### BIG TEN. BIG NEWS.

- Big Ten fans are gearing up for a Thanksgiving feast with several high-profile matchups on the horizon, including a pair of top-10 contests on Thanksgiving Day when No. 2/3 Maryland takes on No. 5/4 NC State and No. 4/6 Indiana faces No. 7/5 Stanford, both at the Baha Mar Hoops Pink Flamingo Championship in the Bahamas. Those two games are just the start for the Big Ten on a loaded Thanksgiving weekend, as conference teams could face up to 11 ranked opponents in various tournaments through Sunday night.
- For the second week in a row, the Big Ten has two teams ranked in the top five of the Associated Press poll, with Maryland rising two spots to No. 2 (the highest ranking for a Big Ten program since Feb. 13 & 20, 2017, when the Terrapins were No. 2) and Indiana holding steady at a program-best No. 4. This week marks the first time the Big Ten has had two teams appear in the AP Top 5 in back-to-back weeks since Dec. 14, 1993-Jan. 25, 1994, when Iowa and Penn State were both in the media's top five for seven consecutive polls.
- This is also the third consecutive week the Big Ten leads the nation with five AP Top 25 teams, including three teams ranked among the AP top 10. Along with Maryland at No. 2 and Indiana at No. 4, Iowa remains in place at No. 8. Michigan is up one spot to No. 12, Ohio State is holding at No. 21 and Michigan State continues to receive votes.
- In the first regular-season Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA)/USA Today poll that also came out Tuesday, the Big Ten is tied for the national lead with five Top 25 teams, including three top-10 programs (and a fourth at No. 11). Maryland is up to No. 3 this week, its highest ranking since March 7-13, 2017, when it was also third, while Indiana moves up one spot to a school-record No. 6 this week, and Michigan did likewise with its one-place rise to No. 9. Iowa is holding steady at No. 11 and Ohio State rises one position to No. 24, with Michigan State also receiving votes from the coaches this week.
- The Big Ten currently maintains one of the nation's best non-conference records this season at 53-12 (.815). During the past three years (2019-20 to date), the Big Ten has gone a combined 220-54 (.803) in non-conference regular-season games, the best stretch in conference history. Last year, Big Ten programs set a conference record for the best non-conference winning percentage in regular-season games for a single campaign at .846 (44-8), which was also the second-highest non-conference winning percentage by any conference last year.
- Maryland secured the Big Ten's second win over a top-15 opponent in as many tries during the first two weeks of the 2021-22 season with a 79-76 victory over No. 6/8 Baylor on Sunday at the XFINITY Center. The Terrapins' win came following Indiana's 88-67 victory over No. 13/13 Kentucky on Nov. 14 in Bloomington.
- Prior to Sunday's win over Baylor, Maryland head coach Brenda Frese was announced as the latest recipient of the Nell and John Wooden Excellence in Coaching Award. The honor was created in 2012 by Bob Geoghan, with the close coordination of Coach Wooden's family, to recognize college basketball coaches who possess the character traits exemplified by the late UCLA legendary coach whose high standards and personal integrity are depicted in his famous "Pyramid of Success." Previous winners of the Nell and John Wooden Excellence in Coaching Award include Roy Williams, Mike Krzyzewski, Jay Wright and Muffet McGraw.
- Michigan's Kim Barnes Arico coached her 300th game with the Wolverines on Monday night and earned her 198th victory in Ann Arbor with a 69-58 win over Oakland. Barnes Arico, who is already the winningest coach in Michigan women's basketball history (198-102, .660 in 10 seasons), is poised to become just the third Wolverine basketball coach (women's or men's) to reach the 200-win milestone at the school, joining John Beilein (278 from 2007-19) and Johnny Orr (209 from 1968-80).
- Nebraska topped the 100-point mark for the third time in five games this season with its 113-58 win over N.C. Central on Nov. 20 at Pinnacle Bank Arena. It's the first time in school history the Huskers have had three triple-digit games in one season, particularly notable for a Nebraska program that, prior to this year, had not scored 100 points in a game since Nov. 15, 2014, vs. Pepperdine. The Huskers have also outscored their five opponents this season by a school-record margin of 228 points (45.6 ppg.), with the previous five-game

margin being 178 points in Dec. 1978, with three of those five that year vs. non-Division I opponents.

