BIG TEN. BIG NEWS.

- The second half of the 2022-23 Big Ten Conference season gets underway this week, with three teams currently tied atop the standings and six schools separated by only two games. Highlighting this week's schedule is a Big Ten Network doubleheader on Thursday night with two top-15 matchups as No. 13/17 Michigan travels to No. 10/11 Maryland (6:30 p.m. ET), followed by No. 2/5 Ohio State at No. 6/6 Indiana (8:30 p.m. ET). In addition, the Big Ten will be featured on the FOX broadcast network for the second time this month, as No. 10/8 Iowa plays host to Nebraska Saturday at 1 p.m. (ET) at Carver-Hawkeye Arena.
- Eight of the 11 Big Ten Conference games to be played through Sunday afternoon will be broadcast live to a global audience on SiriusXM Radio, with the majority of those games airing on the Big Ten Radio alternate channels 195 and/or 196, as well as the SXM app. Sunday's game matching up Michigan State and No. 22/22 Illinois in Champaign is slated for broadcast on SiriusXM's ESPNU Radio Channel 84.
- Iowa tied for its highest-ever ranked win (and posted the highest-ranked road win in program history) on Monday with its 83-72 victory at No. 2/2 (and previously unbeaten) Ohio State. It was the Hawkeyes' third win all-time against a No. 2 team and first since March 4, 1994 (under then-head coach C. Vivian Stringer), when they defeated second-ranked Penn State, 78-68 in Iowa City. The only other time Iowa earned a top-two win was March 27, 1993, in Iowa City, when the Hawkeyes defeated No. 2 Tennessee, 72-56, at Carver-Hawkeye Arena, to clinch the program's first-ever NCAA Final Four appearance.
- Indiana etched its name in the program record books on Monday, securing its best-ever start (18-1) following a 92-83 win at No. 13/16 Michigan. The Hoosiers surpassed the 1971-72 Indiana squad that finished 17-2 during its inaugural season. With Monday's victory, Indiana is also 5-0 against Top 25 opponents this season and is one of six Big Ten Conference programs with multiple wins over ranked teams this year.
- Iowa junior guard Caitlin Clark added to her Big Ten Conference record with her eighth career triple-double, third-most in NCAA history, on Monday night in the Hawkeyes' win at No. 2/2 Ohio State. Clark, who joined Marquette men's basketball All-American Dwyane Wade as the only NCAA Division I players since 1999-2000 with a triple-double against an AP top-2 opponent (Wade did it vs. No. 1 Kentucky in the 2003 NCAA Tournament), finished with 28 points, 10 rebounds and a season-high 15 assists, the latter total tying for the third-most assists ever in a conference game. Of Clark's eight career triple-doubles, four have featured 25-point outings, the most in NCAA Division I history, while her current stretch of four consecutive 20-point/10-assist games is the most by a Division I player in the past 20 seasons.
- The Big Ten Conference made history on Monday as, for the first time in the 47-year history of the Associated Press poll, there are four conference teams in the top 10 of this week's AP poll — No. 2 Ohio State, No. 6 Indiana, and both Iowa and Maryland at No. 10. Along with Michigan, which rose to a season-high No. 13 this week, and Illinois at No. 22, the Big Ten leads all Division I conferences with six teams in the AP Top 25 this week.
- Ohio State fifth-year guard Taylor Mikesell needs two points to reach 2,000 for her career, heading into the Buckeyes' matchup at No. 6/6 Indiana on Thursday night (8:30 p.m. ET on the Big Ten Network). She would be the 39th Big Ten Conference player to score 2,000 career points since the Big Ten incorporated women's athletics in 1981-82, and the third Big Ten player to do so this season. Iowa junior guard Caitlin Clark scored her 2,000th point on Dec. 21 at home against Dartmouth, and Clark's teammate, fifth-year forward/center Monika Czinano, did likewise on Dec. 29 against Purdue, also at Carver-Hawkeye Arena.
- Illinois clinched its first winning season in a decade on Sunday afternoon with a 67-64 victory at Northwestern. The Fighting Illini are 16-4 this year (6-3 in Big Ten play), their highest win total since that 2012-13 campaign (19-14 record), while Illinois' six conference wins are the most for the program in one season since 2014-15, when they finished 6-12 (the Fighting Illini last had a winning conference record in '12-13, going 9-7).

