BIG TEN. BIG NEWS.

- After a two-day midweek break, the Big Ten women's basketball schedule gets going again with multiple games daily through the weekend. The action tips off Thursday with a pair of games, as No. 15/15 Indiana hosts Tennessee in non-conference play (4 p.m. ET on Big Ten Network+) and Purdue entertains No. 16/18 Northwestern in a conference matchup (7 p.m. ET on BTN/FOX Sports app).
- The Big Ten salutes former Ohio State (and current Stanford) head coach Tara VanDerveer, who has tied Tennessee's Pat Summitt for the most wins ever by an NCAA women's basketball coach (1,098). VanDerveer led OSU to a 110-37 (.748) record and four Big Ten titles (1982-85) during her five-year tenure in Columbus (1980-81 to 1984-85) and still holds the Big Ten coaching record for career winning percentage in conference play (.534, .930). She will go in search of her record-breaking 1,099th career win Tuesday night when Stanford visits Pacific (9 p.m. ET on ESPN2).
- Once again this week, Iowa's Caitlin Clark was named the Big Ten Player and Freshman of the Week, the conference announced Monday. Clark, who also became the first Big Ten freshman ever to be named the ESPNW National Player of the Week, averaged 34.5 points, 7.0 rebounds and 5.0 assists in the Hawkeyes' two games last week. The West Des Moines, Iowa, native is also the first conference freshman to be a two-time Big Ten Player of the Week in the same season since 2015-16 (Nebraska's Jessica Shepard).
- For the third consecutive week, the Big Ten shares top honors among all conferences with five Top 25 teams in both the Associated Press and Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA)/USA Today polls, plus three others receiving votes. Both polls can be found in full on page 3 of this update.
- The Big Ten has the nation's third-best non-conference winning percentage (against D-I opponents) this season, with an .829 (34-7) mark to date. That includes three wins over Top 25 teams — Maryland 115-96 over No. 14 Arkansas on Nov. 29 (a Big Ten record for points against a ranked team); Michigan 76-66 at No. RV/23 Notre Dame on Dec. 3; Iowa 82-80 over No. RV/24 Iowa State on Dec. 9.
- The start of conference play in the Big Ten has proven highly competitive this year. Of the seven conference games played to date, five have been decided by single digits (and a sixth by just 13 points).
- Big Ten teams have quickly discovered their shooting touch, with six conference programs among the nation's top 20 (including five in the top 11) in field-goal percentage in Tuesday's NCAA statistics report. Ohio State is No. 1 (.556), followed by Northwestern (3rd - .537), Michigan (4th - .531) and Iowa (9th - .506). Maryland (11th - .499) and Indiana (18th - .487) are also in the top 20 in field-goal percentage.
- Ohio State is one of several Big Ten programs to lead the nation in various NCAA statistical categories as of Tuesday. Along with OSU's top-ranked field-goal percentage (.556), Maryland is No. 1 in the country in scoring offense (96.8 ppg.), while Northwestern is tops in both assists (23.5 apg.) and assist/turnover ratio (2.14), while Rutgers is a close second in the nation in steals (16.0 spg.).
- Several Big Ten programs added non-conference games to their pre-Christmas schedules. Indiana will play host to Tennessee on Thursday (4 p.m. ET), while Maryland entertains James Madison on Saturday (11 a.m. ET). Rutgers also has three more games on its schedule, hosting Hampton (Friday at noon ET), Sacred Heart (Sunday at 8 p.m. ET) and Manhattan (Dec. 23 at noon ET) before the holiday break.
- As the season progresses, more Big Ten women's basketball games are being added to the BTN and the FOX Sports app schedule, including several upcoming conference matchups — Thursday (Northwestern at Purdue - 7 p.m. ET), Saturday (Michigan at Illinois - noon ET) and a Sunday doubleheader (Purdue at

- Michigan State is 2-0 in conference play for the first time since the 2013-14 season following the Spartans' 86-82 win over Iowa on Dec. 12 in East Lansing. Iowa's Caitlin Clark scored a career-high 35 points in a losing effort, her third 30-point game in five outings this season.
- Michigan is off to its first 5-0 start since 2016-17 following its 93-54 win over Butler on Dec. 9 at Crisler Center. It's the eighth time in program history, and the third under current head coach Kim Barnes Arico, the Wolverines have opened with five consecutive victories.
- With its Dec. 9 victory over Iowa State, Iowa extended its home winning streak to 39 games, the second-longest active string in the nation behind Baylor (58). The Hawkeyes' run began on Feb. 4, 2018, with a 92-84 win over Minnesota.
- Maryland made a Big Ten-record 21 three-pointers (tying for eighth on the NCAA Division I single-game list) in its 112-78 home-opening win over Towson on Dec. 3. The Terrapins topped the previous conference record of 19 treys, shared by Iowa (at Northwestern, Jan. 29, 2015) and Minnesota (at Illinois, Jan. 7, 2016). In addition, Maryland's 21 three-pointers and .677 three-point percentage in the Towson win are the best by any NCAA Division I program this season.
- Indiana junior guard Grace Berger, tallied the first triple-double in Indiana women's basketball history on Nov. 25 with 17 points, 10 rebounds and 10 assists. Berger also recorded the 29th triple-double in Big Ten history and first since Jan. 23, 2018 (Illinois' Alex Wittinger at Penn State). Berger is one of three Division I players with a triple-double this year (Taiah Thornton of Saint Peter's did it the same day as Berger [Nov. 25] against NJIT; Buffalo's Dyaisha Fair did so Sunday vs. Akron).
- On Nov. 23, the Big Ten released its 2020-21 conference schedule, which will see schools play 20 Big Ten games, up two from the previous two seasons. Schools will play seven opponents twice (home and away) and the other six once (three at home and three on the road). To account for the additional games and preserve flexibility in the schedule, the Big Ten Women's Basketball Tournament has been moved to March 9-13 and will continue to be played at Bankers Life Fieldhouse in Indianapolis.
- On Oct. 23, the Big Ten Conference announced the launch of the 'United As One' social justice campaign. 'United As One' is among several conference-wide Equality Coalition initiatives dedicated to constructively and collectively recognizing and eliminating racism and hate in our society by creating resources for inclusion, empowerment and accountability.
- The Big Ten Conference established the Equality Coalition in 2020 with 227 members including presidents and chancellors, directors of athletics, coaches, student-athletes, conference and school administrators, alumni, families and friends representing all 14 institutions.

