT** (2 in 2024), Western Illinois' **NATHAN LAMB** (1 in 2024) and Eastern Illinois' **PIERCE HOLLEY** (1 in 2024).

RECEPTIONS

Southeast Missouri receiving tandem **KALVIN GILBERT** (125) and **CAM PEDRO** (105) tallied 100-yard receiving efforts against Southern Illinois in Week 4. It was the fifth time that SEMO had multiple 100-yard receiving individuals in the same game, the most in Association history. Following the Redhawks for most games with two players with 100 yards receiving are Eastern Illinois (3), Western Illinois (3) and Bryant (1).

BULLDOG BITES

Gardner-Webb's 52-45 season-opening win at then-No. 18/19 Western Carolina was the Association's first over a ranked non-conference foe in the regular-season since Sept. 21, 2024, when Southeast Missouri knocked off No. 7/7 Southern Illinois, 38-21. The Association now has five wins over nationally-ranked out-of-conference members in its three-year history, three of which occurred in 2024. Gardner-Webb's 627 yards of offense against the Catamounts were the fourth-most in a single-game in the Association record book.

BACK-PACKING

Eastern Illinois QB **COLE LaCRUE** rushed for 193 yards in Week 1, an Association-record for a quarterback. He threw for 129 yards to become just the third QB in Association history with 100 rushing + passing yards in a game. Two days later, Gardner-Webb's **NATE HAMPTON** became the first with 200 passing + 100 rushing yards in a contest, as he threw for 263 yards and rushed for 132 in GWU's win at Western Carolina. Hampton was also the first QB in Association history with four rushing TDs in a game.

AROUND THE ASSOCIATION...

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Bucs snapped their 14-game losing streak last week with a 31-24 home victory over South Carolina State in front of the third-largest crowd in school history (6,211). RB **KE'MARION BALDWIN** scored on a 10-yard rush with 1:03 remaining to break the 24-24 tie, and send CSU to its first-ever win over SCSU. The win also helped the Bucs avoid a program-tying 15th consecutive loss. Baldwin finished with 122 rushing yards and two scores, and Charleston Southern had its first 30-point game since Nov. 4, 2023 (35 vs. Tennessee State) ... The win was the Bucs' first non-conference victory since Sept. 7, 2024 (W, 24-20 over nationally-ranked Furman) ... This week, Charleston Southern goes for its first winning streak since 2023 (two-straight wins from Sept. 30-Oct. 14).

EASTERN ILLINOIS

The Panthers' 31-23 win over Western Illinois last week was the program's first victory in Macomb in 35 years (October 1990). EIU scored all four touchdowns on the ground and finished with 239 rushing yards, the program's most rushing yards in a contest since Sept. 23, 2023 (311 vs. McNeese) ... **JACARRE FLEMING** gained a team-high 111 yards on just nine carries (≈12.3 yards per rush) with two scores, while **CHARLES KELLUM** had 74 rushing yards (10 carries) and **JAY PEARSON** added 59 yards (11 carries) ... This week, Eastern Illinois goes for its first winning streak since winning the final four contests of the 2023 season.

GARDNER-WEBB

The Runnin' Bulldogs enter the week seeking their first three-game FCS win streak since winning five-straight FCS contests to close out the 2023 regular-season ... Gardner-Webb has won three of its last four home games ... GWU is looking to record three wins through the first five games of a season for the first time since opening the 2021 season at 3-2 ... Gardner-Webb's 122 points this season are the program's most through the first four games since 2021, when the Runnin' Bulldogs scored 143 in their first four contests.

LINDENWOOD

Lindenwood played its second and final FBS opponent of the season last week, and suffered its first shut-out since the 2017 season (lost 19-0 to Northwest Missouri State on Oct. 21) ... The Lions are seeking their first three-game FCS win streak since winning three-straight during the 2022 campaign (defeated Central Arkansas, Eastern Illinois and Murray State from Oct. 8-22).

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI

The Redhawks' 10 points in their Association-opening loss to UT Martin was their fewest in a conference game since scoring 10 at Murray State in 2021 (L, 28-10 on Nov. 13) ... RB **BRANDON EPTON JR's** 4-yard touchdown run extended Southeast Missouri's TD streak to 28 games ... SEMO is looking to avoid starting 1-5 for the first time since 2013 (started 1-7), as well as avoid dropping back-to-back Association games for the first time since 2023 (lost final three league games).

TENNESSEE STATE

RB **KENDRIC RHYMES** was the Tigers' leading rusher for the fourth-straight game with his 31 yards in last week's Association-opening loss to Tennessee Tech. He also had 53 receiving yards to finish with 84 all-purpose yards. QB **JONATHAN PALMER** was 13-of-25 passing for 127 yards, while **BRYON McNAIR** was 8-of-14 passing for 114. **FREDDY PEREZ** made field goals of 30 and 23 yards to get TSU on the scoreboard before the team recorded a late safety for the final margin.

