## BIG WEST AT A GLANCE

• Pacific is the Big West representative to the NCAA Tournament for the sixth time as a conference member, and ninth overall in school history. The Tigers clinched the automatic bid to the NCAA's as the champion of the Big West Tournament, defeating No. 7 seed UC Santa Barbara (71-68), No. 3 Cal Poly (55-53) and No. 4 UC Irvine (64-55) on successive days.

• The Tigers, the second seed in the Big West Tournament, secured the program's fifth overall, and fourth and final Big West Tournament championship for head coach Bob Thomason. Thomason, the winningest coach in Big West history in overall (436) and conference (248) victories, is retiring this season after 25 years at the helm of the Tigers. Thomason also won Big West Tournament titles in 1997, 2004 and 2006.

• Thomason's four Big West Tournament championships tie for second all-time with Utah State's Stew Morrill. UNLV's Jerry Tarkanian owns the benchmark for most titles with seven.

• This is Thomason's fifth trip to the NCAA Tournament. He is 2-4 all-time in the four previous appearances – 1997, 2004, 2005, 2006. The No. 12 seed Tigers upset fifth-seeded Providence (66-58) in the 2004 first round. In 2005, as a No. 8 seed, the Tigers held off ninth-seeded Pittsburgh, 79-71, for another first round victory. Pacific lost both the 1997 and 2006 first round matchups to St. Joseph's and Boston College as a No. 13 seed. Pacific enters this year's NCAA Tournament against Miami (FL) with its lowest seed yet as a No. 15.

• With a 22-12 record, Thomason's clubs have recorded 20 or more wins in 10 of the last 17 seasons.

• The Big West set an all-time conference record with five postseason clubs this season. In addition to Pacific's NCAA automatic bid, Long Beach State is appearing in the National Invitation Tournament. Cal Poly, UC Irvine and Hawai'i are representing the Big West in the CollegeInsider.com Tournament.

• Long Beach State won its third consecutive Big West regular season championship, finishing 14-4 and one game ahead of Pacific in the standings. The 49ers are the first program to win three straight outright titles since UNLV reeled off seven in a row from 1982-89.

• The 49ers are making their third consecutive postseason appearance (2 NIT, 1 NCAA) with an upcoming NIT matchup Wednesday at Baylor. LBSU is 2-6 in six previous trips to the NIT, with the last win coming in 1990.

• Cal Poly, which has recorded the highest number of Big West wins (12) in school history, makes its postseason debut Wednesday at Weber State in the first round of the CollegeInsider.com Tournament. The Mustangs are one win away from tying the school record for most overall wins (19) while a Big West member.

• UC Irvine is playing in the postseason for the first time since 2002 when the Anteaters appeared in the NIT. The 20 victories for UCI represents the most for the program since posting a 20-9 record in 2002-03.

• Hawai'i appears in the CIT for the second time in three years. The Big West average home attendance leader (6,372) hosts Air Force in the first round.

## STATS OF THE WEEK

• UC Irvine sophomore Will Davis II has a legitimate shot at breaking the Big West single-season record for blocks. The 6-8 center has a league-leading 86 blocked shots, just four short of eclipsing UC Santa Barbara's Eric McArthur, who logged 89 rejections in 1990. Davis II tied the Big West single-game record of eight blocked shots earlier this year, a mark he also initially hit as a freshman.

• UCI head coach Russell Turner will coach his 100th career game when the Anteaters host High Point in the first round of the CIT Wednesday.

• Hawai'i is the only Big West school with two players ranked in the top five in rebounding. Senior center Vander Joaquim ranks No. 2 with 8.4 boards per game while junior forward Christian Standhardinger sits fourth (7.9 rpg). Joaquim is also second in the Big West and tied for No. 30 nationally with 12 double-doubles this season. Standhardinger is fourth in the league with nine double-doubles.

### 38th Annual Big West Men's Basketball Tournament

March 14-16, 2013 • Honda Center • Anaheim, Calif.

The Big West Conference Men's and Women's Basketball Tournament takes place at Honda Center for the third straight year. Honda Center and the Big West have teamed up for "March Madness" and "The Road To The Final Four" on numerous occasions including men's basketball regionals in 1998, 2001, 2003 and 2011, and the first and second rounds in 2008.

Eight men's teams advance to this season's tournament at Honda Center, Mar. 14-16. Thursday's quarterfinal games will include seeds #1 vs. #8, #4 vs. #5, #2 vs. #7 and #3 vs. #6 and all will appear on PRIME TICKET. The highest seeded team among Cal State Fullerton, Long Beach State and UC Irvine will play in Thursday's 6:00 p.m. game. The #1 seeded team will play no later than 6:00 p.m. The bracket will be reseeded for Friday's semifinals, pitting the highest remaining seeded team against the lowest remaining seeded team in one game. The other two quarterfinal winners will meet in the second semifinal. The men's championship game will tip off on Saturday, March 16 at 7:30 p.m. on ESPN2.

