Player Of The Week

Keith Shamburger • Hawai'i Jr. • 5-11 • Guard
Los Angeles, Calif./San Jose State

Offensive heroics, accurate shooting and career-high in assists propelled Hawai'i junior Keith Shamburger to the Big West Men's Basketball Player of the Week award.

Shamburger shot 53.3% (8 of 15) from the field, 50.0% (6 of 12) from three-point range and 90.0% (9 of 10) at the stripe as the Rainbow Warriors posted back-to-back 90-point performances in road wins against UC Davis and UC Irvine.

He also provided heroics with a couple of buzzer beater shots while averaging 15.5 points, 4.5 rebounds and 7.5 assists. He had 15 assists to just three turnovers.

In a 90-73 triumph against the Aggies, Shamburger tallied 14 points, four rebounds and four assists. He drained a career-high four three-pointers, including one at the halftime buzzer, as UH's 17-point margin of victory was its largest on the road in 11 years.

Shamburger was instrumental in helping the Rainbow Warriors overcome a double-digit second half deficit to hand UCI a 90-86 defeat in overtime. The 5-11 guard collected his first double-double with 17 points and a UH career-high 11 assists. In addition to hitting all but one of his 10 foul attempts, Shamburger sank a leaning three-pointer with two defenders draped on him with less than a second remaining to force overtime. He later hit three crucial free throws in the extra period.

Showdown Looms: Cal Poly hosts UC Irvine this week in a battle of the top two teams in the Big West standings. The Mustangs enter the week trailing the Anteaters by a half-game for first place. ESPN3

will televise Saturday's showdown at 8:00 p.m. Cal Poly starts the week on Thursday against last place UC Davis.

No Turnover Troubles: The Mustangs continue to rank among the nation's leaders in fewest turnovers per game. They are now No. 7 nationally (9.5) after tying their season-low with three miscues against UC Riverside on Saturday. Two nights earlier, Cal Poly had just nine turnovers versus Cal State Fullerton. The Mustangs have posted nine games with single-digit turnovers this season.

Nine Points Away For Eversley: Senior Chris Eversley inched to within nine points of becoming the 19th player in Mustang history to reach 1,000 for a career. After tying his season low with seven points against CSF, the 6-7 forward rebounded with 13 versus UCR. It was Eversley's 12 game with double figure points this season.

Big Win: The Titans played back-to-back nip-and-tuck contests last week with mixed results. After a 58-56 loss to Cal Poly, they snapped a three-game skid with a huge 74-72 triumph over UC Santa

Barbara. Cal State Fullerton is 2-3 this season in games decided by five points or less.

Barometer For Success: Cal State Fullerton shot exactly 50 (27 of 54) percent in the win over UCSB. The Titans are 5-0 this season when shooting 50 percent or better.

Harris Ties Career High: Junior Alex Harris matched his career high of 22 points in the win over UCSB. He knocked down a season-best four three-pointers. The guard also has scored in double-digits for five consecutive games.

Threes Galore: CSF has struggled from three-point range this season, hitting at a 30.0 (104 of 347) percent clip. But the Titans found their rhythm against the Gauchos, tying a season best with nine three-pointers (in 20 attempts), and hit above a 40% clip for the first time in 13 games.

Slip And Slide: Cal State Northridge seeks to halt a four-game losing streak when it hosts UC Riverside Thursday on ESPN3. The Matadors won their initial two ESPN3 appearances to start out 2-0

in Big West play, but have since dropped four straight.

Maxwell Joins 1,000-Point Triumvirate: Junior Stephen Maxwell became the third Matador to surpass 1,000 career points this season after scoring a combined 35 points versus UC Irvine and Long Beach State. Maxwell hit 1,000 with a dunk at the 13:55 mark of the first half against the 49ers. Teammates Josh Greene (1,300) and Stephan Hicks (1,190) also have hit the milestone this year.

Bulk Of The Load: Greene, Maxwell and Hicks have combined for 1,012 of the team's 1,546 points scored, or 65.5 percent of the total offense.

No Diverting: The Matadors have trotted out the same starting five - Greene, Maxwell, Hicks, Tre Hale-Edmerson and Landon Drew - in all but one game.

Another Win: Long Beach State won for the third time in its last four games thanks to a 76-62 triumph over Cal State Northridge Saturday. The 49ers now focus their attention on Thursday's huge road game at Hawai'i and a Saturday home date with rival Cal State Fullerton on ESPN3.

Mr. Jennings Heats Up: Senior Dan Jennings has accumulated back-to-back double doubles after his 14-point, 10-rebound effort against CSUN. The 6-9 forward also has made 11 of his last 14 floor shots over that span.

Caffey Climbs The Leaderboard: Junior guard Mike Caffey tallied his seventh 20-point game of the season with a game-high 23-point performance versus the Matadors. Caffey now ranks fifth in the Big West in scoring with 16.5 points per game.

Solid With The Ball: The 49ers consistently take good care of the ball as evidenced that they have played 10 straight games with no more than 11 turnovers. In that span, LBSU is averaging just 9.7 turnovers per game.
