BIG TEN. BIG NEWS.

- Following one of its most successful non-conference seasons ever, the Big Ten surges back into conference play this week, with seven of 13 Big Ten games through next Monday (Jan. 2) televised live on the Big Ten Network (and the FOX Sports app), while the Nebraska-Indiana matchup on New Year's Day will be broadcast live on ESPN and the ESPN app. In addition, SiriusXM Radio is scheduled to carry seven Big Ten women's basketball games globally through next Monday.
- Nebraska needed 15 additional minutes, but battled past No. 20/24 Kansas, 85-79 in triple overtime on Dec. 21 at Pinnacle Bank Arena. It was the longest game involving a Big Ten Conference team since March 1, 2018, when Indiana defeated Michigan State, 111-109 in four overtimes in a second round game at the Big Ten Tournament in Indianapolis. It was also the longest regular season game for a Big Ten program since Feb. 26, 2016, when Michigan State defeated Ohio State, 107-105 in triple overtime in East Lansing.
- Nebraska's victory over Kansas on Dec. 21 put Huskers' head coach Amy Williams one win shy of 300 for her career — she is 299-196 (.604) in 16 seasons, including a 106-87 (.549) record in seven years at her alma mater. This also sets up a unique milestone matchup for Nebraska's next game on Wednesday against No. 14/19 Michigan at Pinnacle Bank Arena (9 p.m. ET on Big Ten Network). Wolverines' head coach Kim Barnes Arico has 499 career wins and will be seeking to give the Big Ten five active coaches with 500 career wins, the most of any conference in the country — the Big Ten's active 500-win club currently includes Iowa's Lisa Bluder (829), Northwestern's Joe McKeown (756), Maryland's Brenda Frese (602) and Michigan State's Suzy Merchant (520).
- The Big Ten leads all Division I conferences with a remarkable nine schools among the top 40 in the latest NET rankings, including two in the top 10 and four in the top 20 — No. 4 Indiana, No. 9 Ohio State, No. 15 Iowa, No. 20 Michigan, No. 27 Illinois, No. 28 Maryland, No. 31 Nebraska, No. 33 Michigan State and No. 39 Purdue. The NCAA Evaluation Tool (NET) is the primary sorting tool used by the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Committee for determining NCAA Tournament teams.
- No. 3/4 Ohio State headed into the holiday break undefeated and picked up its third ranked win of the season with an 84-67 victory over No. 16/15 Oregon on Dec. 21 in the San Diego Invitational championship game. The Buckeyes are off to their best start in the 10-year tenure of head coach Kevin McGuff, and best overall debut since 2011-12, when they started 15-0.
- Only six NCAA Division I programs remain undefeated this season and two of those reside in the Big Ten Conference — Ohio State (13-0) and Indiana (12-0). The other undefeated Division I teams as of Tuesday are LSU (12-0), South Carolina (12-0), St. John's (12-0) and Utah (12-0).
- With last week's victories by Nebraska and Ohio State, the Big Ten Conference posted seven top-10 wins and 12 victories over ranked non-conference opponents this season, both leading all Division I conferences. The seven non-conference top-10 wins (which include three away from home) are the most by the Big Ten in the past 20 years, more than doubling the three top-10 victories in both 2004-05 and 2008-09. The 12 Top 25 wins (seven of which have come on the road or at neutral sites) are also tied for the most for the Big Ten in the regular season during the past two decades, matching the total from the 2004-05 season.
- The Big Ten Conference showed a strong finishing kick to the non-conference season, going 21-1 since Dec. 16, with the only loss coming in overtime. In addition, Big Ten programs earned three more non-conference Top 25 wins in the final week before Christmas — Michigan over No. 6/7 North Carolina (76-68) on Dec. 20, plus victories by Ohio State (84-67 over No. 16/15 Oregon) and Nebraska (85-79 in 3OT vs. No. 20/24 Kansas) on Dec. 21.
- Indiana improved to 12-0 with a 67-50 victory over Butler on Dec. 21, extending the program's best-ever start under ninth-year head coach Teri Moren and third-best in school history. The Hoosiers opened 14-0 in 2013-14 and 15-0 in 1971-72.

BIG TEN. BIG NEWS.