## AWARDS

**ENNIS NAMED FINALIST FOR LOU HENSON AWARD:** Long Beach State senior James Ennis is one of 25 finalists for the 2013 Lou Henson Award, given to the top mid-major player in college basketball. Ennis, who has scored in double figures 32 straight games, ranks fourth in the Big West in scoring (17.1 ppg), ninth in rebounding (6.7 rpg), eighth in field goal percentage (.492), third in free throw percentage (.847) and tied for fourth in steals (1.7 spg).

**SEELEY NAMED MID-MAJOR PRESEASON ALL-AMERICAN:** Cal State Fullerton senior guard D.J. Seeley was one of 31 players to be named to the CollegeInsider.com Preseason All-America Team. Seeley is the fourth Big West player in the last two seasons to find his way onto one of the two preseason All-America lists from the online publication. The Lou Henson Award honors the nation's top mid-major player. Larry Anderson and Casper Ware of Long Beach State represented the Big West on last year's preseason "watch list" as members of the preseason All-America Team. UC Santa Barbara's Orlando Johnson earned a spot on the Lute Olson Preseason All-American Team, which recognizes the nation's top Division I player.

## ***Monson Earns Third Straight Coach Of The Year Honor***

## **Big West Announces 2012-13 Men's Basketball All-Conference Team**

**IRVINE, CA** – The architect of Long Beach State's third straight regular season title – **Dan Monson** – captured his third straight Big West Coach of the Year honor while prized pupil **James Ennis** took home Player of the Year honors, highlighting the announcement of the 2012-13 all-conference team as voted on by the 10 head coaches. UC Davis sophomore sensation **Corey Hawkins** nabbed the Newcomer of the Year award while **Alex Young** of UC Irvine and **Isaac Fotu** of Hawai'i were named Co-Freshmen of the Year to round out the honor roll.

Monson has the Long Beach State program rolling as the 49ers claimed their third straight outright Big West regular season title. The 49ers are the first Big West program to stand alone for three straight seasons atop the standings since UNLV reeled off seven straight from 1982-89. After losing four starters from the 2011-12 club that made an NCAA Tournament appearance, Monson crafted a starting lineup comprised of two returning letterwinners (Ennis, Mike Caffey) and three Division I transfers (Dan Jennings, Tony Freeland, Keala King), and molded them into a champion. The 49ers finished the regular season 18-12 overall, but won 14 of their 18 conference games once Freeland and King became eligible. Monson led Long Beach State to an undefeated home conference record (9-0) for the third straight season, and the 49ers have won 26 straight games against Big West foes in the Walter Pyramid. The sixth-year head coach also collected career win No. 100 at LBSU on Feb. 13 against Cal State Fullerton. Monson's three straight championship teams have tallied a collective record of 65-33 (.663) overall and 43-7 (.860) in Big West games.

Ennis is the third straight 49er to capture the conference's top individual award, following two-time Player of the Year Casper Ware. The senior contributed in all facets of the team's success this season, ranking in the Big West top 10 statistically in scoring (17.0 ppg - 5th), rebounding (6.9 rpg - 8th), field goal percentage (.491 - 7th), free throw percentage (.847 - 2nd), steals (1.8 - 3rd) and blocked shots (1.4 bpg - 4th). Ennis, who scored in double figures in all 29 games this season, extended that streak to 35 straight dating back to 2011-12. The 6-7 guard/forward amassed nine games with 20 or more points and notched seven double-doubles, tying for fifth-most in the league. Ennis, a native of Ventura, Calif., produced 26 points and 15 rebounds against Cal State Fullerton (Feb. 13), and had 24 points to go along with 14 boards in LBSU's 77-76 win at UC Davis (Mar. 7) that clinched the Big West regular season title. Ennis is the ninth 49er in school history to earn Player of the Year honors.

Hawkins, a transfer from Arizona State, impacted UC Davis tremendously as he ascended to the top of the Big West in scoring. The first Aggie Big West scoring champion, the sophomore averaged 20.9 points per game and ranked among the nation's top 20 scorers all season long. The 6-3 guard scored 30 or more points on five occasions, culminating with career-highs of 40 points and 12 rebounds at Hawai'i (Feb. 14). In front of a sellout crowd and the program's first nationally televised appearance, Hawkins put the Aggies on his back with 34 points in a near upset of first place Long Beach State. In addition to his scoring prowess, Hawkins ranked among the Big West leaders in other categories, including rebounding (5.6 rpg - 15th), field goal percentage (.480 - 9th), free throw percentage (.846 - 3rd), steals (1.5 spg - 7th), three-point field goal percentage (.405 - 9th) and three-pointers made per game (1.7 pg - 10th). Hawkins helped spur a nine-win improvement in the win column from a year ago.

