- After a week-long break for the Christmas holiday, Big Ten women's basketball returns to action
 Thursday afternoon with five conference games on the schedule. Highlighting the New Year's Eve slate
 is a doubleheader on BTN and the FOX Sports app with No. 14/14 Maryland visiting Penn State (noon
 ET) and No. 15/16 Northwestern traveling to Nebraska (2 p.m. ET).
- For the second week in a row, the Big Ten has six Top 25 teams in the Associated Press poll and five in the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA)/USA Today poll, plus others receiving votes, leading all conferences in both polls. This is the first time in Big Ten women's basketball history the conference has had six AP Top 25 teams for multiple weeks in the same season, let alone consecutive weeks (the Big Ten had six in the AP Top 25 for single weeks on Nov. 17, 2014 and Jan. 14, 2019).
- Iowa's Caitlin Clark and Rutgers' Arella Guirantes recorded triple-doubles on consecutive days last week, with Clark doing so on Dec. 22 against Western Illinois (13 points/13 rebounds/10 assists) and Guirantes on Dec. 23 against Manhattan (17 points/10 rebounds/11 assists). It marked the first time in Big Ten women's basketball history that triple-doubles were registered on back-to-back days.
- This season, there have been five triple-doubles in NCAA Division I women's basketball, with three of
 those posted by Big Ten student-athletes (Clark and Guirantes, along with Indiana's Grace Berger on
 Nov. 25 against Eastern Kentucky). It's the first time in Big Ten women's basketball history three
 different student-athletes have recorded a triple-double in the same season, and the third time Big Ten
 student-athletes have had at least three triple-doubles in a season (in both 2013-14 and 2014-15,
 lowa's Samantha Logic and Minnesota's Amanda Zahui B. combined for four triple-doubles).
- Clark is the first Big Ten freshman to post a triple-double since Dec. 19, 2017, when Nebraska's Kate Cain had 22 points, 14 rebounds and 11 blocks in a win over Florida Atlantic. Her triple-double also was the 10th by an Iowa player, tying the Hawkeyes for second-most in NCAA Division I history (Oregon-26).
- Guirantes posted the third triple-double ever by a Rutgers women's basketball player and first since Feb. 8, 2011, when Khadijah Rushdan did so in a win over Pittsburgh.
- Clark and Guirantes shared Monday's Big Ten Player of the Week honors, with Clark also earning the Big Ten Freshman of the Week award. Clark is the second freshman in conference history to be a threetime Big Ten Player of the Week, joining Minnesota's Amanda Zahui B., who received the honor four times in 2013-14
- According to Tuesday's NCAA statistical report, the Big Ten leads all Division I conferences in scoring
 offense (80.0 ppg.) and field-goal percentage (.461), while ranking second in three-point percentage
 (.338), free-throw percentage (.726) and third in rebounding (41.0 rpg.).
- Five Big Ten teams currently rank among the top 20 in the country (and three in the top 10) in scoring offense. Maryland is No. 2 at 97.5 points per game, followed by Ohio State (3rd 96.2), Iowa (7th 90.0), Michigan (14th 87.8) and Rutgers (17th 86.0). No other conference has more than four teams among the top 20 (and one in the top 10) in scoring offense, as of Tuesday.
- Rutgers' success on offense is particularly noteworthy, as the Scarlet Knights are on pace to challenge
 their school record for scoring offense (86.2 ppg. in 1978-79). RU has also scored at least 80 points in
 its last four games, something the Scarlet Knights most recently did with a five-game stretch from Jan.
 3-17, 1991, five seasons before current Hall of Fame coach C. Vivian Stringer arrived in Piscataway.
- The Big Ten features four of the nation's top 20 individual scorers from four different conference

programs. Iowa's Caitlin Clark is fourth in the country in scoring at 27.0 points per game, with Michigan's Naz Hillmon ranking 11th at 24.8 ppg., and Rutgers' Arella Guirantes and Wisconsin's Sydney Hilliard tied at No. 16 (23.0 ppg.). No other conference currently has more than three student-athletes among the top 20 in the country in scoring.