- In Nebraska's Nov. 20 win over N.C. Central, sophomore guard Jaz Shelley recorded the fourth triple-double in program history with 14 points, 10 rebounds and 10 steals, all in just 20 minutes of action — according to Her Hoop Stats, it was the fastest and most efficient triple-double by an NCAA Division I player since at least 2009. Shelley's triple-double was also the first by a Husker since Dec. 19, 2017, when Kate Cain had 22 points, 14 rebounds and 11 blocked shots in a win over Florida Atlantic.
- With Shelley's feat, three Big Ten players recorded triple-doubles in a five-day span, including on back-to-back nights for the second year in a row. Penn State's Makenna Marisa (30p/11a/10s) started the run on Nov. 16 vs. Delaware State, followed one night later by Iowa's Caitlin Clark (16p/10r/10a) vs. Southern. Big Ten players have tallied 37 triple-doubles all-time, including eight in the past two seasons, with Clark and Indiana's Grace Berger the only active players in the country with multiple career triple-doubles (Berger has three, all last year).
- Marisa's triple-double was PSU's first since the program began competing in the Big Ten in 1992-93, and was only the second triple-double by a Big Ten women's basketball player to feature steals as a component. On March 5, 2004, Minnesota's Janel McCarville had 23 points/11 rebounds/10 steals in a Big Ten Tournament quarterfinal loss to Ohio State at Gainbridge Fieldhouse in Indianapolis. Marisa's 10 steals also tied for seventh on the Big Ten single-game list and were the most by a conference player since Nov. 26, 2015, when Northwestern's Ashley Deary had 10 steals against Eastern Washington.
- Penn State wrote its name all over the Big Ten record books on Nov. 16 with its 120-51 win over Delaware State at the Bryce Jordan Center. The Lady Lions set a school record for points, while also recording the third-highest point total in Big Ten history and most since Dec. 8, 1990 (Purdue's conference-record 129 points vs. Kent State). In addition, PSU tied a Big Ten record with 37 assists (matching Maryland's total vs. Loyola (Md.) on Dec. 11, 2017) and made 50 field goals, the

third-most in conference history and most since the aforementioned 1990 Purdue game vs. Kent State, when the Boilermakers made a Big Ten-record 57 baskets. Lastly, Penn State recorded 25 steals, tying for eighth-most in the conference record books and most since Nov. 13, 2016, when Maryland had 26 thefts in a win over UMass Lowell.

- Rutgers picked up a notable non-conference win on Nov. 19, rallying from an 18-point deficit at the start of the fourth quarter to defeat Harvard, 68-65 in overtime. The 18-point comeback tied for the fifth-largest in Big Ten history and largest since Nov. 23, 2018, when Iowa erased a conference-record 24-point margin to knock off West Virginia, 84-81. RU's school record for its largest comeback win is 22 points, set at Providence in Nov. 1993 (prior to the program joining the Big Ten).
- With its 100-60 win over Bryant on Nov. 19, Michigan State became the fourth different Big Ten team to score 100 points in a game this season, joining Maryland, Nebraska (three times) and Penn State. The conference also had four teams reach triple digits in at least one game last year, but that quartet was almost entirely different from this season, with the exception of Maryland. The Big Ten's other 100-point teams last year besides the Terrapins were Indiana, Iowa and Ohio State.
- The Big Ten announced Nov. 18 that Megan Kahn has been named Vice President of Women's Basketball. Kahn will work with Commissioner Kevin Warren and Deputy Commissioner/Chief Sports Officer Diana Sabau to lead the women's basketball efforts for the conference. She will be charged with developing a cohesive strategy to strengthen, enhance and expand the Big Ten women's basketball operations, brand and strategic initiatives. Kahn comes to the conference following a successful tenure at WeCOACH, a 501c(3) non-profit organization committed to the educational and professional development of women's coaches across all sports and levels. She also previously served as assistant and associate commissioner at the Atlantic 10 Conference (2008-12) and was tournament manager for game operations at the 2015 and 2019 NCAA Women's Final Fours that were played in Tampa, Fla.

Since its inception in 1896, the pursuit and attainment of academic excellence has been a priority for every Big Ten member institution. But maintaining the conference's standard of competing at the highest level in athletics also endures as an important component of the Big Ten experience. Striking that balance between academics and athletics is integral to the Big Ten's identity. Recognized as one of intercollegiate sports' most successful undertakings, the Big Ten strives for success from its students not only on the field and in the classroom, but around the world as well.

