Player Of The Week

Alan Williams • UC Santa Barbara
Jr. • 6-7 • Forward
Phoenix, Ariz./North HS

UC Santa Barbara junior Alan Williams (Phoenix, Ariz./North HS) tied two school records in leading the Gauchos to a win over South Dakota State, earning Big West Men's Basketball Player of the Week honors.

The 6-7 forward equalled Gaucho single-game records in points (39) and blocked shots (8) in an 83-64 victory over the Jackrabbits, an NCAA Tournament team in 2013. The eight blocks tied for the third-most in Big West history.

Williams scored 26 of his points in the decisive second half on 10-of-12 shooting from the field as the Gauchos distanced themselves from South Dakota State after leading by just two at halftime. He made 16-of-25 shots overall and hit 7-of-9 from the charity stripe. Williams added nine rebounds, three steals and a pair of assists.

It was an impressive return to the court for Williams, who had missed the previous two games with back spasms. **Others nominated:** Chris Eversley (Cal Poly); Stephan Hicks (Cal State Northridge); Mike Caffey (Long Beach State); Chris McNealy (UC Irvine); Christian Standhardinger (Hawai'i)

Back Home For Two: Cal Poly returns to the Mott Athletics Center for a pair of games over the next two weeks, beginning with a game this Saturday against Santa Clara. The Mustangs

are coming off a 1-2 performance at the Global Sports Hardwood Challenge in Eugene, Ore.

Another Close Loss: The Mustangs lost their second game this season by a single basket, falling 73-71 to former Big West member Pacific on Saturday. Senior Kyle Odister missed a potential game-tying shot at the buzzer. Cal Poly lost by two points to Nevada (60-58) back on Nov. 12.

Double-Double: Senior Chris Eversley posted his ninth career double-double with 22 points and 10 rebounds in the loss to Pacific. It was also the second game at the Oregon-hosted tournament that he recorded double-digit rebounds. Eversley had 10 caroms against North Dakota.

Ball Control: Cal Poly leads the Big West and ranks No. 11 in the nation in fewest turnovers per game (9.6).

Skid Reaches Five: The Titans lost all three games at the DirecTV Wooden Legacy last weekend, falling to No. 25 Marquette, Miami (FL) and College of Charleston. Cal State Fullerton has now

lost five in a row. The team seeks to stop the slide on Wednesday at Pepperdine.

Williams Producing At High Level: Senior guard Michael Williams averaged 15.0 points in three DirecTV Wooden Legacy Classic games and extended his personal streak of double-digit scoring contests to eight straight. Williams ranks No. 10 in the Big West in scoring at 14.1 points per game.

Blackwell Emerges: Look for freshman Sheldon Blackwell to make positive strides for the Titan program. The 6-5 guard made the first two starts of his collegiate career against Miami (FL) and College of Charleston. Against the Hurricanes, he produced 13 points to go along with six assists and three steals. Blackwell knocked down seven of his 14 floor shots in the two starts.

Home Sweet Home: Following a nine-day roadtrip that logged nearly 6,000 miles, Cal State Northridge returned to the Matadome Sunday and walloped La Sierra by a 97-79 score. It was the first of three straight and five of the next six on the CSUN home floor.

Hicks On Cusp Of Milestone: Cal State Northridge junior Stephan Hicks should become the 17th player in school history to reach 1,000 career points against Southern Utah on Tuesday. The 6-6 guard/forward enters the game with 998 points.

On A Roll: Hicks has approached the 1,000 point barrier rather quickly using a recent stretch of scoring prowess. He has reeled off four straight 20-point games, and is shooting 60.8 percent (31-for-51) during that span.

That's Efficient: Junior Stephen Maxwell made the most of his 23 minutes against La Sierra, compiling his fourth double-double of the season with 21 points and 13 rebounds, including seven on the offensive end.

The 49ers took Washington to double overtime before succumbing, 92-89. The seven-game skid is the program's longest since 2007-08 when the 49ers ended the season with eight straight defeats.

Monson Looking For Space: Head coach Dan Monson sits at 105 career wins while at Long Beach State. He currently shares the No. 2 spot for most wins with Seth Greenberg (1990-96). He looks to take sole possession of that spot with his next win, with a chance to do so Tuesday against Creighton.

Caffey Remarkable Against Huskies: Junior Mike Caffey notched a career-high 28 points and tied his career best of nine assists in the loss to Washington. The point guard also made a season-high four three-pointers in the game.

Beach On The Tube: The seventh game in LBSU's young season is slated for the tube on Saturday when Fox Sports Prime Ticket will show the 49ers play at North Carolina State.
