- Another busy week lies ahead for Big Ten Conference women's basketball, with conference games five of the next six days. The Big Ten Network will televise five games in that span, including Tuesday night's matchup featuring No. 17/20 Michigan at Purdue, as well as doubleheaders on Thursday (No. 9/11 Maryland at No. 6/6 Indiana; Rutgers at Minnesota) and Saturday (Penn State at No. 12/9 Iowa; No. 3/3 Ohio State at Nebraska). All Big Ten Network games can also be seen on the FOX Sports app, while this week's remaining conference contests will stream live on B1G+ (visit bigtenplus.com for details).
- Along with this week's television schedule, eight Big Ten women's basketball games will be broadcast globally on SiriusXM Radio, including both of the aforementioned Thursday night contests, as well as three games on Saturday (the two noted above, as well as the first of two meetings this year between Michigan State and No. 17/20 Michigan).
- For the first time in 8,072 days (more than 22 years), Illinois earned a place in the national polls this week, as the Fighting Illini were ranked No. 24 in both the Associated Press and Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA)/USA Today Top 25 polls. Illinois, which was last ranked on Nov. 27-28, 2000 (also 24th in both surveys), is the seventh different Big Ten Conference program to be ranked in the Top 25 this season, while the Big Ten currently leads all conferences with six Top 25 programs in both polls, as well as a season-high four schools ranked in the top 10 in one or both polls.
- Following Sunday's 87-81 win over Illinois, No. 3/3 Ohio State continues to extend the best start in school history, now at 17-0 and one of three remaining unbeaten teams in the country (along with South Carolina and LSU). This year's record eclipses the Buckeyes' previous best start in 2011-12 (15-0), while the 6-0 record to begin Big Ten play is OSU's best since 2009-10, when it won its first seven conference games.
- Two Big Ten programs captured their first conference wins of the 2022-23 season on the home hardwood over the weekend, with Rutgers downing Nebraska, 57-45 on Saturday (on Theresa Grentz Day at Jersey Mike's Arena) and Wisconsin edging Minnesota, 81-77 on Sunday at the Kohl Center.
- Michigan State tied the Big Ten Conference record for conference games by making 19 three-point field goals in its 94-85 loss at No. 13/14 Maryland on Saturday. The Spartans matched the marks first reached by Iowa at Northwestern on Jan. 29, 2015, and equaled by Minnesota at Illinois on Jan. 7, 2016 (the overall Big Ten record is 21 made three-pointers by Maryland vs. Towson on Dec. 3, 2020). In addition, MSU set a Big Ten record with its 44 three-point attempts, surpassing the previous mark of 42 attempts by Minnesota against NJIT on Dec. 28, 2015.
- No. 14/19 Michigan welcomed the fourth-largest crowd in program history (10,731) to Crisler Center for its nationally televised matchup Jan. 7 against No. 16/12 Iowa on FOX. It was the fifth time this season a Big Ten Conference program drew a crowd of at least 10,000 fans, with three different schools reaching that total (Iowa, Maryland and Michigan) so far in 2022-23.
- Big Ten Conference women's basketball is reaching new heights in its television exposure this season. Of the 26 highest-rated women's basketball games in 2022-23, 11 of them (42.3 percent) have involved a Big Ten program, including two of the top five and five of the top 13. The Nov. 27 Iowa-UConn game at the Phil Knight Legacy in Portland drew 597,000 viewers on ABC (second in the nation), while the Dec. 11 Maryland-UConn game on ABC (the first-ever Big Ten regular season home game on ABC) had 470,000 viewers, fifth in the country. These figures do not yet include the Jan. 7 Iowa-Michigan on FOX, the first-ever Big Ten women's basketball game televised on the FOX broadcast network.
- There have already been eight Big Ten Conference women's basketball games this season that have attracted more than 200,000 viewers after four Big Ten games reached the 200,000-viewer mark last season. In addition, the Nov. 8 Ohio State-Tennessee game on Big Ten Network drew 100,000 viewers, the second-largest audience for a regular season women's basketball game in BTN history.
- In another example of the depth and strength of the Big Ten Conference this season, Illinois' win over No. 12/10 Iowa on New Year's Day represented the third time this season an unranked Big Ten school defeated a

Top 25 conference program. The others were Nebraska's win at No. 20/21 Maryland on Dec. 4, and Michigan State defeating No. 4/3 Indiana on Dec. 29.

