BIG TEN. BIG NEWS.

- The final month of the 2022-23 Big Ten Conference regular season gets underway this week, highlighted by three games between Top 25 conference programs and two top-10 matchups. More than half of the 13 Big Ten games through next Monday (Feb. 6) will be televised nationally, including three games each on Thursday and Sunday. Four of those games will be televised on the Big Ten Network and the FOX Sports app, with Sunday's Indiana-Purdue game airing on FS1, and two other games slated for either ESPN (Thursday's Maryland-Iowa game) or ESPN2 (Sunday's Ohio State-Maryland game).
- Along with its robust television coverage, the Big Ten Conference will have nine of its next 12 games broadcast worldwide on SiriusXM Radio and the SXM app. Among the highlights on the Big Ten's SiriusXM schedule this week are Thursday's Illinois-Michigan game (which can be heard on both Channels 195 and 196), Sunday's Indiana-Purdue matchup (scheduled for FOX Sports Radio Channel 83) and Sunday's Ohio State-Maryland contest (slated for ESPN Radio Channel 84).
- The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame has begun to announce the top 10 candidates for its five national position awards. Iowa's Caitlin Clark is among the top 10 for the Nancy Lieberman Award, which goes to the country's top point guard, an honor Clark earned last year. Maryland's Diamond Miller and Ohio State's Taylor Mikesell are part of the top 10 list for the Ann Meyers Drysdale Award, which is presented annually to the nation's top shooting guard. The top 10 candidates for the remaining three awards will be announced later this week.
- The Big Ten Conference had four players named to the John R. Wooden Award Late Season Top 20 List that was released late Monday. Indiana's Mackenzie Holmes, the Iowa duo of Caitlin Clark and Monika Czinano, and Maryland's Diamond Miller represent the Big Ten on the rundown of the leading contenders for the national player of the year award.
- Purdue captured a historic 73-65 win at No. 2/5 Ohio State on Jan. 29, posting the first top-five road victory in program history. The Boilermakers also had previously recorded two wins against top-two opponents, both of which came against No. 1 teams at Mackey Arena — Feb. 11, 1994 (57-54 vs. Penn State) and Nov. 15, 1998 (78-68 vs. Tennessee).
- Purdue's victory provided yet another example of the depth and strength of the Big Ten Conference this season. The Boilermakers are the fourth unranked Big Ten school to defeat a Top 25 conference program this season (and three of those came against top-10 opponents). Along with Purdue's win, the other unranked victors have been Nebraska (Dec. 4 at No. 20/21 Maryland), Michigan State (Dec. 29 vs. No. 4/3 Indiana) and Illinois (Jan. 1 vs. No. 12/10 Iowa).
- Indiana became the first Big Ten Conference program to pick up its 20th win this season, as the Hoosiers downed Rutgers, 91-68 on Jan. 29 at Simon Skjodt Assembly Hall. The Hoosiers posted their eighth 20-win season in the nine-year Teri Moren era on the back of a .627 field-goal percentage that was the fifth-best in program history and best since Dec. 5, 2016 (.640 vs. North Texas).
- Illinois snapped a 10-game series losing streak against Michigan State with an 86-76 victory on Jan. 29 at the State Farm Center. It was the first Fighting Illini win over the Spartans since Jan. 23, 2014 (61-51 in East Lansing, Mich.) and the first for Illinois over MSU in Champaign since Feb. 22, 2007 (56-46).
- With its victory over Michigan State, Illinois improved to 7-4 in Big Ten play. It's the most conference wins in a season for the Fighting Illini since 2012-13, when they finished 9-7 in the Big Ten (the program's most recent winning conference season).
- The Big Ten leads all Division I conferences with a remarkable nine schools among the top 50 in the latest NET rankings, including five in the top 20 — No. 5 Indiana, No. 9 Iowa, No. 13 Ohio State, No. 17 Michigan, No. 20 Maryland, No. 34 Illinois, No. 37 Purdue, No. 41 Nebraska and No. 43 Michigan State. The NCAA Evaluation Tool (NET) is the primary sorting tool used by the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Committee for determining NCAA Tournament teams.

