BIG TEN. BIG NEWS.

- For the first time in conference history the Big Ten has nine teams in both the *Associated Press* and *USA TODAY* polls. According to @BTNStatsGuys, the Big Ten's nine teams are the most that any conference has had in the *AP* poll since the Big East also had nine teams on March 7, 2011. The Big Ten's nine teams equal the next two league leaders combined (Big 12 with five and ACC with four). No. 19/No. 22 Northwestern and No. 21/No. 24 Minnesota cracked both polls for the first time this season. In addition to the conference's nine teams, Indiana received votes in this week's *AP* poll, while Purdue received votes in this week's *USA TODAY* coaches poll.
- The Big Ten recorded a 67-14 record (.872 pct.) in Division 1 non-conference play (69-14 overall), marking the highest non-conference winning percentage by any conference in the NCAA. The Big Ten leads the following conferences in non-conference winning percentage: Big 12 (49-11, .816), AAC (34-13, .723), Big East (39-14, .735), SEC (66-22, .750) and ACC (60-22, .731). According to KenPom's rankings, which are based off of KenPom's adjusted efficiency margin metric, the Big Ten finished non-conference play with an 18-13 (.581 pct.) record against top 100 teams.
- The Big Ten boasts three of the top four scorers in the country in Iowa's Luka Garza (1st, 28.8 ppg), Minnesota's Marcus Carr (3rd, 24.6 ppg) and Illinois' Ayo Dosunmu (4th, 24.1 ppg). Additionally, Rutgers' Ron Harper Jr. is tied for 7th in the NCAA with 23.4 points per game.
- No. 19/No. 22 Northwestern has jumped out to a 3-0 start in conference play for the first time since the 1967-68 season. Northwestern defeated Indiana 74-67 on Wednesday and then added to its resume on Saturday, Dec. 26 with a win over then-ranked No. 23/No. 20 Ohio State. The Wildcats' win over the Buckeyes came just one week after they defeated then-ranked No. 4/No. 4 Michigan State, marking the first time since the 2012-13 season that the Wildcats defeated multiple ranked teams in the same week
- No. 21/No. 24 Minnesota notched its first ranked win of the season when the Golden Gophers defeated then-ranked No. 4/No.5 lowa 102-95 in overtime. Junior Marcus Carr scored 30 points in the win, marking his second-straight 30-point game, and has now registered over 1,000 points in his three-year collegiate career. Senior Brandon Johnson established a new program record for three-point percentage by connecting on 8-of-9 attempts (.889 pct.).
- Then-ranked No. 9/No. 9 Wisconsin and then-ranked No. 12/No. 11 Michigan State squared off in a marquee Christmas Day matchup that was televised to a national audience on FOX. The Badgers, now ranked No. 6/No. 7, moved to 8-1 with an 85-76 victory over the Spartans behind a season-high 29 points from senior G D'Mitrik Trice. The Badgers have now won 10 straight Big Ten contests dating back to the 2019-20 season, marking the program's longest conference winning streak since a 10-game streak during the 2014-15 season.
- Illinois sophomore C Kofi Cockburn scored 15 points and grabbed 15 rebounds in the team's win over Indiana, marking his sixth double-double of the season. Cockburn's six double-doubles are the third-most in the country this season trailing only Malachi Smith of Chattanooga and Jordan Goodwin of Saint Louis (seven each).
- lowa currently ranks third in country in points per game (95.11), trailing only Coastal Carolina (96.14) and Gonzaga (95.14). Michigan State (22.5) and lowa (22.0) lead the country in assists per game, while lowa (2.30) and Northwestern (1.93) are tops in the nation in assist-turnover ratio.

BIG TEN WEEKLY AWARDS

Ayo Dosunmu of Illinois was named Co-Player of the Week after averaging 30.0 points, 5.0 assists and 4.0 rebounds in wins over Penn State and Indiana. Dosunmu became the first Illini player in 23 years to register back-to-back 30-point games and is the only player in the country averaging at least 20 points, five rebounds and five assists or game. sists per game.

Marcus Carr of Minnesota was named Co-Player of the Week after scoring 30 points and dishing out eight rebounds in the team's win against lowa. Carr hit two threepointers in the final 31 seconds of the game, including one with five seconds left on the clock to force overtime. Carr ranks third in the country in scoring (24.6 ppg)

Hunter Dickinson of Michigan was named Freshman of the Week for the third time this season. Dickinson scored 13 points, grabbed a career-high 15 rebounds and blocked two shots in Michigan's win at Nebraska to help the Wolverines stay undefeated on the season (7-0).