- The Big Ten leads all conferences with six players on the Wooden Award Midseason Top 25 List unveiled Jan. 4. The Iowa tandem of Caitlin Clark and Monika Czinano is joined by Indiana's Mackenzie Holmes, Maryland's Diamond Miller, Michigan's Emily Kiser and Ohio State's Taylor Mikesell. Kiser was one of four players nationwide to be a midseason addition to the Wooden Award Top 25 list, which contains the strongest contenders for this year's honor. The Wooden Award National Ballot (top 15) will be announced prior to the NCAA Tournament in March, with the 2023 recipient named following the NCAA Women's Final Four in early April.
- The Big Ten leads all Division I conferences with a remarkable 10 schools among the top 60 in the latest NET rankings, including two in the top 10 and four in the top 20 — No. 5 Indiana, No. 9 Ohio State, No. 14 Iowa, No. 20 Michigan, No. 27 Maryland, No. 29 Illinois, No. 32 Michigan State, No. 43 Purdue, No. 44 Nebraska and No. 58 Penn State. The NCAA Evaluation Tool (NET) is the primary sorting tool used by the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Committee for determining NCAA Tournament teams.
- The Big Ten Conference has tied its season high and leads all conferences with six schools in this week's Associated Press Top 25 poll, including three in the top 10. For the sixth week in a row, Ohio State is No. 3 (tying the Buckeyes' highest-ever ranking and best since a No. 3 rank on Nov. 30, 2009), followed by Indiana at No. 6. Maryland has risen to a season-high No. 9 (the fourth Big Ten team to appear in the top 10 this year), with Iowa next at No. 12, Michigan at No. 17 and Illinois at No. 24. The Illinois ranking is particularly noteworthy, as it's the first time the Fighting Illini have appeared in the AP Top 25 poll since they were also 24th on Nov. 27, 2000 (a span of 8,072 days).
- The Big Ten also remains tops among all conferences with a season high-tying six teams in the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA)/USA Today Top 25 poll, including three in the top 10. Ohio State remains No. 3 this week, matching the Buckeyes' highest ranking in the coaches' poll since Nov. 30, 2009, when they were also third. Indiana is up to No. 6 this week, followed by No. 9 Iowa, No. 11 Maryland, No. 20 Michigan and No. 24 Illinois. For the Fighting Illini, it's their first appearance in the WBCA/USA Today Top 25 poll since Nov. 28, 2000 (also No. 24).
- The Big Ten is making a strong case as one of the nation's top conferences this season, between its seven top-10 and 12 ranked wins in non-conference play, 10 schools in the top 60 of the NET rankings and a nation-best six teams ranked in both major national polls. Now, add in the analytical component — in the latest Massey Ratings, the Big Ten has the nation's No. 1 strength of schedule among all conferences (nearly a half rating point clear of the nearest challenger) and the country's top offensive power rating (more than one full rating point ahead of the second-best conference).
- During non-conference play this season, the Big Ten Conference posted seven top-10 wins and 12 victories over ranked non-conference opponents, both leading all Division I conferences. The seven non-conference top-10 wins (which included three away from home) were the most by the Big Ten in the past 20 years, more than doubling the three top-10 victories in both 2004-05 and 2008-09. The 12 Top 25 wins (seven of which came on the road or at neutral sites) tied for the most for the Big Ten in the regular season during the past two decades, matching the total from the 2004-05 season.
- The Big Ten currently leads all Division I conferences in scoring (76.0 ppg.), field-goal percentage (.450), three-point percentage (.346), assists (16.7 apg.) and steals (9.2 spg.), while ranking third in free throw percentage/tops among Autonomy Five conferences (.729).