BIG TEN. BIG NEWS.

- Tickets are now on sale for the 2023 Big Ten Conference Women's Basketball Tournament presented by TIAA, which will be played March 1-5 at the Target Center in Minneapolis. For more information, visit the official tournament web site at bigten.org/WBBT.
- Three of the top 10 (and eight of the top 30) largest single-game attendances in the country this year have taken place on a Big Ten Conference campus, all topping 10,000 fans. The Big Ten is No. 2 nationally with its three top-10 crowds and eight top-30 audiences, which includes four Iowa games (led by a season-high 13,802 fans on Dec. 7 for the Hawkeyes' win over in-state rival Iowa State), Maryland's win over UConn on Dec. 11 (12,566), Michigan's first-ever back-to-back games with 10,000 fans (10,731 vs. Iowa on Jan. 7; 10,534 for a win over in-state rival Michigan State on Jan. 14) and Indiana's regular-season school record of 10,422 on Jan. 15 against Wisconsin.
- The Big Ten has consistently ranked among the top three conferences in women's basketball attendance for the past three decades and that trend appears to be continuing this season. As of Monday, 11 Big Ten programs ranked among the top 40 in the nation (and five in the top 15, all averaging more than 5,000 fans per game) in average attendance, leading all Division I conferences by every attendance measure. Among the Big Ten contingent, Iowa is No. 2 in the nation (9,870), followed by Maryland (9th - 7,216), Indiana (11th - 5,547), Nebraska (12th - 5,264) and Ohio State (14th - 5,012).
- Big Ten Conference women's basketball is reaching new heights in its television exposure this season. Of the 25 highest-rated games in 2022-23, 11 of them (44 percent) have involved a Big Ten program, including three of the top six and six of the top 15. The Nov. 27 Iowa-UConn game at the Phil Knight Legacy in Portland drew 597,000 viewers on ABC (second in the nation), the Jan. 7 Iowa-Michigan game (the first-ever Big Ten women's basketball game on the FOX broadcast network) brought in 564,000 viewers, good for fourth in the country, while the Dec. 11 Maryland-UConn game on ABC (the first-ever Big Ten regular season home game on ABC) had 470,000 viewers, sixth-highest in the nation. The above totals also do not yet include ratings from Monday night's top-15 nationally televised matchups featuring Iowa at Ohio State (ESPN2) and Indiana at Michigan (BTN).
- There have been nine Big Ten women's basketball games this season that have attracted more than 200,000 viewers after four Big Ten games reached the 200,000-viewer mark last season. In addition, the Nov. 8 Ohio State-Tennessee game on Big Ten Network drew 100,000 viewers, the second-largest audience for a regular season women's basketball game in BTN history.
- The Big Ten leads all Division I conferences with a remarkable nine schools among the top 50 in the latest NET rankings, including three in the top 10 and five in the top 25 — No. 5 Indiana, No. 9 Iowa, No. 10 Ohio State, No. 16 Michigan, No. 23 Maryland, No. 31 Illinois, No. 41 Michigan State, No. 43 Nebraska and No. 46 Purdue. The NCAA Evaluation Tool (NET) is the primary sorting tool used by the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Committee for determining NCAA Tournament teams.
- Fueled by its historic four top-10 teams this week, the Big Ten Conference remains the standard bearer among all conferences with six schools in the Associated Press Top 25 poll for the fifth week this season. Ohio State holds steady at No. 2 (tying the Buckeyes' highest-ever ranking and best since the final 2005-06 poll on March 13, 2006), followed by Indiana at No. 6. Iowa is next at No. 10, returning to the top 10 for the sixth week this season, joined by Maryland in a tie for 10th. Michigan is up one place to a season-best No. 13, while Illinois continues to maintain its first extended stay in the AP poll since 2000, checking in at No. 22 this week.
