### BIG TEN. BIG NEWS.

- Big Ten women's basketball conference play continues this week with six nationally-televised games through Jan. 13, including five on BTN and the FOX Sports app, along with Sunday's game on ESPN2 featuring Rutgers at Ohio State. All other conference games this week will be streamed live on Big Ten Network+.
- Maryland head coach Brenda Frese picked up her 550th career victory on Monday when the Terrapins edged Indiana. 84-80 in College Park. Frese is 550-159 (.776) in her 22nd season on the sidelines, including a 493-129 (.793) record in 19 seasons at Maryland.
- Michigan junior guard Leigha Brown was named the Big Ten Player of the Week on Monday, while Iowa guard Caitlin Clark earned her fifth Big Ten Freshman of the Week award. On Tuesday, Clark was also chosen as the United States Basketball Writers Association (USBWA) National Freshman of the Week, the second national honor she has received this year (she was the espnW National Player of the Week on Dec. 14).
- The Big Ten has five schools appearing in the top 20 and eight in the top 50 of the latest NCAA NET (NCAA Evaluation Tool) rankings released Tuesday. The Big Ten's five top-20 schools are the most of any conference, while the Big Ten's eight top-50 programs are third-most in the nation among Division I conferences. The full NET rankings can be found on page 3 of this release.
- For the third week in a row, the Big Ten has six Top 25 teams in the Associated Press poll, while also now have six schools in the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA)/USA Today Top 25 poll, with both being the most ranked teams among all conferences. This is the first time in Big Ten women's basketball history the conference has had six AP Top 25 teams for multiple weeks in the same season, let alone consecutive weeks (the Big Ten had six in the AP Top 25 for single weeks on Nov. 17, 2014 and Jan. 14, 2019).
- Michigan has matched the best start to a season in program history, improving to 7-0 on Sunday with an 84-63 win at Northwestern behind a 55-point first half (Michigan's highest single-half output in conference play since Dec. 30, 1997, when it had 58 against Minnesota). The Wolverines previously began 7-0 in 1999-2000, 2011-12 and 2015-16.
- Michigan State is 8-0 for the first time since the 2012-13 season after Sunday's 71-64 win at Purdue. The Spartans are also 3-0 in conference play for the first time since 2013-14.
- For just the second time, both of the Big Ten's Michigan schools are off to 7-0 starts in the same season. The only other time the Wolverines and Spartans both opened their seasons with 7-0 records was 1999-2000 — Michigan would go on to finish second in the Big Ten and reach the NCAA Tournament, while Michigan State tied for fifth in the conference race and advanced to the WNIT quarterfinals.
- Four Big Ten teams currently rank among the top 10 in the country in scoring offense. Maryland is No. 2 in the nation at 95.6 points per game, followed by Ohio State (3rd - 93.4), Iowa (4th - 92.1) and Michigan (10th - 87.9). No other conference has more than two teams among the top 10 in the nation in scoring offense, as of Tuesday.
- The Big Ten has six programs among the nation's top 25 (including four in the top 10) in field-goal percentage. Michigan is No. 1 in the nation (.539), followed by Ohio State (3rd - .532), Iowa (5th - .512)

and Maryland (8th - .504). Rutgers (20th - .472) and Michigan State (21st - .472) are also in the top 25 in field-goal percentage. No other conference currently has more than three schools in the top 25 nationally (or two in the top 10) in field-goal percentage.

