Will Davis II • UC Irvine

Sacramento, Calif./New Hampton (N.H.) Prep

Junior Will Davis II shot 73.1 percent from the floor to help UC Irvine to a 2-1 record, including a road win over Pac-12 Conference school Washington, earning the Big West Men's Basketball Player of the Week award.

The 6-8 forward drained 10 of 12 shots en route to 22 points against the Huskies in an 86-72 UCI win. He added seven rebounds and two blocked shots in 26 minutes.

Davis II also had 12 points, three rebounds and two blocks in an 84-79 loss at Pacific. He finished the week with 13 points in just 11 minutes in a 110-73 blowout of Pacifica.

For the week, Davis II averaged 15.7 points, 4.7 rebounds and 1.3 blocks per game.

which would also be the longest since that 2009-10 squad opened with five straight defeats.

Marksmen: Senior Kyle Odister has engineered a solid start to the 2013-14 season from the perimeter. The guard has knocked down 10 of his 24 three-point attempts for a 41.7 percent success rate. Ten of Odister's 11 made field goals have come from behind the arc.

Start A New Streak: Cal Poly's loss to Nevada on Nov. 12 was the first in 13 games at the Mott Athletics Center. The Mustangs look to begin a new win streak when Bethesda visits this Saturday.

We Meet Again: After playing Montana State in the Central Michigan Tournament, the Matadors suit up against the Bobcats for the second time in five days as the two teams meet again in Bozeman on Nov. 26.

Three Amigos: The trio of senior Josh Greene and juniors Stephen Maxwell and Stephan Hicks contributed prominently to the Matador stat sheet in 2012-13, and this year is no different. All three are averaging double figures in scoring, and have combined for 150 of the team's 229 points. Maxwell is currently tied for fourth in the Big West at 17.7 points and third in rebounds at 9.3 per game. Hicks is now just 108 points away from reaching the milestone 1,000 for his career.

Sypkens Still Sinking The Trey: Senior guard Ryan Sypkens is tied for the Big West lead with 12 three-pointers. After leading the conference with 106 treys in 2012-13, the eighth-highest single-season total all-time, Sypkens now has 232 threes for his career. He needs one more to tie former UC Irvine player Ross Schraeder (2002-06) at No. 12 on the Big West career list. Sypkens is five short from entering the top 10.
