BIG TEN. BIG NEWS.

- The Big Ten enjoyed a stellar opening week to the 2021-22 season, posting a 31-2 (.939) record, culminating with Indiana's nationally-televised 88-67 win over No. 13 Kentucky on Sunday night. Since the start of the 2019-20 season, the Big Ten has gone a combined 198-44 (.818) in non-conference regularseason games, the best stretch in conference history. Last year, Big Ten programs set a conference record for the best non-conference winning percentage in regular-season games for a single campaign at .846 (44-8), which was also the second-highest non-conference winning percentage by any conference last year.
- On the heels of Indiana's win over Kentucky (the Hoosiers' largest ever against a top-15 opponent), Indiana moved up to a program-best No. 4 in Monday's Associated Press poll, with Maryland jumping a spot to No. 3 and lowa doing likewise to No. 8. This marks the first time since the final poll of the 2004 season that the Big Ten has had two teams ranked in the top five of the AP poll — that week, Purdue was third and Penn State was fifth. With No. 13 Michigan and No. 21 Ohio State also ranked this week, the Big Ten remains tied for the most teams in the AP Top 25 among all Division I conferences (with Michigan State continuing to receive votes in the poll — there is no WBCA/USA Today poll this week).
- Nebraska has opened this season with three consecutive 50-point wins, a first in program history. The Huskers also scored 100 points in their first two games (108-50 vs. Maine; 102-47 vs. Prairie View A&M), the first time they have ever opened a season with back-to-back 100-point outings and the first time they reached triple digits in consecutive games since Jan. 15-18, 1983, when they defeated Iowa State, 108-80, and fell in overtime to Kansas State, 104-103 (the only time the Huskers scored more points in consecutive games than this week's performances).
- Although many of the Big Ten's wins to date this season have featured large margins, two have gone to overtime, with conference teams prevailing both times (Michigan 67-62 over IUPUI on Nov. 9, Minnesota 66-59 at Arizona State on Nov. 12). That extends the Big Ten's winning streak in regular-season nonconference OT games to eight in a row since the start of the 2019-20 season, and conference teams are a combined 13-3 (.813) in overtime in non-conference regular season games during the past four years.
- Michigan State head coach Suzy Merchant picked up her 499th career win on Sunday when the Spartans defeated Niagara, 89-65. Merchant, who is 499-277 (.643) in 27 seasons on the sidelines and 298-157 (.655) in 15 seasons at MSU, can become the sixth current Big Ten coach to record 500 career wins (including Rutgers' C. Vivian Stringer, who is not coaching this year) Tuesday night when Michigan State
- Iowa head coach Lisa Bluder is also closing in on a personal milestone, notching win No. 798 for her career on Sunday when her Hawkeyes picked up an 82-61 road victory at in-state foe Northern Iowa. Iowa will play host to Southern on Wednesday night, which could potentially set the stage for Bluder to register her 800th win as early as this coming Sunday (Nov. 21) when the Hawkeyes host another in-state opponent, Drake (where coincidentally Bluder coached for 10 seasons prior to taking over at lowa in 2000-01).
- Two days after going on the road to defeat Arizona State in overtime, Minnesota returned home to Williams Arena on Sunday with a record-setting defensive performance in a 48-32 victory over George Washington. The Golden Gophers held the Colonials to a .192 field-goal percentage, the lowest in school history (previous was .198 by Army West Point on Dec. 8, 2016), while the 32 points allowed were the fewest ever given up by Minnesota against a Division I opponent and fewest at any time in nearly 45 years (60-25 vs. Minnesota State Mankato on Jan. 7, 1977).
- Wisconsin freshman guard Krystyna Ellew scored a game-high 29 points in the Badgers' season-opening 67-51 win over St. Thomas on Nov. 10 in Madison. It's believed to be the most points ever scored by a Big Ten freshman in her collegiate debut, surpassing the previous mark of 27 points done twice before — Illinois' Robin Preacely vs. Illinois State on Dec. 1, 1992, and lowa's Caitlin Clark vs. Northern Iowa on Nov. 25, 2020.

Recognized as one of intercollegiate sports' most successful undertakings, the Big Ten strives for success from its students not only on the field and in the classroom, but around the world as well.