## **PREMIER ACADEMIC INSTITUTIONS**

The Big Ten Academic Alliance is an academic consortium of all 14 Big Ten universities, which is widely considered to be the model for effective and voluntary collaboration among top research universities.

Every Big Ten Academic Alliance institution ranks among the top 70 universities in the nation according to the 2021 Academic Ranking of World Universities, including six in the top 30.

The Big Ten leads all conferences with more than 1,800 Academic All-Americans, including a Big Ten-record 56 honorees during the 2020-21 academic year.

Big Ten Academic Alliance schools annually conduct \$10 billion in funded research, \$5 billion more than any other conference.

## **A HISTORY OF ATHLETIC SUCCESS**

Big Ten schools have won at least five national championships in 23 of the last 27 years, averaging nearly seven per year during that span.

Since the 2008-09 academic year, current Big Ten institutions have claimed 80 team national championships in 22 different sports.

## **BROAD-BASED PROGRAMMING**

The Big Ten will administer more than \$240 million in direct financial support to more than 9,800 students competing in intercollegiate athletics for more than 11,000 participation opportunities on 350 teams in 42 different sports.

The Big Ten sponsors 28 official conference sports, 14 for men and 14 for women, including the addition of men's ice hockey and men's and women's lacrosse in this decade.

The Big Ten leads the nation in total students competing in intercollegiate athletics and participation opportunities, and sponsors more official sports than all conferences except the Ivy League.

More than 1,500 Big Ten competitors have participated in the Olympics, winning more than 500 medals, including more than 200 gold. The Big Ten Conference enjoyed its finest performance at a single Olympic Games during the 2020 Summer Olympics in Tokyo, Japan, as athletes with Big Ten ties set conference records by earning 51 total medals and 22 gold medals during the 17-day competition. All 14 Big Ten member schools had an athlete win at least one medal in Tokyo, also a first in conference history.

## **PASSIONATE FOLLOWING**

The Big Ten leads all conferences with 6.4 million alumni and nearly 580,000 students.

Each year more than 11 million patrons attend Big Ten home contests, as the conference has led the nation in attendance for men's basketball, ice hockey, volleyball and wrestling.

## **LEADERS IN INNOVATION**

Took part in the nation's first bowl game, winning the 1902 Rose Bowl Game, and signed an exclusive contract with the Tournament of Roses in 1946, making it the first bowl with permanent conference affiliations.

Awarded the first Big Ten Medal of Honor in 1915, honoring outstanding seniors who demonstrated excellence in academics and athletics.

Formed the Big Ten Advisory Commission in 1972, enlisting former students that competed in conference athletics to serve as liaisons to the NCAA's Diversity and Inclusion Department, the Big Ten Student-Athlete Advisory Commission and other organizations.

Became the first conference to voluntarily adopt male and female participation goals after launching its Gender Equity Action Plan in 1992.

Implemented the first collegiate football system of instant replay in 2004, which the NCAA approved for use among all conferences in 2006.

Launched the Big Ten Network (BTN) in 2007, the first national conference-owned television network.

Began partnering with the Ivy League to study the effects of head injuries in sports in 2012.

Accepted Johns Hopkins University as the conference's first sport affiliate members in men's and women's lacrosse in 2013 and 2015, respectively, and added Notre Dame as a sport affiliate member in men's ice hockey in 2017.

## **EXTENSIVE TELEVISION EXPOSURE**

Through the Big Ten's current media agreements with BTN, ABC/ESPN, CBS and FOX, more than 2,000 Big Ten events are produced and distributed nationally and globally on an annual basis.

BTN is in almost 60 million homes across the United States and Canada, and is also available via the Fox Sports App, delivering live and on-demand programming to computers, smartphones and tablets. B1G+ streams hundreds of additional events each season.

## **COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT**

For more than 30 years, through the Big Ten's SCORE (Success Comes Out of Reading Everyday) program, the conference has partnered with Chicago elementary schools to improve reading performance.

Surrounding the Big Ten Football Championship Game and Basketball Tournaments, the conference has held numerous community initiatives, partnered with the College Football Playoff Foundation and other events such as the Big Ten Career Expo, SaturDAY of Service and Youth Football Clinics. In addition, the Big Ten has hosted a downtown 5K, collaborated with a local breast cancer awareness group and provided unique event experiences for military veterans.