TENNESSEE TECH

Tennessee Tech is 4-0 for the sixth time in program history, and its best start since 1977 (8-0) ... TTU's nine-straight wins also ties the longest winning streak in program history ... The Golden Eagles recorded 12 tackles-for-loss last week at Tennessee State, tied for the fourth-most in a single-game in Association history. RB **QUINTELL QUINN** rushed for a game-high 107 yards on just seven carries, while **Q'DARYIUS JENNINGS** added 71 yards on just six attempts. ... Through four games in 2025, Tech has rushed for 16 touchdowns and thrown for 10, has outscored the opposition 217 to 39, and has limited foes to 55.8 net rushing yards per game (233 total) ... Dating back to last season, TTU has held its last eight opponents to less than 300 yards of offense AND below 100 net rushing yards -- both Association consecutive records.

UT MARTIN

QB **JASE BAUER** and WR **BRYCE BAILEY** were the main contributors in the Skyhawks' 34-10 Association-opening win over Southeast Missouri. Bauer was responsible for all four UTM touchdowns (two passing, two rushing) and became the first Skyhawk quarterback to rush for more than 100 yards since Hall of Famer **BRADY WAHLBERG** on Oct. 15, 2005. Bauer was 15-of-22 passing for 225 yards along with 107 rushing yards, and connected twice with Bailey for scoring strikes of 75 and 21 yards. Bailey finished with seven catches for 135 yards on the day ... The Skyhawks have scored 30-plus points in 10 of its last 12 Association games ... UTM is 14-1 against conference foes at home since 2020.

WESTERN ILLINOIS

TE **ALEX WILLIAMS** tallied both the Leathernecks' touchdowns last week against Eastern Illinois with receiving grabs of 8 and 6 yards. WR **TRISTIN DUNCAN** posted the Association's first 10-reception game this season with 10 catches (78 yards). **ANTONIO CHADHA** converted all three of his field goal attempts, with a long of 49.

OVC-Big South Football Tiebreaker Procedure

1. TRANSITIONING SCHOOLS

- To be eligible for the conference's automatic bid to the FCS Football Championship, a school must be a full Division I member.
- Transitioning schools will be utilized in the tiebreaker process.
- If a transitioning school is involved in a two-way tie, the tied team that is eligible for postseason competition shall be the league's recipient of the automatic bid.
- If a transitioning school wins the multi-team tiebreaker, the procedure would start over with the remaining teams.

2. TWO-WAY TIE

- If the two teams played each other during the conference season, the winner of the head-to-head contest shall be the league's recipient of the automatic bid.
- If the tied teams did not play each other during the conference season, each team's head-to-head record against all common opponents in the league will be used to determine the automatic bid.
- If a tie still exists, then each team's record against the next highest common opponent in the league standings will be used to determine the automatic bid. When arriving at a group of tied teams that each team has played, composite records between the tied teams shall be utilized to determine if one of the tied teams has won more games against the group of tied teams.
- If the teams are still tied, a point system will be utilized based on a complete schedule and wins using the NCAA four-metric average ranking for FCS* following all games on the final Saturday of the regular season (and the Massey ranking entering the final day of the regular season for FBS opponents) as indicated below:
- Should the points system finish in a tie, the team with the best ranking in the NCAA four-metric average for FCS* following all games on the final Saturday of the regular season will receive the automatic bid.

3. MULTIPLE TIES

- If at any point, a tie is broken using the multiple-tie tiebreaker procedures and only two teams remain, the remaining teams will revert to the two-way tiebreaker (head-to-head).
- If the tied teams all played each other during the conference season, the team with the best cumulative record involving games with the tied teams shall be declared champion. For example, if a team is 2-0 against two other tied teams, that team will be declared champion.
- If the tied teams all played one another and have identical records against the other tied teams, then each team's record against all common opponents in the league will be used to determine the automatic bid. If teams are still tied, then each team's record against the next highest common opponent in the league standings will be used to determine the automatic bid.
- If the tied teams did not play each other, then each team's record against all common opponents in the league will be used to determine the automatic bid. If the teams are still tied, and they did not play each other, then each team's record against the next highest common opponent in the league standings will be used to determine the automatic bid.
- If the teams are still tied, a point system will be utilized based on a complete schedule and wins using the NCAA four-metric average ranking for FCS* following all games on the final Saturday of the regular season (and the Massey ranking entering the final day of the regular season for FBS opponents) as indicated below:
- Should the points system finish in a tie, the team with the best ranking in the NCAA four-metric average for FCS* following all games on the final Saturday of the regular season will receive the automatic bid.
