Player Of The Week

Luke Nelson • UC Irvine
Fr. • 6-3 • Guard
Worthing, England/The Henley College

Freshman Luke Nelson's clutch play helped UC Irvine take over sole possession of first place and earned him Big West Men's Basketball Player of the Week.

The Anteaters posted close victories over Long Beach State (61-58) and UC Davis (61-59), aided in large part from Nelson's contributions.

Nelson notched a career-high 28 points on 10 of 15 shooting in the win over the 49ers as UCI swept the season series for the first time since 2007-08. The 6-3 guard hit 5 of 8 from three-point territory and made four steals. Two of those steals led to layups in a span of 1:20 in the second half. Nelson also drained a pull-up jumper with 44 seconds left to give UCI a 60-57 lead and sank a free throw with 7.3 seconds remaining for the final margin.

Against the Aggies, Nelson scored just six points but it was his driving layup through traffic with 1:50 left that gave UCI the lead for good at 60-59, helping the Anteaters wipe out an 11-point second half deficit. Nelson also had an impact on the defensive end as his effort helped shut down UC Davis leading scorer Corey Hawkins for the final 3:25 of the game.

For the week, Nelson shot 60.0% (12 of 20) from the field.

BIG WEST AT A GLANCE

• UC Irvine sits in first place this week in a tightly contested Big West race. The Anteaters (7-2) lead UC Santa Barbara by a half game and Long Beach State by a full game. UCI plays a single game at home this week against UC Riverside. UCSB and LBSU square off on Thursday from the Walter Pyramid in a game televised on ESPN3. The Gauchos also host Cal State Northridge. Prime Ticket will carry Saturday's matchup between Cal Poly at Long Beach State at the Pyramid.

• Hawai'i ventures off the islands after a four-game stretch at home. The Rainbow Warriors visit Cal State Fullerton on Saturday for Homecoming. ESPN3 will air that game.

• Fifteen conference games – out of 40 total played – have been decided by five points or less. And of those 15 closely contested games, nine have finished with a margin of three points or less.

• Three "Wild Card" television selections were made this week for March 1 games on ESPN2 and ESPNU, and a March 6 contest on ESPNU. On Saturday, March 1, ESPN2 will broadcast the UC Santa Barbara at UC Davis game at 5 pm, while the Cal Poly at UC Irvine contest will air on ESPNU at 8 pm. ESPNU will also air the Hawai'i at UC Santa Barbara game on Thursday, March 6 at 6 pm.

• UC Santa Barbara junior Alan Williams remains the nation's only player to rank in the top 10 in both scoring and rebounding. He is No. 7 in scoring (23.1 ppg) and No. 3 in rebounds (11.4 rpg). Williams is not far from the national leaders Chad Posthumus of Morehead State and UNLV's Roscoe Smith, each at 11.6 rpg. No Big West player has ever finished a season as the nation's leader in rebounding.

• UC Irvine 7-foot-6 freshman center Mamadou Ndiaye ranks No. 7 nationally in blocked shots per game (3.4). With 82 blocks on the season, he could break the Big West single-season record of 89 this week.

Tough Sledding: Cal Poly dropped its fourth consecutive game and fifth in the last six with Saturday's setback in Hawai'i. The 69-60 loss marked the fifth straight game that Cal Poly has scored 60 or

less points. Cal Poly is last in conference games in scoring offense (61.9 ppg).

Odister Moves Up Threes List: Since missing three games due to injury, senior Kyle Odister has hit six three-pointers in his last two outings. The four threes he canned against UH put him in sole possession of eighth place on Cal Poly's career list. With 158 career threes, Odister needs just three more to leapfrog Ross Ketcham (159) and Lorenzo Keeler (160) for sixth place.

Digging In On "D": The Mustangs continue to play solid defense. In nine league games, they have yet to allow an opponent to score 70 points, and have held eight opponents to 65 or fewer points. The focus on defense has remained consistent, as the Mustangs lead the Big West in overall games for scoring defense (63.8 ppg).

Close Calls: The Titans have lost six of their last seven games after coming up short against UC Riverside and Cal State Northridge last week. Cal State Fullerton led late in both contests, including a

three-point advantage on the Matadors with seven seconds left in regulation. A CSUN three tied the scoreline, and CSF eventually fell, 92-83, in overtime.

Keeping It Going: Senior Michael Williams pieced together consecutive 20-point performances last week to extend his streak of scoring in double figures to 22 straight games. The 6-2 guard has reached the 20-point mark five times in his last nine games, and seven times overall this season.

Harris Hits Career-High: Junior Alex Harris reeled off back-to-back 20-point efforts, culminating with a career-high 27 points against CSUN. The 6-1 guard has posted eight straight double-digit scoring outings, averaging 17.4 points during that span. Harris also knocked down a career-high and a Titan season-high seven three-pointers against the Matadors.

Overtime Overtures: Cal State Northridge seems to favor the extra period these days. Both Matador games last week went to overtime, and the squad has played extra time in three of its last

four. Results were mixed, as CSUN lost in OT at UC Davis but fought past Cal State Fullerton.

Free Throws Are Fabulous: The Matadors set Big West single-game highs for free throws made (40) and attempted (47) in the OT win against CSF. They also supported their standing as the conference's best free throw shooting outfit. CSUN leads the Big West at 77.8% (533 of 685).

More On Free Throws: Senior Josh Greene is a key reason CSUN stands atop the Big West in free throw shooting. By a sizable margin, the 6-0 guard is shooting a Big West best 91.2% (114 of 125). That's a mark that will eventually break a 50-year old school record currently held by Chuck Malouf, who registered an .869 percentage during the 1963-64 season. Greene also is bidding to become just the fourth player in league history to finish above 90% on free throws.

Still In Position: Long Beach State is still positioned to win its fourth straight Big West regular season title following a split of last week's games against UC Irvine and UC Riverside.
