BIG TEN. BIG NEWS.

- This week's conference schedule is highlighted by the 14th annual Big Ten/ACC Challenge that tips off Wednesday and continues Thursday. The latest matchup of two of the nation's top conferences is highlighted by 17 schools that competed in postseason play last year (ACC-9, Big Ten-8), including 2021 NCAA Elite Eight qualifiers Indiana and Louisville and NCAA Sweet Sixteen participants Iowa, Maryland, Michigan, Georgia Tech and NC State. Fans are invited to join the social media conversation for this year's Big Ten/ACC Challenge through the event's official hashtag (#WB1GACC).
- The 2021 Big Ten/ACC Challenge will offer the most robust television package in the event's 14-year history, with a record-setting 12 games on linear television and the other two broadcast digitally on B1G+. The Big Ten Network will once again provide doubleheader coverage on both Wednesday (Purdue-Georgia Tech and Minnesota-North Carolina) and Thursday (Michigan State-Notre Dame and Maryland-Miami), with ESPN adding a doubleheader on Thursday (Michigan-Louisville and Iowa-Duke) along with ESPN2's broadcast of the top-10 showdown between No. 6/6 Indiana and No. 2/3 NC State. The ACC Network will also carry a doubleheader on both nights (Rutgers-Pittsburgh and Ohio State-Syracuse on Wednesday; Penn State-Boston College and Northwestern-Clemson on Thursday), with the Nebraska-Wake Forest game airing on the ACC's Regional Sports Networks package (also on ESPN3), while the two remaining Big Ten home games (Wisconsin-Virginia Tech on Wednesday and Illinois-Florida State on Thursday) will be seen on B1G+ (bigtenplus.com). All BTN games can also be seen on the FOX Sports app, while those on the ESPN and ACC networks are available on the ESPN app.
- No fewer than 11 of the 14 games in this year's Big Ten/ACC Challenge will feature at least one school that is either ranked or receiving votes in one of the major national polls including a pair of Top 10 matchups at 7 p.m. (ET) Thursday — No. 2/3 NC State at No. 6/6 Indiana on ESPN2 and No. 12/9 Michigan at No. 10/5 Louisville on ESPN.
- In the most recent Big Ten/ACC Challenge in 2019 (the 2020 event was cancelled due to the COVID-19 pandemic), the Big Ten clinched its first-ever win with a 9-5 victory that was fueled, in part, by a perfect 5-0 start on the first night. The Big Ten, which won all seven of its home games in the 2019 event, also added road wins by Indiana (at No. 22/21 Miami) and Minnesota (at Notre Dame, handing the Fighting Irish their first loss in seven Challenge appearances). The Big Ten had previously secured three ties in the Challenge (6-6 in 2011, 7-7 in 2014 and 2015) before its 2019 outright victory. The Big Ten schools with the most success in the Challenge have been Maryland (11-2 all-time, including a 4-2 record as a Big Ten member), Michigan (9-4) and Indiana (8-5).
- In recent seasons, the Big Ten/ACC Challenge has emerged as one of the more closely contested non-conference events in the country. The last three times the Challenge has been played, at least half the games were decided by 11 points or fewer (seven in 2017, 10 in 2018, nine in 2019), with eight games in those three years decided by one possession and two going to overtime (2018 - Clemson def. Illinois, 69-67; 2019 - Michigan def. Syracuse, 84-76).
- This is the fourth consecutive week the Big Ten leads the nation with five AP Top 25 teams (all in top 20), including three teams ranked among the AP top 10. Indiana leads the Big Ten contingent at No. 6, with Maryland at No. 8 and Iowa at No. 9. Michigan remains at No. 12 while Ohio State rose to No. 18 and Purdue is receiving votes.
- In the latest Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA)/USA Today poll, the Big Ten is tied for the national lead with five Top 25 teams, including three top-10 programs (and a fourth at No. 12). Indiana leads the way at No. 6, with Maryland at No. 8 and Michigan at No. 9. Iowa is next at No. 12, followed by No. 20 Ohio State.

BIG TEN. BIG NEWS.