BIG TEN. BIG NEWS.

- For the past two weeks, the Big Ten Conference has made history as, for the first time in the 47-year history of the Associated Press poll, there are four conference teams in the top 10 of the AP poll. This week, Indiana leads the Big Ten group at No. 4 (matching the highest AP ranking in program history), followed by No. 6 Iowa, No. 8 Maryland, No. 10 Ohio State and No. 18 Michigan, with Illinois and Purdue receiving votes.
- The Big Ten remains No. 1 among all conferences with a season-high six teams in the latest Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA)/USA Today Top 25 poll, including four in the top 10. Indiana is No. 5 this week, followed by No. 6 Iowa, No. 8 Maryland and No. 10 Ohio State. Michigan is next at No. 19, Illinois is at No. 24, and Purdue is receiving votes in the coaches' poll for the first time this year.
- Six of the top 20 (and 10 of the top 35) largest single-game attendances in the country this year have taken place on a Big Ten Conference campus, all topping 10,000 fans. The Big Ten is No. 2 nationally with its six top-20 crowds and 10 top-35 audiences, which includes five Iowa games (led by a season-high 13,843 fans on Jan. 28 for the Hawkeyes' win over Nebraska), Maryland's win over UConn on Dec. 11 (12,566), Michigan's first-ever back-to-back games with 10,000 fans (10,731 vs. Iowa on Jan. 7; 10,534 for a win over in-state rival Michigan State on Jan. 14) and a pair of Indiana victories (a regular-season school record of 10,455 on Jan. 26 vs. Ohio State; 10,422 on Jan. 15 against Wisconsin).
- No fewer than 11 of the 14 Big Ten programs have drawn at least one crowd of 5,000 fans or more this season, including four (Indiana, Iowa, Maryland and Michigan) that have posted at least one audience of 10,000 fans. Ohio State almost joined the latter group with 9,955 fans visiting Value City Arena for its Jan. 23 game against Iowa.
- The Big Ten has consistently ranked among the top three conferences in women's basketball attendance for the past three decades and that trend appears to be continuing this season. As of Monday, 11 Big Ten programs ranked among the top 40 in the nation (and five in the top 15, all averaging more than 5,000 fans per game) in average attendance, leading all Division I conferences by every attendance measure. Among the Big Ten contingent, Iowa is No. 2 in the nation (10,201), followed by Maryland (9th - 7,037), Indiana (11th - 6,159), Ohio State (12th - 5,728) and Nebraska (14th - 5,264).
- At 10,201 fans per game, Iowa is on pace for the second-highest single-season attendance average in Big Ten Conference history. The only school to produce a higher overall average attendance for one season than Iowa's current mark is Wisconsin (10,455 in 1997-98). Iowa is also averaging 11,110 fans during conference games, which would rank third in Big Ten history behind only Wisconsin (12,474 in 1997-98) and Minnesota (11,281 in 2003-04).