- The Big Ten has six programs among the nation's top 25 (including five in the top 15) in field-goal percentage. Ohio State is No. 2 (.556), followed by Michigan (4th - .531) and Maryland (9th - .500). Rutgers (12th - .495), Iowa (13th - .494) and Michigan State (22nd - .481) are also in the top 25 in fieldgoal percentage. No other conference currently has more than four schools in the top 25 nationally (and one in the top 15) in field-goal percentage.
- Three Big Ten schools lead the nation in various NCAA statistical categories. Ohio State is tops in assist/turnover ratio (1.85), Rutgers leads the way in steals (16.3 spg.) and Northwestern is first in turnover margin (+14.25). Maryland is second in the land in scoring offense (97.5 ppg.), Northwestern is second in turnovers forced (26.25 per game), while Ohio State is second in three other categories — field-goal percentage (.556), scoring margin (+40.8 ppg.) and fewest turnovers (10.2 per game).
- The Big Ten women's basketball television schedule has been updated to include eight appearances on the ESPN family of networks during the remainder of the regular season. The most current schedule of Big Ten women's basketball games on TV may be found online at bigten.org/
- Michigan State is 7-0 for the first time since the 2012-13 season after a 94-56 win over Oakland on Dec. 22. The Spartans shot .650 from the floor (the best by a Big Ten team and third-best among Division I programs this season) on the way to their largest margin of victory and highest point total this year.
- For just the second time, both of the Big Ten's Michigan schools are off to 5-0 starts in the same season. The only other time the Wolverines and Spartans both opened their seasons with at least five consecutive wins was

- 1999-2000, when they each opened 7-0 Michigan would go on to finish second in the Big Ten and reach the NCAA Tournament, while Michigan State tied for fifth in the conference race and advanced to the WNIT quarterfinals.
- With its Dec. 22 victory over Western Illinois, Iowa extended its home winning streak to 40 games, the second-longest active string in the nation behind Baylor (61). The Hawkeyes' run began on Feb. 4, 2018, with a 92-84
- The Big Ten is one of only four Division I conferences with a non-conference winning percentage (against D-I opponents) of better than .800 this season, posting an .846 (44-8) mark to date. That includes three wins over Top 25 teams — Maryland 115-96 over No. 14 Arkansas on Nov. 29 (a Big Ten record for points against a ranked team); Michigan 76-66 at No. RV/23 Notre Dame on Dec. 3; Iowa 82-80 over No. RV/24 Iowa State on Dec. 9.
- On Nov. 23, the Big Ten released its 2020-21 conference schedule, which will see schools play 20 Big Ten games, up two from the previous two seasons. Schools will play seven opponents twice (home and away) and the other six once (three at home and three on the road). To account for the additional games and preserve flexibility in the schedule, the Big Ten Women's Basketball Tournament has been moved to March 9-13 and will continue to be played at Bankers Life Fieldhouse in Indianapolis.
- On Oct. 23, the Big Ten Conference announced the launch of the 'United As One' social justice campaign. 'United As One' is among several conferencewide Equality Coalition initiatives dedicated to constructively and collectively recognizing and eliminating racism and hate in our society by creating resources for inclusion, empowerment and accountability.
- The Big Ten Conference established the Equality Coalition in 2020 with 227 members including presidents and chancellors, directors of athletics, coaches, student-athletes, conference and school administrators, alumni, families and friends representing all 14 institutions.

Since its inception in 1896, the pursuit and attainment of academic excellence has been a priority for every Big Ten member institution. But maintaining the conference's standard of competing at the highest level in athletics also endures as an important component of the Big Ten experience. Striking that balance between academics and athletics is integral to the Big Ten's identity. Recognized as one of intercollegiate sports' most successful undertakings, the Big Ten strives for success from its students not only on the field and in the classroom, but around the world as well.

PREMIER ACADEMIC INSTITUTIONS

The Big Ten Academic Alliance is an academic consortium of all 14 Big Ten universities, which is widely considered to be the model for effective and voluntary collaboration among top research universities.