- Iowa junior guard Caitlin Clark scored her 2,000th career point in the Hawkeyes' win over Dartmouth on Dec. 21. Clark, who currently has 2,013 points, reached the mark in her 75th career game, tying Delaware's Elena Delle Donne as the fastest women's basketball player to hit the 2,000-point milestone since 1999-2000 (further research is pending). Clark is also the 37th Big Ten Conference player to score 2,000 career points since the Big Ten incorporated women's athletics in 1981-82. Clark's teammate, fifth-year forward/center Monika Czinano, will likely be next to record 2,000 points, currently standing at 1,989 points when the Hawkeyes return to the court Thursday against Purdue (9 p.m. ET on BTN).
- Illinois junior guard Genesis Bryant recorded the third triple-double in school history on Dec. 21 with 22 points, 10 rebounds and 12 assists in the Fighting Illini's 81-46 win over Florida Atlantic at the State Farm Center. Bryant is the first Illinois player with a triple-double since Jan. 23, 2018, when Alex Wittinger did so at Penn State (18 points/10 rebounds/11 blocks). Bryant's triple-double is also the second by a Big Ten player this season and the 45th in conference history since the Big Ten incorporated women's athletics in 1981-82 (Iowa's Caitlin Clark posted her conference-record seventh career triple-double on Dec. 4 at Wisconsin).
- With its Dec. 21 victory over Florida Atlantic, Illinois has a school-record 11 wins before Christmas, one more than the previous mark set in 2006-07. The Fighting Illini have also matched their highest season win total (11) in the past eight years (Illinois finished 11-19 in 2019-20).
- Purdue capped off its best non-conference performance in nearly two decades with a 59-53 victory at Texas A&M on Dec. 21. The Boilermakers' 9-1 non-conference record is their best since a 10-1 mark in 2003-04, while the victory at Texas A&M was Purdue's first road win at an SEC school since Dec. 20, 2005, when they defeated Mississippi State, 61-42, in Starkville, Miss.
- As has been the case every week this season, the Big Ten is tied for No. 1 among all conferences with five teams in the Associated Press Top 25 poll, including two in the top five. For the fourth week in a row, Ohio State is No. 3 (tying the Buckeyes' highest-ever ranking and best since a No. 3 rank on Nov. 30, 2009), followed by Indiana at No. 4 (tying the school record the Hoosiers set last year on Nov. 15 & 23). Iowa is at No. 12, with Michigan up to a season-high No. 13 and Maryland at No. 16. Nebraska is once more receiving votes in the AP poll, the seventh time in eight weeks the Huskers have received votes from the media.
- The Big Ten Conference is also sharing top honors among all conferences with five teams in the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA)/USA Today Top 25 poll, now including a season-high three in the top 10. Indiana remains the highest-ranked Big Ten school in the coaches' poll at No. 3, the fourth consecutive week the Hoosiers have held the highest ranking in either major national poll in program history (they have been fourth in the AP poll for five weeks, including the past four, and rose as high as No. 5 in the coaches' poll last year). Ohio State is also holding steady at No. 4, preserving the Buckeyes' highest ranking in that survey since Jan. 18, 2010, when they were also fourth. Iowa is next in the coaches' poll at No. 10, followed by No. 17 Maryland and No. 19 Michigan, with Illinois and Nebraska receiving votes — for Illinois, it's the first time the Fighting Illini have earned mention in the coaches' poll since Jan. 5, 2010).
- The Big Ten Conference is making a strong case as one of the nation's top conferences this season, between its six top-10 and nine ranked wins in non-conference play, nine schools in the top 40 of the NET rankings and seven teams ranked or receiving votes in one or both major national polls. Now, add in the analytical component — in the latest Massey Ratings, the Big Ten has the nation's No. 1 strength of schedule among all conferences (more than a full rating point clear of the nearest challenger) and the country's top offensive power rating (nearly a full rating point ahead of the second-best conference).
