- Big Ten women's basketball action continues Tuesday as Nebraska plays host to Minnesota at 4 p.m. (ET) live on BTN and the FOX Sports app. It will be among four days in the next week when Big Ten women's basketball will be televised nationally on BTN or ESPN2, including a BTN doubleheader Thursday and three games each on Saturday and Sunday.
- Maryland recorded its 99th Big Ten regular-season victory last Sunday at Wisconsin. The Terrapins, who are 99-12 (.892) all-time in regular-season conference games since joining the Big Ten in 2014-15, will look for their milestone 100th conference win Thursday when they play host to Iowa (5 p.m. ET on BTN/FOX Sports app).
- Maryland has won 24 consecutive games against Big Ten opponents (including postseason contests), dating back more than a full year to its victory at Michigan on Jan. 12, 2020. The Terrapins' current streak is tied for third-longest active run of its kind in the country and is the fourth-longest in Big Ten history — the record of 36 consecutive wins against conference opponents was set by Ohio State from Feb. 17, 1984 through Feb. 9, 1986.
- Michigan has set program records for the best overall and conference starts (10-0, 5-0) and has tied the school record with its current 10-game winning streak (set in 2001-02 and matched in 2012-13).
- The Big Ten is one of only two conferences in the country (along with the ACC) to have two schools currently maintaining double-digit winning streaks (Maryland and Michigan have won 10 in a row).
- Nebraska picked up its third win over a ranked opponent this season (all within a 17-day span) with its 63-55 victory over No. 15/15 (and previously-unbeaten) Ohio State on Jan. 16 in Lincoln. The Huskers join Maryland as the two Big Ten programs with three wins over Top 25 teams this season, while Michigan has a pair of victories over ranked opponents to its credit.
- Nebraska senior center Kate Cain was chosen as the Big Ten Player of the Week, the first Husker in more than three years to receive the honor, while Iowa's Caitlin Clark was named the Big Ten Freshman of the Week for the seventh time this year. Clark is tied for the third-most weekly freshman honors in conference history, three shy of the record set by Nebraska's Jessica Shepard in 2015-16.
- The Big Ten has six schools appearing in the top 25 and eight in the top 40 of the latest NCAA NET (NCAA Evaluation Tool) rankings released Tuesday. The Big Ten's six top-25 schools and eight top-40 programs are both the most of any conference in the country.
- Five Big Ten programs are appearing in this week's Associated Press and Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA)/USA Today Top 25 polls, with three others receiving votes in one or both polls (including Nebraska which makes its season debut in both polls). The Big Ten's five Top 25 programs are second among all conferences. Maryland (No. 7/7) and Michigan (No. 11/11) are at their highest rankings this season, with Michigan's current poll positions also the highest in the school's record book, topping the Wolverines' No. 12 rankings on Dec. 24, 2001.
- With Nebraska receiving votes in this week's AP and coaches' polls, nine different Big Ten programs have been ranked or receiving votes in one or both major national polls this season, including six that have appeared in the AP or WBCA/USA Today Top 25 for at least one week.
- According to Tuesday's NCAA statistics report, the Big Ten leads all Division I conferences in scoring (76.0 ppg.) and assists (16.1 apg.), while ranking second in field-goal percentage (.444) and fourth (tops among A5 conferences) in free-throw percentage (.720).
- The Big Ten leads the nation with six teams among the top 25 in the country (and two of the top three)

in scoring offense. Maryland leads the nation in scoring at 92.5 points per game, followed by Iowa (3rd - 88.8), Ohio State (11th - 85.5), Michigan (18th - 81.8), Rutgers (20th - 81.2) and Michigan State (22nd - 80.3). Only one conference has even half that many teams (BIG EAST-3) among the top 25 in the nation in scoring offense, as of Tuesday.