The five Equality Coalition subcommittees -- Education, Inclusion, Community Engagement, Partnership and Public Affairs -- are actively

The five Equality Coalition subcommittees -- Education, Inclusion, Community Engagement, Partnership and Public Affairs -- are actively developing programming and initiatives addressing voter registration, voting, implicit bias training, diversity and engagement programming, best-practices for hiring and conference-wide directory for community outreach programs.

The Big Ten Conference is committed to equipping all people to recognize and combat hate and racism and to cement a more equitable, inclusive

The Big Ten Conference kicked off the 2020 football season with the launch of the 'United As One' social justice campaign. The Big Ten Equality Coalition has, to date, launched several evergreen social justice initiatives in addition to 'United As One.' #B1GVote was established in partnership with the National Lawyers Committee for Civil Rights as a nonpartisan conference-wide educational collaboration to encourage student-athletes to take part in the electoral process.

"All things are possible in the Big Ten when we unite as one," said Big Ten Commissioner Kevin Warren. "I am humbled and deeply appreciative of how our 14 member institutions have communicated, collaborated and committed to develop a conference-wide campaign focused on creating equality and equity in our society."

BIG TEN MEN'S BASKETBALL SOCIAL JUSTICE

Big Ten men's basketball programs continue to support social justice. See below for more information on how Big Ten programs are activating initiatives on their campuses and in their communities.

- In June 2020, the Indiana men's basketball issued a statement that "Racism, in no way, shape or form, can be tolerated." The Hoosiers produced and released a video on social media titled "Our Part."
- lowa Hawkeyes student-athletes had the word EQUALITY on the back of their jersey, underneath the number, and the words PEACE, LOVE, EQUALITY on the front of their pregame shooting shirts when they took the court to tip off the 2020-21 season. Coaches and staff on the bench will rotate wearing ANTI-HATE and ANTI-RACISM lapel pins each game. Click here for more information on how the lowa team takes a stand against social injustice and inequality.
- Maryland student-athletes chose to add the phrases "End Racism" and "Solidarity" to the XFINITY Center court for the 2020-21 season.
- In October 2020, the University of Michigan Athletic Department <u>announced a student-athlete initiative</u> that saw the development of two designs that reflect campus unity and diversity, to be worn on team uniforms, helmets and pregame warmups by all U-M varsity programs during the 2020-21 academic year. The athletic department announced that teams would vote independently to wear either a similar "EQUALITY" or "BLM" mark on their uniforms/helmets. The Michigan men's basketball team tipped off their 2020-21 season against Bowling Green on Nov. 25 and the team's uniforms featured a black circular patch containing the initials "BLM."
- The Minnesota Golden Gophers men's basketball team opened its season on Nov. 25 vs. Green Bay. The program announced it would be promoting messages for social justice throughout the 2020-21 season. The Gophers will wear a 'Love Us' BLM patch on their uniforms, as well as a 'Unity' warm up.
- Amidst the national protests and a summer of unrest and injustice, Nebraska men's basketball was inspired to become change agents in the fight against injustice. For the 2020-21 season, the Huskers will wear a patch on their uniforms that reads "No More Hashtags." No more hashtags, only change. This phrase, not meant to only inspire action instead of talk, is also meant to inspire no more hashtags of names, specifically of victims of injustice. The patch symbolizes the need to move towards actionable steps outlined. Bring awareness to the issues, educating yourself on these issues, being unified on creating change in the world, and the plead to have no more names becoming hashtags.
- Northwestern men's basketball debuted its "Pound The Rock" uniform patch, which depicts a raised fist holding the "Pound The Rock" hammer as a symbol for the ungoing fight against racial injustice and system racism. Additionally, the Wildcats wore Fight For Equality warmup shirts designed by student manager Roman McGee.
- The Ohio State men's basketball team unveiled new uniforms in October 2020. Prior to the Buckeyes' season opener vs. Illinois State, they also announced the <u>addition of a new Equality patch</u> to the uniform.
- The Rutgers men's basketball tipped off the season on Nov. 25 and displayed two new uniform patches during its opening-weekend, non-conference contests. The two patches read "End Racial Inequality" and "Better Together."
- Wisconsin student-athletes will be showing their solidarity with Black and other underrepresented communities on campus as UW Athletics uniforms will include a university crest logo with a black "W." a show of support, inclusion and unity from Badger student-athletes, the UW Athletic Department and UW-Madison as a whole. Wisconsin men's basketball debuted its patch during the season-opening win vs. Eastern Illinois and the Badgers student-athletes wore black warm-up tops with the word "Unity" printed on the back and the school's Black Crest on the front.