Every Big Ten Academic Alliance institution ranks among the top 70 universities in the nation according to the 2019 Academic Ranking of World Universities, including six in the top 30.

The Big Ten leads all conferences with more than 1,800 Academic All-Americans, including 27 honorees during the 2019-20 academic year.

Big Ten Academic Alliance schools annually conduct \$10 billion in funded research, \$5 billion more than any other conference.

A HISTORY OF ATHLETIC SUCCESS

Big Ten schools have won at least five national championships in 23 of the last 26 years, averaging nearly seven per year over that span.

Since the 2008-09 academic year, current Big Ten institutions have claimed 76 team national championships in 21 different sports.

BROAD-BASED PROGRAMMING

The Big Ten will administer over \$200 million in direct financial support to more than 9,800 students competing in intercollegiate athletics for more than 11,000 participation opportunities on 350 teams in 42 different sports.

The Big Ten sponsors 28 official conference sports, 14 for men and 14 for women, including the addition of men's ice hockey and men's and women's lacrosse in this decade.

The Big Ten leads the nation in total students competing in intercollegiate athletics and participation opportunities, and sponsors more official sports than all conferences except the Ivy League.

Almost 1,400 Big Ten competitors have participated in the Olympics, winning more than 600 medals, including nearly 300 gold. In the 2016 and 2018 Olympic Games, more than 200 representatives from Big Ten institutions including current or former students and coaches were members of Olympic teams. Big Ten Olympians collected more than 50 medals in the most recent games in Rio and PyeongChang.

PASSIONATE FOLLOWING

The Big Ten leads all conferences with 6.4 million alumni and nearly 580,000 students.

Each year more than 11 million patrons attend Big Ten home contests, as the conference has led the nation in attendance for men's basketball, ice hockey, volleyball and wrestling.

LEADERS IN INNOVATION

Took part in the nation's first bowl game, winning the 1902 Rose Bowl Game, and signed an exclusive contract with the Tournament of Roses in 1946, making it the first bowl with permanent conference affiliations.

Awarded the first Big Ten Medal of Honor in 1915, honoring outstanding seniors who demonstrated excellence in academics and athletics.

Formed the Big Ten Advisory Commission in 1972, enlisting former students that competed in conference athletics to serve as liaisons to the NCAA's Diversity and Inclusion Department, the Big Ten Student-Athlete Advisory Commission and other organizations.

Became the first conference to voluntarily adopt male and female participation goals after launching its Gender Equity Action Plan in 1992.

Implemented the first collegiate football system of instant replay in 2004, which the NCAA approved for use among all conferences in 2006.

Launched the Big Ten Network (BTN) in 2007, the first national conferenceowned television network.

Began partnering with the Ivy League to study the effects of head injuries in sports in 2012.

Accepted Johns Hopkins University as the conference's first sport affiliate members in men's and women's lacrosse in 2013 and 2015, respectively, and added Notre Dame as a sport affiliate member in men's ice hockey in 2017.

EXTENSIVE TELEVISION EXPOSURE

Through the Big Ten's current media agreements with BTN, ABC/ ESPN, CBS and FOX, more than 2,000 Big Ten events are produced and distributed nationally and globally on an annual basis.

BTN is in almost 60 million homes across the United States and Canada, and is also available internationally via the Fox Sports App, delivering live and on-demand programming to computers, smartphones and tablets. BTN Plus streams hundreds of additional events each season.

COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

For more than 30 years, through the Big Ten's SCORE (Success Comes Out of Reading Everyday) program, the conference has partnered with Chicago elementary schools to improve reading performance.

Surrounding the Big Ten Football Championship Game and Basketball Tournaments, the conference has held numerous community initiatives, partnered with the College Football Playoff Foundation and other events such as the Big Ten Career Expo, SaturDAY of Service and Youth Football Clinics. In addition, the Big Ten has hosted a downtown 5K, collaborated with a local breast cancer awareness group and provided unique event experiences for military veterans.
