- The final week of the 2022-23 Big Ten Conference regular season tips off Tuesday with a marquee top-10 matchup as No. 6/6 Iowa travels to No. 7/8 Maryland for an 8 p.m. (ET) contest at the XFINITY Center. An Iowa victory would set the Hawkeyes up to play for a share of the conference title on Sunday, while a Maryland win would move the Terrapins into a tie for second place and also give Indiana the outright Big Ten crown. Tuesday's Iowa-Maryland game will be televised live on the Big Ten Network and the FOX Sports app, while SiriusXM Radio will offer a live global broadcast on Channel 195 and the SXM app.
- The winner of Tuesday night's Iowa-Maryland game will earn its fourth top-10 victory this season, tying Big Ten Conference champion Indiana for the national lead in that category. All told, only five schools in the country have three top-10 wins to their credit this season — and three of those five reside in the Big Ten (Iowa and Maryland currently have three each and are tied for second nationally along with South Carolina and UConn).
- Tuesday's game between No. 6/6 Iowa and No. 7/8 Maryland in College Park will be the sixth matchup between two top-10 Big Ten Conference programs in the past 29 days, dating back to Jan. 23. It's the first of two top-10 conference contests this week, with Iowa playing host to No. 2/2 Indiana at 2 p.m. (ET) Sunday live on ESPN.
- Indiana clinched a share of its second Big Ten Conference title and its first in 40 years (1982-83 - the first year the Big Ten featured regular-season play) with Sunday's 83-60 win over Purdue at a sold-out Simon Skjodt Assembly Hall. The Hoosiers also tied a program record for conference wins in one season (16 in 2020-21), while extending their school record for overall wins in a season (26) and posting their 14th consecutive victory, the second-longest in program history and one shy of the school record set in 1971-72.
- Ohio State became the fourth Big Ten Conference program to capture five Top 25 victories this season with its 74-61 win at No. 12/13 Michigan Monday night, joining Indiana (9), Iowa (5) and Maryland (5) in that elite group. The Buckeyes are also among seven Big Ten schools with multiple wins over ranked opponents this season — the above four, plus Michigan (3), Nebraska (2) and Purdue (2).
- With Illinois reaching the 20-win mark on Sunday, it's the first time the Big Ten Conference will have six teams with 20 wins prior to the Big Ten Tournament since the 2014-15 season. That year, there were seven conference teams that had 20 wins before the Big Ten Tournament, with Maryland going on to win the Big Ten postseason title and advance to the NCAA Women's Final Four.
- Indiana welcomed its first-ever sellout Sunday against Purdue, with a school-record 17,222 fans packing Simon Skjodt Assembly Hall. It was the second-largest on-campus crowd in the nation this season (South Carolina drew 18,000 for its Feb. 12 game vs. LSU), as well as the third-largest crowd in Big Ten history — Maryland attracted a conference-record 17,950 spectators for its sellout vs. UConn on Dec. 29, 2016, at the XFINITY Center, while Ohio State welcomed 17,525 fans for a sellout vs. Penn State on Feb. 27, 2005.
- ESPN has announced that College GameDay will broadcast live from Iowa's Carver-Hawkeye Arena from 11 a.m.-noon (ET) next Sunday (Feb. 26), prior to the sold-out regular season finale between the No. 6/7 Hawkeyes and No. 2/2 Indiana that will tip off at 2 p.m. (ET) live on ESPN. It will be the first time ESPN's College GameDay will originate from the site of a Big Ten Conference women's basketball game, with Elle Duncan hosting the broadcast and joined by analysts Andraya Carter, Rebecca Lobo, former Purdue head coach (and 2023 Women's Basketball Hall of Fame inductee) Carolyn Peck and Holly Rowe, who joined Andscape's Marc J. Spears as the 2023 recipients of the prestigious Curt Gowdy Media Award, presented by the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame.
- Single-session and all-session tickets are now on sale for the 2023 Big Ten Conference Women's Basketball Tournament presented by TIAA, which will be played March 1-5 at the Target Center in Minneapolis. For more information, visit the official tournament web site at bigten.org/WBBT.
- Media members wishing to apply for credentials to the 2023 Big Ten Conference Women's Basketball Tournament presented by TIAA must do so prior to Friday's 5 p.m. (ET) deadline. The link to apply for credentials can be found online at office.bigten.org/media.
- The Big Ten once more leads all conferences with six schools in the latest Associated Press poll. This also marks

the third consecutive week (and fifth week this season) that a Big Ten school is ranked No. 2 in the AP poll, with Indiana holding down that spot during the current three-week stretch. The Hoosiers, who also picked up a first-place vote this week (the first by a Big Ten program since 2004-05), are followed by No. 6 Iowa, No. 7 Maryland (a season high for the Terrapins), No. 12 Michigan (a season high for the Wolverines for the third straight week), No. 16 Ohio State and No. 25 Illinois.

