Player Of The Week

Josh Ritchart • UC Davis
Sr. • 6-9 • Forward
Auburn, Calif./Forest Lake Christian HS

UC Davis senior Josh Ritchart secured Big West Men's Basketball Player of the Week accolades after helping the Aggies to a pair of wins at the Portland State Tournament, which included a career-high in points.

The 6-9 forward exploded for a career-high 35 points in a tournament-opening 80-75 victory over SIUE. Ritchart made 12 of 14 floor shots, including all three of his three-point attempts, and added 13 rebounds to cement his first double-double of the season.

In a 64-61 overtime victory against Loyola-Chicago, Ritchart just missed a second consecutive double-double as he notched nine points and nine rebounds. He closed out the tournament with 17 points on 7-of-12 shooting to go along with seven rebounds in a 79-63 loss to the host Vikings.

For the week, Ritchart averaged 20.3 points, 9.7 rebounds and 1.0 steals per game as the Aggies improved to 3-3 on the season. He shot 67.6 (23 of 34) percent from the field and 44.4 (4 of 9) percent from three-point range.

Into The Win Column: Cal Poly shook off three straight losses to open the season and planted a 39-point rout on Bethesda University on Saturday. The 78-39 win represented the fewest points

allowed by Cal Poly both overall and at home since defeating Pacific on Mar. 3, 2012.

Wide Margin Winning: Cal Poly's 39-point triumph against Bethesda also was its largest margin of victory since walloping Menlo College 89-43 on Dec. 8, 2012.

Assistance: Senior guard Jamal Johnson's combined five assists against Fresno State and Bethesda last week gave him 221 for his career, moving him into sole possession of seventh place all-time at Cal Poly.

Nwaba's Contributions: Sophomore David Nwaba recorded his third double-digit scoring effort in four games when he posted a career-high 14 points against Bethesda. The 6-4 wing hit 5 of 6 shots in the victory, and is 10 for his last 13 (76.9%) over the last two games.

Unfortunate Turn: The Titans suffered a pair of double-digit road losses last week to USC and San Jose State, but were without the services of leading scorer Alex Harris, who missed both games with

a right ankle sprain and is currently listed as day-to-day. Harris is averaging 17.7 points per game.

Titans To Host Wooden Legacy: Cal State Fullerton is set to host the DirecTV Wooden Legacy at Titan Gym on Nov. 28-29 before the tournament moves to Honda Center for four placement games on Sunday. In addition to the Titans, the loaded field includes Arizona State, College of Charleston, No. 18 Creighton, George Washington, Marquette, Miami and San Diego State.

Williams Making Impact: Senior Michael Williams, a transfer from San Francisco, has started all five games for the Titans and has scored in double figures in each. The guard also has been an adept rebounder, corralling five or more boards in all but one outing. Williams ranks second on the team with 5.2 rebounds per game.

Road Journey Closes: The Matadors conclude their longest roadtrip in school history (nine days, four games) when they visit Montana State on Tuesday. In all, CSUN will have played six straight

games away from the Matadome. CSUN defeated the Bobcats in the opening game of last week's Central Michigan Tournament, 74-73.

Hicks Nears Milestone: Cal State Northridge junior Stephan Hicks scored 62 points over three games at the Central Michigan Tournament to earn All-Tournament honors. He left with 954 career points, just 46 short of becoming the 17th player in school history to reach 1,000.

Free Is Free: Hicks, who had a season-high 24 points in an 80-77 overtime victory against Austin Peay, accounted for half of those on free throws. The forward canned 12-of-12 from the line to tie the school record for free throw percentage in a game. Thanks to players like Hicks, the Matadors lead the Big West in team free throw percentage (.812), shooting 75 percent or better five times this season.

Streak Hits Six: Long Beach State's litany of tough non-conference opponents continued last week with consecutive losses to No. 14 Michigan, No. 10 VCU and Kansas State at the Puerto Rico Tip-Off,

extending the team's losing streak to six straight. The slide is the longest in head coach Dan Monson's LBSU tenure since year one, when the 49ers ended the 2007-08 season with eight straight losses.

Not Getting Any Easier: The 49ers do not get a breather as their next action is a road game at Washington, followed by a home clash with No. 18 Creighton.

Monson Tied For Second: Head coach Dan Monson sits at 105 career wins while at Long Beach State. He currently shares the No. 2 spot for most wins with Seth Greenberg (1990-96).

Spencer Steps Up: Junior guard A.J. Spencer tallied a career-high 14 points as LBSU's upset bid against VCU came up short in a 73-67 loss. It was the fourth straight game that Spencer had scored in double figures.

Aggie Success: UC Davis took its second trip to the state of Portland in the month of November, and came away with a successful outcome. The Aggies were twice victorious at the Portland State Tournament, downing SIUE and Loyola-Chicago by five and three points, respectively.

Sypkens Tees Up 1,000: Senior guard Ryan Sypkens stands just five points shy of 1,000 when the Aggies take the court Tuesday against Causeway Cup rival Sacramento State. Sypkens seeks to become the 19th Aggie in program history to reach the milestone. The last player to do so was Mark Payne on Nov. 14, 2010.

Looking Ahead For Ritchart: Senior Josh Ritchart seems intact on making his final year at UC Davis a memorable one. He currently is tied for the Big West scoring lead with Hawaii's Christian Standhardinger at 18.0 points per game. Ritchart erupted for a career-high 35 points against SIUE to open the Portland State Tournament. With 61 points in three tournament games, Ritchart now has 917 career points and has begun his approach to the 1,000 milestone.