- Maryland's Ashley Owusu and Rutgers' Arella Guirantes both scored 34 points on New Year's Eve, with Owusu notching her career high in a win at Penn State and Guirantes reaching the mark in a narrow loss at Iowa. Five Big Ten players have a total of eight 30-point games this season, including five games of at least 34 points, with Iowa's Caitlin Clark and Michigan's Naz Hillmon sharing the conference season-high scoring mark of 35 points (Clark on Dec. 12 at Michigan State, Hillmon on Nov. 27 at Oakland). By comparison, no other conference in the country has featured more than four 34-point games this year (the NCAA statistics report only lists the top 30 scoring performances to date).
- Nebraska's Sam Haiby earned the top spot on the New Year's Eve edition of ESPN SportsCenter's "Top Plays" for her game-winning basket as time expired in the Huskers' 65-63 win over defending Big Ten co-champion Northwestern on Dec. 31 in Lincoln. It was the highest-ranked opponent Nebraska defeated since Dec. 3, 2014, when the Huskers downed No. 9/9 Duke, 60-54, in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge, also at Pinnacle Bank Arena.
- Nebraska senior center Kate Cain became the sixth Big Ten women's basketball player to record 300 career blocked shots with four rejections in the Dec. 31 win over Northwestern. Cain currently has 303 blocks in her career and is the second conference player in as many years to reach that milestone, following Purdue's Ae'Rianna Harris, who finished with 380 blocks from 2017-20.
- The Big Ten is in position to set a new conference record for the best non-conference winning percentage in regular-season games in a single campaign, currently posting an .846 (44-8) mark to date — the previous record was set last year when conference teams went .788 (123-33) in non-

conference play. This year's record includes three non-conference wins over Top 25 teams — Maryland 115-96 over No. 14 Arkansas on Nov. 29 (a Big Ten record for points against a ranked team); Michigan 76-66 at No. RV/23 Notre Dame on Dec. 3; Iowa 82-80 over No. RV/24 Iowa State on Dec. 9.

- With its Dec. 31 victory over Rutgers, Iowa extended its home winning streak to 41 games, the second-longest active string in the nation behind Baylor (61). The Hawkeyes' run began on Feb. 4, 2018, with a 92-84 win over Minnesota.
- The Big Ten women's basketball television schedule has been updated to include eight appearances on the ESPN family of networks during the remainder of the regular season. The most current schedule of Big Ten women's basketball games on TV may be found online at [bigten.org/B1GWBTV](http://bigten.org/B1GWBTV).
- On Nov. 23, the Big Ten released its 2020-21 conference schedule, which will see schools play 20 Big Ten games, up two from the previous two seasons. Schools will play seven opponents twice (home and away) and the other six once (three at home and three on the road). To account for the additional games and preserve flexibility in the schedule, the Big Ten Women's Basketball Tournament has been moved to March 9-13 and will continue to be played at Bankers Life Fieldhouse in Indianapolis.
- On Oct. 23, the Big Ten Conference announced the launch of the 'United As One' social justice campaign. 'United As One' is among several conference-wide Equality Coalition initiatives dedicated to constructively and collectively recognizing and eliminating racism and hate in our society by creating resources for inclusion, empowerment and accountability.
- The Big Ten Conference established the Equality Coalition in 2020 with 227 members including presidents and chancellors, directors of athletics, coaches, student-athletes, conference and school administrators, alumni, families and friends representing all 14 institutions.



Since its inception in 1896, the pursuit and attainment of academic excellence has been a priority for every Big Ten member institution. But maintaining the conference's standard of competing at the highest level in athletics also endures as an important component of the Big Ten experience. Striking that balance between academics and athletics is integral to the Big Ten's identity. Recognized as one of intercollegiate sports' most successful undertakings, the Big Ten strives for success from its students not only on the field and in the classroom, but around the world as well.

### **PREMIER ACADEMIC INSTITUTIONS**

The Big Ten Academic Alliance is an academic consortium of all 14 Big Ten universities, which is widely considered to be the model for effective and voluntary collaboration among top research universities.

Every Big Ten Academic Alliance institution ranks among the top 70 universities in the nation according to the 2019 Academic Ranking of World Universities, including six in the top 30.

The Big Ten leads all conferences with more than 1,800 Academic All-Americans, including 27 honorees during the 2019-20 academic year.

Big Ten Academic Alliance schools annually conduct \$10 billion in funded research, \$5 billion more than any other conference.

### **A HISTORY OF ATHLETIC SUCCESS**

Big Ten schools have won at least five national championships in 23 of the last 26 years, averaging nearly seven per year over that span.

Since the 2008-09 academic year, current Big Ten institutions have claimed 76 team national championships in 21 different sports.

Began partnering with the Ivy League to study the effects of head injuries in sports in 2012.

Accepted Johns Hopkins University as the conference's first sport affiliate members in men's and women's lacrosse in 2013 and 2015, respectively, and added Notre Dame as a sport affiliate member in men's ice hockey in 2017.