- With Indiana's No. 2 AP ranking the past three weeks, and Ohio State's No. 2 rankings on Jan. 16 and 23, this marks the first time the Big Ten Conference has had multiple schools reach as high as No. 2 in the AP poll in the same season since 1993-94. That year, Penn State spent three weeks at No. 1 and three more at No. 2, while Iowa was ranked No. 2 for the first eight weeks of the season.
- The Big Ten also remains among the national leaders with five schools in the Top 25 of the latest Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA)/USA Today poll. Indiana maintained its highest-ever ranking at No. 2 and picked up a first-place vote (the first for a Big Ten school in 18 years), followed by No. 6 Iowa, No. 8 Maryland (the Terrapins' season high for a third straight week), No. 13 Ohio State and No. 17 Michigan. Illinois is receiving votes in the WBCA poll this week.
- Not only did Indiana hold steady at No. 2 in this week's Associated Press and Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA)/USA Today polls, but the Hoosiers also picked up a first-place vote in each poll. It's the first time a Big Ten Conference school has earned a No. 1 vote in either poll since the 2004-05 season, when Ohio State garnered one first-place vote (most recently on Jan. 31, 2005 in the AP poll, and Feb. 15, 2005, in the coaches' poll).
- Illinois earned its 20th win of the season Sunday with an 85-62 victory over Penn State at State Farm Center. It's the first time the Fighting Illini have posted a 20-win season since 2007-08, while Sunday also boosted Illinois to 10-6 in conference play (the first time it has recorded double-digit Big Ten wins since 1999-2000).
- The Big Ten leads all Division I conferences with a remarkable nine schools among the top 50 in the latest NET rankings, including five in the top 20 — No. 3 Indiana, No. 6 Iowa, No. 14 Ohio State, No. 15 Maryland, No. 19 Michigan, No. 35 Illinois, No. 45 Purdue, No. 46 Michigan State and No. 50 Nebraska. The NCAA Evaluation Tool (NET) is the primary sorting tool used by the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Committee for determining NCAA Tournament teams.
- No fewer than 12 of the top 30 (and 18 of the top 50) largest single-game attendances in the country this year have been hosted by a Big Ten Conference program, all topping 10,000 fans. The Big Ten is No. 2 nationally with its 12 top-30 crowds and 18 top-50 audiences, which includes two of the 20 largest crowds in Big Ten Conference history, both as part of the Indiana-Purdue series — a season-high 17,222 fans on Feb. 19 for Indiana's home win over Purdue (third in Big Ten history) and 14,876 fans (16th in conference history) for the first meeting between the schools at Purdue on Feb. 5.
- No fewer than 13 of the 14 Big Ten programs have drawn at least one crowd of 5,000 fans or more this season, including six (Indiana, Iowa, Maryland, Michigan, Nebraska and Purdue) that have posted at least one audience of 10,000 fans. Ohio State almost joined the latter group with 9,955 on Jan. 23 against Iowa.
- The Big Ten has consistently ranked among the top three conferences in women's basketball attendance for the past three decades and that trend appears to be continuing this season. Currently, 11 Big Ten programs rank among the top 40 in the nation (and five in the top 15, all averaging more than 5,000 fans per game) in average attendance, leading all Division I conferences by every attendance measure. Among the Big Ten contingent, Iowa is No. 3 in the nation (10,450), followed by Indiana (9th - 7,361), Maryland (10th - 7,240), Nebraska (12th - 5,794) and Ohio State (13th - 5,734).
- At 10,450 fans per game, Iowa is challenging the Big Ten Conference single-season

attendance average record. The only school to produce a higher overall average attendance for one season than Iowa's current mark is Wisconsin (10,455 in 1997-98). Iowa is also averaging 11,236 fans during conference games, which would rank third in Big Ten history behind only Wisconsin (12,474 in 1997-98) and Minnesota (11,281 in 2003-04).