- In recent years, the Big Ten Conference has cultivated a deserved reputation as the home for an exciting brand of up-tempo basketball. This season, 10 Big Ten schools rank among the top 50 in the nation in scoring offense (five are averaging more than 80 points per game and rank in the top 25), led by Ohio State (5th - 87.0 ppg.) and Iowa (7th - 86.6 ppg.). In addition, nine Big Ten schools have scored at least 100 points in a game this season.
- The Big Ten features some of the sharpest shooting teams in the country, with six schools among the top 15 (and three of the top 10) in the country in field goal percentage, according to the latest NCAA statistical report. Indiana leads the way (2nd - .496), followed by Iowa (5th - .492) and Ohio State (9th - .485), with Michigan (12th - .481), Illinois (13th - .476) and Purdue (15th - .474) also in the top 15 nationally. Individually, the Big Ten also has two of the nation's top three (and three of the top 15) shooters this season in Indiana's Mackenzie Holmes (2nd - .684), Ohio State's Taylor Thierry (3rd - .667) and Iowa's Monika Czinano (12th - .626).
- Illinois has been even more proficient from outside the arc this season, as the Fighting Illini rank No. 2 in the nation in three-point percentage (.413), one of four Big Ten teams in the top 20 nationally in that category, along with Maryland (13th - .375), Iowa (15th - .372) and Penn State (17th - .370). The Big Ten also is the only conference in the country with four players ranked in the top 25 in three-point percentage — Illinois' Genesis Bryant (2nd - .494), Indiana's Yarden Garzon (15th - .465), Penn State's Makenna Marisa (22nd - .451) and Iowa's Makenna Warnock (25th - .449).
- It's called "sharing the sugar", and no conference is sweeter in the assist game than the Big Ten. Nine conference schools rank among the top 35 in the country in assists (five in the top 20), paced by Iowa (6th - 19.2 apg.), Ohio State (7th - 18.9 apg.) and Michigan State (8th - 18.7 apg.). Four Big Ten players rank among the top 15 nationally in assists — Purdue's Jeanae Terry (6th - 7.2 apg.), Iowa's Caitlin Clark (9th - 6.7 apg.), Nebraska's Jaz Shelley (11th - 6.4 apg.) and Michigan's Leigha Brown (15th - 5.9 apg.).
- Ohio State's production has also carried over to the defensive end of the court, where the Buckeyes lead the nation in turnover margin (+10.35 per game), while ranking fourth in the country in steals (13.8 spg.) and fifth in turnovers forced (23.94 per game). OSU has nabbed double-digit steals in 12 games this year, including a season-high 25 steals on Nov. 20 against McNeese.
- Five of the 17 largest single-game attendances in the country this year have taken place on a Big Ten Conference campus, all topping 10,000 fans. The nation's second-largest crowd this season (13,802) was on hand for Iowa's victory over No. 10/8 Iowa State on Dec. 7 at Carver-Hawkeye Arena. Four days later on Dec. 11, Maryland welcomed 12,566 fans to the XFINITY Center (the program's largest home crowd in nearly six years and seventh-largest in the country this year) to watch the Terrapins defeat No. 6/6 UConn. On Dec. 18, Iowa drew the country's third-largest crowd this year when 13,394 saw the Hawkeyes defeat Northern Iowa. On Dec. 29, Iowa drew 11,942 fans (11th in the nation) for its win over Purdue. Most recently on Jan. 7, Michigan attracted 10,731 fans (No. 17 nationally) for its matchup with No. 16/12 Iowa.
- The Big Ten has consistently ranked among the top three conferences in women's basketball attendance for the past three decades and that trend appears to be continuing this season. As of Tuesday, 11 Big Ten programs ranked among the top 45 in the nation (and five in the top 15) in average attendance, with both figures leading all Division I conferences. Among the Big Ten contingent, Iowa is No. 2 in the nation (9,750 fans per game), followed by Maryland (8th - 7,305), Nebraska (11th - 5,223), Ohio State (13th - 5,046) and Indiana (15th - 4,978).