- The Big Ten is also tops among all conferences with five programs in the nation's top 20 (and two in the top 10) in field-goal percentage. Iowa is No. 3 in the nation (.505), followed by Michigan (10th - .486), Maryland (16th - .477), Rutgers (18th - .473) and Ohio State (20th - .470). Only one conference currently has even three schools in the top 20 (ACC-3) nationally in field-goal percentage.
- Ohio State's victory at Iowa on Jan. 13 snapped the Hawkeyes' 42-game home winning streak, which had been both the second-longest active string in the country and the second-longest in Big Ten women's basketball history (Iowa won 46 in a row at Carver-Hawkeye Arena from Jan. 3, 1986 to Jan. 12, 1990). It was also the first home loss for the Hawkeyes since Jan. 28, 2018, when Nebraska posted a 92-74 victory.
- The Big Ten women's basketball television schedule has been updated through Jan. 25, with all conference games continuing to be televised live on BTN, the ESPN family of networks or streamed live on Big Ten Network+ for the seventh consecutive season. The most current schedule of Big Ten women's basketball games on TV may be found online at bigten.org/B1GWBBTV.
- Michigan's Naz Hillmon piled up career highs of 35 points and 22 rebounds in the Wolverines' victory over Nebraska on Jan. 7. It was the second 30-point, 20-rebound game in NCAA Division I this season and the first by a Big Ten player since Jan. 24, 2016, when Nebraska's Jessica Shepard had 35 points and 20 rebounds at Michigan. It also was the second 30/20 game in Michigan program history and first since Jan. 20, 1979, when Abby Currier (33 points, 20 rebounds) did so against Notre Dame.
- Indiana's Grace Berger became the first NCAA Division I player this season

with two triple-doubles, recording 15 points, 12 assists and 10 rebounds in the Hoosiers' win at Penn State on Jan. 7. Berger is the first Big Ten player with two triple-doubles in a season since 2014-15, when Iowa's Samantha Logic and Minnesota's Amanda Zahui B. both had a pair. Iowa's Caitlin Clark and Rutgers' Arella Guirantes also have triple-doubles this season, giving the Big Ten four of the eight triple-doubles registered by NCAA Division I players in 2020-21 and tying the conference record for triple-doubles in one season (set in both 2013-14 and 2014-15).

- The Big Ten is in position to set a new conference record for the best non-conference winning percentage in regular-season games in a single campaign, currently posting an .846 (44-8) mark to date — the previous record was set last year when conference teams went .788 (123-33) in non-conference play. This year's record includes three non-conference wins over Top 25 teams — Maryland 115-96 over No. 14 Arkansas on Nov. 29 (a Big Ten record for points against a ranked team); Michigan 76-66 at No. RV/23 Notre Dame on Dec. 3; Iowa 82-80 over No. RV/24 Iowa State on Dec. 9.
- On Nov. 23, the Big Ten released its 2020-21 conference schedule, which will see schools play 20 Big Ten games, up two from the previous two seasons. Schools will play seven opponents twice (home and away) and the other six once (three at home and three on the road). To account for the additional games and preserve flexibility in the schedule, the Big Ten Women's Basketball Tournament has been moved to March 9-13 and will continue to be played at Bankers Life Fieldhouse in Indianapolis.
- On Oct. 23, the Big Ten Conference announced the launch of the 'United As One' social justice campaign. 'United As One' is among several conference-wide Equality Coalition initiatives dedicated to constructively and collectively recognizing and eliminating racism and hate in our society by creating resources for inclusion, empowerment and accountability.
- The Big Ten Conference established the Equality Coalition in 2020 with 227 members including presidents and chancellors, directors of athletics, coaches, student-athletes, conference and school administrators, alumni, families and friends representing all 14 institutions.



Recognized as one of intercollegiate sports' most successful undertakings, the Big Ten strives for success from its students not only on the field and in the classroom, but around the world as well.

PREMIER ACADEMIC INSTITUTIONS

The Big Ten Academic Alliance is an academic consortium of all 14 Big Ten universities, which is widely considered to be the model for effective and voluntary collaboration among top research universities.

Every Big Ten Academic Alliance institution ranks among the top 70 universities in the nation according to the 2019 Academic Ranking of World Universities, including six in the top 30.

The Big Ten leads all conferences with more than 1,800 Academic All-Americans, including 27 honorees during the 2019-20 academic year.

Big Ten Academic Alliance schools annually conduct \$10 billion in funded research, \$5 billion more than any other conference.

A HISTORY OF ATHLETIC SUCCESS

Big Ten schools have won at least five national championships in 23 of the last 26 years, averaging nearly seven per year over that span.

Accepted Johns Hopkins University as the conference's first sport affiliate members in men's and women's lacrosse in 2013 and 2015, respectively, and added Notre Dame as a sport affiliate member in men's ice hockey in 2017.