- During non-conference play this season, the Big Ten Conference posted seven top-10 wins and 12 victories over ranked non-conference opponents, both leading all Division I conferences. The seven non-conference top-10 wins (which included three away from home) were the most by the Big Ten in the past 20 years, more than doubling the three top-10 victories in both 2004-05 and 2008-09. The 12 Top 25 wins (seven of which came on the road or at neutral sites) tied for the most for the Big Ten in the regular season during the past two decades, matching the total from the 2004-05 season.
- Big Ten women's basketball is reaching new heights in its television exposure this season. Of the 50 highest-rated games in 2022-23, 21 of them (42 percent) have involved a Big Ten program, including three of the top 10 and nine of the top 25 — and more than half (12) of those 21 Top 50 games were conference matchups. The Nov. 27 Iowa-UConn game at the Phil Knight Legacy in Portland drew 597,000 viewers on ABC (sixth in the nation), while the Jan. 7 Iowa-Michigan game (the first-ever Big Ten women's basketball game on the FOX broadcast network) brought in 564,000 viewers, good for eighth in the country. Most recently, the Jan. 28 Iowa-Nebraska game on FOX brought in 492,000 viewers, 10th-highest in the country and one spot in front of the Dec. 11 Maryland-UConn game on ABC (the first Big Ten regular season home game on ABC), which had 470,000 viewers.
- No fewer than 14 Big Ten Conference games this season have attracted more than 200,000 viewers (and eight have topped 300,000). By comparison, four Big Ten games reached the 200,000-viewer mark last season.
- The Big Ten currently leads all Division I conferences in scoring (74.0 ppg.), field-goal percentage (.442), assists (16.2 apg.) and steals (8.7 spg.), while ranking second in three-point percentage (.336) and third in free throw percentage (.734; first among Autonomy Five conferences).
- In recent years, the Big Ten Conference has cultivated a deserved reputation as the home for an exciting brand of up-tempo basketball. This season, six Big Ten schools are among the top 25 in the nation (five in the top 15) in scoring offense, led by Iowa, which is No. 1 in the nation at 88.3 points per game, while Ohio State (9th - 81.4 ppg.), Indiana (10th - 81.1 ppg.), Michigan State (14th - 78.6 ppg.) and Maryland (15th - 78.5 ppg.) are also in the top 15. The Big Ten also has three of the nation's top 20 scorers in Iowa's Caitlin Clark (3rd - 27.3 ppg.), Indiana's Mackenzie Holmes (6th - 22.6 ppg.) and Maryland's Diamond Miller (20th - 20.2 ppg.).
- The Big Ten features five schools among the top 25 (and four of the top 10) in the country in field goal percentage. Iowa leads the nation at .515, followed by Indiana (3rd - .502), Michigan (9th - .472) and Ohio State (10th - .471), with Illinois (23rd - .459) also in the top 25 nationally. Individually, the Big Ten has three of the nation's top six shooters this season in Indiana's Mackenzie Holmes (2nd - .692), Iowa's Monika Czinano (4th - .673) and Ohio State's Taylor Thierry (6th - .639). The Big Ten has produced the NCAA field-goal percentage champion seven of the past eight years, including Czinano the past two (she was also second to Oregon's Ruthy Hebard during the pandemic-shortened 2019-20 season).
- It's called "sharing the sugar", and no conference is sweeter in the assist game than the Big Ten. Seven conference schools rank among the top 35 in the country in assists (three in the top 10), paced by Iowa, which is No. 2 in the nation at 21.3 apg., followed by Indiana (6th - 18.4 apg.) and Michigan State (9th - 18.1 apg.). Four Big Ten players rank among the top 20 nationally in assists — Iowa's Caitlin Clark leads the nation (8.3 apg.), followed by Purdue's Jeanae Terry (11th - 6.4 apg.), Nebraska's Jaz Shelley (12th - 6.3 apg.) and Michigan's Leigha Brown (16th - 5.7 apg.).

Each year more than 11 million patrons attend Big Ten home contests, as the conference has led the nation in attendance for volleyball, men's basketball, ice hockey and wrestling.



Since its inception in 1896, the pursuit and attainment of academic excellence has been a priority for every Big Ten member institution. But maintaining the conference's standard of competing at the highest level in athletics also endures as an important component of the Big Ten experience. Striking that balance between academics and athletics is integral to the Big Ten's identity. Recognized as one of intercollegiate sports' most successful undertakings, the Big Ten strives for success from its students not only on the field and in the classroom, but around the world as well.

