- Three of the six Big Ten women's basketball games on Thursday's schedule will be televised live on BTN and the FOX Sports app, and all three featuring teams ranked or receiving votes in the national polls. Michigan State visits No. 7/10 Maryland at 4 p.m. (ET) and No. 23/23 Northwestern travels to Iowa at 6 p.m. (ET) before No. 14/11 Ohio State heads to No. 16/15 Indiana for the nightcap at 8 p.m. (ET).
- For the second time in less than two weeks, Ohio State snapped an opponent's significant winning streak, ending Maryland's 24-game Big Ten success string (including postseason games) with an 88-86 victory Monday night in Columbus. The loss, which was the first for the Terrapins to a Big Ten opponent since Jan. 9, 2020 (66-61 at Iowa), ended the fourth-longest conference winning streak in Big Ten history. Back on Jan. 13, OSU stopped Iowa's 42-game home winning streak with a similar two-point win (84-82 in overtime), ending what had been the second-longest such streak in conference history.
- Ohio State's win over No. 7/7 Maryland on Monday night was also the Buckeyes' second consecutive victory over a top-15 opponent after they edged No. 11/11 Michigan, 81-77 on Jan. 21, also in Columbus. It was the first time Ohio State won back-to-back games against top-15 teams since Feb. 20 and 23, 2006, when it defeated No. 14/16 Michigan State and No. 12/11 Purdue as part of a run of three straight wins over ranked teams. This year's Buckeyes are in the midst of a stretch of four consecutive games against Top 25 opponents, the next coming Thursday when it travels to No. 16/15 Indiana (8 p.m. ET on BTN/FOX Sports app).
- Maryland's next opportunity to earn its 100th regular-season Big Ten win Thursday when the Terrapins play host to Michigan State (4 p.m. ET on BTN/FOX Sports app). Maryland is 99-13 (.884) all-time in regular-season conference games since joining the Big Ten in 2014-15.
- Michigan State returned to action Sunday with a 94-62 win at Wisconsin. It was the Spartans' largest margin of victory in head coach Suzy Merchant's 14-year tenure, supplanting a 56-25 win over Northwestern on March 4, 2011, in the Big Ten Tournament quarterfinals at Bankers Life Fieldhouse in Indianapolis. The last time MSU won any game by a larger margin than Sunday was Jan. 1, 2006 (77-44 over visiting Michigan).
- Three Big Ten players were named to the Naismith National Defensive Player of the Year Watch List on Tuesday. Nebraska's Kate Cain, Northwestern's Veronica Burton and Rutgers' Arella Guirantes are among 15 midseason candidates for the honor, with the Big Ten tying for the most players of any conference on this year's Watch List.
- The Big Ten leads all NCAA Division I conferences with five schools in the top 20 and eight in the top 40 of the latest NCAA NET (NCAA Evaluation Tool) rankings released Monday. The full NET rankings are listed on page 3 of this release.
- Five Big Ten programs, the second-most of any Division I conference, are appearing in the latest Associated Press and Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA)/USA Today Top 25 polls, with two others receiving votes in one or both polls. Nine different Big Ten teams have been ranked or receiving votes in one or both polls at some point this season.
- The Big Ten continues to be one of the most competitive and deepest conferences in the country this season. In fact, since the calendar turned to 2021, more than half (19) of the 36 conference games played in January have been decided by 10 points or less, including two overtime games. Since Jan. 13, 10 of 17 Big Ten games were decided by single digits, with nine in doubt inside the final two minutes.
- According to Tuesday's NCAA statistics report, the Big Ten leads all Division I conferences in scoring (75.0 ppg.) and assists (15.8 apg.), while ranking second in field-goal percentage (.439) and free-throw percentage (.724).

The Big Ten Academic Alliance is an academic consortium of all 14 Big Ten universities, which is widely considered to be the model for effective and voluntary collaboration among top research universities.

BIG TEN. BIG NEWS.