Since its inception in 1896, the pursuit and attainment of academic excellence has been a priority for every Big Ten member institution. But maintaining the conference's standard of competing at the highest level in athletics also endures as an important component of the Big Ten experience. Striking that balance between academics and athletics is integral to the Big Ten's identity. Recognized as one of intercollegiate sports' most successful undertakings, the Big Ten strives for success from its students not only on the field and in the classroom, but around the world as well.

PREMIER ACADEMIC INSTITUTIONS

The Big Ten Academic Alliance is an academic consortium of all 14 Big Ten universities, which is widely considered to be the model for effective and voluntary collaboration among top research universities.

Every Big Ten Academic Alliance institution ranks among the top 70 universities in the nation according to the 2022 Academic Ranking of World Universities, including six in the top 30.

The Big Ten leads all conferences with more than 1,900 Academic All-Americans, including 48 honorees during the 2021-22 academic year.

Big Ten Academic Alliance schools annually conduct \$10 billion in funded research, \$5 billion more than any other conference.

A HISTORY OF ATHLETIC SUCCESS

Big Ten schools have won at least five national championships in 24 of the last 28 years, averaging nearly seven per year during that span.

Since the 2005-06 academic year, current Big Ten institutions have claimed 109 team national championships in 26 different sports.

BROAD-BASED PROGRAMMING

The Big Ten will administer more than \$240 million in direct financial support to more than 9,800 students competing in intercollegiate athletics for more than 11,000 participation opportunities on 350 teams in 42 different sports.

The Big Ten sponsors 28 official conference sports, 14 for men and 14 for women, including the addition of men's ice hockey and men's and women's lacrosse in this decade.

The Big Ten leads the nation in total students competing in intercollegiate athletics and participation opportunities, and sponsors more official sports than all conferences except the Ivy League.

More than 1,500 Big Ten competitors have participated in the Olympics, winning more than 500 medals, including more than 200 gold. The Big Ten Conference enjoyed its finest performance at a single Olympic Games during the 2020 Summer Olympics in Tokyo, Japan, as athletes with Big Ten ties set conference records by earning 51 total medals and 22 gold medals during the 17-day competition. All 14 Big Ten member schools had an athlete win at least one medal in Tokyo, also a first in conference history. Big Ten Olympians collected nearly 80 medals in the most recent games in PyeongChang and Beijing.

PASSIONATE FOLLOWING

The Big Ten leads all conferences with 6.4 million alumni and nearly 580,000 students.

Each year more than 11 million patrons attend Big Ten home contests, as the conference has led the nation in attendance for men's basketball, ice hockey, volleyball and wrestling.

LEADERS IN INNOVATION

Took part in the nation's first bowl game, winning the 1902 Rose Bowl Game, and signed an exclusive contract with the Tournament of Roses in 1946, making it the first bowl with permanent conference affiliations.

Awarded the first Big Ten Medal of Honor in 1915, honoring outstanding seniors who demonstrated excellence in academics and athletics.

Formed the Big Ten Advisory Commission in 1972, enlisting former students that competed in conference athletics to serve as liaisons to the NCAA's Diversity and Inclusion Department, the Big Ten Student-Athlete Advisory Commission and other organizations.

Became the first conference to voluntarily adopt male and female participation goals after launching its Gender Equity Action Plan in 1992.

Implemented the first collegiate football system of instant replay in 2004, which the NCAA approved for use among all conferences in 2006.

Launched the Big Ten Network (BTN) in 2007, the first national conference-owned television network.

Began partnering with the Ivy League to study the effects of head injuries in sports in 2012.

Accepted Johns Hopkins University as the conference's first sport affiliate members in men's and women's lacrosse in 2013 and 2015, respectively, and added Notre Dame as a sport affiliate member in men's ice hockey in 2017.

EXTENSIVE TELEVISION EXPOSURE

Through the Big Ten's current media agreements with BTN, ABC/ESPN, CBS and FOX, more than 2,000 Big Ten events are produced and distributed nationally and globally on an annual basis.

BTN is in almost 60 million homes across the United States and Canada, and is also available via the Fox Sports App, delivering live and on-demand programming to computers, smartphones and tablets. B1G+ streams hundreds of additional events each season.

COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

For more than 30 years, through the Big Ten's SCORE (Success Comes Out of Reading Everyday) program, the conference has partnered with Chicago elementary schools to improve reading performance.

Surrounding the Big Ten Football Championship Game and Basketball Tournaments, the conference has held numerous community initiatives, partnered with the College Football Playoff Foundation and other events such as the Big Ten Career Expo, SaturDAY of Service and Youth Football Clinics. In addition, the Big Ten has hosted a downtown 5K, collaborated with a local breast cancer awareness group and provided unique event experiences for military veterans.