PREMIER ACADEMIC INSTITUTIONS

The Big Ten Academic Alliance is an academic consortium of all 14 Big Ten universities, which is widely considered to be the model for effective and voluntary collaboration among top research universities.

Every Big Ten Academic Alliance institution ranks among the top 70 universities in the nation according to the 2022 Academic Ranking of World Universities, including six in the top 30.

The Big Ten leads all conferences with more than 1,900 Academic All-Americans, including 48 honorees during the 2021-22 academic year.

Big Ten Academic Alliance schools annually conduct \$10 billion in funded research, \$5 billion more than any other conference.

A HISTORY OF ATHLETIC SUCCESS

Big Ten schools have won at least five national championships in 24 of the last 28 years, averaging nearly seven per year during that span.

Since the 2005-06 academic year, current Big Ten institutions have claimed 109 team national championships in 26 different sports.

BROAD-BASED PROGRAMMING

The Big Ten will administer more than \$240 million in direct financial support to more than 9,800 students competing in intercollegiate athletics for more than 11,000 participation opportunities on 350 teams in 42 different sports.

The Big Ten sponsors 28 official conference sports, 14 for men and 14 for women, including the addition of men's ice hockey and men's and women's lacrosse in this decade.

The Big Ten leads the nation in total students competing in intercollegiate athletics and participation opportunities, and sponsors more official sports than all conferences except the Ivy League.

More than 1,500 Big Ten competitors have participated in the Olympics, winning more than 500 medals, including more than 200 gold. The Big Ten Conference enjoyed its finest performance at a single Olympic Games during the 2020 Summer Olympics in Tokyo, Japan, as athletes with Big Ten ties set conference records by earning 51 total medals and 22 gold medals during the 17-day competition. All 14 Big Ten member schools had an athlete win at least one medal in Tokyo, also a first in conference history. Big Ten Olympians collected nearly 80 medals in the most recent games in PyeongChang and Beijing.

PASSIONATE FOLLOWING

The Big Ten leads all conferences with 6.4 million alumni and nearly 580,000 students.

Each year more than 11 million patrons attend Big Ten home contests, as the conference has led the nation in attendance for men's basketball, ice hockey, volleyball and wrestling.

LEADERS IN INNOVATION

Took part in the nation's first bowl game, winning the 1902 Rose Bowl Game, and signed an exclusive contract with the Tournament of Roses in 1946, making it the first bowl with permanent conference affiliations.

Awarded the first Big Ten Medal of Honor in 1915, honoring outstanding seniors who demonstrated excellence in academics and athletics.

Formed the Big Ten Advisory Commission in 1972, enlisting former students that competed in conference athletics to serve as liaisons to the NCAA's Diversity and Inclusion Department, the Big Ten Student-Athlete Advisory Commission and other organizations.

Became the first conference to voluntarily adopt male and female participation goals after launching its Gender Equity Action Plan in 1992.

Implemented the first collegiate football system of instant replay in 2004, which the NCAA approved for use among all conferences in 2006.

Launched the Big Ten Network (BTN) in 2007, the first national conference-owned television network.

Began partnering with the Ivy League to study the effects of head injuries in sports in 2012.

Accepted Johns Hopkins University as the conference's first sport affiliate members in men's and women's lacrosse in 2013 and 2015, respectively, and added Notre Dame as a sport affiliate member in men's ice hockey in 2017.

EXTENSIVE TELEVISION EXPOSURE

Through the Big Ten's current media agreements with BTN, ABC/ESPN, CBS and FOX, more than 2,000 Big Ten events are produced and distributed nationally and globally on an annual basis.

BTN is in almost 60 million homes across the United States and Canada, and is also available via the Fox Sports App, delivering live and on-demand programming to computers, smartphones and tablets. B1G+ streams hundreds of additional events each season.

COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

For more than 30 years, through the Big Ten's SCORE (Success Comes Out of Reading Everyday) program, the conference has partnered with Chicago elementary schools to improve reading performance.

Surrounding the Big Ten Football Championship Game and Basketball Tournaments, the conference has held numerous community initiatives, partnered with the College Football Playoff Foundation and other events such as the Big Ten Career Expo, SaturDAY of Service and Youth Football Clinics. In addition, the Big Ten has hosted a downtown 5K, collaborated with a local breast cancer awareness group and provided unique event experiences for military veterans.