The Big West features co-freshmen of the year recipients for the second time in three seasons. Young is the first UC Irvine top frosh since Jerry Green (1999), the school's all-time leading scorer. Young entered the starting lineup eight games into the season and directed one of the nation's top sharing offenses. Under Young's direction, the Anteaters have ranked in the top 15 nationally in assists and he sits among the nation's leaders in assist-to-turnover ratio with 132 assists against only 51 turnovers. The 6-1 guard ranks third on the team with 9.2 points per game and is tied for third with 23 steals.

Fotu becomes Hawai'i's first major award winner in the school's first season as a Big West men's basketball member. The 6-8 forward helped beef up an already formidable Rainbow Warrior frontline and ended up leading the Big West with a .635 field goal percentage in conference games only. Fotu also ranked No. 15 in rebounding (5.7 rpg). His overall averages of 9.9 points and 6.3 rebounds per game placed him third on the team, while his most explosive performance came on Jan. 3 when he scored 29 points against Cal State Fullerton.

The All-Big West First Team has an entirely new look to it with three sophomores, two juniors and one senior comprising the list. In addition to Ennis and Hawkins, Long Beach State sophomore **Mike Caffey**, Cal Poly junior **Chris Eversley**, UC Santa Barbara sophomore **Alan Williams** and Hawai'i junior **Christian Standhardinger** were honored as first-team recipients.

## UC Irvine, UC Santa Barbara Represented In Men's Hoops All-Specialty Awards

IRVINE, CA – Two program firsts and a repeat selection comprised today's announcement of the 2013 Big West Men's Basketball All-Specialty awards. UC Irvine senior **Adam Folker** was a repeat choice as the conference's Best Hustle Player, while Anteater teammate **Will Davis II** became the program's first recipient of the Defensive Player of the Year honor. Junior **Kyle Boswell** also became UC Santa Barbara's first representative as the Best Sixth Player.

The conference's 10 head coaches voted on the awards, but were not allowed to cast votes for their own players. This is the 13th straight year that the Big West has named the All-Specialty Team.

Folker, a native of Markham, Ontario, collected the Best Hustle award for the second straight season after becoming the first UCI player to do so in 2011-12. Folker, who averaged 9.8 points and 6.4 rebounds in the regular season, led the Big West in field goal percentage (.581) and corralled the fourth-highest total of offensive rebounds (81). He scored double-digit points 13 times and double-digit rebounds on four occasions. The 6-9 center had 15 points and 14 rebounds against UC Davis (Dec. 29) in the Big West opener. Over his last four conference games, Folker has shot nearly 71 percent (29 of 41) from the field. He also is the Big West active leader with 604 career rebounds.

An intimidating shot blocking presence, Davis II is the first post player to earn Defensive Player of the Year honors since Titus Shelton of Cal Poly in 2007. The Anteater sophomore led the Big West with 78 blocked shots and 2.5 blocked shots per game. The 78 rejections shattered the UCI single-season record of 55 he established last year. In addition, his blocked shot total ties him for fourth in Big West single-season history and leaves him just 11 short of the 23-year old record held by UC Santa Barbara's Eric McArthur (89, 1990). The 6-8 forward/center had at least one swat in all but four of the 28 games he played in the regular season, including a career-high tying eight against Long Beach State (Mar. 2) that also equalled the Big West single-game record he shares with two others. Davis II posted four or more blocked shots nine times this season.

Previous Gauchos had been recipients of Defensive Player of the Year and Best Hustle, but no one had landed the Best Sixth Player award until Boswell. The 6-2 guard came off the bench in 19 of 28 games and averaged 13.2 points per game, which ranked second on the squad. In conference games only, Boswell's 14.1 points per game was No. 12. Known as one of the Big West's most explosive three-point shooters, the Huntington Beach, Calif. native knocked down 77 three-pointers for the second-highest total in the conference. Boswell connected for three or more treys in 16 games, and knocked down a career-best seven bombs against No. 15 San Diego State (Dec. 6). In 31 reserve minutes against Hawai'i on Feb. 28, Boswell erupted for a career-high 27 points aided by five three-pointers and 10-of-12 free throw shooting.