- At 7-0, Nebraska is off to its best start since the 2014-15 season, following Saturday's 64-56 win at San Diego to claim The Dana on Mission Bay Holiday Tournament title. In 2014-15, the Huskers opened 7-0 on the way to a 21-11 record and a berth in the NCAA Tournament.
- Maryland comes into Thursday's Big Ten/ACC Challenge matchup with Miami sharing the nation's longest active home winning streak (28 games) with Stephen F. Austin. The Terrapins, whose current run began Nov. 17, 2019, with a victory over Delaware at the XFINITY Center, have a way's to go to catch their school record of 48 consecutive home wins from 2007-10.
- Purdue captured its first win over a ranked opponent in nearly three years on Nov. 27 with a 66-61 victory over No. 17/22 Florida State at the Global Sports & Events St. Pete Showcase in St. Petersburg, Fla. The Boilermakers' last Top 25 win came on Jan. 20, 2019, a 56-53 decision over No. 25 Indiana, and their last victory over a team ranked 17th or higher in the Associated Press poll was Feb. 15, 2018, a 75-65 win at No. 10 Maryland.
- Michigan's Kim Barnes Arico collected her 200th victory in Ann Arbor on Nov. 27 with a 64-48 win over Mississippi State at the Daytona Beach (Fla.) Invitational. Barnes Arico, who is the winningest coach in Michigan women's basketball history (200-102, .662 in 10 seasons), is just the third Wolverine basketball coach (women's or men's) to reach the 200-win milestone at the school, joining John Beilein (278 from 2007-19) and Johnny Orr (209 from 1968-80).
- Ohio State carved a place in the Big Ten record books on Nov. 23, scoring 70 points in the first half of its 110-50 victory over Bellarmine. The Buckeyes broke the previous conference record for points in a half (69) that had been set on two prior occasions — Dec. 5, 1982 (Wisconsin vs. Bradley) and Nov. 23, 2002 (Minnesota vs. Purdue Fort Wayne). In both cases, those points came in the second half, with the old Big Ten first half scoring record being 68 points, also twice before — Dec. 8, 1990 (Purdue vs. Kent State) and Feb. 23, 2021 (Maryland vs. Iowa).
- With its win over Bellarmine, Ohio State became the fifth different Big Ten team to score 100 points in a game this season, joining Maryland, Michigan State, Nebraska (three times) and Penn State. It's the third year in a row the Big Ten has had at least four programs reach triple digits in the same season — the 2019-20 campaign was the last time the conference had more 100-point scoring teams, with seven Big Ten programs reaching the century mark at least once that season.
- The Big Ten currently leads all Division I conferences in field goal percentage (.439) and three-point percentage (.344) while ranking second in scoring offense (73.0 ppg.).
- The Big Ten announced Nov. 18 that Megan Kahn has been named Vice President of Women's Basketball. Kahn will work with Commissioner Kevin Warren and Deputy Commissioner/Chief Sports Officer Diana Sabau to lead the women's basketball efforts for the conference. She will be charged with developing a cohesive strategy to strengthen, enhance and expand the Big Ten women's basketball operations, brand and strategic initiatives. Kahn comes to the conference following a successful tenure at WeCOACH, a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization committed to the educational and professional development of women's coaches across all sports and levels. She also previously served as assistant and associate commissioner at the Atlantic 10 Conference (2008-12) and was tournament manager for game operations at the 2015 and 2019 NCAA Women's Final Fours that were played in Tampa, Fla.

Since its inception in 1896, the pursuit and attainment of academic excellence has been a priority for every Big Ten member institution. But maintaining the conference's standard of competing at the highest level in athletics also endures as an important component of the Big Ten experience. Striking that balance between academics and athletics is integral to the Big Ten's identity. Recognized as one of intercollegiate sports' most successful undertakings, the Big Ten strives for success from its students not only on the field and in the classroom, but around the world as well.

PREMIER ACADEMIC INSTITUTIONS

The Big Ten Academic Alliance is an academic consortium of all 14 Big Ten universities, which is widely considered to be the model for effective and voluntary collaboration among top research universities.