- The Big Ten is also No. 1 among all conferences with a season-high six teams in the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA)/USA Today Top 25 poll, including three in the top 10. Ohio State is No. 5 following Monday's loss to Iowa, while Indiana is next at No. 6 and Iowa rises to No. 8. Maryland is knocking on the door at No. 11 for the third consecutive week, Michigan checks in at No. 17, while Illinois moves to No. 22.
- The Big Ten is making a strong case as one of the nation's top conferences this season, between its seven top-10 and 12 ranked wins in non-conference play, nine schools in the top 50 of the NET rankings and a nation-best six teams ranked in both major national polls. Now, add in the analytical component — in the latest Massey Ratings, the Big Ten has the nation's No. 1 strength of schedule among all conferences and the country's top offensive power rating.
- During non-conference play this season, the Big Ten Conference posted seven top-10 wins and 12 victories over ranked non-conference opponents, both leading all Division I conferences. The seven non-conference top-10 wins (which included three away from home) were the most by the Big Ten in the past 20 years, more than doubling the three top-10 victories in both 2004-05 and 2008-09. The 12 Top 25 wins (seven of which came on the road or at neutral sites) tied for the most for the Big Ten in the regular season during the past two decades, matching the total from the 2004-05 season.
- The Big Ten currently leads all Division I conferences in scoring (75.0 ppg.), field-goal percentage (.445), three-point percentage (.342), assists (16.5 apg.) and steals (9.0 spg.), while ranking fourth in free throw percentage/tops among Autonomy Five conferences (.731).
- In recent years, the Big Ten Conference has cultivated a deserved reputation as the home for an exciting brand of up-tempo basketball. This season, seven Big Ten schools rank among the top 30 in the nation in scoring offense (four are averaging more than 80 points per game and five rank in the top 20), led by Iowa (2nd - 87.6 ppg.) and Ohio State (6th - 85.6 ppg.). In addition, nine Big Ten schools have scored at least 100 points in a game this season.
- The Big Ten features some of the sharpest shooting teams in the country, with six schools among the top 25 (and four of the top 10) in the country in field goal percentage, according to the latest NCAA statistical report. Indiana leads the way (2nd - .503), followed by Iowa (3rd - .499), Michigan (9th - .481) and Ohio State (10th - .479), with Illinois (14th - .470) and Purdue (22nd - .463) also in the top 25 nationally. Individually, the Big Ten also has three of the nation's top six (and four of the top 25) shooters this season in Indiana's Mackenzie Holmes (2nd - .673), Iowa's Monika Czinano (3rd - .662), Ohio State's Taylor Thierry (6th - .646) and Michigan's Emily Kiser (25th - .573).
- Illinois has been even more proficient from outside the arc this season, as the Fighting Illini rank No. 4 in the nation in three-point percentage (.403), one of three Big Ten teams in the top 25 nationally in that category, along with Maryland (15th - .371) and Iowa (21st - .366). The Big Ten also has three players ranked in the top 10 nationally in three-point percentage — Indiana's Yarden Garzon (2nd - .500), Illinois' Genesis Bryant (7th - .475) and Maryland's Brinae Alexander (9th - .471).
- It's called "sharing the sugar", and no conference is sweeter in the assist game than the Big Ten. Eight conference schools rank among the top 35 in the country in assists (four in the top 10), paced by Iowa (4th - 20.4 apg.), Indiana (7th - 18.5 apg.), Ohio State (9th - 18.4 apg.) and Michigan State (10th - 18.2 apg.). Four Big Ten players rank among the top 15 nationally in assists — Iowa's Caitlin Clark (2nd - 7.8 apg.), Purdue's Jeanae Terry (8th - 7.0 apg.), Nebraska's Jaz Shelley (11th - 6.2 apg.) and Michigan's Leigha Brown (15th - 5.8 apg.).