- As of Tuesday, the Big Ten leads all Division I conferences in scoring (77.0 ppg.), field-goal percentage (.454), three-point percentage (.349) and assists (16.9 apg.), while ranking second in steals (9.3 spg.) and free throw percentage/tops among Autonomy Five conferences (.730).
- In recent years, the Big Ten Conference has cultivated a deserved reputation as the home for an exciting brand of up-tempo basketball. This season, nine Big Ten schools rank among the top 50 in the nation in scoring offense (five are averaging more than 80 points per game and rank in the top 20), led by Ohio State (4th - 89.4 ppg.), Iowa (7th - 86.3 ppg.) and Indiana (14th - 82.8 ppg.). In addition, eight Big Ten schools have scored at least 100 points in a game this season.
- The Big Ten features some of the sharpest shooting teams in the country, with six schools among the top 15 (and four of the top 10) in the country in field goal percentage, according to the latest NCAA statistical report. Indiana leads the way (4th - .510), followed by Ohio State (6th - .501), Purdue (8th - .494) and Iowa (10th - .488), with Michigan (11th - .485) and Illinois (13th - .480) also in the top 15 nationally. Illinois has been even more proficient from outside the arc, as the Fighting Illini rank second in the nation in three-point percentage (.422).
- It's called "sharing the sugar", and no conference is sweeter when it comes to the assist game than the Big Ten. Seven conference schools rank among the top 30 in the country in assists, paced by Ohio State (6th - 19.8 apg.), Iowa (7th - 19.7 apg.) and Indiana (9th - 19.2 apg.). Three Big Ten players rank among the top 10 nationally in assists — Purdue's Jeanae Terry (4th - 7.6 apg.), Iowa's Caitlin Clark (6th - 7.1 apg.) and Nebraska's Jaz Shelley (9th - 6.5 apg.).
- Ohio State's production has also carried over to the defensive end of the court, where the Buckeyes lead the nation in turnover margin (+12.08 per game), while ranking third in the country in steals (14.5 spg.) and turnovers forced (25.31 per game). OSU has nabbed double-digit steals in 10 games this year, including a season-high 25 steals on Nov. 20 against McNeese.
- Three of the six largest single-game attendances in NCAA Division I women's basketball this season have taken place on a Big Ten Conference campus. The nation's second-largest crowd this season (13,802) was on hand for Iowa's victory over No. 10/8 Iowa State on Dec. 7 at Carver-Hawkeye Arena. Four days later on Dec. 11, Maryland welcomed 12,566 fans to the XFINITY Center (the program's largest home crowd in nearly six years) to watch the Terrapins defeat No. 6/6 UConn. Most recently on Dec. 18, Iowa drew the country's third-largest crowd this year when 13,394 saw the Hawkeyes defeat Northern Iowa.
- The Big Ten has consistently ranked among the top three conferences in women's basketball attendance for the past three decades and that trend appears to be continuing this season. As of Tuesday, 11 Big Ten programs ranked among the top 50 in the nation (and five in the top 20) in average attendance, with both figures leading all Division I conferences. Among the Big Ten contingent, Iowa is fourth in the nation (9,476 fans per game), followed by Maryland (6th - 7,727), Ohio State (13th - 5,015), Nebraska (16th - 4,805) and Indiana (18th - 4,706).
- Maryland's win over No. 6/6 UConn on Dec. 11 was the Big Ten's first regular-season women's basketball home game televised on ABC and it garnered 470,000 viewers, the fifth-largest audience for a televised women's basketball game on any network this season. There have already been six Big Ten women's basketball games this season that drew more than 200,000 viewers after four Big Ten games reached the 200,000-viewer mark last season. Of note, Iowa's Nov. 27 game vs. UConn at the Phil Knight Legacy in Portland attracted 597,000 viewers on ABC, the second-largest figure in the nation this year. Overall, eight of the nation's 20 highest-viewed women's basketball television broadcasts this season have featured at least one Big Ten program.

