### BIG TEN. BIG NEWS.

- The final week of the Big Ten regular season begins at 5:30 p.m. (ET) Tuesday when Penn State travels to No. 25 Rutgers for the second meeting between the schools in the past three days. The game will be televised live on BTN and the FOX Sports app.
- Iowa's Caitlin Clark was selected as the Big Ten Player and Freshman of the Week on Monday, the fifth time this season she has swept both honors, setting a conference record (previous was four by Minnesota's Amanda Zahui B. in 2013-14). It's also the 12th Freshman of the Week honor and 17th combined weekly award for Clark this season, extending her conference record in both categories. Clark was also named one of five finalists for the Nancy Lieberman Award as the nation's top point guard on Monday, and earlier on Tuesday, she was chosen as the USBWA Tamika Catchings National Freshman of the Week for the fourth time this season.
- Also on Tuesday, Maryland's Ashley Owusu and Rutgers' Arella Guirantes were among five finalists for the Ann Meyers Drysdale Award, which is presented annually to the country's top shooting guard. Both the Lieberman and Drysdale awards are among the five positional awards selected each year by the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame and the Women's Basketball Coaches Association.
- Indiana rose to 14-2 in Big Ten play with an 87-75 victory at No. 15/14 Ohio State on Feb. 27. The Hoosiers have now recorded the second-most conference wins in a season in program history (15-3 in 1982-83, their first and only Big Ten title season) and the most under seventh-year head coach Teri Moren. Saturday's win was also Indiana's first over Ohio State since Jan. 31, 2010 (a 67-62 victory in Bloomington), and its first in Columbus since Jan. 31, 2002 (85-72 at St. John Arena).
- Iowa collected its second Top 25 win of the season on Feb. 25 with an 89-67 victory over No. 12/12 Michigan at Carver-Hawkeye Arena. No fewer than six Big Ten programs have multiple Top 25 wins this season (Nebraska has a conference-high four), and 10 conference schools have at least one ranked win, with last Thursday's victory the first top-15 triumph for Iowa since Jan. 12, 2020 (a 91-85 double-overtime win over No. 12/13 Indiana, also in Iowa City).
- In an offensive display fitting of the nation's two highest-scoring offenses, Maryland defeated Iowa, 111-93 on Feb. 23 in College Park. The Terrapins set a Big Ten record for conference games with 68 first-half points and tied the overall Big Ten mark with 41 first-quarter points on the way to their fifth 100-point game and third 110-point outing this season (the latter tying a program record set in 1977-78 and matched in 2017-18). The 111 points were also the most Maryland has scored in a conference game since Jan. 10, 2007 (111-53 at Miami-Fla. while an ACC member) — and it tied the most the Terrapins have scored in conference play in the past 40 seasons.
- Maryland and Iowa combined to make 32 three-point field goals in last week's shootout, including a school-record nine for the Terrapins' Katie Benzan (on 10 tries) and nine for the Hawkeyes' Caitlin Clark (on 16 tries) — the nine triples ties for the seventh-most in a single game by a Big Ten player (sixth-most in a conference game). The 32 combined treys tied a Big Ten record first set on Jan. 29, 2015, in Iowa's 102-99 win at Northwestern (19 for Iowa, 13 for NU), a game that also represented the last time a Hawkeye player made nine triples in a game (Melissa Dixon went 9-of-10 that day).
- The Big Ten is tied for top honors among all NCAA Division I conferences with six schools in the top 25 and eight in the top 40 of the latest NCAA NET (NCAA Evaluation Tool) rankings released Tuesday. The current NET rankings are listed on page 3 of this release.
- Six Big Ten programs, the second-most of any Division I conference, are appearing in the latest Associated Press and/or Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA)/USA Today Top 25 polls, with Iowa also receiving votes in the coaches' poll. Of note this week, Indiana has earned its highest-ever rankings in both poll (No. 10/10).

### BIG LIFE. BIG STAGE. BIG TEN.

The Big Ten Academic Alliance is an academic consortium of all 14 Big Ten universities, which is widely considered to be the model for effective and voluntary collaboration among top research universities.