- Big Ten Conference women's basketball is reaching new heights in its television exposure this season. Of the 30 highest-rated games in 2022-23, nearly half of them (14) have involved a Big Ten program, including four of the top 10 and six of the top 15. The Nov. 27 Iowa-UConn game at the Phil Knight Legacy in Portland drew 597,000 viewers on ABC (fourth in the nation), while the Jan. 7 Iowa-Michigan game (the first-ever Big Ten women's basketball game on the FOX broadcast network) brought in 564,000 viewers, good for sixth in the country. The Jan. 28 Iowa-Nebraska game on FOX brought in 492,000 viewers, eighth-highest in the country and one spot in front of the Dec. 11 Maryland-UConn game on ABC (the first-ever Big Ten regular season home game on ABC), which had 470,000 viewers.
- No fewer than 11 Big Ten Conference games this season have attracted more than 200,000 viewers (and six have topped 300,000). By comparison, four Big Ten games reached the 200,000-viewer mark last season.
- During non-conference play this season, the Big Ten Conference posted seven top-10 wins and 12 victories over ranked non-conference opponents, both leading all Division I conferences. The seven non-conference top-10 wins (which included three away from home) were the most by the Big Ten in the past 20 years, more than doubling the three top-10 victories in both 2004-05 and 2008-09. The 12 Top 25 wins (seven of which came on the road or at neutral sites) tied for the most for the Big Ten in the regular season during the past two decades, matching the total from the 2004-05 season.
- The Big Ten currently leads all Division I conferences in scoring (75.0 ppg.), field-goal percentage (.444), assists (16.3 apg.) and steals (8.9 spg.), while ranking second in three-point percentage (.339) and free throw percentage (.733).
- In recent years, the Big Ten Conference has cultivated a deserved reputation as the home for an exciting brand of up-tempo basketball. This season, seven Big Ten schools rank among the top 35 in the nation in scoring offense (four are averaging 80 points per game and rank in the top 15), led by Iowa (2nd - 87.3 ppg.), Ohio State (6th - 83.7 ppg.) and Indiana (9th - 82.0 ppg.). In addition, nine Big Ten schools have scored at least 100 points in a game this season.
- The Big Ten features some of the sharpest shooting teams in the country, with six schools among the top 25 (and four of the top 10) in the country in field goal percentage, according to the latest NCAA statistical report. Indiana leads the way (2nd - .506), followed by Iowa (3rd - .495), Michigan (9th - .475) and Ohio State (10th - .472), with Illinois (20th - .465) and Purdue (22nd - .462) also in the top 25 nationally. Individually, the Big Ten has three of the nation's top six (and four of the top 25) shooters this season in Indiana's Mackenzie Holmes (2nd - .684), Iowa's Monika Czinano (3rd - .664), Ohio State's Taylor Thierry (6th - .639) and Michigan's Emily Kiser (23rd - .559). The Big Ten has produced the NCAA field-goal percentage champion seven of the past eight seasons, including Czinano the past two (she also finished second to Oregon's Ruthy Hebard during the pandemic-shortened 2019-20 season).
- It's called "sharing the sugar", and no conference is sweeter in the assist game than the Big Ten. Eight conference schools rank among the top 40 in the country in assists (three in the top 10), paced by Iowa (4th - 20.2 apg.), Indiana (6th - 18.8 apg.) and Michigan State (9th - 18.1 apg.). Four Big Ten players rank among the top 20 nationally in assists — Iowa's Caitlin Clark (2nd - 7.9 apg.), Purdue's Jeanae Terry (9th - 6.9 apg.), Nebraska's Jaz Shelley (11th - 6.5 apg.) and Michigan's Leigha Brown (16th - 5.6 apg.).