Each year more than 11 million patrons attend Big Ten home contests, as the conference has led the nation in attendance for volleyball, men's basketball, ice hockey and wrestling.



Since its inception in 1896, the pursuit and attainment of academic excellence has been a priority for every Big Ten member institution. But maintaining the conference's standard of competing at the highest level in athletics also endures as an important component of the Big Ten experience. Striking that balance between academics and athletics is integral to the Big Ten's identity. Recognized as one of intercollegiate sports' most successful undertakings, the Big Ten strives for success from its students not only on the field and in the classroom, but around the world as well.

PREMIER ACADEMIC INSTITUTIONS

The Big Ten Academic Alliance is an academic consortium of all 14 Big Ten universities, which is widely considered to be the model for effective and voluntary collaboration among top research universities.

Every Big Ten Academic Alliance institution ranks among the top 70 universities in the nation according to the 2022 Academic Ranking of World Universities, including six in the top 30.

The Big Ten leads all conferences with more than 1,900 Academic All-Americans, including 48 honorees during the 2021-22 academic year.

Big Ten Academic Alliance schools annually conduct \$10 billion in funded research, \$5 billion more than any other conference.

A HISTORY OF ATHLETIC SUCCESS

Big Ten schools have won at least five national championships in 24 of the last 28 years, averaging nearly seven per year during that span.

Since the 2005-06 academic year, current Big Ten institutions have claimed 109 team national championships in 26 different sports.

BROAD-BASED PROGRAMMING

The Big Ten will administer more than \$240 million in direct financial support to more than 9,800 students competing in intercollegiate athletics for more than 11,000 participation opportunities on 350 teams in 42 different sports.

The Big Ten sponsors 28 official conference sports, 14 for men and 14 for women, including the addition of men's ice hockey and men's and women's lacrosse in this decade.

The Big Ten leads the nation in total students competing in intercollegiate athletics and participation opportunities, and sponsors more official sports than all conferences except the Ivy League.

More than 1,500 Big Ten competitors have participated in the Olympics, winning more than 500 medals, including more than 200 gold. The Big Ten Conference enjoyed its finest performance at a single Olympic Games during the 2020 Summer Olympics in Tokyo, Japan, as athletes with Big Ten ties set conference records by earning 51 total medals and 22 gold medals during the 17-day competition. All 14 Big Ten member schools had an athlete win at least one medal in Tokyo, also a first in conference history. Big Ten Olympians collected nearly 80 medals in the most recent games in PyeongChang and Beijing.

PASSIONATE FOLLOWING

The Big Ten leads all conferences with 6.4 million alumni and nearly 580,000 students.

Each year more than 11 million patrons attend Big Ten home contests, as the conference has led the nation in attendance for men's basketball, ice hockey, volleyball and wrestling.

LEADERS IN INNOVATION

Took part in the nation's first bowl game, winning the 1902 Rose Bowl Game, and signed an exclusive contract with the Tournament of Roses in 1946, making it the first bowl with permanent conference affiliations.

Awarded the first Big Ten Medal of Honor in 1915, honoring outstanding seniors who demonstrated excellence in academics and athletics.

Formed the Big Ten Advisory Commission in 1972, enlisting former students that competed in conference athletics to serve as liaisons to the NCAA's Diversity and Inclusion Department, the Big Ten Student-Athlete Advisory Commission and other organizations.

Became the first conference to voluntarily adopt male and female participation goals after launching its Gender Equity Action Plan in 1992.

Implemented the first collegiate football system of instant replay in 2004, which the NCAA approved for use among all conferences in 2006.

Launched the Big Ten Network (BTN) in 2007, the first national conference-owned television network.

Began partnering with the Ivy League to study the effects of head injuries in sports in 2012.

Accepted Johns Hopkins University as the conference's first sport affiliate members in men's and women's lacrosse in 2013 and 2015, respectively, and added Notre Dame as a sport affiliate member in men's ice hockey in 2017.

EXTENSIVE TELEVISION EXPOSURE

Through the Big Ten's current media agreements with BTN, ABC/ESPN, CBS and FOX, more than 2,000 Big Ten events are produced and distributed nationally and globally on an annual basis.

BTN is in almost 60 million homes across the United States and Canada, and is also available via the Fox Sports App, delivering live and on-demand programming to computers, smartphones and tablets. B1G+ streams hundreds of additional events each season.

COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

For more than 30 years, through the Big Ten's SCORE (Success Comes Out of Reading Everyday) program, the conference has partnered with Chicago elementary schools to improve reading performance.

Surrounding the Big Ten Football Championship Game and Basketball Tournaments, the conference has held numerous community initiatives, partnered with the College Football Playoff Foundation and other events such as the Big Ten Career Expo, SaturDAY of Service and Youth Football Clinics. In addition, the Big Ten has hosted a downtown 5K, collaborated with a local breast cancer awareness group and provided unique event experiences for military veterans.