## BIG TEN. BIG NEWS.

- Nine different Big Ten teams have been ranked or receiving votes in one or both polls this season, with Rutgers the seventh Big Ten school to crack the Top 25 this year after its No. 25 ranking in the AP poll last week.
- According to Tuesday's NCAA statistics report, the Big Ten leads all Division I conferences in scoring (74.0 ppg.), field-goal percentage (.438), and is second in assists (15.7 apg.) and three-point percentage (.338).
- The Big Ten leads the nation with five teams among the top 25 in the country (including the country's No. 1 and 2 teams) in scoring offense. Maryland is first in scoring at 91.7 points per game, on pace to not only set a school record, but become the first Big Ten program to lead the country in scoring since the NCAA began sanctioning the sport in 1981-82. The Terrapins are followed by Iowa (2nd - 88.0), Ohio State (10th - 81.1), Michigan (19th - 78.1) and Rutgers (23rd - 76.9). No other conference has more than three teams among the top 25 in the nation in scoring offense.
- Continuing the theme of high-powered offenses, the Big Ten not only has three teams scoring more than 80 points per game, but half (7) of the conference schools are averaging better than 75 points per game, as of Tuesday. The Big Ten has never finished a season with eight teams averaging 75 ppg. — the closest the conference came was in 1995-96, when five of the (then) 11 Big Ten programs averaged more than 75 ppg. (Northwestern, Ohio State, Penn State, Purdue and Wisconsin).
- The Big Ten is also tops among all conferences with four programs in the nation's top 25 in field-goal percentage. Iowa is No. 1 in the nation (.518), followed by Maryland (6th - .486), Rutgers (11th - .474) and Michigan (23rd - .462). No other conference has more than three schools in the top 25 nationally in field-goal percentage.
- The Big Ten's shooting prowess extends to the three-point line as well, where three conference programs are among the top 15 in the nation in three-point percentage. Maryland is No. 2 in the country in that category (.413), with Iowa in third (.412) and Rutgers at No. 14 (.383). The Big Ten is one of just two conferences with three teams in the top 15 in three-point percentage.
- The Big Ten features two of the nation's top 10 in no fewer than seven separate NCAA statistical categories (including three national leaders), as of Tuesday. In scoring, Iowa's Caitlin Clark is second (26.9 ppg.), followed by Michigan's Naz Hillmon in third (25.8 ppg.). In field-goal percentage, Iowa's Monika Czinano is No. 1 in field-goal percentage (.692), with Hillmon in second (.649). In three-point percentage, Maryland's Katie Benzan is No. 1 (.527) and Rutgers' Diamond Johnson is third (.494). In three-pointers made, Clark is third (3.90) and Benzan is fourth (3.76). In steals, Northwestern's Veronica Burton leads the nation (4.21 spg.), while Rutgers' Tekia Mack is seventh (3.42 spg.). In blocks, Nebraska's Kate Cain is seventh (3.05 bpg.) and Indiana's Mackenzie Holmes is ninth (2.95 bpg.). And, in assist/turnover ratio, Penn State's Niya Beverley is third (3.79) and Burton is eighth (2.94).
- For the seventh consecutive season, all Big Ten games during conference play are being televised live on BTN, FS1, the ESPN family of networks or streamed live on Big Ten Network+. The most current schedule of Big Ten women's basketball games on TV is online at [bigten.org/B1GWBTV](http://bigten.org/B1GWBTV).
- The Big Ten could set a new conference record for the best non-conference winning percentage in regular-season games in a single campaign, currently at .846 (44-8) — the previous record came last year when conference teams went .788 (123-33). This year's record includes three non-conference Top 25 wins — Maryland 115-96 over No. 14 Arkansas on Nov. 29 (a Big Ten record for points against a ranked team); Michigan 76-66 at No. RV/23 Notre Dame on Dec. 3; Iowa 82-80 over No. RV/24 Iowa State on Dec. 9.
- On Oct. 23, the Big Ten Conference announced the launch of the 'United As One' social justice campaign. 'United As One' is among several conference-wide Equality Coalition initiatives dedicated to constructively and collectively recognizing and eliminating racism and hate in our society by creating resources for inclusion, empowerment and accountability.
- The Big Ten Conference established the Equality Coalition in 2020 with 227 members including presidents and chancellors, directors of athletics, coaches, student-athletes, conference and school administrators, alumni, families and friends representing all 14 institutions.