The deadline to apply for credentials is Feb. 24.
- Tickets are now on sale for the 2023 Big Ten Conference Women's Basketball Tournament presented by TIAA, which will be played March 1-5 at the Target Center in Minneapolis. For more information, visit the official tournament web site at bigten.org/WBBT.

Each year more than 11 million patrons attend Big Ten home contests, as the conference has led the nation in attendance for volleyball, men's basketball, ice hockey and wrestling.



Since its inception in 1896, the pursuit and attainment of academic excellence has been a priority for every Big Ten member institution. But maintaining the conference's standard of competing at the highest level in athletics also endures as an important component of the Big Ten experience. Striking that balance between academics and athletics is integral to the Big Ten's identity. Recognized as one of intercollegiate sports' most successful undertakings, the Big Ten strives for success from its students not only on the field and in the classroom, but around the world as well.

PREMIER ACADEMIC INSTITUTIONS

The Big Ten Academic Alliance is an academic consortium of all 14 Big Ten universities, which is widely considered to be the model for effective and voluntary collaboration among top research universities.

Every Big Ten Academic Alliance institution ranks among the top 70 universities in the nation according to the 2022 Academic Ranking of World Universities, including six in the top 30.

The Big Ten leads all conferences with more than 1,900 Academic All-Americans, including 48 honorees during the 2021-22 academic year.

Big Ten Academic Alliance schools annually conduct \$10 billion in funded research, \$5 billion more than any other conference.

A HISTORY OF ATHLETIC SUCCESS

Big Ten schools have won at least five national championships in 24 of the last 28 years, averaging nearly seven per year during that span.

Since the 2005-06 academic year, current Big Ten institutions have claimed 109 team national championships in 26 different sports.

BROAD-BASED PROGRAMMING

The Big Ten will administer more than \$240 million in direct financial support to more than 9,800 students competing in intercollegiate athletics for more than 11,000 participation opportunities on 350 teams in 42 different sports.

The Big Ten sponsors 28 official conference sports, 14 for men and 14 for women, including the addition of men's ice hockey and men's and women's lacrosse in this decade.

The Big Ten leads the nation in total students competing in intercollegiate athletics and participation opportunities, and sponsors more official sports than all conferences except the Ivy League.

More than 1,500 Big Ten competitors have participated in the Olympics, winning more than 500 medals, including more than 200 gold. The Big Ten Conference enjoyed its finest performance at a single Olympic Games during the 2020 Summer Olympics in Tokyo, Japan, as athletes with Big Ten ties set conference records by earning 51 total medals and 22 gold medals during the 17-day competition. All 14 Big Ten member schools had an athlete win at least one medal in Tokyo, also a first in conference history. Big Ten Olympians collected nearly 80 medals in the most recent games in PyeongChang and Beijing.

PASSIONATE FOLLOWING

The Big Ten leads all conferences with 6.4 million alumni and nearly 580,000 students.

Each year more than 11 million patrons attend Big Ten home contests, as the conference has led the nation in attendance for men's basketball, ice hockey, volleyball and wrestling.

LEADERS IN INNOVATION

Took part in the nation's first bowl game, winning the 1902 Rose Bowl Game, and signed an exclusive contract with the Tournament of Roses in 1946, making it the first bowl with permanent conference affiliations.

Awarded the first Big Ten Medal of Honor in 1915, honoring outstanding seniors who demonstrated excellence in academics and athletics.

Formed the Big Ten Advisory Commission in 1972, enlisting former students that competed in conference athletics to serve as liaisons to the NCAA's Diversity and Inclusion Department, the Big Ten Student-Athlete Advisory Commission and other organizations.

Became the first conference to voluntarily adopt male and female participation goals after launching its Gender Equity Action Plan in 1992.

Implemented the first collegiate football system of instant replay in 2004, which the NCAA approved for use among all conferences in 2006.

Launched the Big Ten Network (BTN) in 2007, the first national conference-owned television network.

Began partnering with the Ivy League to study the effects of head injuries in sports in 2012.

Accepted Johns Hopkins University as the conference's first sport affiliate members in men's and women's lacrosse in 2013 and 2015, respectively, and added Notre Dame as a sport affiliate member in men's ice hockey in 2017.

EXTENSIVE TELEVISION EXPOSURE

Through the Big Ten's current media agreements with BTN, ABC/ESPN, CBS and FOX, more than 2,000 Big Ten events are produced and distributed nationally and globally on an annual basis.

BTN is in almost 60 million homes across the United States and Canada, and is also available via the Fox Sports App, delivering live and on-demand programming to computers, smartphones and tablets. B1G+ streams hundreds of additional events each season.

COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

For more than 30 years, through the Big Ten's SCORE (Success Comes Out of Reading Everyday) program, the conference has partnered with Chicago elementary schools to improve reading performance.

Surrounding the Big Ten Football Championship Game and Basketball Tournaments, the conference has held numerous community initiatives, partnered with the College Football Playoff Foundation and other events such as the Big Ten Career Expo, SaturDAY of Service and Youth Football Clinics. In addition, the Big Ten has hosted a downtown 5K, collaborated with a local breast cancer awareness group and provided unique event experiences for military veterans.
