Player Of The Week

Christian Standhardinger • Hawai'i
Sr. • 6-8 • Forward
Munich, Germany/Nebraska

Christian Standhardinger helped Hawai'i to a pair of double-digit victories over Tennessee State and Western Michigan, earning the senior the Big West Men's Basketball Player of the Week award.

Standhardinger averaged 18.5 points and 8.0 rebounds per game while shooting 46.2 percent (12-of 26) from the field. In just 21 minutes of action, he recorded the 10th double-double of his career with 20 points and 12 rebounds in the 85-55 win over Tennessee State. It was the largest margin of victory ever in a season-opener against a Division I opponent for the Rainbow Warriors.

The 6-8 forward collected a team-high 17 points the next night as UH downed Western Michigan, 78-68. In addition to posting four rebounds, an assist, a block and a steal, Standhardinger scored 12 of his points in the first half to help UH build a 39-36 halftime lead.

This is Standhardinger's third career Big West Player of the Week honor.

Tough Setbacks: Cal Poly is off to an 0-2 start after losing on the road to No. 5 Arizona (73-62) and at home to Nevada (60-58). The Mustangs led the Wolf Pack by four points with 28 seconds to go,

but two turnovers proved costly in the waning seconds. Cal Poly is 0-2 for the first time since the 2009-10 season.

Eversley Off To Good Start: Senior Chris Eversley has continued the solid play that led to his selection as an All-Big West First Team pick. The forward scored 17 points at Arizona and added 19 more against Nevada for his 35th and 36th career double-digit scoring games.

Mott Magic: Cal Poly's loss to Nevada was the first in 13 games at the Mott Athletics Center. The Mustangs finished 13-1 at home last year, including a perfect 9-0 mark in conference games.

Odister Brilliant Versus Wildcats: Senior guard Kyle Odister knocked in a career-high seven three-pointers to finish with a game-high 21 points against Arizona.

Congrats, Coach: Cal State Fullerton's Dedrique Taylor got off to a roaring start in his collegiate head coaching debut at Montana State, as the Titans shellacked the Bobcats, 84-55. CSF drained

nine three-pointers in 18 attempts.

Harris Continues Solid Play: Junior Alex Harris, the team's leading returner scorer at 10.5 points per game, delivered an impressive contribution in the season opener with a game-high 20 points against the Bobcats. Harris connected on 8-of-13 floor shots to help the Titans shoot 53.6% for the game.

Keep Up The Road Work: The Titans, which open the season with four of their first five games on the road, continue a two-game trip to the Northwest with a Wednesday game at Seattle University. The matchup is the first of a home-and-away series this season between the Titans and Redhawks. CSF looks for back-to-back road wins for the first time since defeating Cal State Northridge (1/5/13) and CSU Bakersfield (1/9/13).

Theus Wins In Debut: The Matador head coaching debut of Reggie Theus was successful as Cal State Northridge earned an 86-74 victory over Hope International last Friday. The Matadors could

not repeat the outcome in game two as they fell, 95-79, at USC on Tuesday.

Freebie Fest: Cal State Northridge turned in one of the best free throw shooting performances in NCAA history against Hope International. The Matadors sank 32 of 33 attempts for a .970 success rate, which represented the sixth-best percentage in a single game ever. UC Irvine and Pacific (2/21/81) along with Samford and Central Florida (12/20/90) own the record with a perfect 1.000 on 34 of 34 shooting.

Greene Hits Milestone: Senior guard Josh Greene posted 16 points in his season debut to give him 1,006 for his career, making him the 16th player in Cal State Northridge history to reach the millenium milestone. Greene slid past Ollie Carter (1964-66), who had 1,003 points, into 15th place on the school's career scoring list.

Career Bests: The two cornerstones of Long Beach State's roster, junior Mike Caffey and senior Dan Jennings, had career-best performances on opening night. Caffey scored a career-high 27 points while Jennings registered a double-double, posting 10 points with a career-high 17 rebounds.

More Jennings: Jennings was one of the few bright spots for the 49ers in their 91-57 loss at No. 5 Arizona on Tuesday. Jennings tied for game high honors with 16 points and hit 8 of 10 free throws. He also added eight rebounds, a block and a steal in 27 minutes.

Even Steven: UC Davis went 1-1 to open the 2013-14 season. The Aggies dropped a 100-83 decision at Portland and walloped Holy Names, 80-54. Davis begins a four-game roadtrip this Friday at Utah, concluding the following week with its second trip to the state of Oregon in the Portland State Tournament.

Stellar Debut For Hawkins: Corey Hawkins, the 2012-13 Big West Newcomer of the Year, had a solid line in last Friday's opener against the Pilots. He compiled 16 points, eight rebounds and seven assists to just miss on recording the first Aggie triple-double since Mark Payne did so against Sacramento State during the 2007-08 season.

Long Distance Party: Senior guard Ryan Sypkens is one of the top shooters in the Big West, and he proved that again against Holy Names.
