Player Of The Week

Alan Williams • UC Santa Barbara
Jr. • 6-7 • Forward

UC Santa Barbara's Alan Williams (Phoenix, Ariz./North HS) sandwiched a pair of dominating performances around the New Year to claim his third Big West Player of the Week honor of the 2013-14 season.

The junior wrapped up 2013 with a big game in a road win over Seattle, scoring 27 points and pulling down eight rebounds in 30 minutes. He shot 8-of-14 from the field, hit 11-of-13 from the charity stripe and collected three steals and a pair of blocks. The win was the first by a Big West school over the Redhawks this season, ending a five game losing string.

Williams then put forth another efficient effort in a blow-out win over The Master's College, scoring 23 points on 10-of-12 shooting in 22 minutes. He was also able to pull down 12 rebounds, five of them coming on the offensive end, and added a pair of steals and one block. Most impressively, Williams did not commit a single turnover.

Go East Young Men: Cal Poly made its furthest trip east since its Division I debut last week, a matchup against Delaware that ended in an 82-72 loss. The Mustangs fell to 0-7 on the road this season

and lost their 12th straight non-conference road contest dating back to last season.

From Out Of Nowhere: Junior Anthony Silvestri started the first game of his collegiate career against the Blue Hens and delivered a career-best performance. Silvestri played 19 minutes and scored a career-best 14 points, knocking down a personal-high four three-pointers in the process. Silvestri's barrage from deep was a pleasant surprise as he had hit five threes in his previous 12 contests combined.

Still Stingy As Always: The Mustangs have allowed 70+ points in four straight games, the longest streak since Joe Callero's first season on the sidelines. Despite the recent struggles, Cal Poly is still a top-tier defensive club, ranking first in the Big West in points allowed per game at 65.2.

End Of The Gauntlet: Long Beach State wrapped up its harrowing non-conference slate with a 69-59 road loss to Missouri. The game was the 49ers' fourth against a ranked opponent and eighth against a power conference team.

Streak Snapped: LBSU's season-high three-game win streak was snapped against the Tigers, as well as the first loss since transfer Tyler Lamb became eligible four games ago.

Iron Caffey: Junior Michael Caffey played 39 minutes against Missouri, the fifth straight game he registered 36 or more minutes in a game. In all, Caffey has played at least 32 minutes in all but four games this season and leads the Big West in minutes played (491) and minutes played per game (35.1).

Right In The Gulley: Kris Gulley had his best game of the season against the Tigers, scoring 13 points. He hit a pair of threes, five of his six free throws and added three rebounds.
