## Player Of The Week

**Michael Williams • Cal State Fullerton**  
Sr. • 6-2 • Guard  
**Van Nuys, Calif./San Francisco**

Impressive shooting and prodigious scoring mixed well for Cal State Fullerton senior Michael Williams, the Big West Men's Basketball Player of the Week who led the Titans to back-to-back conference wins for the first time this season.

Williams averaged 25.5 points in keying wins against Cal State Northridge (82-81) and Long Beach State (84-76) last week. The two wins clinched a spot for CSF in the Big West Tournament, as well as vaulting the Titans into fifth place in the league standings.

For the week, the guard shot 60.6% (20 of 33) from the floor, and made six of his 15 three-point attempts.

Williams played all 40 minutes against the Matadors, contributing 23 points, four rebounds and two assists in the one-point triumph. He hit 8 of 15 shots overall.

Against Long Beach State, Williams erupted for 20 of his 28 points in the second half as the Titans erased an early 14-point deficit and secured the comeback victory. He connected on 12 of 18 from the field, including 4 of 8 on three-pointers.

Williams has recorded double figures in 28 straight games, has scored at least 20 points 12 times, and has led CSF in scoring in four straight games.

## BIG WEST AT A GLANCE

• The final week of Big West regular season play is here, as teams jockey for seeding position at next week's conference tournament (March 13-15) at Honda Center. The No. 1 seed and regular season championship is also up for grabs. UC Irvine controls its own destiny on both fronts. The Anteaters (20-10, 11-3), winners of 20 games for two straight seasons, clinch the top seed and their first outright league title since 2000-01 with wins against Cal State Fullerton and UC Davis.

• UC Santa Barbara (19-8, 10-4) seeks its first Big West title since sharing those honors with Pacific in 2009-10. The Gauchos could earn their first outright crown since the 2002-03 season with two wins and two UCI losses. UCSB, which hosts Hawai'i and travels to Cal Poly, needs one win to secure 20 wins for the third time in five years. UCSB's +8 improvement in the win column from 2012-13 is the best among Big West schools.

• A flurry of televised games dot the schedule as the regular season wraps up. ESPNU will carry the Hawai'i at UC Santa Barbara game Thursday. Also on Thursday, UC Riverside can secure a berth in the Big West Tournament with a win against UC Davis in front of the ESPN3 cameras. UC Irvine hosts UC Davis Saturday on Prime Ticket, while Long Beach State and UCR appear on ESPN3.

• UC Irvine 7-foot-6 center Mamadou Ndiaye set the school's single-season blocked shots record, finishing the week with 90 and eclipsing the old mark of 88 set by teammate Will Davis II last year. Now No. 2 on the Big West single-season chart, Ndiaye is five swats away from tying Pacific's Michael Olowokandi (1997-98) for the record.

• Of the last 32 conference games, 13 have been decided by five points or less. Ten of those games have been decided by one possession.

Despite the recent struggles, the Mustangs have an opportunity to sweep the season series from the Gauchos for the first time since 2006-07.

**Nwaba With Big Game:** Sophomore Dave Nwaba posted his third 20-point game of the season in the loss at UC Irvine. He added a career-high 13 rebounds to secure his first double-double.

**Johnson Eyes Assist Chart:** Senior Jamal Johnson is getting close to becoming the sixth player in Mustang history with 300 career assists. The 6-0 guard is tied for sixth all-time at Cal Poly with 286 assists.

**Eversley Moves Up:** Senior Chris Eversley is now No. 15 all-time in school history with 1,117 points. He is 22 rebounds away from becoming the ninth player to amass 600 in a career.

**Titans Punch Ticket:** Cal State Fullerton's two home wins against Cal State Northridge and Long Beach State last week clinched a berth in next week's Big West Tournament. The Titans have won

four of their last six games.

**Quite The Roll:** Senior Michael Williams has notched 20 or more points in seven of his last eight outings. In the last eight games, the 6-2 guard is averaging 22.4 points. Williams, who has scored in double figures in all 28 games, had 28 points on 12 of 18 shooting against LBSU on Saturday.

**Recipe For Success:** The Titans shot a combined 54.6% (59 of 108) in the two wins last week, improving to 7-0 on the season when they shoot 50 percent or better. CSF has scored at least 74 points in those seven wins.

**Harris Doing His Part:** Junior Alex Harris has scored in double figures in 14 straight games, and he has six 20-point efforts during that stretch. Harris made 18 trips to the free throw line against LBSU en route to a 22-point performance.