Since its inception in 1896, the pursuit and attainment of academic excellence has been a priority for every Big Ten member institution. But maintaining the conference's standard of competing at the highest level in athletics also endures as an important component of the Big Ten experience. Striking that balance between academics and athletics is integral to the Big Ten's identity. Recognized as one of intercollegiate sports' most successful undertakings, the Big Ten strives for success from its students not only on the field and in the classroom, but around the world as well.

PREMIER ACADEMIC INSTITUTIONS

The Big Ten Academic Alliance is an academic consortium of all 14 Big Ten universities, which is widely considered to be the model for effective and voluntary collaboration among top research universities.

Every Big Ten Academic Alliance institution ranks among the top 70 universities in the nation according to the 2019 Academic Ranking of World Universities, including six in the top 30.

The Big Ten leads all conferences with more than 1,800 Academic All-Americans, including 27 honorees during the 2019-20 academic year.

Big Ten Academic Alliance schools annually conduct \$10 billion in funded research, \$5 billion more than any other conference.

A HISTORY OF ATHLETIC SUCCESS

Big Ten schools have won at least five national championships in 23 of the last 26 years, averaging nearly seven per year over that span.

Since the 2008-09 academic year, current Big Ten institutions have claimed 76 team national championships in 21 different sports.

BROAD-BASED PROGRAMMING

The Big Ten will administer over \$200 million in direct financial support to more than 9,800 students competing in intercollegiate athletics for more than 11,000 participation opportunities on 350 teams in 42 different sports.

The Big Ten sponsors 28 official conference sports, 14 for men and 14 for women, including the addition of men's ice hockey and men's and women's lacrosse in this decade.

The Big Ten leads the nation in total students competing in intercollegiate athletics and participation opportunities, and sponsors more official sports than all conferences except the lvy League.

Almost 1,400 Big Ten competitors have participated in the Olympics, winning more than 600 medals, including nearly 300 gold. In the 2016 and 2018 Olympic Games, more than 200 representatives from Big Ten institutions including current or former students and coaches were members of Olympic teams. Big Ten Olympians collected more than 50 medals in the most recent games in Rio and PyeongChang.

PASSIONATE FOLLOWING

The Big Ten leads all conferences with 5.7 million alumni and nearly 580,000 students.

Each year more than 11 million patrons attend Big Ten home contests, as the conference has led the nation in attendance for men's basketball, ice hockey, volleyball and wrestling.

LEADERS IN INNOVATION

Took part in the nation's first bowl game, winning the 1902 Rose Bowl Game, and signed an exclusive contract with the Tournament of Roses in 1946, making it the first bowl with permanent conference affiliations.

Awarded the first Big Ten Medal of Honor in 1915, honoring outstanding seniors who demonstrated excellence in academics and athletics.

Formed the Big Ten Advisory Commission in 1972, enlisting former students that competed in conference athletics to serve as liaisons to the NCAA's Diversity and Inclusion Department, the Big Ten Student-Athlete Advisory Commission and other organizations.

Became the first conference to voluntarily adopt male and female participation goals after launching its Gender Equity Action Plan in 1992.

Implemented the first collegiate football system of instant replay in 2004, which the NCAA approved for use among all conferences in 2006.

Launched the Big Ten Network (BTN) in 2007, the first national conference-owned television network.

Began partnering with the Ivy League to study the effects of head injuries in sports in 2012.

Accepted Johns Hopkins University as the conference's first sport affiliate members in men's and women's lacrosse in 2013 and 2015, respectively, and added Notre Dame as a sport affiliate member in men's ice hockey in 2017

EXTENSIVE TELEVISION EXPOSURE

Through the Big Ten's current media agreements with BTN, ABC/ ESPN, CBS and FOX, more than 2,000 Big Ten events are produced and distributed nationally and globally on an annual basis.

BTN is in almost 60 million homes across the United States and Canada, and is also available internationally via the Fox Sports App, delivering live and on-demand programming to computers, smartphones and tablets. BTN Plus streams hundreds of additional events each season.

COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

For more than 30 years, through the Big Ten's SCORE (Success Comes Out of Reading Everyday) program, the conference has partnered with Chicago elementary schools to improve reading performance.

Surrounding the Big Ten Football Championship Game and Basketball Tournaments, the conference has held numerous community initiatives, partnered with the College Football Playoff Foundation and other events such as the Big Ten Career Expo, SaturDAY of Service and Youth Football Clinics. In addition, the Big Ten has hosted a downtown 5K, collaborated with a local breast cancer awareness group and provided unique event experiences for military veterans.