Since its inception in 1896, the pursuit and attainment of academic excellence has been a priority for every Big Ten member institution. But maintaining the conference's standard of competing at the highest level in athletics also endures as an important component of the Big Ten experience. Striking that balance between academics and athletics is integral to the Big Ten's identity. Recognized as one of intercollegiate sports' most successful undertakings, the Big Ten strives for success from its students not only on the field and in the classroom, but around the world as well.

PREMIER ACADEMIC INSTITUTIONS

The Big Ten Academic Alliance is an academic consortium of all 14 Big Ten universities, which is widely considered to be the model for effective and voluntary collaboration among top research universities.

Every Big Ten Academic Alliance institution ranks among the top 70 universities in the nation according to the 2022 Academic Ranking of World Universities, including six in the top 30.

The Big Ten leads all conferences with more than 1,900 Academic All-Americans, including 48 honorees during the 2021-22 academic year.

Big Ten Academic Alliance schools annually conduct \$10 billion in funded research, \$5 billion more than any other conference.

A HISTORY OF ATHLETIC SUCCESS

Big Ten schools have won at least five national championships in 24 of the last 28 years, averaging nearly seven per year during that span.

Since the 2005-06 academic year, current Big Ten institutions have claimed 109 team national championships in 26 different sports.

BROAD-BASED PROGRAMMING

The Big Ten will administer more than \$240 million in direct financial support to more than 9,800 students competing in intercollegiate athletics for more than 11,000 participation opportunities on 350 teams in 42 different sports.

The Big Ten sponsors 28 official conference sports, 14 for men and 14 for women, including the addition of men's ice hockey and men's and women's lacrosse in this decade.

The Big Ten leads the nation in total students competing in intercollegiate athletics and participation opportunities, and sponsors more official sports than all conferences except the Ivy League.

More than 1,500 Big Ten competitors have participated in the Olympics, winning more than 500 medals, including more than 200 gold. The Big Ten Conference enjoyed its finest performance at a single Olympic Games during the 2020 Summer Olympics in Tokyo, Japan, as athletes with Big Ten ties set conference records by earning 51 total medals and 22 gold medals during the 17-day competition. All 14 Big Ten member schools had an athlete win at least one medal in Tokyo, also a first in conference history. Big Ten Olympians collected nearly 80 medals in the most recent games in PyeongChang and Beijing.

PASSIONATE FOLLOWING

The Big Ten leads all conferences with 6.4 million alumni and nearly 580,000 students.

Each year more than 11 million patrons attend Big Ten home contests, as the conference has led the nation in attendance for men's basketball, ice hockey, volleyball and wrestling.

LEADERS IN INNOVATION

Took part in the nation's first bowl game, winning the 1902 Rose Bowl Game, and signed an exclusive contract with the Tournament of Roses in 1946, making it the first bowl with permanent conference affiliations.

Awarded the first Big Ten Medal of Honor in 1915, honoring outstanding seniors who demonstrated excellence in academics and athletics.

Formed the Big Ten Advisory Commission in 1972, enlisting former students that competed in conference athletics to serve as liaisons to the NCAA's Diversity and Inclusion Department, the Big Ten Student-Athlete Advisory Commission and other organizations.

Became the first conference to voluntarily adopt male and female participation goals after launching its Gender Equity Action Plan in 1992.

Implemented the first collegiate football system of instant replay in 2004, which the NCAA approved for use among all conferences in 2006.

Launched the Big Ten Network (BTN) in 2007, the first national conference-owned television network.

Began partnering with the Ivy League to study the effects of head injuries in sports in 2012.

Accepted Johns Hopkins University as the conference's first sport affiliate members in men's and women's lacrosse in 2013 and 2015, respectively, and added Notre Dame as a sport affiliate member in men's ice hockey in 2017.

EXTENSIVE TELEVISION EXPOSURE

Through the Big Ten's current media agreements with BTN, ABC/ESPN, CBS and FOX, more than 2,000 Big Ten events are produced and distributed nationally and globally on an annual basis.

BTN is in almost 60 million homes across the United States and Canada, and is also available via the Fox Sports App, delivering live and on-demand programming to computers, smartphones and tablets. B1G+ streams hundreds of additional events each season.

COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

For more than 30 years, through the Big Ten's SCORE (Success Comes Out of Reading Everyday) program, the conference has partnered with Chicago elementary schools to improve reading performance.

Surrounding the Big Ten Football Championship Game and Basketball Tournaments, the conference has held numerous community initiatives, partnered with the College Football Playoff Foundation and other events such as the Big Ten Career Expo, SaturDAY of Service and Youth Football Clinics. In addition, the Big Ten has hosted a downtown 5K, collaborated with a local breast cancer awareness group and provided unique event experiences for military veterans.
