Player Of The Week

**Stephen Maxwell • Cal State Northridge
Jr. • 6-7 • Forward
Woodland Hills, Calif./Taft HS**

A dominating effort from Stephen Maxwell spurred Cal State Northridge to a 2-0 league record and anointed the junior Big West Men's Basketball Player of the Week.

Maxwell averaged 25.0 points and 7.0 rebounds while shooting 75.0 (18 of 24) percent from the field as the Matadors dispatched UC Davis (89-77) and Hawai'i (79-78) at home.

He recorded his sixth and seventh 20-point games of the season to help CSUN race out to a 2-0 Big West start for the first time since 2007-08. Maxwell's 26 points against the Aggies were two short of his season-high. He made all 10 free throw attempts to tie a school single-game record for free throw percentage (1.000).

Against the Rainbow Warriors, the 6-7 forward notched 24 points and 10 rebounds for his eighth double-double of the year and 22nd of his career. He connected on 10-of-14 from the field and went 4-of-4 at the charity stripe.

Maxwell, who has shot 50 percent or better in seven straight games, is hitting at a .613 clip for the season. That mark is currently the third-best for a single-season at CSUN.

Maxwell also has hit 21 consecutive free throws after sinking all 14 tries successfully last week.

Strong Start Again: For the second straight year, Cal Poly rushed out to a 2-0 Big West start after disposing of two of the league's top performers in non-conference play – Hawai'i and UC Santa Barbara. The

Mustangs shot a season-best 61.1 (11 of 18) percent from three-point range to derail the Gauchos.

Lightning Strikes In Thunderdome: Cal Poly's 72-64 victory Saturday at the Thunderdome marked the first time since Jan. 20, 2007 that the Mustangs won in Santa Barbara. Junior Anthony Silvestri knocked down a career-high five threes and compiled 17 points in just 15 minutes to steer Cal Poly to the win.

Sizzling Hot At The Mott: The Mustangs led wire-to-wire in a 77-65 triumph over UH in last Thursday's league opener, signaling Cal Poly's fifth straight win over the Rainbow Warriors. It was the 15th straight Big West home win for Cal Poly, which has not lost a conference game at the Mott Athletics Center since Long Beach State triumphed 78-69 on Jan. 19, 2012.

Deja Vu?: The Matadors got off to an auspicious start in Big West play, sweeping UC Davis and Hawai'i at home last week. CSUN began conference play 2-0 for the first time since 2007-08. That

year, the Matadors enjoyed a 7-0 Big West start and eventually finished with a share of the regular season title at 12-4.

Maxwell Inches Closer To 1,000: Cal State Northridge could add a third player to the prestigious 1,000-point career scoring list very soon. With teammates Josh Greene (1,249) and Stephan Hicks (1,137) having already achieved the mark, junior Stephen Maxwell is next in line. The forward is 51 points shy of becoming the 18th player in school history to accomplish the feat.

Not Greene Behind The Ears: Greene looks to become just the fourth player in school history to score 1,000 career points and dish out 300 assists. He needs seven more assists to join Markus Carr (1998-02), Ian Boylan (2001-05) and Andre Chevalier (1990-94) on that list. Greene is seventh all-time in career points with 1,249.

Historic Run Fuels 49ers: The 49ers rebounded with a 25-point triumph, 99-74, against UC Davis on Saturday. Most startling was the way LBSU opened the second half. Down 44-40 at halftime, the 49ers ignited an incredible 30-0 run over the first eight minutes to effectively put the game away. It was LBSU's widest margin of victory since defeating UC Riverside by 40 on Feb. 16, 2013.

Hammonds Struts His Stuff: Freshman Travis Hammonds, a 6-6 guard who enrolled at LBSU for the spring semester, made a huge impact in the win over the Aggies. He notched a career-high 20 points on 7 of 9 shooting, while adding six rebounds, four assists and three steals.

Lamb Keeps Motoring: Junior transfer Tyler Lamb recorded his sixth straight double-digit scoring effort with 16 points against UC Davis.