Since its inception in 1896, the pursuit and attainment of academic excellence has been a priority for every Big Ten member institution. But maintaining the conference's standard of competing at the highest level in athletics also endures as an important component of the Big Ten experience. Striking that balance between academics and athletics is integral to the Big Ten's identity. Recognized as one of intercollegiate sports' most successful undertakings, the Big Ten strives for success from its students not only on the field and in the classroom, but around the world as well.

PREMIER ACADEMIC INSTITUTIONS

The Big Ten Academic Alliance is an academic consortium of all 14 Big Ten universities, which is widely considered to be the model for effective and voluntary collaboration among top research universities.

Every Big Ten Academic Alliance institution ranks among the top 70 universities in the nation according to the 2019 Academic Ranking of World Universities, including six in the top 30.

The Big Ten leads all conferences with more than 1,800 Academic All-Americans, including 27 honorees during the 2019-20 academic year.

Big Ten Academic Alliance schools annually conduct \$10 billion in funded research, \$5 billion more than any other conference.

A HISTORY OF ATHLETIC SUCCESS

Big Ten schools have won at least five national championships in 23 of the last 26 years, averaging nearly seven per year over that span.

Since the 2008-09 academic year, current Big Ten institutions have claimed 76 team national championships in 21 different sports.

BROAD-BASED PROGRAMMING

The Big Ten will administer over \$200 million in direct financial support to more than 9,800 students competing in intercollegiate athletics for more than 11,000 participation opportunities on 350 teams in 42 different sports.

The Big Ten sponsors 28 official conference sports, 14 for men and 14 for women, including the addition of men's ice hockey and men's and women's lacrosse in this decade.

The Big Ten leads the nation in total students competing in intercollegiate athletics and participation opportunities, and sponsors more official sports than all conferences except the Ivy League.

Almost 1,400 Big Ten competitors have participated in the Olympics, winning more than 600 medals, including nearly 300 gold. In the 2016 and 2018 Olympic Games, more than 200 representatives from Big Ten institutions including current or former students and coaches were members of Olympic teams. Big Ten Olympians collected more than 50 medals in the most recent games in Rio and PyeongChang.

PASSIONATE FOLLOWING

The Big Ten leads all conferences with 6.4 million alumni and nearly 580,000 students.

Each year more than 11 million patrons attend Big Ten home contests, as the conference has led the nation in attendance for men's basketball, ice hockey, volleyball and wrestling.

LEADERS IN INNOVATION

Took part in the nation's first bowl game, winning the 1902 Rose Bowl Game, and signed an exclusive contract with the Tournament of Roses in 1946, making it the first bowl with permanent conference affiliations.

Awarded the first Big Ten Medal of Honor in 1915, honoring outstanding seniors who demonstrated excellence in academics and athletics.

Formed the Big Ten Advisory Commission in 1972, enlisting former students that competed in conference athletics to serve as liaisons to the NCAA's Diversity and Inclusion Department, the Big Ten Student-Athlete Advisory Commission and other organizations.

Became the first conference to voluntarily adopt male and female participation goals after launching its Gender Equity Action Plan in 1992.

Implemented the first collegiate football system of instant replay in 2004, which the NCAA approved for use among all conferences in 2006.

Launched the Big Ten Network (BTN) in 2007, the first national conference-owned television network.

Began partnering with the Ivy League to study the effects of head injuries in sports in 2012.

Accepted Johns Hopkins University as the conference's first sport affiliate members in men's and women's lacrosse in 2013 and 2015, respectively, and added Notre Dame as a sport affiliate member in men's ice hockey in 2017.

EXTENSIVE TELEVISION EXPOSURE

Through the Big Ten's current media agreements with BTN, ABC/ESPN, CBS and FOX, more than 2,000 Big Ten events are produced and distributed nationally and globally on an annual basis.

BTN is in almost 60 million homes across the United States and Canada, and is also available internationally via the Fox Sports App, delivering live and on-demand programming to computers, smartphones and tablets. BTN Plus streams hundreds of additional events each season.

COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

For more than 30 years, through the Big Ten's SCORE (Success Comes Out of Reading Everyday) program, the conference has partnered with Chicago elementary schools to improve reading performance.

Surrounding the Big Ten Football Championship Game and Basketball Tournaments, the conference has held numerous community initiatives, partnered with the College Football Playoff Foundation and other events such as the Big Ten Career Expo, Saturday of Service and Youth Football Clinics. In addition, the Big Ten has hosted a downtown 5K, collaborated with a local breast cancer awareness group and provided unique event experiences for military veterans.