Every Big Ten Academic Alliance institution ranks among the top 70 universities in the nation according to the 2021 Academic Ranking of World Universities, including six in the top 30.

The Big Ten leads all conferences with more than 1,800 Academic All-Americans, including a Big Ten-record 56 honorees during the 2020-21 academic year.

Big Ten Academic Alliance schools annually conduct \$10 billion in funded research, \$5 billion more than any other conference.

A HISTORY OF ATHLETIC SUCCESS

Big Ten schools have won at least five national championships in 23 of the last 27 years, averaging nearly seven per year during that span.

Since the 2008-09 academic year, current Big Ten institutions have claimed 80 team national championships in 22 different sports.

BROAD-BASED PROGRAMMING

The Big Ten will administer more than \$240 million in direct financial support to more than 9,800 students competing in intercollegiate athletics for more than 11,000 participation opportunities on 350 teams in 42 different sports.

The Big Ten sponsors 28 official conference sports, 14 for men and 14 for women, including the addition of men's ice hockey and men's and women's lacrosse in this decade.

The Big Ten leads the nation in total students competing in intercollegiate athletics and participation opportunities, and sponsors more official sports than all conferences except the Ivy League.

More than 1,500 Big Ten competitors have participated in the Olympics, winning more than 500 medals, including more than 200 gold. The Big Ten Conference enjoyed its finest performance at a single Olympic Games during the 2020 Summer Olympics in Tokyo, Japan, as athletes with Big Ten ties set conference records by earning 51 total medals and 22 gold medals during the 17-day competition. All 14 Big Ten member schools had an athlete win at least one medal in Tokyo, also a first in conference history.

PASSIONATE FOLLOWING

The Big Ten leads all conferences with 6.4 million alumni and nearly 580,000 students.

Each year more than 11 million patrons attend Big Ten home contests, as the conference has led the nation in attendance for men's basketball, ice hockey, volleyball and wrestling.

LEADERS IN INNOVATION

Took part in the nation's first bowl game, winning the 1902 Rose Bowl Game, and signed an exclusive contract with the Tournament of Roses in 1946, making it the first bowl with permanent conference affiliations.

Awarded the first Big Ten Medal of Honor in 1915, honoring outstanding seniors who demonstrated excellence in academics and athletics.

Formed the Big Ten Advisory Commission in 1972, enlisting former students that competed in conference athletics to serve as liaisons to the NCAA's Diversity and Inclusion Department, the Big Ten Student-Athlete Advisory Commission and other organizations.

Became the first conference to voluntarily adopt male and female participation goals after launching its Gender Equity Action Plan in 1992.

Implemented the first collegiate football system of instant replay in 2004, which the NCAA approved for use among all conferences in 2006.

Launched the Big Ten Network (BTN) in 2007, the first national conference-owned television network.

Began partnering with the Ivy League to study the effects of head injuries in sports in 2012.

Accepted Johns Hopkins University as the conference's first sport affiliate members in men's and women's lacrosse in 2013 and 2015, respectively, and added Notre Dame as a sport affiliate member in men's ice hockey in 2017.

EXTENSIVE TELEVISION EXPOSURE

Through the Big Ten's current media agreements with BTN, ABC/ESPN, CBS and FOX, more than 2,000 Big Ten events are produced and distributed nationally and globally on an annual basis.

BTN is in almost 60 million homes across the United States and Canada, and is also available via the Fox Sports App, delivering live and on-demand programming to computers, smartphones and tablets. B1G+ streams hundreds of additional events each season.

COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

For more than 30 years, through the Big Ten's SCORE (Success Comes Out of Reading Everyday) program, the conference has partnered with Chicago elementary schools to improve reading performance.

Surrounding the Big Ten Football Championship Game and Basketball Tournaments, the conference has held numerous community initiatives, partnered with the College Football Playoff Foundation and other events such as the Big Ten Career Expo, SaturDAY of Service and Youth Football Clinics. In addition, the Big Ten has hosted a downtown 5K, collaborated with a local breast cancer awareness group and provided unique event experiences for military veterans.