- Averaged 26.3 points, 10.0 assists and 5.0 rebounds per game with a .500 field-goal percentage, .514 three-point percentage and a double-double in a 2-1 week for the Hawkeyes
- Scored 34 points (including a career-high nine three-pointers) in a Feb. 23 loss at No. 8/8 Maryland, her fifth consecutive and ninth overall 30-point game this season, both the most by an NCAA Division I freshman since 2000
- Tallied 27 points (10-17 FG, 7-12 3FG) and delivered nine assists in a Feb. 25 win over No. 12/12 Michigan
- Registered her seventh double-double of the season Sunday at Wisconsin with 18 points and a career-high 14 assists, breaking the Iowa freshman record for assists in a season (149; previous record was 148 by Kathleen Doyle in 2016-17)
- Earns her fifth career Big Ten Player of the Week award, setting a conference record for most Player of the Week awards by a freshman, surpassing the four honors by Minnesota's Amanda Zahui B. in 2013-14
- Last Iowa Player of the Week: Caitlin Clark (Feb. 15, 2021)
- Collects the 12th Big Ten Freshman of the Week award of her career, extending her conference record in that category



### **PREMIER ACADEMIC INSTITUTIONS**

The Big Ten Academic Alliance is an academic consortium of all 14 Big Ten universities, which is widely considered to be the model for effective and voluntary collaboration among top research universities.

Every Big Ten Academic Alliance institution ranks among the top 70 universities in the nation according to the 2019 Academic Ranking of World Universities, including six in the top 30.

The Big Ten leads all conferences with more than 1,800 Academic All-Americans, including 27 honorees during the 2019-20 academic year.

Big Ten Academic Alliance schools annually conduct \$10 billion in funded research, \$5 billion more than any other conference.

### **A HISTORY OF ATHLETIC SUCCESS**

Each year more than 11 million patrons attend Big Ten home contests, as the conference has led the nation in attendance for men's basketball, ice hockey, volleyball and wrestling.

### **LEADERS IN INNOVATION**

Took part in the nation's first bowl game, winning the 1902 Rose Bowl Game, and signed an exclusive contract with the Tournament of Roses in 1946, making it the first bowl with permanent conference affiliations.

Awarded the first Big Ten Medal of Honor in 1915, honoring outstanding seniors who demonstrated excellence in academics and athletics.

Formed the Big Ten Advisory Commission in 1972, enlisting former students that competed in conference athletics to serve as liaisons to the NCAA's Diversity and Inclusion Department, the Big Ten Student-Athlete Advisory Commission and other organizations.

Became the first conference to voluntarily adopt male and female participation goals after launching its Gender Equity Action Plan in 1992.

Implemented the first collegiate football system of instant replay in 2004, which the NCAA approved for use among all conferences in 2006.

Launched the Big Ten Network (BTN) in 2007, the first national conference-owned television network.

Began partnering with the Ivy League to study the effects of head injuries in sports in 2012.

Accepted Johns Hopkins University as the conference's first sport affiliate members in men's and women's lacrosse in 2013 and 2015, respectively, and added Notre Dame as a sport affiliate member in men's ice hockey in 2017.

### **EXTENSIVE TELEVISION EXPOSURE**

Through the Big Ten's current media agreements with BTN, ABC/ESPN, CBS and FOX, more than 2,000 Big Ten events are produced and distributed nationally and globally on an annual basis.

BTN is in almost 60 million homes across the United States and Canada, and is also available internationally via the Fox Sports App, delivering live and on-demand programming to computers, smartphones and tablets. BTN Plus streams hundreds of additional events each season.

### **COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT**


