## Player Of The Week

**Alan Williams • UC Santa Barbara**  
**Jr. • 6-7 • Forward**  
**Phoenix, Ariz./North HS**

Posting his eighth and ninth double-doubles of the season, junior Alan Williams led UC Santa Barbara to a pair of victories as the Big West Men's Basketball Player of the Week.

It was the fourth Player of the Week award in 2013-14 for Williams, one of just 10 players in Big West history with that many citations in one season.

Williams averaged 26.5 points, 15.0 rebounds, 1.5 steals and 1.5 blocks in a monstrous week of production. His efforts helped the Gauchos to double-digit victories over UC Irvine (80-60) and UC Davis (82-67).

Against UCI's 7-foot-6 freshman Mamadou Ndiaye, Williams posted 26 points on 10 of 17 shooting, and added 10 rebounds.

Williams bettered that effort against UC Davis, exploding for 27 points, 20 rebounds and a career-high tying four assists. He was the first Gaucho in 24 years to record 20 or more points and 20 or more rebounds in a game. The 6-foot-7 center also became the first Big West player to collect 20 caroms in a game since Cal State Fullerton's Omonde Amoki on Mar. 8, 2012.

Williams is second in the conference with nine double-doubles. He has recorded 20 or more points in four straight games and has 14 such performances this year.

## BIG WEST AT A GLANCE

• The Big West race features a three-way tie for first place between Long Beach State, UC Irvine and UC Santa Barbara entering this week's play. All three teams sport 5-2 conference records. UCI seeks its first conference sweep of LBSU since the 2007-08 season when the two teams joust at the Bren Events Center Thursday in a 7:30 pm game televised on PRIME TICKET. It's a battle between two of the conference's top defensive units – UCI is No. 2 in scoring defense at 62.3 points per game while LBSU is No. 3 at 63.9. In their first meeting Jan. 9 on opening night of Big West play, UCI eked out a 46-44 win at the Walter Pyramid to end LBSU's 26-game home Big West win streak. The 90 points scored was the lowest combined total between two teams so far in conference play.

• The winner of the Long Beach State and UC Irvine matchup could very well have sole possession of first place depending on the outcome of UC Santa Barbara at Hawai'i. The Gauchos, No. 11 this week in the CollegelInsider.com Mid-Major poll, have won 11 of their last 14 games since defeating Pac-12 foe California (72-65) on Dec. 6. The Rainbow Warriors also have been hot, with wins in 13 of their last 17 outings. UCSB junior Alan Williams, who has captured four Big West Player of the Week awards this season, has scored 20-plus points in four straight games and 14 overall. **Williams is the only player in NCAA Division I to rank in the top 10 nationally in both scoring (No. 7 - 23.3 ppg) and rebounding (No. 7 - 11.1 rpg).** Four UH starters average double figures in scoring, led by senior Christian Standhardinger – No. 3 in the Big West at 17.6 points per game. **Sophomore Isaac Fotu ranks No. 7 nationally in field goal percentage (.622), and is shooting 68.5% (61 of 89) over his last eight games.**

• UC Riverside hosts a pair of ESPN3 games this week, welcoming Cal State Fullerton Thursday and Long Beach State Saturday to the SRC Arena. Eleven of the 32 Big West games that have been played so far have been decided by five points or less, and UCR has competed in four of them. As a whole, the Highlanders have played 21 games, and 12 of those have been decided by five points or less.

**Mustang Struggles:** After owning a 16-game win streak at home in Big West contests, the Mustangs have now lost three straight at the Mott Athletics Center. Last week UC Davis and UC Irvine defeated

the Mustangs, who have lost four of their last five going into a Thursday encounter at Hawai'i.

**Eversley Hits Milestone Mark:** Senior Chris Eversley etched his name into the Mustang record books after scoring 31 points in two games last week. The 6-7 forward now has scored 1,022 points for his career, and is the 19th player in Cal Poly history to accomplish the feat.

**SC Top 10:** Eversley's left-handed dunk on Big West leading shot blocker 7-6 Mamadou Ndiaye of UCI ended up as No. 1 on ESPN's Sports Center "SC Top 10" highlight show.

**Seeking Offense:** Cal Poly is averaging 56.0 points over its last four games, and is No. 9 in the Big West in scoring offense (63.9 ppg). The Mustangs are 1-7 in games in which they score under 60 points.

**Toss It Out:** The Titans are coming off one of their most difficult shooting nights of the season, connecting at 31.2% (20 of 64) from the field and 47.8% (11 of 23) at the foul line in Saturday's 75-56 set-

**On The Other Hand:** Senior Michael Williams remains CSF's most consistent performer. The 6-2 guard posted his 20th straight game with double-digit points as he totalled a game-high 18 against the 49ers. Williams has notched 18 or more points in eight of his last 11 outings.

**Harris Amps Up His Game:** Junior Alex Harris also continues to contribute effectively for the Titans. His 16 points against LBSU marked the sixth straight game he scored in double figures.

**Active On The Boards:** An opportunistic group of Titans collectively pulled down 18 offensive rebounds in the LBSU game, the second-highest total for CSF this season.

**Road Woes Be Gone:** UC Davis broke an eight-game road losing streak with a hard fought 62-58 victory against Cal Poly last Thursday. The win was the Aggies' first in San Luis Obispo since 2009.

**On The Brink Of 300:** Senior Ryan Sypkens drained four three-pointers against Cal Poly and five more versus UC Santa Barbara to raise his season total to conference-leading 74. Sypkens, who has hit at least five treys on six different occasions this season, bumped his career total to 294. He is on the cusp of becoming just the fourth player in Big West history to notch 300 career threes. In addition, the 6-4 guard moved into sole possession of fifth place in the Big West record book with 694 three-point attempts.

**Three-Point Displays:** The Aggies have knocked down double-digit three-pointers in five of their last eight contests.