- The Big Ten leads the nation with six teams among the top 20 in the country (including three in the top 10 and the country's No. 1 and 3 teams) in scoring offense. Maryland leads the nation in scoring at 92.0 points per game, followed by Iowa (3rd - 88.8), Ohio State (9th - 85.3), Michigan State (18th - 81.5), Michigan (19th - 81.4) and Rutgers (20th - 81.2). No other conference has more than two teams among the top 20 in the nation in scoring offense.
- The Big Ten is also tops among all conferences with six programs in the nation's top 25 in field-goal percentage. Iowa is No. 3 in the nation (.505), followed by Michigan (11th - .480), Rutgers (14th - .473), Maryland (15th - .473), Ohio State (20th - .466) and Michigan State (22nd - .465). Only one other conference has even half as many schools in the top 25 (ACC-4) nationally in field-goal percentage as the Big Ten currently does.
- Michigan junior forward Naz Hillmon scored 50 points (20-30 FG), the most by any NCAA player in any division this season, and grabbed 16 rebounds in the Wolverines' 81-77 loss at Ohio State on Jan. 21. It was the third 50-point game in Big Ten women's basketball history and first since Feb. 21, 2016, when Minnesota's Rachel Banham posted her second such game in two weeks with 52 points at Michigan State. Hillmon's 50 points also were the most ever by a Michigan player, topping both the women's record (45 by Diane Dietz vs. Illinois on Feb. 27, 1982) and later the men's record (48 by Cazzie Russell vs. Northwestern on March 5, 1966, and Rudy Tomjanovich vs. Indiana on Jan. 7, 1969).
- Hillmon is the first NCAA Division I women's basketball player with a 50-point/15-rebound game since Jan. 3, 2003, when South Carolina's Jocelyn Penn had 51 points and 15 rebounds against Stetson.
- Hillmon's 20 made field goals are the most ever in a Big Ten game, breaking the old record of 19 set by Minnesota's Rachel Banham in her conference-record (and NCAA record-tying) 60-point performance at Northwestern on Feb. 7, 2016. The 20 baskets are also tied for the third-most by any Big Ten women's basketball player in any game and the most since Dec. 21, 1991, when Minnesota's Carol Ann Shudlick made 21 field goals at Marquette.
- Purdue head coach Sharon Versyp picked up her 300th win in West Lafayette on Jan. 21 when her Boilermakers edged Wisconsin, 56-55 at Mackey Arena. Versyp is 300-184 (.620) in her 15th season at Purdue (417-247, .628 in 21 seasons overall) and is the eighth Boilermaker coach across all sports to reach the 300-win milestone.
- For the seventh consecutive season, all Big Ten games during conference play are being televised live on BTN, the ESPN family of networks or streamed live on Big Ten Network+. The most current schedule of Big Ten women's basketball games on TV is online at bigten.org/B1GWBTV.
- The Big Ten is in position to set a new conference record for the best non-conference winning percentage in regular-season games in a single campaign, currently posting an .846 (44-8) mark to date — the previous record was set last year when conference teams went .788 (123-33) in non-conference play. This year's record includes three non-conference wins over Top 25 teams — Maryland 115-96 over No. 14 Arkansas on Nov. 29 (a Big Ten record for points against a ranked team); Michigan 76-66 at No. RV/23 Notre Dame on Dec. 3; Iowa 82-80 over No. RV/24 Iowa State on Dec. 9.
- On Nov. 23, the Big Ten released its 2020-21 conference schedule, which will see schools play 20 Big Ten games, up two from the previous two seasons. Schools will play seven opponents twice (home and away) and the other six once (three at home and three on the road). To account for the additional games and preserve flexibility in the schedule, the Big Ten Women's Basketball Tournament has been moved to March 9-13 and will continue to be played at Bankers Life Fieldhouse in Indianapolis.
- On Oct. 23, the Big Ten Conference announced the launch of the 'United As One' social justice campaign. 'United As One' is among several conference-wide Equality Coalition initiatives dedicated to constructively and collectively recognizing and eliminating racism and hate in our society by creating resources for inclusion, empowerment and accountability.
- The Big Ten Conference established the Equality Coalition in 2020 with 227 members including presidents and chancellors, directors of athletics, coaches, student-athletes, conference and school administrators, alumni, families and friends representing all 14 institutions.

Since its inception in 1896, the pursuit and attainment of academic excellence has been a priority for every Big Ten member institution. But maintaining the conference's standard of competing at the highest level in athletics also endures as an important component of the Big Ten experience. Striking that balance between academics and athletics is integral to the Big Ten's identity. Recognized as one of intercollegiate sports' most successful undertakings, the Big Ten strives for success from its students not only on the field and in the classroom, but around the world as well.

PREMIER ACADEMIC INSTITUTIONS

The Big Ten Academic Alliance is an academic consortium of all 14 Big Ten universities, which is widely considered to be the model for effective and voluntary collaboration among top research universities.

Every Big Ten Academic Alliance institution ranks among the top 70 universities in the nation according to the 2019 Academic Ranking of World Universities, including six in the top 30.

The Big Ten leads all conferences with more than 1,800 Academic All-Americans, including 27 honorees during the 2019-20 academic year.

Big Ten Academic Alliance schools annually conduct \$10 billion in funded research, \$5 billion more than any other conference.

A HISTORY OF ATHLETIC SUCCESS

Big Ten schools have won at least five national championships in 23 of the last 26 years, averaging nearly seven per year over that span.

Since the 2008-09 academic year, current Big Ten institutions have claimed 76 team national championships in 21 different sports.

BROAD-BASED PROGRAMMING

The Big Ten will administer over \$200 million in direct financial support to more than 9,800 students competing in intercollegiate athletics for more than 11,000 participation opportunities on 350 teams in 42 different sports.

Each year more than 11 million patrons attend Big Ten home contests, as the conference has led the nation in attendance for men's basketball, ice hockey, volleyball and wrestling.

LEADERS IN INNOVATION

Took part in the nation's first bowl game, winning the 1902 Rose Bowl Game, and signed an exclusive contract with the Tournament of Roses in 1946, making it the first bowl with permanent conference affiliations.

Awarded the first Big Ten Medal of Honor in 1915, honoring outstanding seniors who demonstrated excellence in academics and athletics.

Formed the Big Ten Advisory Commission in 1972, enlisting former students that competed in conference athletics to serve as liaisons to the NCAA's Diversity and Inclusion Department, the Big Ten Student-Athlete Advisory Commission and other organizations.

Became the first conference to voluntarily adopt male and female participation goals after launching its Gender Equity Action Plan in 1992.

Implemented the first collegiate football system of instant replay in 2004, which the NCAA approved for use among all conferences in 2006.

Launched the Big Ten Network (BTN) in 2007, the first national conference-owned television network.

Began partnering with the Ivy League to study the effects of head injuries in sports in 2012.

Accepted Johns Hopkins University as the conference's first sport affiliate members in men's and women's lacrosse in 2013 and 2015, respectively, and added Notre Dame as a sport affiliate member in men's ice hockey in 2017.

EXTENSIVE TELEVISION EXPOSURE

Through the Big Ten's current media agreements with BTN, ABC/ESPN, CBS and FOX, more than 2,000 Big Ten events are produced and distributed nationally and globally on an annual basis.

COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

Surrounding the Big Ten Football Championship Game and Basketball Tournaments, the conference has held numerous community initiatives, partnered with the College Football Playoff Foundation and other events such as the Big Ten Career Expo, Saturday of Service and Youth Football Clinics.