PREMIER ACADEMIC INSTITUTIONS

The Big Ten Academic Alliance is an academic consortium of all 14 Big Ten universities, which is widely considered to be the model for effective and voluntary collaboration among top research universities.

Every Big Ten Academic Alliance institution ranks among the top 70 universities in the nation according to the 2021 Academic Ranking of World Universities, including six in the top 30.

The Big Ten leads all conferences with more than 1,800 Academic All-Americans, including a Big Ten-record 56 honorees during the 2020-21 academic year.

Big Ten Academic Alliance schools annually conduct \$10 billion in funded research, \$5 billion more than any other conference.

A HISTORY OF ATHLETIC SUCCESS

Big Ten schools have won at least five national championships in 23 of the last 27 years, averaging nearly seven per year during that span.

Since the 2008-09 academic year, current Big Ten institutions have claimed 80 team national championships in 22 different sports.

BROAD-BASED PROGRAMMING

The Big Ten sponsors 28 official conference sports, 14 for men and 14 for women, including the addition of men's ice hockey and men's and women's lacrosse in this decade.

The Big Ten leads the nation in total students competing in intercollegiate athletics and participation opportunities, and sponsors more official sports than all conferences except the Ivy League.

More than 1,500 Big Ten competitors have participated in the Olympics, winning more than 500 medals, including more than 200 gold. The Big Ten Conference enjoyed its finest performance at a single Olympic Games during the 2020 Summer Olympics in Tokyo, Japan, as athletes with Big Ten ties set conference records by earning 51 total medals and 22 gold medals during the 17-day competition. All 14 Big Ten member schools had an athlete win at least one medal in Tokyo, also a first in conference history.

PASSIONATE FOLLOWING

The Big Ten leads all conferences with 6.4 million alumni and nearly 580,000 students.

Each year more than 11 million patrons attend Big Ten home contests, as the conference has led the nation in attendance for men's basketball, ice hockey, volleyball and wrestling.

LEADERS IN INNOVATION

Took part in the nation's first bowl game, winning the 1902 Rose Bowl Game, and signed an exclusive contract with the Tournament of Roses in 1946, making it the first bowl with permanent conference affiliations.

Awarded the first Big Ten Medal of Honor in 1915, honoring outstanding seniors who demonstrated excellence in academics and athletics.

Formed the Big Ten Advisory Commission in 1972, enlisting former students that competed in conference athletics to serve as liaisons to the NCAA's Diversity and Inclusion Department, the Big Ten Student-Athlete Advisory Commission and other organizations.

Became the first conference to voluntarily adopt male and female participation goals after launching its Gender Equity Action Plan in 1992.

Implemented the first collegiate football system of instant replay in 2004, which the NCAA approved for use among all conferences in 2006.

Launched the Big Ten Network (BTN) in 2007, the first national conference-owned television network.

Began partnering with the Ivy League to study the effects of head injuries in sports in 2012.

Accepted Johns Hopkins University as the conference's first sport affiliate members in men's and women's lacrosse in 2013 and 2015, respectively, and added Notre Dame as a sport affiliate member in men's ice hockey in 2017.

EXTENSIVE TELEVISION EXPOSURE

Through the Big Ten's current media agreements with BTN, ABC/ESPN, CBS and FOX, more than 2,000 Big Ten events are produced and distributed nationally and globally on an annual basis.

BTN is in almost 60 million homes across the United States and Canada, and is also available via the Fox Sports App, delivering live and ondemand programming to computers, smartphones and tablets. B1G+ streams hundreds of additional events each season.

COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

For more than 30 years, through the Big Ten's SCORE (Success Comes Out of Reading Everyday) program, the conference has partnered with Chicago elementary schools to improve reading performance.

Surrounding the Big Ten Football Championship Game and Basketball Tournaments, the conference has held numerous community initiatives, partnered with the College Football Playoff Foundation and other events such as the Big Ten Career Expo, SaturDAY of Service and Youth Football Clinics. In addition, the Big Ten has hosted a downtown 5K, collaborated with a local breast cancer awareness group and provided unique event experiences for military veterans.
